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HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the final quarter of 2020, our Dialysis Aid Program aided 30 kidney failure patients from low-income earners or unemployed group, compared to 33 patients within the same period in 2019. Dialysis fee subsidy received by each patient ranges from RM130 to RM1,500 per month for a period of three months or more. 12 of the beneficiaries are new cases. Special thanks to Yayasan Kossan (YK) and MaybankHeart under their Bina Bersama campaign for their support this quarter. The beneficiaries listing is as follow:

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



AHMAD FAIZAL BIN OTHMAN

Mr Faizal, 41, is a divorced father of 3. He has high blood pressure, kidney failure, Hep C, and bone disease. In Nov 20, his legs lost strength. GHCA provided him a wheelchair to ease his mobility.



CHELLAPPAN A/L KUPPUSAMY

Mr Chellappan, 70, unemployed, has kidney failure. He relies on his son and welfare aid. His JKM aid increases to RM350 in Dec 20, but he still needed GHCA support for his dialysis fee.



LAI YOKE THYE

Mdm Lai, 56, widow, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Nov 20, she had undergone a hand fistula surgery that will help save some money for her dialysis dressing cost.



PANG PHEY SHUANG

Ms Pang, 34, single, is blind and stays at a nursing home that is paid for by her hairdresser sister. In Oct 20, her sister's salary was impacted by CMCO. GHCA increased her aid to RM1,000 from Nov 20.



CHAN SHI LING

Mdm Chan, 34, has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney failure, and partial blindness. She folds joss money for a living and her income is currently affected. Thus, GHCA extended her aid to Jun 21.



AWRUONG A/P K. GOVINDASAMY

Mdm Awruong, 61, stays with her disabled son and daughter-in-law. In Dec 20, her daughter-in-law found a job as part-time dishwasher. GHCA extended her aid until Mar 21 to give her time to look for a more affordable NGO dialysis centre.



HUSSEN BIN ABDULLAH

Mr Hussen, 60, lives with his breadwinner wife, 48, who works as a maid. In Nov 20, he was diagnosed with Hep B and was admitted to HKL, which also provided him with free dialysis treatment. Thus, our aid stopped after Nov 20.



JAY KUMAR A/L R. SANJEEVANTHAN

Mr Jay, 57, blind, has diabetes and kidney failure, and stays with his wife and two children. In Nov 20, his wife is still looking for additional house cleaning job, which is affected by the CMCO.

LEE KOW MOY

Mdm Lee, 63, has low blood pressure, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. From Nov 20, her son had to withdraw RM500 monthly from his EPF to help pay a portion of her treatment cost.



TAI NYEK KUAN

Mdm Tai, 68, lives with her husband, breadwinner Grab driver son, and granddaughter. She has high blood pressure, high cholesterol, and kidney illness. Her son's income is affected by CMCO, but he still works hard to take care of Mdm Tai.



ZAINAL BIN ZAIBUN

Mr Zainal, 54, stays with his wife and children. He has gout, kidney failure, and high blood pressure. We ended our support in Nov 20 after he rejected our advice to switch to an NGO dialysis centre.



SHU MENG KWAI

Mr Shu, 68, has kidney failure, hyperuricemia, and high blood pressure. In Dec 20, his application for dialysis fee support from a private charity has been approved and he no longer requires our aid.



THOO FONG MING

Mdm Thoo, 64, is a widow and night market toy trader. She has high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney disease. In Nov 20, she had to stop running her stall with the rise in Covid-19 cases. Her aid was extended to May 21.



NG CHEE YING

Mr Ng, 54, unemployed, has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney failure, and is a leg amputee. In Dec 20, his blood sugar level had reduced from 14 to 8, which is a good sign of improvement.



NORSHAHRIL BIN NORJIHAD

Mr Shahril, 40, lives with his wife and 2 sons. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Oct 20, his SOCSO pension has been approved and he no longer requires our aid.



TAN AMAU

Mdm Tan, 67, lives with her husband, son, and her son's partner. She has stroke, high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Dec 20, her MOH subsidy was finally approved. Thus, she no longer requires our assistance.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



CHAN KHENG POH

Mr Chan, 44, has high blood pressure, heart ailment, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Nov 20, his MOH aid had finally been approved and he does not require our help anymore.



