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# HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

## Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the second quarter of 2019, our Dialysis Aid Program supported 35 kidney patients who are either low income earners or unemployed due to their medical condition, compared to 28 supported cases within the same period in 2018. Each patient receives a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM130 to RM1,000 per month for a period of six (6) months or more to ease their burden. From these 35 beneficiaries, 16 are new cases. ## MAH LAI MUN

Ms Mah, 35, suffers from blurred vision, diabetes and kidney failure. In Mar 2019, her blood vessels damaged and affected her fistula. Her partner has difficulty covering her expenses. Currently, he works as a part time Grab driver and is looking for home based job so that he can look after her.



## LIM WAI CHEAH

Ms Lim, 23, suffers from anaemia, diabetes, kidney failure, and blindness. In Mar 2019, she was admitted to the hospital due to seizure and low blood level but has since recuperated. She is a strong-willed woman who can take care of herself despite her disability and life's challenges.



## YONG KIM LIN

Mdm Yong, 72, is a retiree and has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She is now undergoing chemotherapy for neck tumour. Her husband was diagnosed with nose cancer recently and will be undergoing chemotherapy. In view of that, GHCA extended 6 months support to her.



## CHANG YIT CHIEW

Mr Chang, 77, is a retiree and has high blood pressure, diabetes, and suffered a mild stroke. He had difficulty walking and his wife takes care of his daily needs. He will be undergoing an operation on his leg soon at the Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia Medical Centre.



## LAI YOKE KHEW

Mdm Lai, 62, has diabetes, high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney failure. She lives with her pregnant daughter and son-in-law. She has successfully obtained approval for dialysis treatment from the Ministry of Health and will no longer require our support after May 2019.

## LIEW TZER GIO

Mr Liew, 34, is an insurance agent and Grab driver. He has high blood pressure, kidney disease, and anaemia. His insurance job income is not doing well, and he struggles to reach his sales target. Hence, we will be supporting him until Jul 2019 to ease his burden.



## GOPAL A/L SINNTHAMBY

Mr Gopal, 63, unemployed, had almost depleted his wife's savings for his dialysis treatment. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Recently, he was required to take epoetin injection due to his blood test result.



## KRISHNAN A/L RAJOO

Mr Krishnan, 64, has kidney failure. His wife was diagnosed with thyroid disease, which requires daily care from his son. On May 2019, his health has showed an improvement in terms of blood haemoglobin level and blood sugar level.



## ROSLI BIN ABDUL HAMID

Rosli, 50, has high blood pressure, kidney disease, diabetes, and had amputated his right leg. He has a wife and 3 children. In our May 2019 visit, his condition remains the same. His dialysis fee is subsidised by Socso, while GHCA supports his epoetin injection fee, which ended in May 2019.



## SHU MENG KWAI

Mr Shu, 67, has kidney failure, hyperuricemia, and high blood pressure. He used to work as sub-contractor and factory worker in a bread factory but is currently unemployed. GHCA will be extending our support to Shu until Dec 2019.



## SATHIYASELAN A/L P KUNJAN

Mr Sathiyaselan, 65, lives alone and struggles to make ends meet. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, heart ailment, and kidney failure. In May 2019, he had to undergo a fistula operation as his blood vessels had narrowed. GHCA assisted him with the RM3,000 operation cost, as well as extended our support until Dec 2019.

## TAN HAN BEE

Mdm Tan, 69, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. She runs a sewing business in a small shop to earn a living and cover part of her dialysis expenses. GHCA support is still ongoing to ease her financial burden.



## LIM CHIN GEE

Mr Lim, 50, lives in a shophouse. He has kidney failure, high blood pressure, and heart ailment. In Jun 2019, our support ended, with his health and financials seeing improvement. He has also shifted to a new house which is more comfortable.



## CHANG AH CHAI

Mr Chang, 65, lives alone and works hard as a chicken rice hawk stall worker for 20 years. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. His MOH dialysis subsidy application has been approved in Apr 2019. Hence, he thanked us and will no longer require our support.



## LOH YUN SHEONG

Mr Loh, 54, has undergone dialysis treatment for over 10 years. He requires epoetin injection for his treatment due to anaemia. His condition has now stabilised, and we have ended our support after May 2019.



## THOO FONG MING

Mdm Thoo, 63, is a widow. She has high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney disease. We will be supporting her to run her toy stall business under our Family Care assistance from Apr 2019, and we have also extended her dialysis support period to Nov 2019.



