HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the fourth quarter of 2019, we supported 33 kidney patients compared to 26 cases within the same period in 2018. Each patient receives a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM130 to RM2,500 per month for a period of six (6) months or more to ease their burden. From these 33 beneficiaries, 5 are new cases. 

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



TAI NYEK KUAN

Mdm Tai, 67, lives with her husband, son and granddaughter in a low-cost flat. She has high blood pressure, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. Her Grab driver son is the sole bread winner. She is still awaiting approval for MOH subsidy as of Dec 2019.



ARUMUGAM A/L N. VELLASAMY

Mr Arumugam, 63, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. His daughter covers his dialysis fee, which is high due to the epoetin injection that he had to take. He is still awaiting approval for MOH subsidy as of Dec 2019.



MUHAMED ZULKAFLI BIN MD NOR

Mr Zulkafli, 43, is unemployed due to blurred vision, high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. His factory worker wife supports him but is unable to cover his dialysis cost. In Oct 2019, he is relieved now that his wife employment as a factory worker was not terminated.



KOH CHUN KEAT

Mr Koh, 31, lives alone in a rented room. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. He was a sales assistant in a spectacle shop until 2017. In Oct 2019, he is still unable to find work as his body is too weak and he often felt dizzy after dialysis treatment.



NG SOI CHIN

Mr. Ng, 69, lives with his wife at her eldest daughter's house. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, heart ailment, and kidney failure. He is continuing treatment. In Nov 2019, he started collecting recyclables to earn some pocket money.



GOPAL A/L SINNTHAMBY

Mr Gopal, 63, unemployed, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Oct 2019, he received good news from St John Dialysis Centre that he has been accepted as one of the beneficiaries for Unit Transformasi Masyarakat India (MITRA) from Oct 2019 to Sep 2020. where his dialysis fee will be fully subsidised. Thus, he no longer requires our aid after Oct 2019.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



HUSSEN BIN ABDULLAH

Mr HusSEN, 59, lives with his wife, 48, who works as maid. He is unemployed due to his illness. In Oct 2019, they are still working hard to sell fried banana, bakso noodle, and kuih-muih outside their house. Sometimes, his wife collects recyclables to earn some pocket money as well.



MUHAMED ZULKAFI BIN MD NOR

Mr Zulkafli, 43, is unemployed due to blurred vision, high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. His factory worker wife supports him but is unable to cover his dialysis cost. In Aug 2019, his wife might get retired due to age limit, but her employment had since been extended.



SUTINI BINTI TIMBUL

Mdm Sutini, 59, widow, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. In our Oct 2019 visit, she thanked GHCA for the continued support and was grateful that her son is assisting with the household expenses.



LEE BENG TECK

Mr Lee, 52, lives with his wife, son, and grandchild. He has high blood pressure and diabetes. His son supports the household alone. Lee was diagnosed with kidney failure in Aug 2019. With our support, he is continuing his dialysis treatment.



LEE KOW MOY


Mdm Lee, 62, mother of 3, is unemployed due to old age and health issues. She stays with her son and solely depends on him. In Nov 2019, her Bantuan Sihat Selangor application was rejected. Thus, GHCA extended her support for another 5 months until May 2020.



WONG TAI TAI

Mdm Wong, 50, recently had kidney failure and underwent a fistula operation in Oct 2019. As she is in a private dialysis centre, only part of her fees is covered by SOCSO. She needs a further RM1000 monthly. Her driver husband earns RM2000, while one of her sons also has kidney failure. Thus, we extended 6 months' aid to her.


YAP AH PAU

Mr Yap, 58, stays with his brother, 63, in their ancestral house. Both are unemployed due to old age and rely on another brother and JKM aid to survive. Fortunately, his SOCSO application has been approved and he will no longer require our aid after Dec 2019.



THOO FONG MING

Mdm Thoo, 63, is a widow. She has high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney disease. In Oct 2019, her MOH aid was approved. Thus, we supported her balance RM130 fees and she no longer requires our assistance after Nov 2019.



CHOW THEN PO

Mr Chow, 78, was a freelance actor, earning little with no savings due to his unstable income. His friend helps him with his room rental. In Nov 2019, his MOH dialysis aid has been approved so he no longer requires our support.



YAP PAN WAH

Mr Yap, 55, has diabetes, cataract, and kidney failure. He was a retired chef due to his physical condition. His cashier daughter, 19, and night market stall helper wife earns below RM2000 in total. Thus, GHCA provided dialysis subsidy to Mr Yap from Nov 2019 onwards.



