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HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the first quarter of 2021, 28 kidney failure patients from the low-income earners or unemployed group were assisted via our Dialysis Aid Program, compared to 27 supported patients within the same period in 2020. Each patient receives dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM130 to RM2,500 per month for a period of three months or more to ease their burden. 5 of the beneficiaries are new cases. Special thanks to Yayasan Kossan (YK) and MaybankHeart under their Bina Bersama campaign for their support this quarter. The beneficiaries listing is as follow:

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



AHMAD FAIZAL BIN OTHMAN

Mr Faizal, 42, is a divorced father of 3. He has high blood pressure, kidney failure, Hep C, and bone disease. Unfortunately, GHCA had to stop our support after Mar 21 as Mr Faizal had passed away due to kidney failure and heart ailment.



CHELLAPPAN A/L KUPPUSAMY

Mr Chellappan, 71, has kidney failure. He relies on his son and welfare aid. In Mar 21, his MOH application was rejected. He is now appealing the decision. Thankfully, his son increased his income with overtime. Therefore, GHCA will be lowering our dialysis aid to RM720 monthly from Apr 21.



LAI YOKE THYE

Mdm Lai, 57, widow, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Mar 21, she started having walking complication and is now on a wheelchair. She has just submitted her MOH aid application and is now waiting for approval.



PANG PHEY SHUANG

Ms Pang, 35, single, blind, has kidney illness, and stays at a nursing home that is paid for by her hairdresser sister. In Feb 21, her sister's income was severely affected by MCO 2.0. Thus, GHCA is continuing our aid for Ms Pang.



CHAN SHI LING

Mdm Chan, 35, has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney failure, and partial blindness. She folds joss money for a living. In Mar 21, her income improves slightly, able to earn RM200 monthly now compared to RM50 monthly last year.



AWRUONG A/P K. GOVINDASAMY

Mdm Awruong, 62, stays with her disabled son and daughter-in-law. In Mar 21, she is still looking for available slots in NGO dialysis centre near her house but was only able to be placed on a waiting list. GHCA extended her aid for another 3 months.



HUSSEN BIN ABDULLAH

Mr Hussien, 61, lives with his wife, 49, who works as a maid. In Jan 21, he had to transfer to Touch Dialysis after contracting Hep B. GHCA supported his RM2,500 monthly dialysis fee there. From Apr 21, his aid will be reduced to RM1,500 as another NGO will also support him partially.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



JAY KUMAR A/L R. SANJEEVANTHAN

Mr Jay, 58, blind, diabetic, and has kidney failure, stays with his wife and two children. In Feb 21, his wife stopped working to take care of Jay. GHCA extended his aid for 3 months to May 21 to allow time for his wife to find a part-time job.



LEE KOW MOY

Mdm Lee, 64, has low blood pressure, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. Her son, who lost his job during MCO, had since found a new job as a furniture salesman. Thus, GHCA will be ending our aid after Feb 21.



TAI NYEK KUAN

Mdm Tai, 69, lives with her husband, breadwinner Grab driver son, and granddaughter. She has high blood pressure, high cholesterol, and kidney illness. In Feb 21, her MOH aid has been approved and will no longer require our aid from Mar 21.



THOO FONG MING

Mdm Thoo, 65, is a widow and night market toy trader. She has high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney disease. In Mar 21, she has resumed her night market stall business, but at fewer days as she requires more rest now after dialysis.



NG CHEE YING

Mr Ng, 55, a leg amputee, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Mar 21, his wife found a cleaner job while their JKM aid was also increased. GHCA will extend our aid for 6 months as he is still coping with his treatment fees while raising his two school-going children.



CHIA TEK MAU

Mdm Chia, 58, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure and had to move to a nursing home to facilitate her dialysis treatment. In Feb 21, we extended her support for 6 months in view of her pending MOH application.



CHAN HUNG MEI

Mdm Chan, 74, lives with her retired husband and son. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Feb 21, we extended her support for 6 months in view of her pending MOH application. Her son's income as a delivery man has also been slowly improving.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



GOPAL A/L SINNTHAMBY

Mr Gopal, 65, unemployed, has diabetes, high blood pressure, and kidney failure. He had almost depleted his wife's savings for his dialysis treatment. In Mar 21, his JKM aid has been increased to RM500. Our aid is still ongoing.



