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HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the third quarter of 2018, our Dialysis Aid Program supported 28 kidney patients who are either low income earners or unemployed due to their medical condition, compared to 18 supported cases within the same period in 2017. Each patient receives a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM130 to RM1,000 per month for a period of six (6) months or more to ease their burden. Special thanks to Yayasan Kossan for their support to fund five of our beneficiaries (listed as number 1 ~ 5 below) in Jul 18, and another five of our beneficiaries in Aug 18 and Sep 18 (listed as number 18, 21, 22, 23, and 24 below). HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



NG KAH YOK @ HWANG PAIK YIK

Madam Ng is a 77-year-old dialysis patient who is separated from her husband. Her eldest daughter takes care of her, working overtime to support the family. Madam Ng had applied for MOH subsidies in April 2018 and is currently still awaiting for reply from the lengthy approval process.



MURUGAN A/L RAGAVAN

Murugan is a hardworking 39 years old man who was diagnosed with kidney disease at an early age. Despite his sickness, he worked hard as a freelance truck driver. During our recent visit in Aug 2018, he has started a fruit delivery business on his own. GHCA decided to provide support for his business initiative. For more details, kindly refer to the Individual Cases – Family Care section.



TOH SOK HOI

Madam Toh is a 57-year-old dialysis patient housewife. Her husband used to own a fish-ball business but is no longer able to continue his business after a heart surgery. During our visit in July 2018, she felt much healthier and less dizzy. Her three children are working hard to support her financially.



LIEW TZER GIO

Liew is a 33 years old insurance agent and Grab driver. He suffers from high blood pressure, kidney disease, and anaemia. During our visit in Aug 2018, he had undergone parathyroidectomy operation due to excruciating pain in his bones. Doctor had advised him to take 5 Epoetin injection weekly during hemodialysis treatment.



Monthly Dialysis Expenses:

RM2,000 → RM160

LOW KAR WAI

Low, aged 39, used to work as a freelance script writer in film production. He has two kids aged 10 and 12. His SOCSO assistance application was thankfully approved in August 2018, reducing his dialysis expenses to RM160 monthly. Thus, our monthly subsidies were used to pay off his outstanding dialysis treatment fee of RM3,000.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



LOH YUN SHEONG

Mr Loh is 53 years old and has undergone dialysis treatment for more than 10 years. He requires epoetin injection for his treatment due to anaemia. His blood level had decrease to 6.5 in July 2018 and he was admitted to the hospital but was found to be alright after a medical check-up. Thus, the dialysis centre doctor might prescribe him with a different blood injection treatment.

Monthly Personal Income:

RM 0 → RM200



THOO FOONG MING

Madam Thoo is a 62 years old widow. During our visit in August 2018, her health condition has improved, where she can now operate a stall at a nearby night market to sell toys and earn around RM200 monthly.



PASCHAL GOMEZ

Paschal Gomez is 77 years old and was diagnosed with Crohn's Disease and kidney failure. During our visit in September 2018, he had done an operation to insert a fistula on his hand that allows doctor to put injection via his hands and not neck anymore. This reduces his chance of getting a viral infection.



SAMEY @ ANNASAMY A/L KANNAN

Mr Samey, age 71, suffers from diabetes, high blood pressure, and kidney disease. He is a leg amputee and now uses a wheelchair and artificial limb for mobility. His body gets numb and stiff after his heamodialysis treatment, causing him to be depressed. Samey had applied for MOH subsidies in July 2018 and is waiting for approval.



Monthly Dialysis Expenses:

RM2,050 → RM 0

KUMARARAJA A/L SELVANATHAN

Mr Kumararaja is a kidney disease patient supported by his wife who works 12 hours daily in a semiconductor factory to cover their household expenses and his dialysis fee. During the visitation in July 2018, his wife income has increased by RM500 due to OT pay. He was also successfully transferred to the Banting Hospital in September 18, which does not require dialysis fee. Thus, he will no longer require our dialysis aid.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



NAGAMAH A/P GOPAL

Nagamah, 68 years old, is diagnosed with kidney failure and she is supported by her daughter. Madam Nagamah is showing signs of memory and dementia issues. From July 2018 onwards, she needs to take three injections weekly compared to two previously, and she will vomit occasionally. She is however grateful for our vital support.