FAISOL BIN MAHMUD

Mr Faisal, 53, has heart ailment, kidney failure, and walking complications. His dialysis fees are mostly covered by ZAKAT. In Oct 2019, his daughter, 20, remains unemployed despite our repeated encouragement. Thus, we ended our support in Oct 2019, hoping that his daughter will step up to support the family.



CHANG YIT CHIEW

Mr Chang, 77, retiree, has high blood pressure, diabetes, a mild stroke, and had amputated his left leg. He had difficulty walking. His wife takes care of his daily needs. In Dec 2019, his children are still giving special care towards him with his daughter visiting him more often to cook for him.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



SHU MENG KWAI

Mr Shu, 67, has kidney failure, hyperuricemia, and high blood pressure. In Nov 2019, his wife's home tailor business has slowed down. Luckily, his brother still occasionally provided him with some allowance. GHCA extended our support to Shu until Jun 2020.



MAWAR BIN SALEH

Mr Mawar, 52, has high blood pressure, diabetes, blurred vision, kidney failure, and back ailment. In Nov 2019, his wife gets a part time night market stall helper job while continuing her keropok business outside her daughter's school. Support to Mawar will be extended to Jun 2020.



LATIFF BIN BACHOK

Mr Latiff, 57, father of 6, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. He was a driver but now depends on his children and welfare aid. Support for Latiff ended in Oct 2019 with his children taking on the role to support him.



LETCHMY A/P SINNIAM

Mdm Letchmy, 66, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Oct 2019, she has been accepted as a beneficiary of Unit Transformasi Masyarakat India (MITRA), with her dialysis fee being fully covered. Thus, she no longer requires our assistance.



KRISHNAN A/L RAJOO

Mr Krishnan, 64, has kidney failure. His wife has thyroid disease, which requires daily care from his lorry driver son. In Oct 2019, he was accepted as a beneficiary of Unit Transformasi Masyarakat India (MITRA), which fully covers his dialysis fee. Thus, he no longer needs our aid.



SIVAPERUMAL A/L SUBRAMANIAM

Mr Sivaperumal, 49, has diabetes, high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney failure. In Oct 2019, he was accepted as a beneficiary of Unit Transformasi Masyarakat India (MITRA), which fully covers his dialysis fee. Thus, he no longer needs our aid.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



TING JACK KEE

Mr Ting, 26, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. He was a phone promoter until being diagnosed with the illness in Jun 2019. In Nov 2019, his SOCSO application is still under processing status. Thus, GHCA extended his support period until Feb 2020.



LAHMANA A/L GURUVAREDDY

Mr Lahmana, 66, has diabetes, kidney failure, and high blood pressure. In Oct 2019, he was accepted as a beneficiary of Unit Transformasi Masyarakat India (MITRA), which fully covers his dialysis fee. Thus, he no longer needs our aid.



SATHTHIVEL A/L MUNUSAMY

Mr Saththivel, 60, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. His right arm was amputated due to a motor accident. In Dec 2019, his blood sugar and blood pressure has returned to a healthy level while his children will now be supporting his dialysis fee.



KANDIAH A/L RAMASAMY

Mr Kandiah, 71, lives with his wife. He has 5 children but all of them had abandoned him. He has kidney failure and walking complications. With our support, he is continuing his dialysis treatment.



TESLYN TAN AI LIN

Mdm Teslyn, 35, has high blood pressure, diabetes, eyesight problem, and kidney failure. In Nov 2019, GHCA collaborated with Viva Home for a complete makeover of her dilapidated home with a fresh coat of paint to give her a more comfortable living condition.



LEE LAI THIAM

Mr Lee, 40, is single and stays in his sister's house. His sister has heart ailment while he has high blood pressure and kidney failure. Lee was a lorry and Grab driver but stopped in Mar 2019. In Oct 2019, he found a part time job as a delivery man, earning RM50 a day, three days a week for a RM600 monthly pay.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



CHENG KAM CHEONG

Mr Cheng, 77, is single and lives in his friend's house. He was a singer for over 30 years but had retired. He depleted his savings to treat his kidney illness. He had successfully shifted to a cheaper dialysis centre in Oct 2019 but sadly passed away at the end of the month.



