HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the third quarter of 2020, our Dialysis Aid Program supported 32 low income earners or unemployed kidney failure patients, compared to 37 supported cases within the same period in 2019. Dialysis fee subsidy received by each patient ranges from RM130 to RM1,500 per month for a period of three months or more to ease their burden. From these 32 beneficiaries, 6 are new cases. Special thanks to Yayasan Kossan (YK), Global Giving (GG), Yayasan Tan Sri Lee Shin Cheng (YTSLSC), and Lajuga Fashion Sdn Bhd for their support this quarter. The beneficiaries listing is as follow:

KASSIRAJAN A/L S. RAMASAMY

Mr Kassirajan, 63, has diabetes, poor eyesight, and mobility issue due to a stroke. In Aug 20, his MOH aid has been approved and will no longer requires our support. His family will work hard to pay for his balance outstanding dialysis fee.



AWRUONG A/P K. GOVINDASAMY

Mdm Awruong, 61, stays with her disabled son and daughter-in-law. In Jul 20, she no longer requires our aid as she will be transferring to NKF for treatment. In Sep 20, she remains at Cheras Dialysis for treatment due to a miscommunication with NKF. Thus, GHCA resume her aid from Oct 20.



YONG KIM LIN

Mdm Yong, 72, retiree, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Aug 20, her MOH application appeal is still pending documents from her children even after repeat reminders. With their lack of initiative, GHCA ended our aid.



HUSSEN BIN ABDULLAH

Mr Hussen, 60, lives with his breadwinner wife, 48, who works as a maid and was unemployed due to MCO. In Jun 20, his wife has resumed work. GHCA extended our support to him to Jan 21.



SUTINI BINTI TIMBUL

Mdm Sutini, 60, widow, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. SOCSO covers 70% of her dialysis fee. In Sep 20, she will be changing to peritoneal dialysis treatment under a doctor's monitoring. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.



JAY KUMAR A/L R. SANJEEVANTHAN

Mr Jay, 57, blind, has diabetes and kidney failure, and stays with his wife and two children. In Aug 20, his wife has found a part-time cleaner job after having lost one due to MCO. Seeing her strong will to work hard and support Mr Jay, GHCA extended our aid for 6 months as encouragement.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



LEE KOW MOY

Mdm Lee, 63, has low blood pressure, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. Her son, who lost his job during MCO, has since found another job. GHCA extended her support for 3 months until her son stabilises in his new job.



LAI YOKE THYE

Mdm Lai, 56, widow, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Jul 20, she reduced her treatment fee with medications from the public hospital. GHCA extended her aid to Feb 21 at a lowered RM720 monthly aid from Aug 20.



PANG PHEY SHUANG

Ms Pang, 34, single, is blind and stays at a nursing home that helps in her daily routine. Her dialysis fees are subsidised by MOH, with the balance and nursing home fees covered by her hairdresser sister. Support is still ongoing for Ms Pang.



WONG WOON

Mr Wong, 67, single, has kidney failure. He runs a small welding business, earning RM2500. As his monthly dialysis fee is RM1800 while his MOH aid is still pending, GHCA provided him with RM720 monthly dialysis aid from Aug 20 to ease his burden while waiting for his MOH aid application.



CHELLAPPAN A/L KUPPUSAMY

Mr Chellappan, 70, unemployed, has kidney failure. He relies on his carwash worker son and welfare aid. In Sep 20, his SOCSO application was rejected due to insufficient contribution. GHCA extended his support for 6 months until Mar 21.



AHMAD FAIZAL BIN OTHMAN

Mr Faizal, 41, is a divorced father of 3. He has high blood pressure, kidney failure, Hepatitis C, and bone disease. Yakin Jaya is the only dialysis centre in Melaka that can accept patients with his condition. GHCA will extend his aid for 6 months.



