NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS - 31 DECEMBER 2014

1. PRINCIPAL OBJECTIVES

The Society was registered on 1 July 2014 with the principal objectives to assist and to provide support for the less fortunate communities in Malaysia. The principal office and registered address is located at No.70B, Jalan Anggerik Vanilla, Z31Z/, Seksyen 3, Kota Kemuning, 40460 Shah Alam, Selangor.

2. BASIS OF PREPARATION AND SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

a) Basic of Preparation

The financial statements of the Society has been prepared under the historical cost convention and comply with applicable Approved Accounting Standards issued by the Malaysian Association Standards Board.

b) Property, Plant and Equipment

Property, plant and equipment are stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation.

Depreciation of the furniture and fittings is computed on a straight line basis to write-off the cost to its residual value over its estimated useful life at 20% p.a.

The carrying values of the assets are reviewed for impairment when there is an indication that the assets might be impaired. Impairment is measured by comparing the carrying values of the assets with their recoverable amounts.

An impairment loss is charged to the income and expenditure account immediately, unless the asset is carried at revalued amount. Any impairment loss of a revalued asset is treated as a revaluation decrease to the extent of previously recognised revaluation surplus for the same asset.

Subsequent increase in the recoverable amount of an asset is treated as reversal of the previous impairment loss and is recognised to the extent of the carrying amount of the asset that would have been determined (net of amortisation and depreciation) had no impairment loss been recognised. The reversal is recognised in the income statement immediately, unless the asset is carried at revalued amount.

c) Capital Work-In-Progress

Capital work-in-progress consists of land and building under construction. The amount is stated at cost and includes capitalisation of interest incurred on borrowings related to property under construction until the property is ready for its intended use. Capital work-in-progress is not depreciated as this asset is not available for intended use.

d) Income Recognition

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable on an accrual basis. Revenue is recognised to the extent that it is probable that economic benefits associated with the transactions will flow to the Society.