AWRUONG A/P K. GOVINDASAMY

Mdm Awruong stays with her son and daughter-in-law in a rented room. Her disabled son works as a recyclables collector to pay for her dialysis fee. In Oct 2019, we assisted her son to get the rotator for his prosthetic leg to ease his mobility. He can now walk via a walking stick and is under rehab at home to get used to the prosthetic leg



YONG KIM LIN

Mdm Yong, 72, is a retiree and has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Her husband has just completed his chemotherapy in Dec 2019 for nose and neck cancer. Thus, GHCA extended our support to May 2020 while her husband recuperates.



LECHUMI A/P PERUMAL

Mdm Lechumi, 63, has blurred vision, diabetes, and kidney failure. She lives with her retired husband, and two children. In Nov 2019, she successfully enrolled into a fully subsidised dialysis centre for her treatment. Thus, she no longer requires our assistance thereafter.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Family Care

In the fourth quarter of 2019, we reached out to 40 underprivileged families, compared to 43 families within the same period in 2018. 9 of these families are new cases. Special thanks to Hong Leong Foundation, Project Cabel, and Cari Online Media for funding our beneficiaries this quarter.

His son, 14, walks to school to save on transportation. GHCA collaborated with VIVA Homes to purchase a bicycle for his son to travel to school.



DAYANIDHI ARUMUGAM SHANMUGAM

Dayanidhi, 12, has cerebral palsy and can only consume milk. Via funds raised on Cari Online Media, we extended our support until Dec 2019, which enables his mother more time to secure a better job during this period.



NEROSHA A/P KRISHNAN

Nerosha, 26, met with a motor accident that dislodged her intestine outside her body. In Sep 2019, her nasi lemak business is slowly picking up, so we decided to extend her colostomy bags supply support until Jan 2020.



KRISHNAKUMAR A/L ARUMUGAM

Mr Krishnakumar, 38, father of four, has pancreas cancer. He works with his wife at a salon but met with an accident recently that caused him unable work. On top of that, his wife needs to take care of him. Therefore, GHCA resumed grocery support for them after Aug 2019.



VANITHA A/P THAMIZARASAN

Mdm Vanitha, 37, single mother of 8, is continuing her new job as a factory worker. Her parents take care of her 8 children when she goes to work. Her eldest son had just sat for his SPM and hopefully will be able to secure a part-time job soon while waiting for his results to help ease her burden.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



INNASMUTHU A/L SAVARIAPAN

Mr Innasmuthu, 47, father of 5, has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney disease, and blurred vision. His wife has just found a job as a cleaner at a temple. We resumed our grocery support from Nov 2019 to allow them some time to stabilise their earning capacity.



YONG LING HUAY

Mdm Yong, 51, looks after her grandchildren and mother. She was laid off as a stall helper in Sep 2019. Thankfully, she was able to secure a job as a waitress in Oct 2019 and will no longer require our assistance after December 2019.



CHEONG MUN WAI

Mr Cheong, 38, suffers from mental disability and derailed speech. His widowed mother, 61, takes care of him. His physical condition has shown improvement and he will no longer requires our support after Nov 2019, while his mother looks for a suitable learning centre to enrol him in.



THOO FOONG MING

Mdm Thoo, 62, is a widow and our Dialysis Aid beneficiary. She operates a night market toy stall to earn a living. We assisted her with toy supplies. She now operates her stall every night from Tuesday till Saturday. We hope that with our support, she can stabilise her income level soon.



HAMIZA BINTI MD ISA

Mdm Hamiza, 40, is a mother of 2. Her daughter has learning disability. Her husband works as a lorry driver. We assisted her to start a homemade spring roll biscuit business and she has now started to sell them at restaurants and stalls via consignment basis to earn some income.



MYTHILI AND DARNESHKUMAR

GHCA supported tuition fees for Mythili, 16, and Darneshkumar, 14 to aid their studies. Their mother is unemployed and has anaemia, diabetes, and dyslipidemia. Our assistance ended in Oct 2019 with the completion of their final year examination.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



CHAN KIM WOON

Mr Chan, 60, has skin disease, bone ache, and old age illness. His cleaner wife, 61, is the sole breadwinner. GHCA assisted with his medication fees. In Nov 2019, his medical condition has improved and will no longer require our aid.



MARGRET A/P DAVID

Ms Margret, 38, has Type I diabetes since young. She was a kindergarten teacher but stopped after starting dialysis 6 years ago. GHCA supported her rental as an encouragement for her to seek a part time job. We ended our support in Dec 2019, seeing the lack of initiative from Ms Margret.



PASKARAN A/L MARUDAI

Mr Paskaran, 51, father of 2, stays with his wife. He is a dialysis patient and has been unemployed since 2000. With the aid provided by SOCSO, JKM, and his dialysis centre, he will no longer require our support after Dec 2019.