LEDCHUMANAN A/L GURUNaidu

Mr Ledchumanan is 64 years old and needs RM1,800 monthly to cover for his dialysis fees. His household expenses are catered by both his children. His condition has caused a financial and emotional strain to his family. Ledchumanan had submitted his application for MOH subsidies in August 2018 and is now waiting for approval.



MUNIANDY A/L PALAR

Mr Muniandy 64 years old, used to work as a rubber tapper. His wife had utilised all her EPF savings for his dialysis fee, but it only lasted for a year. Despite the efforts put in by his wife to take care of his daily needs, Muniandy passed away in September 2018 after struggling hard with diabetes, kidney failure, and depression.



POOMALAI A/L VELLASAMY

Mr Poomalai is 68 years old and is on dialysis treatment 3 times weekly. We had been supporting him for his dialysis treatment for the past four years. During our visit in September 2018, his daughter who used to stay with him had move out and is no longer supporting him financially anymore.



DEVINDRAN A/L MONIAM

Devindran is 35 years old and has walking complications. With MOH's increased subsidies recently, his treatment cost has been reduced to RM130 monthly. He wanted to focus on running a car wash business so that he can be financially independent, but he is currently facing trouble identifying a suitable place to run the business.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



LEE KAH CHUN

Mr Lee is 30 years old but has been diagnosed with kidney failure, diabetes, and dry gangrene. He lives in pain every day, surviving on painkiller. He had amputated both his legs and one finger due to his condition. He is currently waiting for MOH subsidies approval after his father assisted him in submitting his application in August 2018.



GOPAL A/L SINNTHAMBY

Mr Gopal is an unemployed 62 years old man. Starting from September 2018, our monthly support for Gopal will be increased to RM1,000 after finding out from our visit in August 2018 that his wife's savings has been almost depleted to pay for his dialysis treatment. We will also be supporting his wife Arulselvi with RM150 worth of groceries support to ease their burden.



MAH LAI MUN

Ms Mah suffers from blurred vision, diabetes and kidney failure. Her partner takes care of her during the day and work as a Grab car driver at night. During our visit in September 2018, we found out that Ms Mah had sadly undergone a surgery to remove her left eyeball due to a virus infection. She often felt discomfort and relied heavily on her partner to take care of her.



CHEN SIEW CHIN

Madam Chen has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Two of her children had abandoned her, while another was unable to support her financially. Her relative provides her with shelter and daily meals. During our visit in September 2018, she is now taking epoetin injection twice weekly as her haemoglobin level had reduced.



LAI SANG

Mr Lai is a 55 years old dialysis patient who worked as a part time painter. He was abandoned by his 3 children and is living in a dilapidated factory owned by his boss. GHCA had been supporting his dialysis treatment. He met with a car accident on 26 September 2018 and was admitted to the ICU, with his condition remaining under observation.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



YEONG MEE LIN

Madam Yeong is a 67 years old mother suffering from kidney failure, mild stroke, blurred vision, and knee pain. Her second daughter had migrated to Macau but provides her with RM800 monthly allowance. Yeong successfully went through a laser surgery to treat her blurred vision in August 2018 and can see better now.



YONG KOON TAK

Mr Yong, 59 years old, suffers from diabetes, high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney failure. His wife, aged 57, worked as a clerk to support the family. During our visit in September 2018, he informed us that he had a blood vessel blockage and will be undergoing a heart operation in March 2019 to clear it.



CHONG CHUN ONN

Mr Chong, 36 years old, used to work as chef in Singapore but his medical condition changes all that. He will be having a surgical procedure to insert a fistula into his hand in October 2018 for his dialysis treatment. GHCA is also exploring on supporting him with a motorcycle deposit which will enable him to find work with the vehicle.



