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HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the second quarter of 2020, 31 low income or unemployed kidney patients were supported under our program compared to 35 cases within the same period in 2019. Dialysis fee subsidy received by each patient ranges from RM130 to RM1,500 per month for a period of three months or more to ease their burden. From these 27 beneficiaries, 10 are new cases. Special thanks to MaybankHeart, Yayasan Kossan, AIA Shared Services (AIASS), Persatuan Penganut Buddha Nan Yin Kong (NYK), Jayakailash Melon (JM), and 好康分享群 HKG for their support this quarter. HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



TAI NYEK KUAN

Mdm Tai, 68, lives with her husband, sole bread winner Grab driver son, and granddaughter. She has kidney failure, high blood pressure, and high cholesterol. The MCO impacted her son's income. Thus, we extended her dialysis aid support.



AHMAD FAIZAL BIN OTHMAN

Mr Faizal, 41, is an unemployed single father of 3. He has high blood pressure and kidney failure. He relied on SOCSO and MAIM aid for his partial dialysis fees and subsistence. GHCA will support him with RM720 dialysis aid for 6 months.



MUTHIYAH A/L GOVINDAN

Mr Muthiyah, 68, stays with his wife and son, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. His son was retrenched in Jan 20 and they now relies on his severance money. We provide him with 3 months aid while his son looks for a job.



AWRUONG A/P K. GOVINDASAMY

Mdm Awruong, 61, stays with her disabled recyclables collector son and daughter-in-law. In Apr 20, her treatment fees increase with added injections. We advised her to apply for treatment at an NGO dialysis centre while extending her support for 3 months to lessen her burden.



YONG KIM LIN

Mdm Yong, 72, retiree, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Her husband had just died in Mar 20 due to cancer. Her MOH aid application was rejected due to documentation issues in May 20. She is now filing for an appeal.



HUSSEN BIN ABDULLAH

Mr Hussen, 60, lives with his wife, 48, who works as maid. He operates a street stall selling food but was forced to stop due to MCO. Luckily, his wife had resumed her maid duties on Jun 20. They survived on groceries donations during MCO.



SUTINI BINTI TIMBUL

Mdm Sutini, 60, widow, has high blood pressure and kidney failure, and whose dialysis fee was previously supported by Zakat. GHCA provided subsidy to her, with her dialysis centre bearing the balance and helping to look for other NGOs that could help support her treatment fees.

JAY KUMAR A/L R. SANJEEVANTHAN

Mr Jay, 57, blind, has diabetes and kidney failure, and stays with his wife and two children. His breadwinner wife lost her cleaner job due to MCO and had worked part time for a month. She is now actively searching for a full-time cleaner job.



TESLYN TAN AI LIN

Mdm Teslyn, 36, has high blood pressure, diabetes, eyesight illness, and kidney failure. She lost her job due to MCO while her treatment fee increases due to medication. Her husband too has kidney failure in Apr 20. Thus, GHCA extended her support until Jul 20 with increased aid of RM720.



LEE POH YOK

Mdm Lee, 68, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She is a widow and stays with two of her children. Due to MCO, her construction worker son's income was affected and now struggles to support the family. She had applied for MOH subsidy and is waiting for decision.



KASSIRAJAN A/L S. RAMASAMY

Mr Kassirajan, 63, has diabetes, poor eyesight, and mobility issue due to a stroke. With MCO, his wife and son had pay cut from their jobs, causing his dialysis outstanding bill to reach RM7000. His MOH aid application is also still pending.



V. KANNAMAL A/P VEERASAMY

Mdm Kannamal, 52, is a dialysis patient with pneumonia. She lives with her outdoor machine operator husband and 4 children. GHCA will extend her dialysis aid with reduced amount of RM720 monthly from Jun 20 to Aug 20.



ZAINAL BIN ZAIBUN

Mr Zainal, 54, has gout, kidney failure, and high blood pressure. He stays with his wife and three children. In Jun 20, his Zakat aid application was rejected. They have submitted an appeal and is now waiting for the result.



CHELLAPPAN A/L KUPPUSAMY

Mr Chellappan, 70, unemployed, has kidney failure. He stays with his wife and relies on his carwash worker son and Welfare aid. During MCO, his son's income was affected. Thus, GHCA provided him with RM1,000 dialysis subsidy.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



LAI YOKE THYE

Mdm Lai, 56, widow, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Her children, an office clerk and an aircond technician, struggle to cover her dialysis bills. GHCA provides her with dialysis aid for 3 months and had advised her to apply for MOH aid within this time frame.