TAI NYEK KUAN

Mdm Tai, 68, lives with her husband, sole bread winner Grab driver son, and granddaughter. She has kidney failure, high blood pressure, and high cholesterol. She is still waiting for her MOH aid application process. Thus, GHCA extended her aid for 6 months until Mar 21.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



TESLYN TAN AI LIN

Mdm Teslyn, 36, has high blood pressure, diabetes, eyesight illness, and kidney failure. She is a freelance accountant. In Jul 20, her sister had started to provide her with financial aid. Thus, GHCA ended our support after Jul 20.



LEE POH YOK

Mdm Lee, 68, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She is a widow and stays with two of her children. In Jul 20, her MOH aid has been approved and she no longer requires our assistance thereafter.



V. KANNAMAL A/P VEERASAMY

Mdm Kannamal, 52, is a dialysis patient with pneumonia. She lives with her outdoor machine operator husband and 4 children. In Aug 20, her MOH aid has been approved and she no longer requires our assistance thereafter.



ZAINAL BIN ZAIBUN

Mr Zainal, 54, has gout, kidney failure, and high blood pressure. He stays with his wife and three children. In Aug 20, he has yet to receive reply on his Zakat appeal. Thus, GHCA advised him to switch to an NGO dialysis centre for a more affordable treatment fee by Nov 20.



JEYAMALATHI A/P RAJASVRAN

Mdm Jeyamalathi, 38, lives with her lorry driver assistant husband and daughter, 11. She has kidney failure, diabetes, and high blood pressure. In Jul 20, her SOCSO aid has been approved and she no longer requires our assistance thereafter.



SHU MENG KWAI

Mr Shu, 68, has kidney failure, hyperuricemia, and high blood pressure. In Sep 20, GHCA advised him to seek for other support to aid his daily expenses while reducing reliance on his wife's EPF savings. His dialysis aid period was extended for 3 months.



THOO FONG MING

Mdm Thoo, 64, is a widow. She has high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney disease. The MCO affected her income as a night market toy trader. In Aug 20, she had resumed operating her night market stall. GHCA will continue our support up to Nov 20 until her business stabilises.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



KANDIAH A/L RAMASAMY

Mr Kandiah, 72, has kidney failure and walking complications. He lives with his wife. He is an MOH aid recipient. In Jul 20, his children have started supporting him. Thus, he no longer requires our assistance.



CHE AWAH BINTI JAMALUDDIN

Mdm Che Awah, 44, mother of 3, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She is a nurse while her husband is a canteen worker who was affected by MCO. In Jul 20, her husband has resumed work and they no longer need our aid.



KRISHNAMA A/P RAJA KAPAL

Krishnama 46, single, has Alzheimer, high blood pressure, stroke, and kidney failure. She is taken care by her niece. Her dialysis fee is subsidised by SOCSO. In Aug 20, her niece has started selling home-made cendol part-time. With the extra income, they no longer require our support.



NG CHEE YING

Mr Ng, 54, unemployed, has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney failure, and is a leg amputee. In Sep 20, his wife lost her job, but has since found a part-time dishwasher and homestay cleaner job. GHCA has extended his support for six months.



MURTHY A/L RAMIAH

Mr Murthy, 59, a security guard, lives with his wife. He has high blood pressure, heart illness, and kidney failure. His eldest daughter is a store cashier. In Sep 20, as his other daughter has found a cleaner job, he no longer requires our support.



JOSUPH A/L VELLAIYAH

Mr Josuph, 55, father of 2, is a hotel waiter who has high blood pressure, heart ailment, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Aug 20, he will be switching to NKF dialysis centre, which is fully covered by SOCSO. Thus, he no longer requires our support.



NORSHAHRIL BIN NORJIHAD

Mr Shahril, 40, lives with his wife and 2 sons. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. His dialysis fees are subsidised by SOCSO. He has twice failed in his SOCSO invalidity pension application and is now in the process of applying for the third time.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



CHAN SHI LING

Mdm Chan, 34, lives alone in a rented room. She has a son, 13, with her ex-husband. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney failure, and partial blindness due to diabetes. Her dialysis fees are partially covered by SOCSO, where she needs to cover the balance RM430 monthly. She takes on part-time work, folding joss money to earn a living. GHCA decided to support her with RM260 subsidy monthly from Jul 20 until Dec 20.