## POOMALAI A/L VELLASAMY

Mr Poomalai, 69, is on dialysis treatment 3 times weekly. He had some health issues with his leg at the end of 2018, but his condition has improved since our Mar 2019 visit. Thus, we ended our support in Jun 2019.

## DEVINDRAN A/L MONIAM

Devindran, 36, has walking complications. With MOH's subsidy approval, his treatment cost has been reduced to RM130 monthly. He will be receiving assistance from an NGO after Jun 2019. Thus, our support ends after Jun 2019.



## FAISOL BIN MAHMUD

Mr Faisol, 53, has heart ailment, kidney failure, and walking complications. His factory worker wife earns RM1200 monthly. His dialysis expenses are mostly covered by ZAKAT, while GHCA supports his remaining haemodialysis fee. In our recent visit, his health is getting better.



## TAI NYEK KUAN

Mdm Tai, 67, lives with her husband, son and granddaughter in a low-cost flat. She has high blood pressure, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. Her son is the sole bread winner, bearing the household expenses and her dialysis fee. GHCA subsidise RM1,000 of her dialysis fee.



## OON KHAI SIANG

Mr Oon, 32, has thalassemia, high blood pressure, and kidney failure. He was unable to work due to his health condition. We will be ending our support after Jun 2019 as he was selected to undergo free dialysis treatment at Hospital Selayang thereafter.



## TANG KUAN YENG

Mr Tan, 29, suffers from kidney failure and high blood pressure. He works as a handphone seller including on weekends, earning RM1,075 a month. However, his salary was not enough to cover his dialysis fee. GHCA is supporting him with RM720 monthly dialysis fee subsidy.



## ARUMUGAM A/L N. VELLASAMY

Mr Arumugam, 63, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. His daughter must cover the cost of his dialysis treatment, which is higher due to the epoetin injection that he had to take. GHCA assisted him with RM1,000 monthly dialysis subsidy, so that he will continue his treatment without worrying about the financial burden.

## **THULASY A/P MUNIANDY**

Mdm Thulasy, 50, mother of 3, has high blood pressure, ovarian cancer, and kidney failure. She is unemployed due to her health condition and depends on welfare and SOCSO aid to sustain her livelihood. GHCA provided aid for her monthly epoetin injection until Jun 2019.



## **PATMANI A/P VADIVELOO**

Mdm Patmani, 61, stays with her siblings as she has no one to look after her. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Her siblings cover part of her dialysis fee GHCA is assisting her with RM305 monthly dialysis aid to cover her remaining dialysis fee.



## **AWRUONG A/P K. GOVINDASAMY**

Mdm Awruong stays with her son and daughter-in-law in a rented room. Despite being disabled, her son works hard collecting recyclables to help pay for her dialysis cost. GHCA decided to help with RM720 monthly for her dialysis treatment.



## **SUTINI BINTI TIMBUL**

Mdm Sutini has high blood pressure and kidney failure. Her husband passed away in Feb 2019. She is unable to cover her dialysis treatment fee. Thus, GHCA decided to assist her with RM720 monthly dialysis subsidy. She was so thankful and content to receive the help from GHCA.



## **MAWAR BIN SALEH**

Mdm Mawar, 52, has high blood pressure, diabetes, blurred vision, and kidney failure. He is unemployed due to his condition. His wife is taking care of him full time. He could not afford his dialysis fee. GHCA is subsidising RM1,000 of his dialysis fee to ensure his health improves.



## **MUHAMED ZULKAFLI BIN MD NOR**

Mr Zulkafli, 43, has blurred vision, high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure, causing him to be unemployed. He depends on his factory worker wife for a living, who is unable to cover his dialysis cost. GHCA assists with RM720 monthly dialysis assistance.

## LATIFF BIN BACHOK

Mr. Latiff, 57, father of 6, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. He was a limousine and taxi driver. He now depends on his children and welfare aid for his dialysis fee. GHCA is helping him with RM720 monthly dialysis aid.



## KOH CHUN KEAT

Mr Koh, 31, lives alone in a rented room. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. He was a sales assistant in a spectacle shop until 2017. GHCA is assisting him with RM360 monthly dialysis subsidy.




## HUSSEN BIN ABDULLAH

Mr Husse, 59, lives in a small room with his wife Mukaromah, 48, who works as maid at a nearby house. He is unemployed due to his illness. His wife was unable to afford his dialysis fee. GHCA is covering his total dialysis expenses monthly to enable him to continue treatment.