JEYAMALATHI A/P RAJASVRAN

Mdm Jeyamalathi, 38, lives with her lorry driver assistant husband and daughter, 11. She has kidney failure, diabetes, and high blood pressure. While waiting for her SOCSO aid application, we provide her with 3 months dialysis aid subsidy.



WONG TAI TAI

Mdm Wong, 51, has kidney failure. Due to MCO, her driver husband was on unpaid leave and is still looking for a job. In Jun 20, she managed to switch to an NGO dialysis centre with subsidised dialysis fee and will no longer require our aid.



LEE KOW MOY

Mdm Lee, 63, has low blood pressure, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. Due to MCO, her son lost his job as his company went bankrupt. Thus, GHCA extended her support for 3 months to ease her while her son searches for a new job.



CHANG YIT CHIEW

Mr Chang, 78, retiree, has high blood pressure, diabetes, mild stroke, and had amputated his left leg. Despite the MCO, his children stepped up to cover his household expenses and medical fees and no longer requires our support after Apr 20.



SHU MENG KWAI

Mr Shu, 68, has kidney failure, hyperuricemia, and high blood pressure. The MCO impacted his wife's tailoring income as well as allowances from his brothers. Thus, GHCA extended our support for another 3 months until Sep 20.



ARUMUGAM A/L N. VELLASAMY

Mr Arumugam, 64, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. His daughter partly covers his high dialysis fee that includes epoetin injection. In Apr 20, his MOH subsidy was approved and he will no longer requires our support after Apr 20.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



NG SOI CHIN

Mr Ng, 70, lives with his wife and daughter. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, heart ailment, and kidney failure. His youngest daughter has stepped in to cover his dialysis fees while his eldest daughter takes care of the household expenses. With that, GHCA ended our support in May 20.



THOO FONG MING

Mdm Thoo, 64, is a widow. She has high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney disease. The MCO affected her income as a night market toy trader. She relied on allowances given by her son-in-law for the time being.



KANDIAH A/L RAMASAMY

Mr Kandiah, 72, has kidney failure and walking complications. He lives with his wife. He is still repaying his outstanding dialysis fees with our support. In Jun 20, his children have also started giving him RM200 allowances.



CHE AWAH BINTI JAMALUDDIN

Mdm Che Awah, 44, has high blood pressure, diabetes and kidney failure. She is a nurse while her husband is a school canteen helper. The MCO affected her husband's income. She is now the sole breadwinner for her family of five.



KRISHNAMA A/P RAJA KAPAL

Krishnama 46, single, has Alzheimer, high blood pressure, stroke, and kidney failure. She is taken care by her niece. Her dialysis fee is subsidised by SOCSO, while GHCA helps her EPO injection fee. Her breadwinner niece's income was affected by the MCO. Thus, GHCA extended our support for 3 months to Aug 20 to ease her family's burden.



NG CHEE YING

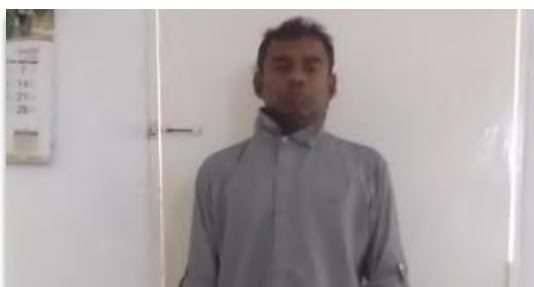
Mr Ng, 54, unemployed, is staying with his breadwinner wife and 2 daughters. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney failure, and has amputated his left leg. His wife works 2 jobs as a waitress and office cleaner. His daughters work part time while studying to support their own expenses. SOCSO subsidises his dialysis fee, excluding his dressing and injection fees. GHCA supports him with RM360 monthly dialysis fee subsidy for 6 months from Apr 20.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



MURTHY A/L RAMIAH

Mr Murthy, 59, a security guard, lives with his wife. He has high blood pressure, heart illness, and kidney failure. His eldest daughter is a store cashier. His second daughter is unfit to work due to severe obesity while his 3 other children are in school. SOCSO subsidises his dialysis fee. GHCA will provides him with RM720 monthly aid for 6 months to cover his injection and outstanding fees from Apr 20.



JOSUPH A/L VELLAIYAH

Mr Josuph, 55, father of 2 daughters, is a hotel waiter who has high blood pressure, heart ailment, diabetes, and kidney failure. He is subsidised by SOCSO for most of his dialysis fees. His wife needs to take care of her aged mother and is unable to work. Thus, GHCA provides him with dialysis subsidy of RM260 monthly for 3 months starting from May 20.