TAN AMAU

Mdm Tan, 67, lives with her husband, son, and her son's partner. She has stroke, high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Her husband runs a night market bread stall and struggles to pay for her monthly dialysis treatment fee. Her son meanwhile helps with the household expenses. GHCA decided to support her with RM720 subsidy monthly from Jul 20 until Dec 20.



CHAN KHENG POH

Mr Chan, 44, has high blood pressure, heart ailment, diabetes, and kidney failure. He runs a photography studio with his wife. Due to MCO, their business was affected, and he is now unable to pay for his dialysis fee. GHCA decided to support him with RM720 subsidy monthly from Aug 20 until Oct 20 with the hope that his business will slowly pick up soon.



CHIA TEK MAU

Mdm Chia, 57, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She used to live with her son but had to move to a nursing home to facilitate her dialysis treatment. Her son is a grocery store helper while her daughter is a university student working part-time as a kindergarten teacher. She relied on her relatives for her nursing home expenses. GHCA decided to support her with RM1,000 dialysis aid from Sep 20 to Feb 21.



CHAN HUNG MEI

Mdm Chan, 73, lives with her retired husband and son, who just lost his job as tour guide due to MCO. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. With her son unemployed, she relied on his son's savings to pay for her household expenses and dialysis treatment fee. While her son looks for a job, GHCA will support her with RM1,000 dialysis aid from Sep 20 to Feb 21.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Family Care

Yvonne, 14, was under GHCA tuition fee aid, which was converted to groceries aid when she stopped tuition due to MCO. Her mother, who is the main provider, lost her job to MCO and had since switched two jobs because it is not suitable for her with the long working hour. In Sep 20, her mother found a job in an IT company as an office admin and will no longer require our support.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



MUHAMMAD RIFQI MIKAEL

Rifqi, 1, has down syndrome, narrowed valve, and thyroid. He had a heart surgery in Jun 20, and in Sep 20, he encountered breathing issue. He was referred back to IJN. We extended his milk supply aid to Oct 20 while monitoring his situation.



SUKUMARAN A/L KUMARASAMY

Mr Sukumaran, 42, is a father of 5. He has diabetes and chronic pancreas illness. His wife lost her job as a kindergarten teacher in Jul 20 as she could not commit full time, having to take care of him. Thus, GHCA decided to extend his support until Nov 20, while he awaits his SOCSO aid application.



CHAN LAY KIN @ CHAN LEE KIN

Mdm Chan, 77, blind, lives alone, and stopped her eye treatment in Apr 20 due to MCO. In Jul 20, her caretaker resumed bringing her for her eye check-ups. Thus, our medical support also continues from Jul 20 until Dec 20.



NORSYAKILA BINTI ABDUL RAZAK

Mdm Syakila, 30, single mother of 1, is an admin clerk. In Jul 20, she resumed her part time warehouse helper job and also managed to find a lower rate babysitter for her daughter. GHCA decided to extend her rental aid until Oct 20.



YUGESHWARAN A/L MAHENDRAN

Yugeshwaran, 15, lives with his parents, sister, and grandmother. In Sep 20, his teacher informed that he is attending tuition classes everyday with improvements in his English and Malay language. GHCA will extend his education aid until Mar 21.



GAN KOK CHENG

Gan Kok Cheng, 17, lives with his parents and sibling. His mother is the breadwinner after his father had stroke. He improves a lot in his studies with his tuition classes. With his SPM on Jan 21, GHCA extends his education aid until Dec 20.



TUNG BAO CHUAN

Bao Chuan, 9, lives with his mother. His father passed away in Jun 20. His mother mends fishing net for a living and is illiterate. Thus, she is unable to help him in his studies. GHCA extended his education aid until Dec 20 so that he can continue his tuition classes to improve his studies.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



VANATHAYEE A/P APRAVOO

Mdm Vanathayee, 78, requires diapers due to a broken hip and is waiting for JKM aid process. She only has RM10 daily for groceries for her family of 9. GHCA will increase our aid to RM300 monthly from Sep 20 for her diaper and grocery supplies.



