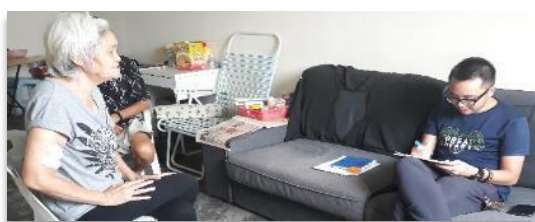

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the first quarter of 2020, our program supported 27 kidney patients compared to 26 cases within the same period in 2019. Each patient receives a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM130 to RM2,500 per month for a period of three months or more to ease their burden. From these 27 beneficiaries, 8 are new cases. Special thanks to Yayasan Kossan, Cari Internet, Tian Hock temple, and Persatuan Penganut Buddha Nan Yin Kong for their support this quarter. The beneficiaries listing is as follow:

TAI NYEK KUAN

Mdm Tai, 68, lives with her husband, sole bread winner son, and granddaughter in a low-cost flat. She has high blood pressure, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. Her MOH subsidy application was returned due to incomplete documents. Thus, she resubmitted her application in Mar 2020.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



ARUMUGAM A/L N. VELLASAMY

Mr Arumugam, 64, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. His daughter partly covers his high dialysis fee that includes epoetin injection. In Mar 2020, his MOH application was rejected so he had filed for an appeal.



MUHAMED ZULKAFLI BIN MD NOR

Mr Zulkafli, 44, unemployed, has blurred vision, high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. His wife supports him but is worried that her work contract will be terminated. In Jan 2020, his wife's contract has been extended and he no longer requires our assistance after Feb 2020.



KOH CHUN KEAT

Mr Koh, 32, unemployed, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Mar 2020, he had a blood transfusion operation, which will increase his dialysis fees as he has to change his dialyser for each dialysis session thereafter. GHCA will review on possible aid increase after Apr 2020.



NG SOI CHIN

Mr Ng, 70, lives with his wife and daughter. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, heart ailment, and kidney failure. In Jan 2020, he had a minor motor accident that injured his hand. He now rests at home. He applied for MOH subsidy in Mar 2020.



AWRUONG A/P K. GOVINDASAMY

Mdm Awruong, 61, stays with her disabled recyclables collector son and daughter-in-law, who covers her dialysis fee. Her diabetes is now under control and she no longer need to skip dialysis treatment to save money.



YONG KIM LIN

Mdm Yong, 73, is a retiree and has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Her husband has just completed his chemotherapy in Dec 2019 for nose and neck cancer. She now waits for her MOH subsidy application status



HUSSEN BIN ABDULLAH

Mr Hussien, 60, lives with his wife, 48, who works as maid. He is unemployed due to his illness. In Mar 2020, they opened a street stall to sell fried banana, bakso noodle, and kuih-muih, earning revenue up to RM800.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



SUTINI BINTI TIMBUL

Mdm Sutini, 60, widow, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. In Jan 2020, her Zakat dialysis subsidy stopped, so her family is looking for support to cover her dialysis fee shortfall.



JAY KUMAR A/L R. SANJEEVANTHAN

Mr Jay, 57, blind, has diabetes and kidney failure, and stays with his cleaner wife and two young children. He is dependent on his wife for his daily routine and relies on JKM aid for household expenses. GHCA supported him RM720 monthly dialysis aid while the rest is supported by MOH.



LEE BENG TECK

Mr Lee, 53, has kidney failure, diabetes, and high blood pressure. His son supports the family. With support from Tian Hock temple, GHCA subsidised his full treatment fee until Feb 2020 to allow him time to apply for MOH aid.



LEE KOW MOY

Mdm Lee, 63, unemployed mother of 3, has low blood pressure and kidney illness. She relies on her son's support. With our support, her cholesterol level has gone down, and her blood pressure had also normalised in Mar 2020.



WONG TAI TAI

Mdm Wong, 51, and one of her sons both have kidney failure. In Mar 2020, due to the Covid-19 outbreak, her driver husband was forced to be on unpaid leave, which affects the family's income. Thankfully, she still has some stored food at home to last awhile.