## NIRMALA A/P VENGITTASAN

Mdm Nirmala, 33, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. Unemployed because of her illness, she was unable to pay for her dialysis fee. She depended on her lorry driver husband, who earns RM1,800. GHCA subsidise RM360 of her dialysis fee to ease her husband's burden.



## LEE KOW MOY

Mdm Lee, 62, mother of 3, is unemployed due to old age and health issues. She stays with her son and solely depends on him. She has low blood pressure and kidney illness. GHCA is assisting her with RM720 monthly dialysis aid to ease her and her son's burden.



## NG SOI CHIN

Mr. Ng, 69, lives with his wife at her eldest daughter's house. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, heart ailment, and kidney failure. His eldest daughter and son-in-law are working hard to take care of him, but his dialysis cost is too high for them. GHCA will be subsidising RM720 monthly for his dialysis fee.

## Individual Cases – Family Care

In the second quarter of 2019, we reached out to 38 underprivileged families, compared to 34 families within the same period in 2018. 8 of these families are new cases. Special thanks to Project Cabel and Cari Online Media, and Stephy for funding our beneficiaries in the second quarter of 2019.

## TAN LEE HU

Mr Tan, 42, sole breadwinner father of 2 with a hearing-impaired wife, is working odd jobs due to his bad knee condition. With JKM's increased subsidy to RM300 as well as an additional RM400 from his night market stall helper job, Mr Tan no longer require our assistance after May 2019.



## MUNADI BIN MARSIIYA

Mr Munadi, 62, has high blood pressure, diabetes, gout, and is unemployed. His sole breadwinner Indonesian wife was jailed in March 2019 for being an illegal immigrant, causing them financial difficulty. His son, 14, is still schooling. As his room rental and son's education fee are supported by a local charity, GHCA extended grocery support for his family.



## YAP EN BOO @ YAP AH MAI

Mdm Yap, 72, has diabetes and high blood pressure. Her son takes care of her and her Down-Syndrome daughter. Her health condition remained the same and she is thankful for the assistance from GHCA, which ends in May 2019.



## LIM CHIN GEE

Mr Lim, 50, is both a GHCA Family Care and Dialysis Aid beneficiary. His wife and daughter work as a restaurant waiter and cashier while he works in food delivery. In June 2019, they shifted to an apartment owned by his employer with lower rental, but better environment and they are very happy with the change.



## DAYANIDHI A/L ARUMUGAM SHANMUGAM

Dayanidhi, 12, has cerebral palsy and can only consume milk. He is now calmer, less aggressive, and has stopped self-mutilation. We managed to raise funds via Cari Online Media to extend our support until Dec 2019, to give his mother time to secure a better job during this period.

## YAP BEE WEI

Mdm Yap, 36, has 7 kids. In the 6 months support period, she has shown great improvement. From unemployment, she now works as a waiter, earning RM1300 monthly. Two of her children also work part-time as waiters during weekends. Thus, she no longer requires support from GHCA.



## NEROSHA A/P KRISHNAN

Nerosha, 26, met with a motor accident that dislodged her intestine outside her body. Despite this, she works hard, selling detergent and ice-cream from home. Her business is not doing well, but she is not giving up and is trying her best.



## ELWIN RAJ A/L A. EASTER

Elwin, 17, bed-ridden, has muscular dystrophy and severe scoliosis, and can only take milk as his diet. His mother, Gomathi, is one of our beneficiaries for business start-up support. She could now support Elwin with her income and no longer require our support after May 2019.



## DAVID A/L ANTHONIAPAN

Mr David, 52, is wheelchair-bound and had his right hand amputated. He has a young daughter and sells handcraft for a living. In our May 2019 visit, his business income has improved, earning RM1000 monthly. Thus, he no longer requires our support.



## GOMATHI A/P RAMASAMY

Mdm Gomathi, 44, a single mother of 2, is one of our successful business start-up beneficiaries. In our May 2019 visit, she is now able to self-sustain from her nasi lemak catering business, and no longer requires our support.



## KRISHNAKUMAR A/L ARUMUGAM

Mr Krishnakumar, 38, father of four, has pancreas cancer. We assisted his wife to start a salon to earn a living in Q4 2018. Now, he utilised his time helping his wife at the salon, selling flowers to temples during the day, and selling nasi lemak at night outside the salon. Their target to earn at least RM50 daily has been reached for most of the days.