NORSHAHRL BIN NORJIHAD

Mr Shahril, 40, lives with his breadwinner private caregiver wife and 2 primary school sons. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. His dialysis fees are subsidised by SOCSO, but he still needs to pay the balance RM540 each month. Therefore, GHCA will be providing him with RM360 monthly subsidy for his dialysis fees for 6 months from May 20.



PANG PHEY SHUANG

Ms Pang, 34, single, stays at a nursing home due to being blinded and requires help in her daily routine. Her dialysis fees are subsidised by MOH. Her balance dialysis fee and nursing home fees are currently shouldered by her youngest hairdresser sister. Thus, GHCA provided her with dialysis subsidy of RM720 monthly for 6 months starting May 20 to ease her sister's burden.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Family Care

In the second quarter of 2020, we reached out to 29 underprivileged families, compared to 38 families within the same period in 2019. 4 of these families are new cases. Special thanks to AIA Shared Services (AIASS) for supporting beneficiaries 1~15 for the month of May 20 during the MCO period.

YVONNE LOW KAI EN

Yvonne, 14, was under GHCA tuition fee aid. Her mother, who is the main provider, lost her job due to MCO. Yvonne also stopped tuition. In Jun 2020, her mother found a retail cashier job. Seeing her effort, GHCA converted our support to grocery aid and extended it for 3 months from Jul 20.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



MUHAMMAD RIFQI MIKAEL

Rifqi, 1, has down syndrome, narrowed valve, and thyroid. His lorry driver father's income was affected during MCO. In Jun 20, Rifqi had a successful major heart surgery at Institut Jantung Negara (IJN) and was discharged after 10 days.



KRISHNAVENI A/P SANARAJOO

Mdm Krishnaveni, 40, mother of 3, has high blood pressure. With her husband's job as a lorry driver stabilising and able to support their family, she will no longer requires our aid after Jun 20.



TUNG CHUNG MOI

Mr Tung, 79, has abdominal cancer. His wife is the sole breadwinner. In Jun 20, he passed away due to old age. His wife thanked us for supporting them all this while. Thus, GHCA ended our support after Jun 20.



NORSYAKILA BINTI ABDUL RAZAK

Mdm Syakila, 30, single mother of 1, is an admin clerk, part time warehouse helper, and sambal business operator. She lost her part time job due to MCO. Seeing her situation, GHCA extended her rental aid for another 3 months until Jul 20.



BHAWANI A/P SELVAKAANTHAN

Ms Bhawani, 19, has diabetes and mental illness. In Jun 20, she was diagnosed with kidney illness. Seeing that her siblings have no intention to work even after repeated advise and solely rely on our grocery aid, GHCA ended our support after Jun 20.



LIEW KON FONG

Mdm Liew, 54, single mother of 2, has Stage 4 throat cancer and is on chemotherapy at HKL. Her daughter had found a better paying job after MCO. Thus, her medical expenses can now be covered by her daughter, with our aid ending in Jun 20.



SITI YUSRAAINI BINTI MAWAR

Yusraaini, 17, stays with her mother, who is a part-time helper at a convenient store and a titbits seller. Her SPM will be postponed to next year due to MCO, and her tuition centre was also closed down. Thus, her tuition aid was converted to grocery aid until Jun 20, and will thereafter be put on hold until she resumed her tuition.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



LIM HUI YING AND LIM HUI QING

Hui Ying and Hui Qing, 17, are twins. Their mother is the sole provider. During MCO, tuition fees were lowered due to classes being made online. Thus, their mother could now afford their tuition fees and our support ends after Jun 20.



SRIDHARAN AND RASMIKA ARUMUGAM

Sridharan and Rasmika, 10, are twins. They needed assistance in catching up at school. With MCO, their tuition classes have been put on hold. Thus, their tuition aid was converted to groceries aid throughout this quarter.



VANATHAYEE A/P APRAVOO

Mdm Vanathayee, 78, lives with her daughter and breadwinner grandson. She requires diapers due to a broken hip. Her daughter lost her job due to MCO. We have advised her family to apply for JKM Social Welfare aid for her diaper supplies.



AMISAH BINTI MOHD ISA

Mdm Amisah, 34, and her husband are deaf and mute. They have 4 children. They operate a stall selling Roti John. Due to MCO, they had to closed down their stall. So, we converted their business supplies aid to groceries aid for this quarter.