LIM HUI YING AND LIM HUI QING

Hui Ying and Hui Qing, 16, are twins. Their father disappeared 10 years ago. Their mother is the sole breadwinner, running a hawker stall. GHCA supported their education fee until Oct 2019 upon completion of their final year examination. Support will resume in Jan 2020.



VELAYUTHAM A/L ANTHONY

Mr Velayutham, 43, lives with his 2 wives and 7 children. He had severe diabetes and stroke. In Dec 2019, he was admitted to HTAR after breaking his right leg due to a fall. GHCA assisted him with monthly diaper and milk supplies after he was discharged from the hospital.



MARIMUTHU A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Marimuthu, 69, had his right leg amputated due to diabetes and has gastric. He and his wife are unemployed and relies on their children for pocket money. In Dec 2019, he managed to rent out one of his house's room for RM250 a month. GHCA extended our support for 3 months of grocery aid until their rental income is stable.

Mdm Chaw, 55, has just finished chemotherapy treatment for Stage 3 ovarian cancer in Dec 2019. She lives with her breadwinner husband, 70, and have no children. Thus, GHCA will continue to support her colostomy bags supplies to help ease the financial burden of her husband.



CHIN KONG MING

Mr Chin, 52, single, was a healthy man. After he fell in a toilet, he paralysed his lower half body. In Oct 2019, his physical condition improved and is no longer bed ridden. GHCA extended our support to Jan 2020 to cover his TCM medication that will enhance his health condition.



YVONNE LOW KAI EN

Yvonne, 13, completed her UPSR last year but scored badly. GHCA supported her tuition fees to help with her studies. Her mother, the main income provider, had just lost her job but luckily was able to find another job as a cashier. Support for Yvonne will be extended until Jun 2020.



SARASWATHY A/P MUNUSAMY

GHCA assisted Mdm Saraswathy, 45, to start a roadside nasi lemak stall with her daughter. Her business now is going well, earning her approximately RM1,000 a month. Thus, she no longer requires our aid after Oct 2019.



LIAN CHENG CHYE

Mr Lian, 65, is a stroke patient who needs diaper supplies daily. His children support the household expenses. In Oct 2019, his daughter has found a better paying job. Meanwhile, another NGO will also assist him with his diaper supplies. Thus, our assistance stops after Oct 2019.



CHANDRAMMAH A/P KRISHNAN

Mdm Chandrammah, 45, is a single mother of 3. She works as a murukku maker. Two of her children recently lost their job. In Oct 2019, her daughter managed to secure a job as a factory operator. We extended her support for another 3 months as her family's income stabilises, while also encouraging them to work hard.

MUHAMMAD RIFQI MIKAEL

Rifqi, 10 months, has down syndrome, narrowed valve, and thyroid. He can only consume a specific prescribed milk via syringe due to his condition. Once he reaches an ideal body weight to undergo corrective surgery, he will be referred to Institute Jantung Negara (IJN) for a heart operation.



FATIMAH BINTI ABDULLAH

Mdm Fatimah, 60, is blind and has gastric, diabetes, and heart problem. She lives with her 80 years old husband. Sadly, she passed away in Nov 2019 due to heart complications. GHCA gave condolence fee of RM300 to her husband, whom will be taken care of by her stepdaughter now.



TUNG CHUNG MOI

Mr Tung, 78, has abdominal cancer and needs to use colostomy bags. After he got ill, his wife becomes the sole breadwinner. In Dec 2019, he managed to get grocery support from a local charity for his monthly grocery supplies, which will further reduce his financial burden.



YAN KIM TUCK

Mr Yan, 67, is a bedridden chronic schizophrenia and diabetic patient. In Oct 2019, he passed away after being admitted into ICU. GHCA provided his wife with an RM300 condolence fee, while she has since able to secure a job as a cleaner in a restaurant that provides accommodation.



N. RAJESWARI A/P N. NADARAJAH

Mdm Rajeswari, 61, has heart disease, high blood pressure, and eye cataract. She lives with her husband, 2 children, and 2 grandchildren. Her husband sadly passed away in Dec 2019 due to kidney complications. Fortunately, her daughter has recently managed to secure a job with APM.



SUKUMARAN A/L KUMARASAMY


Mr Sukumaran, 41, is the father of Mythili and Darneshkumar under our education support. He has diabetes and chronic pancreas illness. In Nov 2019, we encouraged him to reapply for SOCSO aid as it was rejected previously. His wife is also looking a starting a home tuition class. GHCA extended our medical support until Feb 2020.