## **VANITHA A/P THAMIZARASAN**

Mdm Vanitha, 37, single mother of 8, is continuing her new-found job as an office cleaner since Mar 2019, earning RM1100 monthly. GHCA will extend her support period for another 3 more months. She is still grateful that her parents could take care of her 8 children when she goes to work.



## **MAZNIZAH SHAMSIA BINTI KOSNI**

Mdm Maznizah, 40, mother of 3, is continuing her part-time job at a packaging company. Her daughter has also started working as a cashier in 7-eleven. With their improved situation, they no longer require our assistance after Jun 2019.



## **SELVAMONEY A/L SABASTIAN**

Mr Selvamoney, 70, has Stage 3 colon cancer, is unemployed, and his wife has thyroid, osteoporosis, and frequent headache. GHCA ended our colostomy bag supplies support after Apr 2019, with his sister assisting him thereafter.



## **CHONG LI YOON**

Mdm Chong, 38, mother of 5, could hardly provide nutritious food for her children. She no longer requires our support after Apr 2019 as she will send her children to a welfare home nearby and thereafter work in a clerk position that was referred by her friend.



## **KAMALA A/P MUTHIAH**

Mdm Kamala, 65, has diabetes, cataract, heart ailment, and high blood pressure. In Apr 2019, her daughter had found work as an admin operator, and can now support Kamala. Hence, they no longer require our assistance.



## **PACKIAMARY A/P AROKIASAMY**

Mdm Packiamary, 62, stays with her bed-ridden husband. She has breast cancer, heart ailment, blurred vision, asthma, and high blood pressure. Our support ended in May 2019, with her daughter stepping up to support her groceries thereafter.

## THANAVALLI A/P AMMASIS

Mdm Thanavalli, 43, is a housewife. Her husband whom had a heart attack, has now resumed work as a mechanic. Thanavalli has also started working as a tuition teacher and will no longer require our support after May 2019.



## INNASMUTHU A/L SAVARIAPAN

Mr Innasmuthu, 47, father of 5, has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney disease, and blurred vision. During our visit in May 2019, his wife promised to find some part-time cleaner job in 3 months' time to help support the family.



## KALA A/P SUBRAMANIAM

Mdm Kala, 37, is unemployed, with 4 children. Her lorry attendant husband earns RM1,500 monthly, which is insufficient to cover their monthly expenses. With not much effort shown by Kala and her husband to look for part time job to improve on their financial situation despite our assistance, GHCA ended our support in May 2019.



## YONG LING HUAY

Mdm Yong, 51, looks after her grandchildren and mother. She works hard as a night market stall helper to cover her grandchild's milk and diapers. In Jun 19, her hard work paid off with an RM400 increase in salary. GHCA extended 3 months support to Yong to motivate her continued effort.



## PARAMESWARY A/P SUPPAIAH

Mdm Parameswary, 39, is a mother of 3. Her husband works as a sub-contractor staff for wiring and cleaning job. During our Apr 2019 visit, we discovered some fraudulent elements in her supporting documents and decided to terminate our support.



## BATUMALAI A/L RAMACHANDRAN

Mr Batumalai, 34, is a father of 2. He is a lorry driver but his salary is insufficient to cover his house expenses. During our Apr 2019 visit, we discovered some fraudulent elements in his supporting documents and decided to terminate our support.


## RIZWAN LO ABDULLAH

Mr Rizwan, 42, father of 3, injured his hand and leg in a workplace accident. In May 2019, he has healed and resumed work as a lorry mechanic. His wife is pregnant with twins and is expecting in Jul 2019. Despite all the hardships they had been through, they continued to stay strong.



## A.V.A VENGADESWARAN A/L ATHMANATHAN

Mr Vengadeswaran, 43, has skin disease and liver cancer and has to consume special dietary milk. In May 2019, a local government hospital will be supporting his milk supplies. Thus, GHCA will be reducing our support amount to RM300.



## ALVIN A/L ANNANDAN

Mr Alvin, 38, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Due to his condition, he has difficulty finding jobs. His wife earns RM900 as a nurse assistant and unable to cover rental and their daughter's school expenses. GHCA assist with rental support to lessen their burden.



## KAMINI A/P ARUMUGAM

Kamini, 39, is a mother of 4 with asthma. With our support, she strives for a better life and in Jun 2019, she managed to obtain a higher pay travel agency job, earning RM1,800 monthly. She is now more confident with herself and aims to be self-sustainable soon.