AMISAH BINTI MOHD ISA

Mdm Amisah, 34, and her husband are deaf and mute. With GHCA's help, they can now earn RM45 daily from their Roti John stall. Her husband has also started working as a Grabfood driver. Thus, they no longer requires our support after Aug 20.



LEE CHEN WAI

Mr Lee, 24, lives with his mother. He has ADHD, epilepsy, learning disability, and gout while his mother has lupus. In Jul 20, he started having heart issue and needs to visit the hospital often. Thus, we extended his transport aid to Feb 21.



NASURIANI BINTI CHE OM

Mdm Nasuriani, 51, divorcee single mother of 6, is a school transport service provider who stopped work due to MCO. In Jul 20, she resumed work, as well as starting an online food delivery business with our support. She now earns an RM1700 income and no longer require our aid after Sep 20.



PATMALOSNI A/P MURUGIAH

Mdm Patmalosni, 30, mother of 5 young children, relies on welfare aid for a living as her husband is in jail. In Sep 20, she found a work-from-home job, packing cupcakes. GHCA increased our support to RM300 monthly from Oct 20 to Mar 21.



SITI FARIDAH BINTI MD KHAMARUDDIN

Mdm Siti, 31, is visually impaired, unemployed, and has end stage kidney failure. GHCA provided support for her EPO injections. In Sep 20, her eyes condition deteriorate with internal bleeding that made her eyes blurry and painful. She is currently doing regular check up at PPUM.



NOOR FIZURA BINTI ZAMRI

Mdm Fizura, 33, is a single mother of 3, with a physically disabled child. She runs a food delivery business. GHCA supported her business food supplies for 2 months. She is now able to be self-sustained already and no longer requires our aid.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



NG YI QIAN

Ng Yi Qian, 17, will be taking her SPM next year. Her father had passed away while her mother is a thyroid and breast cancer survivor, working as a hawker stall helper. GHCA decided to support her tuition fees from Jul 20 until Dec 20.



ROHAYA BINTI AHMAD

Mdm Rohaya, 47, mother of 2, was a babysitter. Her husband used to run a burger stall. They lost their job due to MCO and intend to restart their burger stall but do not have enough capital. GHCA aided them with RM300 monthly business groceries for 3 months from Jul 20.



AZMI BIN FADZIL

Mr Azmi, 50, lives with his wife and 4 children. He was a lorry driver but stopped due to kidney failure. His eldest daughter was also laid off due to MCO. GHCA provided RM300 monthly grocery aid for 3 months to ease his condition. In Sep 20, his SOCSO invalidity pension was approved while his daughter also managed to secure a new job. Thus, he no longer requires our aid after Sep 20.



LOO CHOY KWAN

Mdm Loo, 53, single mother of a schooling son, has diabetes and could not stand for long. Her husband passed away 3 years ago. She is a market stall helper, earning only RM500 and has trouble managing her monthly expenses. GHCA assisted her with RM150 monthly grocery aid for 3 months from Aug 20 and assisted her with her JKM aid application.



AMIZATUL AZLIN BINTI ROSLI

Mdm Amizatul, 33, lives with her breadwinner TNB subcontractor husband and 5 children. She wanted to start an online business selling batik cakes and needed monetary support to purchase the cake ingredients. GHCA provided RM300 monthly support for 3 months from Aug 20 for her to jumpstart her business.



LAU OOI KIEN

Mdm Lau, 48, lives with her husband and kindergarten daughter. They ran a western food hawker stall that closed down due to MCO. In Jul 20, they shifted to sell western food and cakes via online and carboot stall. GHCA supported their business groceries for 2 months from Sep 20.