VEERANAN A/L PAMPASAMY

Mr Veeranan, 62, stays with his wife and young daughter. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Mar 21, he now had to rely on a wheelchair for mobility. He applied for JKM aid in Jan 21 and is now waiting for its approval.



LIM KIM FOONG

Mdm Lim, 55, widow, stays with her brother's family. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, depression, and kidney failure. She had unfortunately passed away in Jan 21, thus ending our support.



LEE AH MOI

Mdm Lee, 68, widow, stays with her daughter. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure, with both legs amputated. Thankfully, her family's income was not that affected by MCO 2.0, so they are still coping well with her dialysis fee.



WAHAB BIN MANGIN

Mr Wahab, 85, has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney failure, and heart illness. He relies on his son's EPF for his expenses. In Jan 21, his JKM aid has been approved but his MOH approval is still pending. Our support is still ongoing.



FOO KHEE YONG

Mr Foo, 68, divorcee, stays alone. He has kidney failure and depends on his siblings for a living. Our support is still ongoing to ease his worries as he had felt guilty for being a burden to his sibling, whose income was affected by MCO 2.0.



LIM SIEW KIEW @ LIM SIEW KEOW

Mdm Lim, 78, widow, lives with her grandchildren and daughter. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Mar 21, she had been approved for transfer to a government hospital at Putrajaya from Apr 21 onwards for her treatment and will no longer require our aid.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



TASAN A/L BERAN

Mr Tasan, 79, has walking complications, high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. His breadwinner taxi driver son-in-law's income was affected by MCO 2.0. Support is still ongoing while he waits for his MOH aid approval.



EMMANUEL A/L N.ARUNASALAM

Mr Emmanuel, 27, has kidney failure and lost his job due to MCO. In Jan 21, he found part time jobs working as a security guard, and as an airport taxi driver. GHCA extended his support for 3 months at RM720 monthly starting from Feb 21.



CHONG KIM FUNG

Mr Chong, 63, stays with his son and nephew. He has high blood pressure and kidney failure. He used to receive MOH support for his dialysis, but it was stopped in 2020. GHCA provides dialysis aid of RM720 monthly to him starting Jan 21.



DEVANAH BIN HASSAN

Mr Devanah, 58, lives alone in his brother's house, who lets him stay there for free. He has kidney failure and relies on SOCSO and JKM aid for his expenses and dialysis fee. GHCA provides dialysis aid of RM360 monthly to him from Mar 21.



LAU SAID NI

Ms Lau, 40, has kidney failure. Her dialysis fee is partly supported by SOCSO. She stays with her Grab driver brother, who supports the household. Ms Lau runs a hawker stall to cover her dialysis fee. Seeing her determination, GHCA provides her with 3 months dialysis aid to reduce her burden.



MUHAMMAD AZLI BIN ABDULLAH

Mr Muhammad, 27, relies on his mother, 60, who is a 7-Eleven cashier, for a living. He has kidney failure and is a SOCSO aid recipient. However, his mother is struggling to cover his balance dialysis fees and household expenses. GHCA supports him with 3 months dialysis aid to reduce their burden.



CHAN CHEN

Mr Chan, 64, stayed with his wife and son, who has severe depression. They rely on JKM and relative's aid for a living. After he was diagnosed with kidney failure, he struggles to pay for his dialysis treatment. GHCA will support him with RM720 dialysis aid from Mar 21.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Family Care

In the first quarter of 2021, we reached out to 35 underprivileged families, compared to 41 families within the same period in 2020. 11 of these families are new cases. Our heartfelt appreciation to Hong Leong Foundation for supporting all our Family Care beneficiaries in Jan 2021.

MUHAMMAD RIFQI MIKAEL

Rifqi, 2, has down syndrome, narrowed valve, and thyroid. He is still waiting for his surgery date. In Jan 21, his father managed to secure work as a lorry driver and will no longer require our aid.