CHANG YIT CHIEW

Mr Chang, 78, retiree, has high blood pressure, diabetes, mild stroke, and had amputated his left leg. In Jan 2020, he had a cataract surgery while in Feb 2020, he had to undergo a 1-month treatment in hospital for pulmonary edema.



SHU MENG KWAI

Mr Shu, 68, has kidney failure, hyperuricemia, and high blood pressure. His wife is a sole breadwinner home tailor while his brother supports him with some allowance. However, the current Covid-19 issue has impacted his wife's tailoring business income.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



THOO FONG MING

Mdm Thoo, 64, is a widow. She has high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney disease. Her night market toy stall business is affected by the Covid-19 MCO. Thus, GHCA extended our dialysis aid to her from Mar 2020 till Aug 2020.



MAWAR BIN SALEH

Mr Mawar, 53, has high blood pressure, diabetes, blurred vision, kidney failure, and back ailment. Unfortunately, in Jan 2020, he passed away due to his weak physical condition as a result of being a kidney failure patient.



TING JACK KEE

Mr Ting, 27, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. He was a phone promoter until being diagnosed with the illness in Jun 2019. In Feb 2020, he has yet to take the initiative to submit his SOCSO aid application as promised. Thus, support for him was terminated after Feb 2020.



KANDIAH A/L RAMASAMY

Mr Kandiah, 72, has kidney failure and walking complications. He lives with his wife. He had RM1200 unpaid dialysis fees in Jan 2020. Thus, GHCA increased our aid to RM330 monthly from Feb 2020 to Jul 2020 to cater for his unpaid fees.



TESLYN TAN AI LIN

Mdm Teslyn, 36, has high blood pressure, diabetes, eyesight problem, and kidney failure. She is a freelance accountant and main provider for her visually impaired husband, who was recently admitted into the hospital for kidney illness. She hopes her husband does not need to receive the same medical treatment as hers.



LEE LAI THIAM

Mr Lee, 41, is single and stays in his sister's house. His sister has heart ailment while he has high blood pressure and kidney failure. In Jan 2020, he now works as a delivery man for his brother's company, whom will also be paying for his dialysis expenses. Thus, GHCA will stop our support after Jan 2020.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



CHE AWAH BINTI JAMALUDDIN

Mdm Che Awah, 44, has high blood pressure, diabetes and kidney failure. She is married with 3 children. She is a nurse while her husband is a school canteen helper, both working hard to support the family and her medical fee. GHCA helps her with RM260 monthly dialysis aid.



LEE POH YOK

Mdm Lee, 68, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She is a widow and stays with two of her children, who are struggling to support her monthly dialysis fee. Thus, GHCA helps her with RM720 monthly dialysis subsidy while she waits for her MOH subsidy approval.



KASSIRAJAN A/L S. RAMASAMY

Mr Kassirajan 63, his wife, and 2 children stays at his brother's house. He has diabetes, poor eyesight, and mobility issue due to a minor stroke. His monthly dialysis fee exceeds RM2000 so GHCA assisted him with monthly dialysis aid of RM1000 from Mar 2020 to ease his burden.



V. KANNAMAL A/P VEERASAMY

Mdm Kannamal, 52, has diabetes, heart ailment, high blood pressure, pulmonary edema, and kidney failure. She relies on an oxygen breathing machine. Her husband is unable to cover her over RM2000 dialysis fee. GHCA provided her with 3 months' aid for her to apply for MOH aid and urges her jobless daughter to find work.



KRISHNAMA A/P RAJA KAPAL

Krishnama 46, single, has Alzheimer, high blood pressure, stroke and kidney failure. She is taken care by her niece. Her dialysis fee is fully covered by SOCSO. GHCA will be assisting to pay for her iron injection and outstanding fee at the dialysis centre for 3 months.