Mr Lim, 62 is a monk living with his friends from church and collects recyclables for a living. He is on physiotherapy treatment after a knee gel replacement surgery and is still unable to work. Thus, GHCA supported his rental fees for 3 months starting Oct 2019 while he recuperates.



KRISHNAVENI A/P SANARAJOO

Mdm Krishnaveni, 39, has a child who requires hearing aid and frequent hospitalisation. Her husband lost his job as he needs to take his daughter to the hospital often. GHCA supported them with grocery aid from Oct 2019. Her husband also successfully found a job as contract lorry driver in Dec 2019.



NORSYAKILA BINTI ABDUL RAZAK

Mdm Syakila, 29, is a divorcee single mother of a young child. She works as an admin clerk with a low salary of RM1250 while starting a small business producing and selling sambal during her free time. From Nov 2019, GHCA supported her monthly rental fees for 3 months to enable her to concentrate on growing her business.



SILVASAMY A/L KRISHNAN

Mr Silvasamy, 61, is single, unemployed, blind, and has neck cancer. He lives with his brother's family and mother. He can only drink milk and porridge through a neck feeding tube. GHCA supports Mr Silva for his milk supply while he applies for appeal from JKM for welfare aid.

LEONG LAI HENG

Mdm Leong, 77, is living with her husband and 3 sons. Her husband is a retired taxi driver who has blurred vision. 2 of her sons have mental illness. Another son is now recuperating from a work-related hand injury. Leong works as a part time promoter, earning RM1100 to support the household expense. GHCA will support her family with grocery aid starting from Nov 2019.



BHAWANI A/P SELVAKAANTHAN

Ms Bhawani, 18, has diabetes and mental illness. She is the youngest daughter among 4 siblings and lives with her mother, second sister, niece, and nephew. In Oct 2019, she was admitted into ICU for consuming poison and barely survived. She now suffers side effects that includes falling hair and unable to consume solid food. She was advised to consume Ensure milk for her health, which GHCA is supporting from Nov 2019.



CHAN LAY KIN @ CHAN LEE KIN

Mdm Chan, 76, lives alone. Her husband passed away 11 years ago. Her 3 children have either passed away or were lost in contact. She received monetary support from JKM and is cared for by a caretaker whom assisted her with her bills and groceries. She needed regular check-up and medicine for her eyes. GHCA assisted her with medical expenses support.



NAGESWARY A/P RAMESH

Mdm Nageswary, 27, lives with her forklift driver husband whom earns RM2000. She is a freelance house cleaner, whom also does home cooked food business, with her husband bringing the food to sell to his colleagues. However, her sales are small and unstable. They have 6 children with the eldest being 9 years old. Her husband's salary is not enough to cover their household expenses. GHCA provided grocery support for her family to ensure that her children are well-fed.

Mr Lee, 52, has walking complication. With no EPF nor SOCSO, he relies on insurance for his medical bills. To ensure he stays insured, GHCA supported him with a one-off subsidy as he could not afford to pay for his latest premium.

Mr Kumaran, 33, lost one of his leg and requires a rotator for his prosthetic leg to ease him in his mobility at work in a recycling factory. Thus, GHCA supported the fees for his rotator.


CHAN LAY KIN @ CHAN LEE KIN

Thus, GHCA supported 2 of the injections at RM7,590, with Zakat helping to cover for the remaining injections.



KARUPPIAH A/L SUPPIAH

Mr Karuppiah, 81, has high blood pressure, thyroid and heart ailment that requires urgent angioplasty surgery in UMMC. GHCA subsidised RM3500 for his operation, with operation being very successful.



PERAKASH A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Perakash, 45, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and heart ailment that requires angioplasty surgery in UMMC. GHCA subsidised RM4500 for his operation. He has now resumed his work as security guard after the operation.



GOVINDASAMY A/L NARAYANAN

Mr Govindasamy, 55, has high blood pressure, diabetes and heart ailment that requires angioplasty surgery. GHCA subsidised RM2179 for his operation. He is still recuperating and is not allowed to work as hard labour anymore.

VASANTHAN A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Vasanthan, 57, has diabetes, high blood pressure, and heart ailment that requires a second angioplasty surgery in UMMC. GHCA subsidised RM2500 for his operation. He is doing well post operation.

Mr Malcom, 55, has kidney and heart ailment that requires urgent angioplasty surgery. GHCA subsidised RM4000 for his treatment but he unfortunately passed away right after the operation. We hope that he rests in peace.