TAN LI CHIN

Madam Tan, aged 50, lives in a small house at Pulau Ketam. She had to take a ferry to Port Klang thrice weekly to receive haemodialysis treatment in Klang. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, and heart ailment. Her second daughter has to quit her job to take care of her. In July 2018, she relocated to Klang to ease her frequent visitation to the Klang Hospital.



LIM WAI CHEAH

Ms Lim, 22 years old, suffers from anaemia, diabetes, kidney failure, and blindness. She relies on her monthly Socso of RM1,900, which is insufficient to cover her medical expenses and meals. Fortunately, her sister is providing her with food and shelter. In September 2018, she was admitted into the Klang Hospital again due to anaemia. Her health condition remains unstable.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



TAN HAN BEE

Madam Tan, 68 years old, suffers from high blood pressure and kidney failure. She runs a sewing business in a small shop but as the rental increase, she faced difficulty to sustain her business. She earned roughly RM1,000 monthly. Previously, she received MOH subsidies, but it was stopped in June 2018. Therefore, we are supporting Madam Tan with RM720 monthly.



MENG KWAI SIM

Madam Meng is a 66 years old single lady who stays alone. She had previously worked as a babysitter, promoter, and assistant supervisor for more than 30 years. Four years ago, she was diagnosed with thyroid cancer, high blood pressure, and kidney failure. This prevented her from earning a living. GHCA is supporting her with RM720 monthly subsidy for her haemodialysis treatment fee.



LIM CHIN GEE

Mr Lim, aged 49, lives in a shop lot at Klang. He was diagnosed with kidney failure, high blood pressure, and heart ailment, with only 60% of his heart being functional. He often felt dizzy after haemodialysis treatment. His wife and daughter are working as waitresses in a small restaurant to help cover their household expenses. Thankfully, his dialysis expense was mostly covered by PERKESO with the remaining RM160 monthly being subsidised by GHCA. We also supported him with 6 months of groceries.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Family Care

In the third quarter of 2018, we have reached out to 37 underprivileged families, compared to 28 families within the same period in 2017. Special thanks to Project Cabel and Cari Online Media for funding our beneficiaries in quarter 3, and to Ms Denise Gan for supporting 22 beneficiaries in July 2018, and 3 beneficiaries in August 2018.

PATMANATHAN A/L ELLAPAN

Mr Patmanathan was diagnosed with diabetes, kidney failure, cataract, and had his leg amputated. He is unable to continue his previous work role due to his physical disability. During our visit in August 18, his financial condition has stabilised with his son currently working. Thus, he no longer requires grocery support anymore.



SUSEILA A/P VELLIAH

Suseila, 64 years old, has heart disease and high blood pressure. After the sudden passing away of her husband Anandakumar in April 2018, we had been providing her with groceries support. In July 2018, she successfully obtained a living allowance of RM600 per month from her husband's SOCSO. She now does not need to worry about her living expenses anymore.



TAN LEE HU

Mr Tan, 41 years old, is a father of 2 children and with a hearing-impaired wife. He previously worked as a sub-contractor but is now taking on odd jobs due to his knee condition which gets painful when he walks. As the sole breadwinner, he struggles with his monthly expenses. GHCA is supporting him with RM300 monthly grocery support for 6 months from September 2018.



MAHESWARY A/P RAMASANDIRAN

Madam Maheswary, 41 years old, worked as a cleaner and earned around RM1,000 a month. She had to cover her house rental, groceries, and also take care of her cousin brother Saravanan, who is one of GHCA's Family Care beneficiary. GHCA is assisting her with RM150 grocery support for 4 months from September 2018 onwards to ease her financial burden.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



ARULSEVI A/P PERIASAMY

Madam Arulsevi, 59, is the wife of GHCA's Dialysis Aid beneficiary, Gopal. She is a full-time house wife who takes care of her leg amputee husband. She had used up all her EPF savings to cover her husband's medical fees. GHCA is assisting her with RM150 grocery support for 6 months, which starts from September 2018 until February 2019.