ZAINAL BIN ZAIBUN

Mr Zainal, 54, has gout, kidney failure, and high blood pressure. He stays with his wife and three children. His children are unable to cover for his over RM3000 dialysis fee. Thus, GHCA steps in to subsidise RM1000 of his dialysis fee for 6 months.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Family Care

In the fourth quarter of 2019, we reached out to 41 underprivileged families, compared to 40 families within the same period in 2019. 15 of these families are new cases. We were unable to secure any sponsor for this program in the quarter under review.

NEROSHA A/P KRISHNAN

Nerosha, 27, met with a motor accident that dislodged her intestine outside her body. In Feb 2020, she is looking for another location for her nasi lemak business. She thanked us and inform us that she no longer requires our support.



KRISHNAKUMAR A/L ARUMUGAM

Mr Krishnakumar, 39, father of four, has pancreas cancer. His mother is now back to health and have starter working as a factory cleaner. They can cover their living expenses and will no longer require our aid after Mar 2020.



VANITHA A/P THAMIZARASAN

Mdm Vanitha, 38, single mother of 8, is a factory worker. In Mar 2020, as her son did not put in effort to look for a job while Vanitha also did not submit her application for JKM subsidy as per promised, her assistance was terminated.



INNASMUTHU A/L SAVARIAPAN

Mr Innasmuthu, 48, father of 5, has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney disease, and blurred vision. In Jan 2020, a fraud was detected when his wife provided false statement about working as temple cleaner. Thus, their support was ended.



THOO FOONG MING

Mdm Thoo, 63, is a widow and our Dialysis Aid beneficiary. She operates a night market toy stall to earn a living. We assisted her with toy supplies. She no longer requires support for her toy supplies. Thus, our support ends in Mar 2020.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



HAMIZA BINTI MD ISA

Mdm Hamiza, 41, is a mother of 2. Her daughter has learning disability. We assisted her to start a homemade spring roll biscuit business. Her business has since stabilised, and she no longer requires our assistance after Mar 2020.



VELAYUTHAM A/L ANTHONY

Mr Velayutham, 44, lives with his 2 wives and 7 children. He had severe diabetes and stroke. In Mar 2020, he passed away due to brain damage by high blood pressure. GHCA will continue the support for his wife, Mariammal after Mar 2020.



MARIMUTHU A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Marimuthu, 70, has diabetes, gastric, and is a leg amputee. He and his wife are unemployed and relies on room rental income for a living. In Mar 2020, their tenant had moved out. Though our support ended in Mar 2020, we will try to refer his case to other charity for support.



CHAW MOH CHENG

Mdm Chaw, 56, was a Stage 3 ovarian cancer patient. She was declared cancer free in Dec 2019. She no longer requires our aid after Mar 2020 with the huge reduction in medical expenses ever since she was cancer free.



CHIN KONG MING

Mr Chin, 53, single, temporarily paralysed his lower body after a fall. In Jan 2020, he was able to lift his arm and may be able to resume walking in 2 - 3 months. As he no longer needs to consume medication, our support ended in Jan 2020.



YVONNE LOW KAI EN

Yvonne, 14, is the eldest daughter among 3 siblings. Her cashier mother is the main provider. Yvonne is now focused on improving her Malay language and is doing better in school and tuition with our tuition fee support.



CHANDRAMMAH A/P KRISHNAN

Mdm Chandrammah, 46, is a mother of 3. In Jan 2020, we detected elements of fraud in her given statement and she is unmotivated to look for a job to support the family. So, GHCA decided to stop the support after Jan 2020.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



MUHAMMAD RIFQI MIKAEL

Rifqi, 1, has down syndrome, narrowed valve, and thyroid. In Jan 2020, his condition improved, and he had reached his ideal weight. He now waits for a major heart surgery to be done at IJN. GHCA extended his support for another 6 months.



KRISHNAVENI A/P SANARAJOO

Mdm Krishnaveni, 40, mother of 3, has high blood pressure. Her husband had just found a job as a lorry driver while she also started work as a home babysitter, taking care of 2 babies from Mar 2020. GHCA extended our aid for another 3 months.