CHIA TEK MAU

Mdm Chia, 57, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure and had to move to a nursing home to facilitate her dialysis treatment. In Dec 20, she submitted her application for MOH aid and is hopeful to get an approval soon.



CHAN HUNG MEI

Mdm Chan, 73, lives with her retired husband and son. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. GHCA found a donor who supported her with a one-off RM5,500 donation in Oct 20, while in Nov 20, her son had found a part time job working as a goods delivery man.



GOPAL A/L SINNTHAMBY

Mr Gopal, 64, unemployed, had depleted his wife's savings for his dialysis treatment. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. He was a beneficiary of MITRA until Sep 20. GHCA will support him for 6 months from Nov 20.



SIVAPERUMAL A/L SUBRAMANIAM

Mr Sivaperumal, 50, lives with his wife and 3 young children. He was a MITRA beneficiary until Sep 20. GHCA assisted him from Nov 20 to Dec 20, upon which he moved to Melaka and no longer require our assistance.



VEERANAN A/L PAMPASAMY

Mr Veeranan, 61, stays with his wife and young daughter. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. He receives SOCSO subsidy for his medical fee. GHCA supports his dialysis fee for 6 months from Nov 20 to ease his burden and advised him to apply for JKM aid in this period.



LIM KIM FOONG

Mdm Lim, 54, widow, stays with her brother's family. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, depression, and kidney failure. Her husband died in Apr 20. GHCA supports her dialysis fee for 6 months until Apr 21 to ease her burden and advised her to apply for MOH aid in this period.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



LEE AH MOI

Mdm Lee, 67, widow, stays with her daughter. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Both of her legs are amputated. GHCA supports her dialysis expenses until Apr 21 and advised her to apply for MOH aid within this time.



WAHAB BIN MANGIN

Mr Wahab, 84, has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney failure, and heart illness. He relies on his son's EPF for his expenses. We support his dialysis fees until Apr 21 while he applies for MOH aid.



FOO KHEE YONG

Mr Foo, 67, divorcee, stays alone. He has kidney failure and depended on his siblings for a living. He has applied for MOH aid in May 20 but is still pending approval. GHCA supports his dialysis fees for 6 months from Nov 20.



LIM SIEW KIEW @ LIM SIEW KEOW

Mdm Lim, 77, widow, lives with her grandchildren and daughter, whose income was affected by the CMCO. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. GHCA supports her dialysis fees until Apr 21 to give her daughter time to stabilise her income, while also apply for MOH aid.



TASAN A/L BERAN

Mr Tasan, 78, has walking complications, and kidney failure. He depended on his son-in-law and grandchildren for a living. His MOH aid is pending approval. GHCA supports his dialysis fees for 6 months from Nov 20 to ease his family's burden.



SUSILA A/P RAMIAH

Mdm Susila, 66, widow, has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney failure, and leg ailment. Her cashier daughter is the sole breadwinner. She sometimes skips her dialysis due to lack of funds. GHCA supports her dialysis expenses for 6 months to enable her to continue her treatment.



EMMANUEL A/L N.ARUNASALAM

Mr Emmanuel, 26, has kidney failure in 2018. His father and wife support the household after he lost his delivery job due to MCO. He must skip his treatment occasionally to save cost. GHCA supports his dialysis fees for 3 months while he looks for a new job during this period.

Individual Cases – Family Care

In the final quarter of 2020, we reached out to 35 underprivileged families, compared to 40 families within the same period in 2019. 17 of these families are new cases. GHCA sincerely appreciates Hong Leong Foundation for supporting all our Family Care beneficiaries for this quarter in review.

Rifqi, 1, has down syndrome, narrowed valve, and thyroid. He is still waiting for his next surgery date. His dad is currently looking for a job while his mom has started working as a car salesperson. Thus, GHCA extended our support to Jan 21.



SUKUMARAN A/L KUMARASAMY

Mr Sukumaran, 42, is a father of 5. He has diabetes and chronic pancreas illness. In Nov 20, he is still waiting for his hospital medical report for submission to SOCSO's pension application. Thus, GHCA extended our support until Feb 21.