## ZULIA BINTI MAHALI

Mdm Zulia, 36, has 8 children. Her husband is a part time security guard whom neglects the family. She works part time as a Grab driver and has started operating a small business selling kuih Melayu to restaurant supplier. GHCA ended our support after May 2019.



## CHEONG MUN WAI

Mr Cheong, 38, suffers from mental disability and often had derailed speech. His widowed mother, 61, takes care of him due to his aggressive nature that requires attentive care. GHCA assists them with monthly groceries aid and we have also advised his relatives to source for a suitable Disability Centre to enrol him in for better professional care.

## TAN HOCK CHUAN

Mr Tan, 49, is an iron factory welder earning RM600 monthly. He has 3 schooling children. GHCA supports his family with rental aid to reduce their burden. As a token of appreciation, his wife comes by to Great Heart Community Centre (GHCC) often to help clean up our centre.



## CHUA SENG HENG

Mr Chua, 68, lives with his siblings who work as tailor, cleaner, and security guard. Most of them are low-income earner with salary not exceeding RM1,000. They relied on each other to support their household expenses. GHCA supports him with rental aid. As a token of appreciation, he helps to tend GHCC's garden three days a week.



## THOO FOONG MING

Mdm Thoo, 62, is a widow and our Dialysis Aid beneficiary. Thoo's daughter has epilepsy and two children of her own to take care of. Thoo operates a toy stall at the Pandan Jaya night market to earn a living. We assisted her with toy supplies, which enables her to earn RM600-800 monthly.



## THINARATCHAKY A/P KARUPPIAH

Thinaratchaky, 45, is a mother of 3. Her husband is a factory technician, earning RM3,000 monthly, but ran into issues with loan shark due to him being a guarantor for a loan. His entire salary is now collected by the loan shark and must work part-time as a wiring contractor to support the family. GHCA provided her with groceries support so that her children will get proper nutrition.



## HAMIZA BINTI MD ISA


Mdm Hamiza, 40, is a mother of 2, with her eldest daughter having learning disability. Her husband works as a lorry driver, earning RM1,200 monthly. Hamiza used to be unemployed but with the encouragement from GHCA, she is now working part time as a food stall helper in order to lessen her husband's burden.

## TAI YEOW @ TAN POON GIAU

Mr Tai, 78, has 3 children. His youngest son, 53, works odd sub-contractor jobs, earning RM1,000 monthly, to support the family, which includes his daughter-in-law and grandchild. Mr Tai's eldest son, 60, stays with him and suffers from neurological issues and elderly bowel incontinence. GHCA will be supporting him with 6 months of diapers & grocery supplies.



## MYTHILI AND DARNESHKUMAR

Mythili, 16, and Darneshkumar, 14, are the children of our Ad-Hoc case beneficiary, Mdm Geetha A/P Sivasangaran. Geetha is unemployed and suffers from anaemia, diabetes, and dyslipidemia. Her husband is a lorry driver who earns RM1,400 monthly. Geetha is concerned about her children's education. Thus, GHCA is supporting Mythili and Darneshkumar's tuition fee for 6 months to prepare them for their SPM and PT3 next year.



## CHAN KIM WOON

Mr Chan, 60, has skin disease, bone ache, and old age illness. He is married with 2 daughters, both unemployed and suffering from depression and skin disease. His wife, 61, is the sole breadwinner, working as cleaner, earning RM600 monthly. They are also taking care of their relative's two children, aged 3 and 5. GHCA is assisting in his medicine fees to reduce their financial burden.

Mdm Letchmy, 68, has asthma, bronchitis, lung illness, and knee bilateral dislocation. She needed knee gel injection for her right knee but could not afford it. Ms Pennarasi, 18, is in Form 6 and has good result. Her dad had a stroke in Jan 2019 and lost his income. Thus, she had difficulties paying her school fees and transportation. GHCA assisted her with RM572 in education aid.

Ms Chan, 33, was one of our former Family Care beneficiary who suffers from mental illness. In our recent visit, we noticed that she needed a bicycle to ease her in collecting recyclables for a living. Thus, we extended the support.

Mr Alvin, 29, married with 3 children, was our former Family Care beneficiary who managed to secure a job after our assistance. He now needs to rent a home but was unable to pay for the full deposit. Thus, GHCA subsidise part of his deposit.



## GEETHA A/P SIVASANGARAN

Geetha, 39, mother of 5, has anaemia, diabetes, and dyslipidemia. GHCA assisted in her urgent need to pay her four children's outstanding school fees. Her children Darneshkumar and Mythili and are also our Family Care beneficiaries.