Mr Devarajan, 64, is a diabetic patient. He injured his leg and requires treatment for his wound. Fearing amputation, he seeks traditional medicine treatment, but is unable to afford the full treatment fees. Thus, GHCA subsidised RM2000 of his treatment fees.

LAUNCHING OF KAMPUNG RALAK LEARNING CENTRE

Study supplies such as exercise books, stationaries, and white board were provided to over 100 students there. We will also be supporting the teacher's allowance for a year and will be monitoring the students' results and attendance records on a quarterly basis. With the centre now in operation, it is hoped that the quality of education for the children from the village will be enhanced.

Participants were divided into several groups and given big plastic bags for the clean-up, which they managed to fill up by the end of the session. One of the students aptly sum up the session, in that clean-ups remain an excellent hands-on educational tool for the communities whom are often not aware of the plastic pollution impact, nor of their power to do something about it.



A DAY WITH CHAMPIONS

The session was organised to provide festive cheers and affection to the children in need while equipping them with some essential items and medical supplies. It also serves to influence students to be grateful for their life and give back to the society.

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Lunch Box for the Hungry

In the fourth quarter of 2019, we have conducted 67 Lunch Box for the Hungry sessions, distributing 15,172 lunch boxes to our beneficiaries, versus 69 sessions and 11,058 lunch boxes in the same period of 2018. As of end Dec 2019, 264 beneficiaries consisting of the elderlies, poor families, primary, secondary, and kindergarten students were enrolled in the program. TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy

In quarter four of 2019, we served 559 patients in 49 check-up sessions, versus 28 sessions and 329 patients in the same period of 2018. 55% of the patients reported an improvement to their condition.

Classes for the Children

In the fourth quarter of 2019, we conducted 10 sessions of Malay and English language classes on Saturdays, attended by 383 students in total, averaging 38 students per session. This is in comparison to 10 sessions attended by 195 students, averaging 19 students per session in the same period of 2018. 62% of the students reported an improvement in the learning materials that were taught in quarter four. There were also 11 sessions of Yoga classes attended by 69 students, 12 sessions of Singing classes attended by 91 students, and 8 sessions of Calligraphy classes attended by 94 students.



Vegetable Garden for the Community

In the fourth quarter of 2019, we harvested 281.9kg of vegetables in 34 harvesting sessions, benefitting 166 beneficiaries. In comparison, the same period of 2018 yields 145.5kg of vegetables in 24 harvesting sessions. Vegetables and fruits grown in this quarter are papaya, banana, kangkong, bok choy and Chinese mustard.

Great Vision Charity Association

Great Vision Charity Association is a non-profit, voluntary charity association that emphasizes the important role that education and awareness plays in transforming our society and embraces the philosophy that "to give a man a fish and you feed him for a day; teach a man to fish and you feed him for a lifetime" in our charitable work.




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Shopping Buddy Program

In the final quarter of 2019, 31 families from PPR Pantai Ria participated in the Shopping Buddy program to ease their burden, with 10 low income families being chauffeured by volunteers to shop for groceries. PRUKasih Program

In the fourth quarter of 2019, GVCA focused in servicing the community through claims, with 29 claims for illnesses, accidents, and death filed, amounting to RM43,456 being disbursed to the affected members. 3 residents were newly enrolled in the program during the house visitations.



PRUKASIH BENEFICIARIES HIGHLIGHTS



MARIMUTHU (ACCIDENT CLAIM)

Mr Marimuthu works as a garbage collector. He accidentally cut his leg and caught an infection. Due to a swelling, he could not walk for many months. During his medical leave period, he uses the food and rental aid to support himself and his family as he recuperates.



MUTHUSAMY (ILLNESS CLAIM)

Mr Muthusamy worked as a driver. He was forced to amputate his leg due to diabetes and was out of job and in despair. Through the food and rental aid received and GVCA social worker's mental care support, he was temporary relieved financially and smiles are seen on his face again.



TAN (DEATH CLAIM)

Mdm Tan lost her husband in a motor accident. He was the main breadwinner for the family and their disabled son. She was in deep despair after losing her loving husband. As a beneficiary to her late husband, Mdm Tan received condolence money, food, and rental aid to help her to cope during her time of difficulty.

Didik-Kasih EduCare Program

In fourth quarter of 2019, there were 21 candidates enrolled with the program, aimed at providing needy students with a startup assistance of RM1,500 and monthly study allowances for their tertiary education, while also guiding them to plan and conduct a charity project to give back to the society.