SUKUMARAN A/L KUMARASAMY

Mr Sukumaran, 43, has diabetes and pancreas illness. His wife now runs a plant nursery venture, while her eldest daughter will be working soon. Thus, GHCA ended our aid after Feb 21.



NORSYAKILA BINTI ABDUL RAZAK

Mdm Syakila, 31, single mother of 1, she quit her job to focus on running a small business, selling bottled honey with delivery services. GHCA will explore on helping to jumpstart her business.



YUGESHWARAN A/L MAHENDRAN

Yugeshwaran, 16, is under our tuition aid. His father's outstanding loan with a moneylender is expected to only be repaid fully by Jul 21. Thus, GHCA extended his tuition aid for 3 months.



TUNG BAO CHUAN

Bao Chuan, 10, lives with his widowed mother, a fishing net mender whose income was affected by CMCO. His tuition aid was thus converted to rental aid to ease her mother's burden. He now studies online from home.



VANATHAYEE A/P APRAVOO

Mdm Vanathayee, 78, requires diapers due to a broken hip. In Feb 21, her lorry driver husband income was reduced to half due to MCO 2.0, while her JKM aid has yet to be approved. Thus, GHCA extended her support until May 21.



LEE CHEN WAI

Mr Lee, 25, has ADHD, learning disability, gout, and epilepsy, having to visit the hospital often. In Feb 21, he was diagnosed with suspected cancer. Thus, GHCA extended our aid for 3 months while he undergoes further diagnostics.



PATMALOSNI A/P MURUGIAH

Mdm Patmalosni, 31, mother of 5, relies on aid for a living. She now takes care of her sister's children, in exchange for groceries. GHCA will be lowering our aid to RM150 from Apr 21, while she promised to look for a job within 3 months' time.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



SITI FARIDAH BINTI MD KHAMARUDDIN

Mdm Siti, 32, is visually impaired and has kidney failure. GHCA supported her dialysis EPO injections. In Jan 21, her blood count improves, and she requires lesser EPO injections. Thus, GHCA lowered our aid to RM250 monthly.



LOO CHOY KWAN

Mdm Loo, 54, widow with a young son, has diabetes. Her salary was affected by CMCO. In Jan 21, her income has reverted to normal and would not require our aid after Jan 21.



AMIZATUL AZLIN BINTI ROSLI

Mdm Amizatul, 34, lives with her husband and 5 children. She runs a small batik cake business which was affected by CMCO. In Jan 21, her business has since recovered, and she no longer requires our aid after Jan 21.



LIZ HAZRYNN BINTI BAHARUKOM

Ms Liz, 47, single, unemployed, stays with her brother. She has stroke, hypertension, dysphemia, anemia, and uterine fibroid. In Mar 21, her JKM aid and MAIM aid has both been approved. Thus, she no longer requires our support after Mar 21.



NOR HASNIZA BINTI HARUN

Mdm Hasniza, 36, mother of 5, is an admin assistant. In Mar 21, her income has increased, while her husband's new job as a food industry agent has also stabilised. Thus, she no longer requires our support after Mar 21.



ZALEHA BINTI MOHD SALLEH

Mdm Zaleha, 40, mother of 4, has a Down syndrome and thyroid disease son. In Mar 21, she wanted to open a fried food stall. Thus, we provided her with an ad-hoc business start up support, while ending our monthly grocery aid after Mar 21.



NORIZAN BINTI MOHD NOR

Mdm Norizan, 49, single mother of 6 children, works 3 jobs to support her family. Her income was affected by CMCO. In Mar 21, her main job as a school transportation provider has revert back to normal with the reopening of schools. Thus, she no longer requires our help after Mar 21.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



SHAHRIL RIZAL B. FAUZI

Mr Shahril, 37, father of 4, is both deaf and mute. His household income is now unaffected by MCO 2.0 and he is able to cover his family's expenses. Thus, GHCA will be stopping our support after Mar 21.



ROSHAIZAN BIN ABDUL WAHAB

En Roshazain, 47, father of 2, was a cancer survivor. His breadwinner wife recently had a stroke that affected half her body while he was also diagnosed with another tumour in his intestine. GHCA will extend our aid for another 3 months until their condition improves.