FOH CHEE KEONG

Mr Foh, 63, is a widower. He has 3 children but had lost contact with them after his divorce 30 years ago. He used to be a gardener but is now unemployed due to old age. He has HIV, tuberculosis, and heart ailment and is consuming medicine from HTAR. GHCA will provide him with RM300 groceries aid for 3 months from Sep 20.



ARUEL A/L Y.R.AROKIASAMY

Mr Aruel, 73, is a childless widower after his wife died 10 years ago and relies on SOCSO invalidity pension. His brothers and nephews visit him occasionally to give him pocket money. He has low blood pressure and is a prostate cancer survivor. GHCA will provide him with RM300 groceries aid monthly for 3 months from Sep 20.



SRIDHARAN AND RASMIKA ARUMUGAM

Sridharan and Rasmika, 10, are twins. They needed assistance in catching up at school. With MCO, their tuition classes have been put on hold. Their tuition aid was converted to groceries aid while GHCA provided them a laptop to ease them in studying online. Their mother has now found a catering job, earning RM1000 monthly and no longer requires our support after Jul 20.

RATTNESH A/L SAMYNATHAN

Rattnesh, 8, has Spastic Diplegic Cerebral Palsy. He needs a bilateral solid ankle-foot orthosis to control the position and motion of his ankle, compensate for weakness, and correct his deformities. The orthosis costs RM900.00, and his family could not afford it as his father works as a hard labour, earning below RM1,000 monthly. GHCA assisted him to procure the orthosis.



VANATHAYEE A/P APRAVOO

Mdm Vanathayee, 78, is our family care beneficiary. During MCO, her breadwinner grandson did not receive his salary for 3 months and had been surviving on BPN aid. Thus, they were unable to pay rent for 3 months. Their house owner demands them to clear their outstanding rental and forced them to vacate the house if they failed to do so. Thus, GHCA supported her outstanding rental of RM1,350 on a one-off basis.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



ROHAYA BINTI AHMAD

Mdm Rohaya, 47, is our family care beneficiary. Her husband used to run a burger stall, earning RM300 monthly but the business was forced to stop during MCO. In Aug 20, other than assisting with her monthly stall supplies, GHCA helped her to design and print a banner for her burger stall. Her husband set up the banner at their stall and they were very pleased with the banner design, as it helps attract more customer to their stall.



VINNILA A/P SAMBU

Mdm Vinnila, 65, fell down the toilet in Aug 20 and was diagnosed with closed left neck of femur fracture. She needed to undergo an operation that costs RM4,500. Her daughter is a factory worker with 3 children and can only afford RM500 from her savings. Thus, GHCA helped her with the remaining RM4,000 medical expenses.



JAY KUMAR A/L R.SANJEEVANTHAN

Mr Jay, 57, is one of our dialysis aid beneficiaries. Having been impacted by the MCO, their house rental had been outstanding for 3 months, and they were forced to vacate their house if he is still unable to clear the outstanding rental of RM1,200. Thus, GHCA assisted him with a one-off support for his outstanding rental.



LIM KAY CHOR

Mr Lim, 69, has high blood pressure, diabetes, stroke, and is bed-ridden. In Jul 20, his wife had a surgery for breast cancer and could not take care of him. Thus, she was forced to send him to a nursing home until she was discharged from the hospital. GHCA helped with his nursing home fee.



JAMES PEREIRA A/L LUKOSE PEREIRA

Mr James, 60, has heart canal blockages, high blood pressure, diabetes, and high cholesterol and can only work 3 to 4 days monthly as a taxi driver. He needed funds to perform his second angiogram at PPUM, which GHCA assisted with a RM5,000 aid. He has now regained his health and can work full time as a taxi driver.