PREMA A/P GANAPATHY

Prema is a 43 years old single mother of four. She works as a labourer in bakeries and restaurants, earning RM500. She plans to start an ice cream stall business but does not have the capital. GHCA will be assisting her with 6 months groceries, along with ice box equipment and ingredients to jumpstart her business. In the future, she plans to extend her business to include selling fruit rojak and is currently looking for a suitable place.



YAP EN BOO @ YAP AH MAI

Madam Yap, 71 years, suffers from diabetes and high blood pressure. She has 9 children, with 7 of them married but did not provide allowance to her. One of her son is taking care of her, together with her daughter which has Down Syndrome. Support is still ongoing for Madam Yap.



NG SIEW KIAU

Madam Ng, aged 67, has epilepsy since young and has been unemployed due to her physical condition. She relies on Social Welfare aid for her rental and get her meals via GHCC's Lunch Box for the Hungry program. During our visit in September 2018, she was much relieved with our assistance and is thankful for being able to buy her own food now.



LIM CHIN GEE

Mr Lim, aged 49, is a GHCA Dialysis Aid beneficiary. We provided his family with a RM300 monthly grocery subsidy in addition to the dialysis aid to ease his burden. He often felt guilty for not being able to support his family, since his wife and daughter are the ones who shoulder their household expenses by working as restaurant waitresses.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



CHELVAN A/L MUTHOO

Mr Chelvan, a 55-years-old divorcee, recently obtained employment as a contract security guard, earning RM1,200 but working 12 hours a day. In our last month of support in August 2018, Chelvan thanked us for helping with his rental during his time in need until he is able to manage his own expenses now.



DAYANIDHI A/L ARUMUGAM SHANMUGAM

Dayanidhi is an 11-year-old boy with cerebral palsy and who can only consume PediaSure milk as his diet. In August 2018, he had to be hospitalised after showing signs of self-mutilation behaviour, but it was soon under control. GHCA is now assisting her mother to market her homemade Muruku to nearby restaurants to increase their household income.



LACHEMY A/P PERISAMY

Madam Lachemy is a single, 67-years-old lady who suffers from diabetes, high blood pressure, and depression. She recently found a job as an office cleaner and is appreciating her life more with her current job and situation.



LOH CHOONG WEI

Choong Wei, aged 7, suffers from epilepsy and is the grandson of Madam Thoo Foong Ming, one of our beneficiaries for kidney dialysis subsidies. Support for his diapers and milk powder will be stopped in August 2018 as his father's tuberculosis is now under control and can therefore work to bear his children's expenses.



Monthly Work Income:

NEROSHA A/P KRISHNAN

Nerosha is a young girl who met with a horrible motor accident in February 2014. She had bowel and perineal injuries, and her intestine was dislodged outside her body. She now needs to use colostomy bag to pass motion for the rest of her life. Despite her physical condition, she started a small business selling washing detergents and ice-cream from her home, earning around RM200 monthly.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



NG CHING MEE

Madam Ng is a 63-years-old frail lady and is taken care of by her single daughter. She has osteoporosis combined with backbone spinal compression and was in constant pain. Thankfully, in August 2018, her health condition improves, and she is no longer in pain due to her current medication and nutrition intake.



NG JOE ZE

Joe Ze is 11 years old and has learning disability. He lives in a family of 10 with his 7 siblings, father, mother, and grandmother. Since being discharged from the hospital for suspected H1N1 in May 2018, he had been attending his tuition classes diligently, where the teacher was always patient and provided extra care towards him.



PARAMESWARY A/P RAJINDRA

Madam Parameswary has two children, with one having Down Syndrome and requires extra care. She works as a tailor. GHCA had assisted her to apply for aid from the Social Welfare Department it was great news when her application was approved in September 2018 with a monthly aid of RM350 from the Social Welfare Department.



SARAVANAN A/L SIVALINGAM

Mr Saravanan is a severe diabetes and cataract patient who suffered a serious fall down the stairs. GHCA has been providing transportation subsidy for his travel to the hospital for treatment. Unfortunately, his situation does not improve after 6 months of treatment. GHCA will be providing Saravanan with a wheelchair in October 2018 to aid his mobility.