CHAN LAY KIN @ CHAN LEE KIN

Mdm Chan, 77, is blind and lives alone. In Dec 20, she rejected our advice to enrol in a nursing home. As a local church and a retail shop will be helping with her food and medicine supplies, GHCA ended our support in Dec 20.



NORSYAKILA BINTI ABDUL RAZAK

Mdm Syakila, 30, single mother of 1, is an admin clerk. In Oct 20, her part time warehouse job was affected by CMCO and she struggles to cope with her expenses. Thus, GHCA extended her rental aid for another 6 months until Apr 21.



YUGESHWARAN A/L MAHENDRAN

Yugeshwaran, 15, comes from a B40 family and lives with his parents, sister, and grandmother. As per commented by his tuition teacher, he is hardworking and continues attending tuition classes even during school and public holidays.



GAN KOK CHENG

Gan Kok Cheng, 17, lives with his parents and sibling. His mother is the breadwinner after his father had stroke. He completed his tuition classes in Dec 20, with his SPM being on Feb 21. Thus, our education aid also ended on Dec 20.



TUNG BAO CHUAN

Bao Chuan, 9, lives with his widowed mother, who is a fishing net mender and struggles to pay for her rental. With his tuition ending in Dec 20, GHCA will convert our support to rental aid for 6 months while also monitoring his studies to ensure that he does not get affected.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



VANATHAYEE A/P APRAVOO

Mdm Vanathayee, 78, stays with her daughter and grandson. She requires diapers due to a broken hip. In Dec 20, one of her bed-ridden relative was also placed under her grandson's care. Thankfully with GHCA's aid, they are able to cover their groceries and Mdm Vana's diaper supplies.



LEE CHEN WAI

Mr Lee, 24, lives with his mother. He has ADHD, epilepsy, learning disability, and gout while his mother has lupus. Recently, he had to visit the hospital often for suspected stomach bleeding.



PATMALOSNI A/P MURUGIAH

Mdm Patmalosni, 30, mother of 5 young children, relies on welfare aid for a living as her husband is in jail. She is still looking for a full-time job or additional part-time job that enables her to take care and support her children.



SITI FARIDAH BINTI MD KHAMARUDDIN

Mdm Siti, 31, is visually impaired, unemployed, and has kidney failure. GHCA provided support for her EPO injections. In Nov 20, she underwent an eye operation that was covered by the hospital. GHCA extended our aid for 6 more months.



NG YI QIAN

Ng Yi Qian, 17, stays with her widowed thyroid and breast cancer survivor mother, who is a hawker stall helper. With her SPM delayed to Feb 21, her tuition classes will be extended to Jan 21. Thus, GHCA extended her tuition aid to Jan 21.



ROHAYA BINTI AHMAD

Mdm Rohaya, 47, mother of 2, was a babysitter. Her husband restarted his burger stall with our support and they can now earn between RM3,000 -RM5,000 per month. They thanked us and no longer require our aid after Dec 20.



LOO CHOY KWAN

Mdm Loo, 53, widow with a young son, has diabetes and could not stand for long. In Oct 20, her salary was deducted by half due to CMC, while her JKM application is still in process. Thus, GHCA extends her grocery aid for another 3 months to Jan 21.

AMIZATUL AZLIN BINTI ROSLI

Mdm Amizatul, 33, lives with her husband and 5 children. In Oct 20, her batik cake small business was affected by the CMCO with the closure of schools, as it is part of her client base. Thus, GHCA extended our support for 3 months until Jan 21.



LAU OOI KIEN

Mdm Lau, 48, lives with her husband and young daughter. Due to MCO, they shifted to operating a western food delivery business with GHCA support. In Nov 20, they decided to relocate back to their hometown to run their business there and thus no longer require our support.



FOH CHEE KEONG

Mr Foh, 63, is a widower. He has HIV, tuberculosis, and heart ailment. In Nov 20, he has transferred to an old folks' home and thus will no longer requires our assistance.



ARUEL A/L Y.R.AROKIASAMY

Mr Aruel, 73, is a widower, prostate cancer survivor with low blood pressure. In Nov 20, he has transferred to an old folks' home and thus will no longer requires our assistance.



SITI SAMIRAH BINTI RIDZUAN

Mdm Siti, 26, is a mother of 3. Her husband lost his job and is looking at starting a food business. GHCA provided them with business supplies for 3 months. Their business has since been doing well and she no longer needs our aid after Dec 20.