WONG CHEE LEONG

Mr Wong, 55, is physically weak due to intestine cancer. In Mar 21, his breadwinner wife switched to a food caterer job to serve food to his neighbours, while also working as a babysitter. GHCA will extend his support for 3 months.



MAHASWARI A/P SINAYOGAM

Mdm Mahaswari, 65, has thyroid disease and high cholesterol. Her husband has retired. They now relied on JKM aid for a living. Our grocery aid ended in Mar 21.



AMISAH BINTI MOHD ISA

Mdm Amisah, 35, single mother of 4, is deaf and mute. Her husband died in an accident while she was pregnant. In Mar 21, after giving birth, she resumed her burger business. GHCA extended her aid for 3 months at RM300 monthly from Apr 21.



KRISHNAKUMAR A/L ARUMUGAM

Mr Krishnakumar, 40, father of 4, has pancreas cancer. We terminated our support in Jan 21, after we found out that there were elements of fraud in his provided statements to qualify for our business start-up support.



GAN POH HONG

Mdm Gan, 45, mother of 6, lives with her elder brother. Her metal factory worker husband and eldest daughter work to support the family. In Feb 21, her second daughter managed to secure a factory job. Thus, GHCA will extend our support for 3 months until her probation period ends.

NEROSHA A/P KRISHNAN

Ms Nerosha, 27, is wheelchair-bound. She was supposed to represent Malaysia for a dance competition in Japan this year, but it was canceled due to Covid-19. We comforted her to never give up in pursuing her dream to be a dancer.



LIM SIOW GAN @ LIM CHEW NGAN

Madam Lim, 72, is a widow. Her husband passed away in Dec 20. She has Stage 2 breast cancer and is relying on SOCSO pension for a living. In Mar 21, her caretaker sister has secured a job as a factory worker and will no longer require our support.



NUR QISTINA BALQIS BINTI ZAIPUL

Nur Qistina, 12, is the child of Hasniza, our Family Care beneficiary. She is sitting for her UPSR this year. GHCA provides her with RM100 tuition support from Jan 21 to ease her parents' burden.



TAN HOCK CHUAN

Mr Tan, 51, father of 3 schooling children, was our beneficiary in 2019. He has high blood pressure and brain surgery and is now on medication. Due to MCO, he is unable to pay for his house rental. GHCA supports him with rental aid from Jan 21.



CHUA SENG HENG

Mr Chua, 70, was our beneficiary in 2019 and is our frequent vegetable garden volunteer. He and his siblings, all low-income earners, relied on each other for their household expenses. Due to MCO, he struggles with his rent. Thus, GHCA provides him with rental aid from Jan 21.



MUNIRA BINTI ANUAR

Mdm Munira, 34, stays with her 2 young children and parents. She is on ventilator for respiratory distress, has postpartum infective endocarditis, and severe thromboembolic stroke after giving birth, and is unable to walk. GHCA supports her with diaper and milk supplies of RM400 from Jan 21 while also advising her to apply for JKM aid.



NG YI QIAN

Yi Qian, 18, stays with her widowed thyroid and breast cancer survivor mother, who is a hawker stall helper. With her SPM delayed to Feb 21, we extended her tuition aid to cover her final two months of classes prior to her SPM exams.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



VANI A/P RAMA

Mdm Vani, 36, single mother with four young children, was a cleaner who lost her job in Oct 20 and had to rely on JKM aid for the time being. GHCA provides her with grocery aid for 3 months from Feb 21 while she strive to secure a job.

Mdm Krishnah Devi, 62, single mother of a schooling son, stays at a nursing home. She has diabetes, high blood pressure, kidney failure, heart ailment and stroke. She requires assistance with her daily activities. GHCA supports half her nursing home fees from Feb 21, while the rest of the fee is covered by her JKM aid.



GOVINDASAMY A/L NADASAPATHAR

Mr Govindasamy, 76, lives alone ever since his wife passed away in Feb 21. His children are not willing to take care of him nor give him any allowance. He relies on his pension for his household expenses but is struggling to cover his rental. GHCA provides him with rental aid for 6 months from Feb 21 until Jul 21.