TUNG CHUNG MOI

Mr Tung, 79, has abdominal cancer. His wife is the sole breadwinner. In Jan 20, he is better with the completion of his chemotherapy. As his wife's salary is not enough to cover his colostomy bag supply, GHCA extended our support to Aug 2020.



N. RAJESWARI A/P N. NADARAJAH

Mdm Rajeswari, 62, has heart disease, high blood pressure, and eye cataract. In our Feb 2020 visit, we found out that she and her daughter is not willing to work full time and wanted to depend on aid. Thus, our support ended after Feb 2020.



SUKUMARAN A/L KUMARASAMY

Mr Sukumaran, 42, is a father of 5. He has diabetes and chronic pancreas illness. In Feb 2020, his wife started working as a part time tutor and driver for school children. Seeing the hard work of his wife, GHCA extended our support to May 2020.



THEYNAJAYAM A/L NADESAN

Mr Theynajayam, 65, lives with his wife and son. He has colon cancer and needed colostomy bags. His son is the sole breadwinner. In Mar 2020, his son had an increment where he will no longer requires our support after Mar 2020.



LIM JIT CHAIN

Mr Lim, 62 is a monk living with his friends from church and collects recyclables for a living. In Jan 2020, he started working as a part-time chef helper. Thus, GHCA extended his rental aid until Mar 2020 for his income to stabilise.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



NORSYAKILA BINTI ABDUL RAZAK

Mdm Syakila, 30, single mother of 1, is an admin clerk and runs a sambal business. In Jan 2020, her business stagnates. So, she added weekend works as a Zalora warehouse helper. Seeing her hard work, we extended our support until Apr 2020.



SILVASAMY A/L KRISHNAN

Mr Silvasamy, 62, single, unemployed, blind, and has neck cancer. He can only consume liquid food via a feeding tube. In Mar 2020, his friends started providing him diapers, milk, and groceries. He no longer requires our support after Apr 2020.



LEONG LAI HENG

Mdm Leong, 78, lives with her retired husband and 3 sons. She is a part time promoter. Her 2 sons have mental illness. In Jan 2020, GHCA advised her to apply for JKM aid for her son with mental illness, with all relevant information provided to her. Aid for her was also extended until Apr 2020.



BHAWANI A/P SELVAKAANTHAN

Ms Bhawani, 19, has diabetes and mental illness. Her condition is improving since her poisoning incident. In Mar 2020, GHCA encouraged her family to seek for jobs while under our support, as currently only her disabled mother is working.



CHAN LAY KIN @ CHAN LEE KIN

Mdm Chan, 77, blind, lives alone. She received JKM aid and a caretaker assisted her with her bills and groceries. She needed regular check-up and medicine for her eyes. GHCA's medical support is still on going, which helps control her eye pain.



NAGESWARY A/P RAMESH

Mdm Nageswary, 28, lives with her forklift driver husband and 6 children. She is a house cleaner and runs a home cooked food business. However, her earnings are unstable. She is now looking for a better part-time work from home job.



PUTERI NURUL AZRIZZA

Puteri, 19, lives with her parents, 4 siblings and 2 nieces. She needed monthly supplies of inhalers for asthma and frequently visits the ICU due to it. Her father is on SOCSO invalidity pension. GHCA will support her inhaler purchase from Jan 2020.

YUGESHWARAN A/L MAHENDRAN

Yugeshwaran, 15, lives with his parents, sister, and grandmother. Both his parents are working in a factory. As Yugeshwaran will be sitting for his PT3 exam this year, GHCA will be supporting his tuition fees from Jan 2020.



LIEW KON FONG

Mdm Liew, 54, single mother of 2, has Stage 4 throat cancer and is on chemotherapy at HKL. Her daughters are unable to fully cover her treatment fee. Thus, GHCA will support her medical and transportation fee for 6 months from Jan 2020.



PAVITHRAN A/L PARTHIVAN

Yusraaini, 17, is the daughter of our dialysis beneficiary who passed away in Dec 2019. She stays with her mother, who is a part-time helper at a convenient store. As she will be taking her SPM this year, GHCA will support her tuition fees for 6 months from Jan 2020.