SEONG YOKE SIM

Madam Seong, 87-years-old, is bed-ridden and has high blood pressure. Her single mother daughter takes care of her along with three primary-school-going children. Her health condition remained good in our September 2018 visit and her daughter is grateful for our support to Madam Seong that enables her to maintain her health condition.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



TAN HOCK CHUAN

Mr Tan now works as a daily wage helper in a renovation company, earning up to RM900 monthly. His wife works as a part time cleaner and also helped out at GHCC. Both are working hard for their 3 children's future. During our August 2018 visit, they no longer have to collect recyclables for a living anymore.

THERESAMAH A/P SAMUEL PILLAI

Madam Theresamah 64-years-old, used to rely on her retired husband's pension for a living. She recently secured a part-time job as restaurant cleaner, earning RM360 monthly. Her health has also improved, with stabilising blood sugar level.



RANJIT KAUR AP KARTAR SINGH

Madam Ranjit, 56-years-old, is a mentally ill stroke patient. She stays with her younger sister and 5 children. She is unable to work as she faints occasionally. During our visit in September 2018, both sisters were thankful to our support but hope that our groceries support could be extended for the sake of the 5 children.



GAMMALA A/P P MUNISAMY

Madam Gammala, 65 years old, is a single mother with 2 mentally disabled children. She has high blood pressure and frequently falls sick. They relied on Social Welfare aid to pay for rental, utility bills, and medication. During visit in August 2018, she reported to be constantly bothered by headache and needed to visit the clinic often.

ALVIN A/L J RICHARD

Mr Alvin lost his job in April 2018 due to a hand injury. His wife is unable to work as she must take care of their four children. With encouragement from our volunteers, he found a security guard job in June 2018, earning RM1,000. Further good news awaits when he found a better job as an assistant chef in August 2018, earning around RM1,500 monthly.

CHUA AI KONG

Mr Chua, 63-years-old, is diagnosed with Parkinson disease. He used to be a fisherman but had thereafter worked together with his wife as a labourer to peel off shrimp skin. Sadly, his wife passed away in September 2018, leaving him all alone. He now turned his life focus onto his job to prevent himself from missing his wife every day.



TOH BEE CHOO

Madam Toh, 41 years old, is a widow staying alone in her ancestral house. She suffers from high blood pressure and was unable to work long hours. During our visit in September 2018, we bought her a new pair of spectacles to replace her damaged one and brought her some nutritional supplements that was advised by her doctor.



ELWIN RAJ A/L A. EASTER

Elwin, 16 years old, is bed-ridden, suffers from muscular dystrophy and severe scoliosis, and can only take milk as his diet. His mother, Gomathi, is one of our beneficiaries for business start-up support. In July 2018, he began to consume Milo beverages without throwing up. We now include Milo as part of his monthly grocery supplies.



DAVID A/L ANTHONIAPAN

Mr David, 51 years old, is wheelchair-bound and had his right hand amputated. He has an 11 years old daughter and makes a living selling handcraft souvenirs in Batu Caves. Every month, he spends over RM200 on medical supplies. Support is still ongoing by GHCA to assist David in subsidising for his medical supplies.

GOMATHI A/P RAMASAMY

Madam Gomathi, is a 43 year old single mother of 2 children. Initially unemployed, we assisted her to start a nasi lemak stall to support her family's expenses, earning RM1,500 monthly. She expanded her business to include delivery of nasi lemak and kuih from August 2018 onwards, earning roughly a further RM400 monthly.

LEE PEI TENG

Madam Lee, 39 years old, was raised in a single-parent family. She had spinocerebellar ataxia and relies on a wheelchair for mobility. Her speech is unclear at times. During our recent follow up, her speech was clearer, with better strength on four limbs as her mother assisted her with physiotherapy exercises daily at home.