## WONG KOK CHONG

Mr Wong, 37, has high blood pressure, heart ailment, diabetes, and kidney failure. He needs medical equipment such as medical drip stand and sphygmomanometer to monitor his condition at home. GHCA assisted him with the supplies.

## Lunch Box for the Hungry

In the second quarter of 2019, we have conducted 70 Lunch Box for the Hungry sessions, distributing 14,876 lunch boxes to our beneficiaries, versus 34 sessions and 3,925 lunch boxes in the same period of 2018. ## TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy

In quarter two of 2019, we served 559 patients in 39 check-up sessions, versus 21 sessions and 163 patients in the same period of 2018. 59% of the patients reported an improvement to their condition. We have also expanded our services to include Thursday session.

## Classes for the Children



In the second quarter of 2019, we conducted 10 sessions of Malay and English language classes on Saturdays, attended by 359 students in total, averaging 36 students per session. This is in comparison to 10 sessions attended by 193 students, averaging 19 students per session in the same period of 2018. 58% of the students reported an improvement in the learning materials that were taught in quarter two.

## Vegetable Garden for the Community

In the second quarter of 2019, we harvested 281.6kg of vegetables in 31 harvesting sessions, benefitting 292 beneficiaries. In comparison, the same period of 2018 yields 153.7kg of vegetables in 27 harvesting sessions. Vegetables and fruits grown in this quarter are papaya, banana, lettuce, kangkong, spinach, mustard green, and bok choy. Our Lunch Box for the Hungry and TCM beneficiaries continued helping as volunteers to distribute the vegetables upon harvesting.

This project is conducted with the hope that the continued actions will get the community to start be concerned about environmental cleanliness. Some volunteers were seen bringing along their kids to join our clean-up too!



### JENJAROM TEAM

Our Jenjarom team clean up the area around Jalan Bacang 17, Jalan Sekolah and Jalan Bacang 1. The team has managed to collect 159.6kg rubbish. Local actor and TV personality, Sarah Lian, also joined one of the sessions when she was on her 30 days act of kindness challenge!



### SEKINCHAN TEAM

Sekinchan team was always the smallest team but their dedication is greatly appreciated by all. 3 clean-ups around Jalan Orkid 1, Jalan Pasar, and Jalan Mawar 2 yields 48.32kg of rubbish.



### SUBANG JAYA TEAM

Sunway Student Volunteers (SSV) have been conducting clean-up activities around Caltex SS14 every month and will proceed to work around SS15 area in the future. 71 volunteers helped to collect 72.8kg of rubbish in past 3 months to keep SS14 clean.

## River Clean-up Project

On 21 Apr 2019, GHCA partnered with Global Environment Centre (GEC) for a session of river clean-up at Jalan PJS 6/5E, Taman Desaria. A river care education briefing was provided by GEC project coordinator, Mr Sathis, to 25 volunteers from GHCA and Sunway Student Volunteers along with the local communities. Unusual items found during the clean-up includes bicycles and unidentified objects. Mr Sathis explained that drains and rivers need to be cleaned to prevent them from being a source of pollutants to the seas. Apart from that, volunteers also help to clean up the park in the surrounding so that the rubbishes will not further pollute the river.

## Shopping Buddy Program

In the second quarter of 2019, volunteers continued to assist us in becoming the chauffeurs and shopping buddies for 30 low income families from PPR Pantai Ria to shop for groceries. ## PRUKasih Program

In the second quarter of 2019, a further 75 residents from 69 households enrolled in the program via monthly recruitment drive and house visitation. 26 claims for illnesses and accidents, amounting RM20,428 have been disbursed to the affected members in the quarter under review.



## FINANCIAL EDUCATION

Since Mar 2019, GVCA has introduced Financial Education to PRUKasih members and claimants to instil awareness on financial management to the community. During the claim disbursement process, GVCA social workers would go through a financial education module with each PRUKasih claimants to teach them topics that includes cash flow management, differentiation of needs and wants, budget management, savings, credit management, and financial protection options that they could explore.

On 22 Jun 2019, GVCA also conducted a Financial Education Workshop with 32 residents of PPR Pantai Ria at the Credit Counselling and Debt Management Agency (AKPK)'s KL branch.



## Didik-Kasih EduCare Program

In second quarter of 2019, there were 23 candidates enrolled with the program, aimed at providing them with a startup assistance of RM1,500 and monthly study allowances for their tertiary education, while also guiding them to plan and conduct a charity project to give back to the society.