LIZ HAZRYNN BINTI BAHARUKOM

Ms Liz, 46, single, unemployed, stays with her brother. She has stroke, hypertension, dysphemia, anemia, and uterine fibroid. GHCA provides her with 3 months grocery aid from Oct 20. In Nov 20, she managed to secure 2 part-time jobs as a food packer and a fishing business helper. Seeing her effort, GHCA extended our support until Mar 21.



LIM KAY CHOR

Mr Lim, 69, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and stroke. He and his wife rely on SOCSO pension for their expenses. He is bed-ridden and unable to speak clearly. His wife has breast cancer. In Dec 20, he passed away. GHCA will continue our rental support for his widowed wife from Jan 21.

NOR HASNIZA BINTI HARUN

Mdm Hasniza, 35, mother of 5, is an admin assistant. Her husband lost his job to MCO. GHCA gives her grocer and diaper aid from Oct 20. In Dec 20, her husband found a food industry agent job. Thus, GHCA extends our aid for 3 months while her husband stabilises in his new job.



ZALEHA BINTI MOHD SALLEH

Mdm Zaleha, 39, mother of 4, satay stall helper, has a Down syndrome and thyroid disease son. Her husband is a construction worker. In Dec 20, she lost her job but gets JKM aid. GHCA extends our aid for 3 months while she looks for a new job.



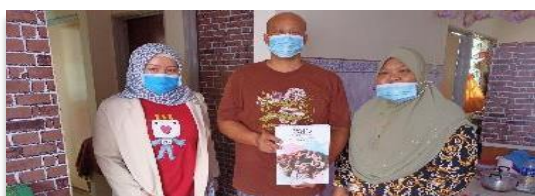
NORIZAN BINTI MOHD NOR

Mdm Norizan, 48, single mother of 6 children, works 3 jobs to support her family. Her eldest son is a Foodpanda driver. Her income is affected by CMCO. Thus, GHCA provides her with grocery aid for 6 months from Oct 20.



SHAHRIL RIZAL B. FAUZI

Mr Shahril, 36, factory operator father of 4, has severe back pain due to a childhood accident. He and his wife are both deaf and mute. GHCA supports him with grocery aid for 6 months while assisting him with JKM aid application.



ROSHAIZAN BIN ABDUL WAHAB

En Roshazian, 46, father of 2, was a Grab driver but stopped after starting chemotherapy for intestine cancer. His wife is a babysitter and sells nasi lemak to support the family. Thus, GHCA supports her business grocery for 6 months.



WONG CHEE LEONG

Mr Wong, 54, has intestine cancer, which causes him to be physically weak. Due to MCO, he lost his job. His part-time cleaner wife is now the breadwinner. GHCA supported him with RM300 monthly grocery aid from Oct 20.



MARIAMMAL A/P UTTUKOTTAN

Mdm Mariammal, 43, widow, lost her cleaner job due to CMCO and had to move to a lower rental house. GHCA supported her with two months' rental for Oct 20 and Nov 20 while she waits to resume her job once CMCO is over.

Mdm Zaiton works as a babysitter. She met with an accident and injured her ankle. The healing process of her ankle takes time, while her income as a babysitter was also affected due to the CMCO. With the claim amount received, she is able to use it to purchase her household necessities, which eases her burden.



ZAMRI (ILLNESS CLAIM)

Mr Zamri is a factory worker. He was hospitalised for a heart attack. As a result, had to rest for 2 months to recuperate. The claim amount received greatly helped him to alleviate his burden on his household expenses, enabling him to concentrate on recuperating with peace of mind.



JAMAL OMAR (DEATH CLAIM)

Ms Rozita is the beneficiary for her late father, Mr Jamal Omar, who passed away due to cancer. The claim amount received was used to buy daily necessities for her family of 5. Although she is still in a state of grief, she tried to be strong for her aging mother, who had always been by her father's side throughout his illness.

Didik-Kasih EduCare Program

In final quarter of 2020, there were 25 candidates enrolled with the program, aimed at providing needy students with a startup assistance and monthly study allowances for their tertiary education, while also guiding them to plan and conduct charity projects to give back to the society.