LAKSHMI ISHA A/P SUGUMARAN

Lakshmi Isha, 6, has congenital heart problem and gastroesophageal reflux disease and can only consume glucose water and milk through tube feedings. She is on colostomy bags, which is a huge financial burden to her family. GHCA assists her with milk supply aid of RM400 from Feb 21 for 2 months while her father's job stabilises.



KARPPAGAM A/P AROKIANATHAN

Mdm Karppagam, 44, single mother of two, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and amputated her left leg, resulting in job loss. She had to skip her hospital wound cleaning appointments due to financial constraints. From Feb 21, GHCA assists her hospital transportation for 3 months and encouraged her to apply for SOSCO pension.



HARINI A/P KANANBATHI

Ms Harini, 14, has Crohn's disease and needs to consume Ensure milk as her diet from Mar 21. Her father is a house painter and struggles to cover her required milk supplies. Thus, GHCA will support her with 4 tins of Ensure milk monthly from Mar 21 until Aug 21.

Mr Chan, 64, single, lives alone. He was a draftman who lost his job due to MCO. He is depending fully on his savings now and struggles to pay his rent. He managed to find work in Feb 21 but needed help to cover his outstanding rental. GHCA provided him with a one-time rental aid.

Orang Asli Villages

FLOOD RELIEF MISSION AT EAST COAST ORANG ASLI VILLAGES

On 23 Jan 2021, Great Heart Charity Association collaborated with the Malaysian Red Crescent Society (MRCS) for the East Coast Flood Relief Mission to provide aid to the Orang Asli villagers in Kuala Rompin, Pekan, and Chini, Pahang. 634 families from 5 villages, namely, Kampung Jong, Kampung Merani Nenasi, Kampun Tasik Mentiga, Kampung Pematang Siput, and Kampung Sawak benefited from the relief mission.

During the flood relief mission, 2 types of relief aids were distributed to the villagers, based on the needs of the respective villages. Villagers from three villages received food baskets worth RM100 each, while the remaining two villages received hygiene kits worth RM100 each. The team from GHCA and MRCS also conducted some simple assessments with the villagers to find out the longer-term needs of the villages and how the flood has affected them.

The flood created a huge impact to the villagers, with their source of income greatly affected, since most of the villagers there relied on farming to make a living. With the flooding, almost 90% of their farms has been destroyed. The relief mission is hope to at least ease some of the villagers' burden.

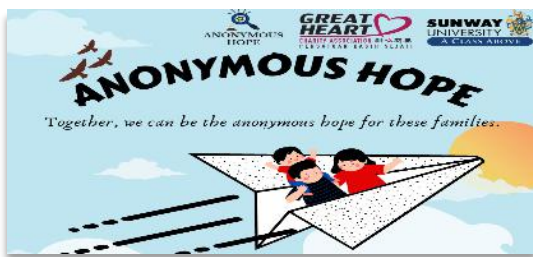
LOVE IN ACTION FUNDRAISER

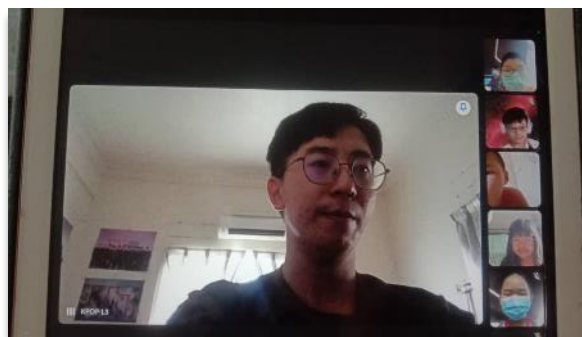
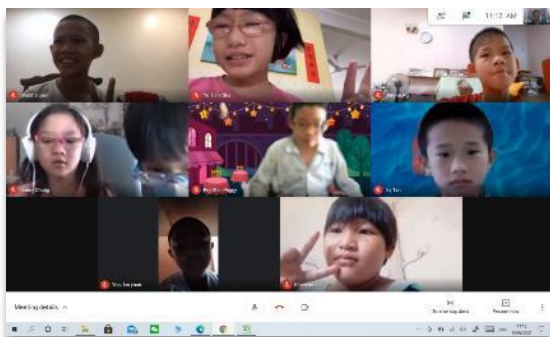
program that came from 18 families to monthly grocery aid as due to the pandemic, these beneficiaries would prefer to cook by themselves to avoid going out daily.