MARIAMMAL A/P UTTUKOTTAN

Mdm Mariammal, 43, is the breadwinner wife of our past family case beneficiary, Mr Velayutham, who died in Mar 20. Her cleaner income was affected by MCO. Thus, GHCA supported her with 3 months groceries aid from Apr 20. In Jun 20, her daughter started working in a factory. Thus, she no longer requires our aid after Jun 20.



SUKUMARAN A/L KUMARASAMY

Mr Sukumaran, 42, is a father of 5. He has diabetes and chronic pancreas illness. His SOCSO aid submission was delayed due to MCO, while his wife's work was also disrupted. Thus, GHCA extended our support for 3 months to Aug 20.



SILVASAMY A/L KRISHNAN

Mr Silvasamy, 62, single, unemployed, blind, and has neck cancer. He can only consume liquid food via a feeding tube. In Mar 2020, his friends started providing him diapers, milk, and groceries. He no longer requires our support after Apr 2020.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



LEONG LAI HENG

Mdm Leong, 78, lives with her retired husband and 3 sons. She is a part time promoter. With her lack of response to apply for JKM aid for her son, even after our offer to arrange her transportation, we ended our support in Apr 20.



CHAN LAY KIN @ CHAN LEE KIN

Mdm Chan, 77, blind, lives alone. She received JKM aid and a caretaker assisted her with her bills and groceries. GHCA supported her eye treatment at a specialist clinic until Apr 20 when she stopped due to MCO and may resume in Q3 2020.



NAGESWARY A/P RAMESH

Mdm Nageswary, 28, lives with her forklift driver husband and 6 children. She is a house cleaner and runs a home cooked food business. In May 20, she stopped working and gave us unsubstantiated reason. Thus, we ended her support in May 20.



PUTERI NURUL AZRIZZA

Puteri, 19, lives with her parents, 4 siblings and 2 nieces. She needed monthly supplies of inhalers for asthma and frequently visits the ICU. She has completed her practical in Mar 20 while her elder sister is also working now. Thus, they no longer require our aid after Jun 20.



YUGESHWARAN A/L MAHENDRAN

Yugeshwaran, 15, lives with his parents, sister, and grandmother. Even during MCO, he attends tuition and received praise from his teacher for his effort. Thus, GHCA extends his tuition aid support for 3 months until Sep 20.



GAN KOK CHENG

Gan Kok Cheng, 17, lives with his parents and sibling. His father had stroke. Thus, his cleaner mother is the breadwinner. She had to stop work due to MCO but resumed back in May 20. While in MCO, he still attends tuition classes virtually.



TUNG BAO CHUAN

Bao Chuan, 9, is the son to beneficiary Tung Chung Moi, who passed away in Jun 20. His mother supports the family by taking on fishing net mending jobs. Support is still ongoing for his tuition fee aid so that he could improve on his command of English and Malay.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



REBECCA KHAR SAU LING

Mdm Rebecca, 28, is bedridden for tuberculosis, which paralysed her. She was warded for almost a year. Her aging parents took care of her ever since. In May 20, she passed away due to breathing complications.



LEE CHEN WAI

Mr Lee, 24, lives with his mother. He has ADHD, epilepsy, learning disability, and gout while his mother has lupus. They relied on Social Welfare aid for a living. GHCA's transportation aid is still ongoing for them to continue their hospital visit 4 days a week for treatment.



NASURIANI BINTI CHE OM

Mdm Nasuriani, 51, divorcee single mother of 6, is a school transport service provider. Her eldest daughter has anxiety disorder and is unfit to work. Due to MCO, her income stopped so she moved to doing online home cooked food business with her children helping with delivery. PATMALOSNI A/P MURUGIAH

Mdm Patmalosni, 30, relies on Social Welfare aid for a living. She is unable to work as she must take care of her 5 young children by herself. Her husband is serving jail time. GHCA is supporting her with RM150 groceries and milk supply for her children for 6 months from Apr 20.



SITI FARIDAH BINTI MD KHAMARUDDIN

Mdm Siti, 31, is visually impaired, unemployed, and has end stage kidney failure. She does her dialysis treatment at NSCMH Seputeh. She receives JKM aid while her husband works as a contractor. Her son is cared for by her mother-in-law in Indonesia. As part of her treatment, she needs to purchase additional EPO injections from PPUM that cost RM 347.40 monthly. Thus, GHCA will provide her with medical aid of RM 300 monthly for 6 months from May 20.

Mdm Iruthiamary, 76, was diagnosed with stage 4 stomach cancer in Mar 20. She also has high blood pressure, heart ailment, and diabetes. To be discharged from the hospital, she needed to rent an oxygen tank from the hospital, which her daughter was unable to afford as she was jobless due to MCO. GHCA covers her oxygen tank rental, ambulance service, and milk supply. She passed away at the end of Apr 20.