HE MOI ENG

Madam He, 51, is a widow with 2 daughters. One of them is a slow learner. She has high blood pressure and kidney failure and can barely work. Thankfully, she is able to seek her haemodialysis treatment in the Melaka General Hospital. GHCA is assisting her with 3 months grocery subsidy of RM300 monthly.



KRISHNAKUMAR A/L ARUMUGAM

Mr Krishnakumar, 37, is a father of four and has pancreas stone. He used to work as a security guard but had stopped as he can hardly walk as his health deteriorates. He is now working part time repairing electronic appliances from home but is struggling to earn a living to feed his children and wife.



AMELIN TEOH MEI SUN

Ms Amelin, 19 years old, was diagnosed with second stage brain tumour. She had difficulty walking while her radiotherapy treatment had induced vomiting. Her mother takes care of her while she is bed-ridden and unconscious. Amelin requires constant supplies of milk powder and diapers, with her sister being the family sole breadwinner working as a hospital nurse.



KAMALAN A/P ELLAPAN

Madam Kamalan, 88, has high blood pressure, diabetes, heart ailment, and stroke complications. She has been unconscious due to cerebral haemorrhage. She has a son and 2 daughters, where one is mentally-impaired. Her son rarely visits her. Her remaining daughter takes care of her and her mentally-impaired daughter. GHCA will be supporting her with diaper and wet tissue supplies worth RM300 monthly.

RENE MIKEL BIN MUHAMMAD IRSYAD EDWARD

Mr Rene, 18, has slow-learning disability. He is unemployed and was raised by his mother along with his four siblings after his father passed away. GHCA decided to provide 2 months grocery support of RM300 monthly for his family in August and September 2018, as he is expected to receive aid from other charity agency soon.



LEE POH YOK

Madam Lee, 66 years old, is the mother to one of our Family Care beneficiaries, Mr Yap, who passed away in June 2018. We are still engaged with this family as supplier for GHCC's Lunch Box for the Hungry program with Madam Lee taking over from Mr Yap, and further assisted them with RM300 worth of groceries support.



MURUGAN A/L RAGAVAN

Murugan is a hardworking 39 years old man who was diagnosed with kidney disease at an early age and is one of our Dialysis Aid beneficiaries. He is starting a fruit delivery business to supply apples, oranges, kiwi fruits, grapes, and others. Thus, to motivate him to work hard on his newly start-up business, we are extending him with support of RM600 monthly to cover for the cost of fruits.

Therefore, GHCA sponsored a refrigerator to her to enable her to store the wet groceries that we bought for her.



SELVARAJ A/L JOHN @ GOVINDARAJOO

Mr Selvaraj, 53, suffers from diabetes, heart ailment, and high blood pressure. He lost both his legs due to diabetes. Despite having his legs amputated, Selvaraj still works hard as a part-time admin in a management office using a wheelchair. To ease his mobility, we sponsored him a prosthetic leg that enables him to finally walk with the assistance of a walking frame after months of training and rehabilitation!



PATMANATHAN A/L ELLAPAN

Mr Patmanathan is one of our Family Care beneficiaries. In June 2018, he went for an eye operation to treat cataract and needed to put on a special cataract lens post-operation. Unfortunately, the operation was unsuccessful and requires insertion of a Capsular Tension Ring (CTR) in his eyes that requires a further RM420. GHCA assist him for the CTR payment.

SEONG YOKE SIM

Madam Seong is one of our Family Care beneficiaries. Her daughter takes care of her along with three primary school children. In our recent visit, we realised her daughter and grandchildren slept on the living room because their room was too small for the four of them to sleep together. Therefore, GHCA bought a double bunk bed for them so that they can all sleep comfortably inside the room.



WONG POU YI

Ms Wong Pou Yi, 22 years old, was diagnosed with Wilson disease. It made her bed-ridden as her limbs became stiff and she will unconsciously tremble and cramp. GHCA assists her with one-time support of diapers to lessen her mother's burden. Her mother needed the temporary support while waiting for other parties' assistance process.