Shopping Buddy Program

In the first quarter of 2021, 80 low-income families from PPR Pantai Ria benefited from the Shopping Buddy Program, with groceries aid worth RM200 being provided to each family per month for Feb 21 and Mar 21. This was especially crucial for the 80 families, as many were affected by the sudden implementation of MCO2.0 in Jan 21. Volunteers assisted in calling each of the families to find out more about their situation, and the customised groceries items required respectively, before acting as their Shopping Buddies to assist the 80 families with their groceries needs. This initiative was supported by Yayasan Hasanah under the Hasanah Special Grant 2020. During the 3 months of the program under this initiative, the 80 families were able to gain access to healthy and nutritious food, while they weather through the pandemic and economic uncertainties.



TESTIMONIES



HADIZAH (*beneficiary*)

"I am a single mother of 7 from a low-income family with arthritis and is unable to work. I rely on my 2 children, a waiter and a sales promoter, to support our family. They had to start work from 17 and are unable to continue studies to support our family. The pandemic caused my eldest child to lose her job as the company went out of business. Fortunately, by the third month of assistance, 2 of my other children had secured jobs to support our family. I am thankful for the balanced diet aid that we received, as it has been a while since we could afford fruits in our diet. Thank you for easing our burden."

PRUKasih Program

In the first quarter of 2021, 12 residents were onboarded into the program, while a further 30 claims for various illnesses, accidents, and deaths, worth RM35,664 were filed, approved, and disbursed to the affected members.

In Mar 21, the PRUKasih-Taylor's Entrepreneurship Program was also kick started, with two entrepreneurs from PPR Pantai Ria successfully getting enrolled onto the program that is aimed to provide training to jumpstart and expand their businesses. The participants will be joining a series of engaging online lectures on Entrepreneurship skills and emotional wellbeing that will be rolled out throughout the year, with a graduation session planned out for by year end.



PRUKASIH HIGHLIGHTS



AMALINA (ACCIDENT CLAIM)

Mdm Amalina is a Food Panda rider. She had an accident on her way home from work and was unable to work for 33 days, affecting her source of income. She received RM784 in claims that enable her to buy daily necessities while she recuperates.



MUNIRA ANUAR (ILLNESS CLAIM)

Mdm Munira is recovering from a coma due to postpartum complications. Her baby was taken care of by her mother, who is unemployed, causing her family to be burdened by this. She received RM1,528 in claims that was used to buy necessities for her baby and herself.



WONG CHEE WOUI (DEATH CLAIM)

Mr Wong had Covid-19 and passed away in the hospital. His family was in despair as they could not visit him nor attend his funeral until he was being cremated. Mr Wong's wife received RM9,988 in death benefit to help sustain their family while they grieve.

Didik-Kasih EduCare Program

In first quarter of 2021, there were 24 candidates enrolled with the program, aimed at providing needy students with a startup assistance and monthly study allowances for their tertiary education, while also guiding them to plan and conduct charity projects to give back to the society. Special thanks to BAT Malaysia Foundation, Wipro Unza, and Mdm Tan Ee Hong for funding the candidates.

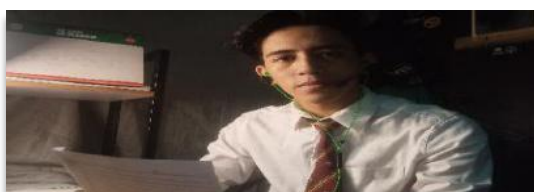
NURUL IZZATY AKHTAR

LEENESH A/L YELLAIYAH

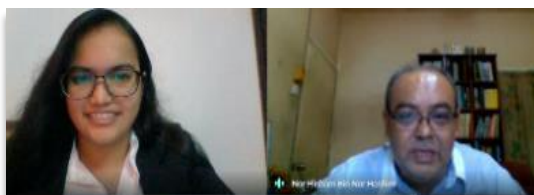