LIM HUI YING AND LIM HUI QING

Hui Ying and Hui Qing, 16, are twins. Their stall hawker mother is the sole provider. Since they showed positive improvement in their 2019 final year examination, GHCA will extend their tuition fees aid for 6 months from Jan 2020.



SRIDHARAN AND RASMIKA ARUMUGAM

Sridharan and Rasmika, 10, are twins and they are our family case beneficiary Dayanidhi's siblings. They needed assistance in catching up at school. Thus, GHCA decided to support their home tuition fees for 6 months from Feb 2020.



GAN KOK CHENG

Gan Kok Cheng, 17, lives with his parents and younger brother. His father had a brain bacteria infection that leads to a mild stroke while his cleaner mother is the main breadwinner. GHCA will be supporting his tuition fees for 6 months starting Feb 2020.

Mr Lee, 24, lives with his mother. He has ADHD, epilepsy, learning disability, and gout while his mother has lupus. Both needs to visit the hospital 4 days a week with the transportation fees costing RM40 a day. They relied solely on JKM aid. GHCA supports his transportation fees from Mar 2020.



AMISAH BINTI MOHD ISA

Mdm Amisah, 34, and her husband are deaf and mute. They have 4 children. They operate a stall selling Roti John. They received support from JKM and MAIM, totaling RM500 monthly. GHCA will support their stall supplies for 6 months from Mar 2020. We will also assist them to expand their business by moving to a higher traffic venue.

Ad-Hoc Cases

In the first quarter of 2020, we assisted 19 underprivileged families with ad-hoc emergency funding. Case 6 - 19 are our Dialysis and Family Care beneficiaries who were affected by the COVID-19 Movement Control Order (MCO) in Mar 2020 and was provided with a one-time relief aid to help them go through this difficult period. TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy

In first four of 2020, we served 377 patients in 30 check-up sessions, versus 31 sessions and 365 patients in the same period of 2019. 64% of the patients reported an improvement to their condition. Starting 3 Mar 2020, the TCM sessions has been extended to include Mondays.

Classes for the Children

In the first quarter of 2020, we conducted 7 sessions of Malay and English language classes on Saturdays, attended by 221 students in total, averaging 31 students per session. Real life physical items such as leaf, cotton, and green beans were used as examples to ease learning. 84% of the students reported an improvement in the learning materials that were taught in the quarter. There were also 6 sessions of Yoga classes attended by 34 students, 10 sessions of Singing classes with 102 students, 7 Calligraphy classes with 51 students, 5 Diabolo classes with 69 students, and 2 sessions of Taekwondo classes with 16 students. Diabolo classes were introduced in Feb 2020 while Taekwondo classes started in Mar 2020.



Vegetable Garden for the Community

In the first quarter of 2020, we harvested 103.3kg of vegetables in 18 harvesting sessions, benefitting 213 beneficiaries. In comparison, the same period of 2019 yields 137.2kg of vegetables in 16 harvesting sessions. Vegetables and fruits grown in this quarter are papaya, banana, kangkong, bok choy, spinach, lettuce, and Chinese mustard. Some of our beneficiaries from the Lunch Box for the Hungry program continued to help out with distribution duties during harvesting sessions.

On 2 Feb 2020, GHCC threw a celebration to usher the year of the rat for 400 guests that consisted primarily of beneficiaries of various races that comes from its various charity programs. Guests were entertained by dancing performances from the students of our dancing classes, as well as a mesmerising acrobat performance by one of our TCM practitioner. A calligraphy competition was also held that was participated by 95 people, young and old.



SUNWAY CNY CHEER AT GHCC

On 15 Feb 2020, the caring team from Sunway Group came by GHCC to celebrate CNY with a *muhibbah* spirit by providing groceries to 222 GHCA beneficiaries of various races under their SunwayForGood CNY Cheer program. Sunway volunteers led by Mr Bernard Paul, General Manager of Corporate Sustainability & Events, gave out over RM41,000 worth of groceries and red packets to the families. The groceries consist of necessities such as rice, milk powder, essence of chicken, and canned food.