SARAVANAN A/L SIVALINGAM

Mr Saravanan is one of our Family Care beneficiaries with severe diabetes and cataract who suffered a serious fall down the stairs. Unfortunately, after months of treatment, his leg condition has not shown any improvement due to diabetes. GHCA decided to provide Saravanan with a new and lighter wheelchair that allows him to move around the hospital easier.



ARCHANA AH A/P GEORGE

Ms Archanaah, 15 years old, is one of our Family Care beneficiaries, Madam Prema's daughter. She is currently sitting for her PT3 examination. Her mother is going through a financial struggle as she has to cater for the whole family's expenditures. GHCA subsidised RM480 school bus fee for 3 months for Archanaah and her sibling to motivate them in their studies. We also helped to pay 3 months of her family's outstanding rental debt to motivate her mother to work hard on her ice cream business.

MEDICATED OILS DISTRIBUTION TO AMITABHA MALAYSIA CARING SHELTER

Five GHCA volunteers went to Amitabha Malaysia Caring Shelter on 14 July 2018 to distribute medicated oils to the elderly. The medicated oils were donated by readers of Sin Chew Daily with the objective to give care and love to the elderly in old folks' home. There were 25 elderly aged 63 - 92 who received the medicated oils. The volunteers also had a great chitchatting session with the elderly.



MEDICATED OILS DISTRIBUTION TO GRACE HOME

Seven GHCA volunteers visit Grace Home on 28 July 2018 to distribute medicated oils to the 25 old folks there, who are aged 52 - 88. The oils were donated by readers of Sin Chew Daily. The volunteers also spent time accompanying the old folks and had small talks with them.



VISITATION TO LADYBIRD ORGANIC FARM WITH RUMAH AMAL LIMPAAH KASIH

On 23 August 2018, a learning trip was organised to bring 60 children from Rumah Amal Limpahan Kasih to the Ladybird Organic Farm. Through the trip, the children were given various hands-on guidance on growing their own crops, from how to grow seedlings in seedling tray and transferring seedlings onto land, to ploughing soil methods and how to harvest crops.



VISITATION TO PUSAT KANAK-KANAK DOWN SYNDROME DAN HYPER ACTIVE

Nine GHCA volunteers visited the Down Syndrome and Hyper Active Children Care Centre on 22 September 2018 to organise some interactive activities with the special needs children at the centre. There are total 13 residents at the centre, with age ranging from 8 years old to 56 years old, and are affected with Down Syndrome, hyper active, autism, physical disability, and mental disability.

On 23 September 2018, fifteen GHCA volunteers organised a Hope Reading Program session in Melaka for 21 children from Yayasan Sunbeams Home with the objective to instil the love of reading in the children and provide them with the opportunity to step into a bookstore to buy their favourite books. Each child was provided with RM50 budget to buy their choice of books.



MOVIE TIME AND LUNCHEON WITH AMITABHA MALAYSIA CARING SHELTER

Fourteen GHCA volunteers brought 13 old folks from the Amitabha Malaysia Caring Shelter for a movie time and luncheon session on 27 September 2018, with the objective to enable the elderly to experience watching movie in a cinema. The volunteers also spent time feeding the old folks during luncheon and chitchatting with them.



CSR WITH SWIFT AT AMITABHA MALAYSIA CARING SHELTER

On 29 September 2018, 30 staffs from SWIFT volunteered their time with us to repaint the Amitabha Malaya Caring Shelter, refurbishing the shelter with mural art, and played interactive games with the old folks. Special thanks to SWIFT for donating RM20,000 to this project. Goodies bags consisting of medicated oil, wiping towel, and body powder were also handed out to the old folks.



COMMUNITY DAY WITH PPR PANTAI RIA RESIDENTS

On 30 September 2018, GHCA collaborated with Great Vision Charity Association and Persatuan Penduduk PPR Pantai Ria to organise a Community Day event to distribute groceries for the urban poor residents there. 350 residents benefited from the function where groceries aid valued at RM50 each consisting of rice, cooking oil, canned food, sugar, salt, biscuit, and instant noodles were handed out to them.