ZULEHA BEE A/P HAZIR HAN

Mdm Zuleha, 45, was our family case beneficiary in 2018. She is a fast-food restaurant cleaner who was on unpaid leave during MCO. She has 4 school-going children, with her son, who had just started working in Telekom Malaysia also being on unpaid leave. Since the start of MCO, her family have been eating porridge only, due to financial strains. Thus, GHCA provided her with RM300 one-off grocery aid. Her son's salary had resumed in Jun 20 and they are doing okay now.

GUNA SOUNDRI A/P MURUGESU

Mdm Guna, 62, lives with her dispatcher husband and youngest son. She has diabetes, asthma, kidney failure, and heart ailment where she had to undergo an angiogram at PPUM that requires RM3,913.20. She sold her jewellery and manage to pay the RM1,000 deposit. GHCA catered for her balance RM2,913.20 medical fees.



MARIAMMAL A/P UTTUKOTTAN

Mdm Mariammal, 43, is our Family Care beneficiary. Due to MCO, she was unable to work as a cleaner and thus has overdue rental debt. Thus, GHCA assisted her with an RM1,000 ad-hoc aid to partially settle her overdue rental. With her daughter starting work in Jun 20, it is hoped that this aid will ease the burden of her household.



QUEK WAN HENG

Mr Quek, 35, single, lives in a rented apartment with his 8 friends. He was a restaurant waiter but lost his job due to MCO. His savings only last him until Apr 20. Only 2 of his friends managed to retain their restaurant waiter job post MCO. Thus, they have an outstanding RM2,000 rental debt. To ease his burden, GHCA provided him with a one-off RM1,000 rental aid so that he can continue to stay there while actively searching for a new job.

RM110K DISBURSED TO THOSE IN NEED

Hearing the urgent plights of many needy families due to the MCO, GHCA ran the Great Heart Covid-19 Relief Aid (GH-CRA) project to mitigate the urgent needs of underprivileged families across Malaysia in a record time of 15 days from planning to disbursement. After vetting through 735 applications, a total of RM103,400 was disbursed to 517 families from across all 13 states as well as federal territory of Malaysia. Individuals from the B40 community, as well as those undergoing treatment for chronic illnesses such as cancer or kidney failure were given priority to receive the aid worth RM200 per family. A further RM6,900 worth of groceries was given out to 16 families.

VISITATION TO KAMPUNGS IN PAHANG

During 25 ~ 26 Jun 2020, our team returned to Kampung Petoh and Kampung Patah Jelutong to follow up on our Orang Asli Empowerment Project. The aid provided includes 1 ton of fertilisers and installation of 2 water wells and 2 water tanks for the villagers to support their fruit farm. Vegetables and fruits grown in this quarter are papaya, banana, kangkong, bok choy, spinach, lettuce, brinjal, and Chinese mustard.

PRUKasih Program

In the second quarter of 2020, due to the MCO, a temporary process measure was in place with the beneficiary claimants of PRUKasih receiving their claims via direct bank transfer instead of food voucher handouts throughout the quarter. A total of 14 claims for illnesses, accidents, and death, amounting RM16,688 have been approved to disburse to the affected members in the quarter under review. Meanwhile, 6 residents were enrolled to the program when recruitment resumes in Jun 20.

Mr Khairuddin is a lorry driver and has leukemia. He will use the PRUKasih aid to pay for his treatment. In Jun 20, GVCA also assisted him with Rakan Shopping grocery aid. With the help, we hope he will be able to get through this difficulty.



ZAITON (DEATH CLAIM)

Mdm Zaiton lost her husband and main financial support a few months ago due to asthma. She uses the condolences money, food aid, and rental aid from PRUKasih to support her living expenses and also arranged a tahlil ceremony for her deceased husband to rest in peace.



PULSE FREE COVID-19 PROTECTION

During the MCO, Prudence Foundation launched a free Covid-19 Protection Plan via the PULSE app, which was also extended to PRUKasih members. Members who were diagnosed with Covid-19 can receive up to RM1,000 cash-relief upon hospitalisation. This free Covid-19 protection plan has provided an additional protection on top of the PRUKasih plan.

Didik-Kasih EduCare Program

In second quarter of 2020, there were 22 candidates enrolled with the program, aimed at providing needy students with a startup assistance and monthly study allowances for their tertiary education, while guiding them to give back to the society via charity projects.