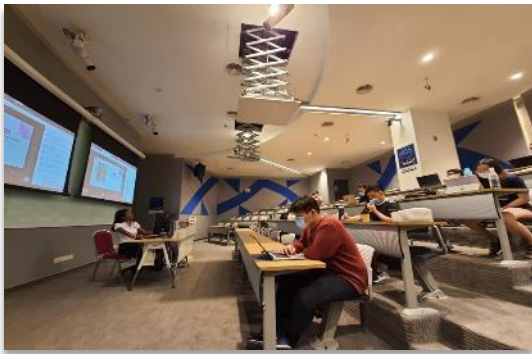

TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy

SUSPENSION OF PROGRAM DUE TO MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (MCO)

Due to the Movement Control Order (MCO), the TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy Program was still suspended throughout the third quarter of 2020. Recommencement of program will be subjected to further guidelines and SOP as per communicated and updated by the government and relevant agencies.

Classes for the Children

In the third quarter of 2020, the Classes for the Children program was resumed on 1 Aug 2020 with social distancing in place according to SOP. 9 sessions of Malay and English language classes were conducted, attended by 267 students in total, averaging 30 students per session, compared to 11 session attended by 389 students, averaging 35 students per session, during the same quarter of 2019. 55% of the students reported an improvement in the learning materials that were taught in quarter three.



Vegetable Garden for the Community

In the third quarter of 2020, 135.5kg of vegetables were harvested in 25 harvesting sessions that is distributed to 32 beneficiaries and 63 neighbours. In comparison, the same period of 2019 yields 153.7kg of vegetables in 16 harvesting sessions. Vegetables grown in this quarter are kangkong, bok choy, spinach, lettuce, brinjal, radish, long bean, and Chinese mustard.

MOONCAKES FOR CHARITY

On 4 Sep 2020, we launched the Mooncakes for Charity campaign in conjunction with the Mooncake Festival to fundraise for our Dialysis Aid program. The responses were overwhelming, with all available mooncakes being sold off before the campaign period ends. A total of 754 mooncakes were sold via the campaign, raising a total of RM5,311.50. PRUKasih Program

In the third quarter of 2020, 45 residents enrolled in the program via our monthly recruitment drive and house visitation. A total of 13 claims for illnesses, accidents, and death, amounting to RM18,144 have been approved for disbursement to the affected members in the quarter under review. In Jul 20, 1800pcs of face masks were also distributed to PRUKasih members aged 60 years old and above to protect them from the pandemic.



PRUKASIH HIGHLIGHTS



ZAINA ISHAK (ACCIDENT CLAIM)

Pn Zaina works as school cleaner. She met an accident and got her arm injured. Her recovery process will take a long time due to her age. She utilised the PRUKasih aid voucher to purchase groceries for her family. This helps to slightly reduce the burden of her family.



LATIFAH (ILLNESS CLAIM)

Pn Latifah is a baker. She was diagnosed with ovarian tumour and was unable to work while undergoing treatment. With the PRUKasih claim received, she uses it to support her financial burden. She will only resume her baking work once fully recovered.



AZIANI (DEATH CLAIM)

Pn Latifah lost her daughter Aziani to breast cancer. Appointed as Aziani's beneficiary, she utilised the aid to make a tahlil ceremony and recitation of Yassin, hoping that her daughter will rest in peace. The balance funds was used to cover her transportation fees to visit her daughter's grave every morning ever since her passing. Meanwhile, her meal vouchers obtained were used for buying household items and groceries.

Didik-Kasih EduCare Program

In third quarter of 2020, there were 25 candidates enrolled with the program, aimed at providing needy students with a startup assistance and monthly study allowances for their tertiary education, while also guiding them to plan and conduct charity projects to give back to the society. The candidates are transformed from a receiver to giver through the charity projects as well as volunteering activities with the association. Special thanks to the sponsors BAT Malaysia Foundation, Wipro Unza, and Mdm Tan Ee Hong for funding the candidates.

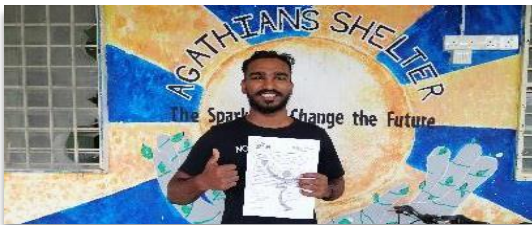