Orang Asli Villages

ORANG ASLI EMPOWERMENT PROJECT AT KAMPUNG ORANG ASLI SIMPAI

On the 19 May 2018, our team conducted a follow up visit to the Kampung Orang Asli Simpai in Muadzam Shah, Pahang. GHCA decided to sponsor two water wells to Kampung Fauzi and Kampung Busu, and one solar fence to Kampung Rendang, as well as a bathroom and toilet for their learning centre. The function of the solar fence is to protect the villagers' crop from being eaten by the wild animals.

UNITAR INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY

On 10 August 2018, representatives from GHCA was invited to the UNITAR International University to conduct a 2-hours educational seminar for 44 students and 3 lecturers to share some insights on our experience working in the charity sector. The session was held to inspire and encourage the students to participate in community services.



PROJECT PRESENTATION BY STUDENTS FROM SUNWAY UNIVERSITY

Representatives from GHCA were invited to Sunway University by Community Service course lecturer to be one of the panel judges for 7 groups of students vying for funding for their charity projects. Each group took turns to present and explain their charity project ideas in detail, elaborating on their planned activities, budgeted cost, and fundraising methods. Two groups were selected by GHCA's representatives at the end of the presentation where their projects will be funded under the You & Me Educational Program. Both the projects are expected to be carried out in October 2018.

On 12 August 2018, 37 underprivileged children from 3 different homes, namely Rumah K.I.D.S., Rumah Ozanam, and Persatuan Kebajikan dan Sosial Kim Loo Ting KL, were invited to the Sunway University to participate a Charity Sports Carnival. Organised by 25 volunteer students from AIESEC Sunway University & Sunway Student Volunteers (SSV) and funded by GHCA, the children were given the opportunity to play various sport games such as dodgeball, capture the flag, and an obstacle course. The children gave their very best in each game segment, demonstrating great teamwork along the way. The sports carnival ended with both children and volunteers smiling from ear to ear.



Vegetable Garden for the Community

In the third quarter of 2018, we harvested a whopping 157.37kg of vegetables via 28 harvesting sessions, benefitting 142 GHCC beneficiaries. Many provided feedback that the vegetables that we grow taste better as it is grown without chemical pesticide or fertilisers. We take this as a good opportunity to create awareness on the importance of consuming organically-grown vegetables and fruits to a person's health and wellbeing. The program also saw continued support from our Lunch Box for the Hungry and TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy beneficiaries, who volunteered themselves to distribute vegetables to neighbours and the needy. We happy to see our beneficiaries contributing their time by slowly becoming a volunteer themselves.

PRUKasih Program

In the third quarter of 2018, 168 residents from 137 households have been successfully enrolled for the program via monthly recruitment drive and house visitation. A total of 17 claims related to illnesses, accidents, and death have been filed by the PRUKasih members, with RM28,564.00 worth of claims been approved for disbursement to the affected members.

LYDIAWATI (DEATH CLAIM)

In June, Lydiawati lost two family members in a day. Her father, who was a PRUKasih member, passed away due to heart attack while her baby passed away due to illnesses. She will be receiving food and rental aid from PRUKasih for a year as well as funeral expenses for her father.



ZALINAH (ILLNESS CLAIM)

Zalinah used to sell kuih desserts for a living. Due to illness, she was unable to work and lost her income. She received food and rental aid for 7 months to help ease her financial burden while she recuperates.



ZALINAH (ACCIDENT CLAIM)

Saidatul work as a machine operator technician in the hospital and met an accident that broke her arms. She has been on MC for more than 6 months which affects her income during the period. With food and rental aid from PRUKasih, she could rest and recuperate with peace of mind while waiting for her wound to recover so that she could resume working soon.

Didik-Kasih EduCare Program

The Didik-Kasih EduCare program aids underprivileged students in pursuing their tertiary studies by providing them with study aid fund. In return, the students are groomed to organise and lead a charity project to give back to the society. In the second quarter of 2018, 5 new candidates have been accepted
