Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In quarter 3 of 2021, 35 kidney illness patients from the vulnerable communities were supported, compared to 32 patients within the same period in 2020. Each patient receives a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM130 to RM1,000 per month to ease their burden. There are 11 new cases this quarter. HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



JAY KUMAR A/L R. SANJEEVANTHAN

Mr Jay, 58, blind, diabetic, and has kidney failure, stays with his wife and two children. In Aug 21, his wife was still unable to work as a cleaner due to the MCO. Therefore, GHCA extended his support until Nov 21.



THOO FONG MING

Mdm Thoo, 65, is a widow. She has high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney disease. In Aug 21, she had to support her recently unemployed son-in-law with her rental income. She now relies on her son's allowance for a living. Thus, GHCA extended our support until Feb 22.



NG CHEE YING

Mr Ng, 55, a leg amputee, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Sep 21, his wife's job as a cleaner in an old folks' home has stabilised. Thus, he no longer requires our assistance after Sep 21.



VEERANAN A/L PAMPASAMY

Mr Veeranan, 62, stays with his wife and teenage daughter. He has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Unfortunately, Mr Veeranan passed away in Jul 21. Thus, his dialysis aid also ended.



FOO KHEE YONG

Mr Foo, 68, divorcee, stays alone. He has kidney failure and depends on his siblings for a living. In Jul 21, his MOH and JKM aid are still pending approval. Thus, GHCA extended his dialysis support until Oct 21.



TASAN A/L BERAN

Mr Tasan, 79, has walking complications, high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Jul 21, his taxi driver son-in-law still struggles to cover his dialysis fee as his income was affected by MCO. Thus, we extended his aid until Oct 21.



EMMANUEL A/L N.ARUNASALAM

Mr Emmanuel, 27, has kidney failure. He found work as a driver for airport workers and as a school student transporter, but his income was impacted with the school shutdown. Thus, GHCA extended his support until Oct 21.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



CHONG KIM FUNG

Mr Chong, 63, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. He has obtained a one-off RM2000 aid from Bantuan Sihat Selangor but his MOH aid is still being processed. Thus, GHCA extended his support until Dec 21.



DEVANAH BIN HASSAN

Mr Devanah, 58, lives alone, has kidney failure, and relies on SOCSO and JKM aid. In Aug 21, his brother was affected by the MCO and struggles to support part of Mr Devanah's expenses. Thus, GHCA will be extending his support until Feb 22.



LAU SAID NI

Ms Lau, 40, has kidney failure. Her dialysis fee is partly supported by SOCSO. She runs a hawker stall for a living, which is still affected due to the dine-in restrictions. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Feb 22.



MUHAMMAD AZLI BIN ABDULLAH

Mr Muhammad, 27, has kidney failure and recently found job as a cook, after having relied previously on his mother, 60, who is a 7-Eleven cashier. However, both their income was affected recently. Thus, GHCA extended his aid till Feb 22.



NIRMALA A/P VENGITTASAN

Mdm Nirmala, 35, stays with her lorry driver husband and requires help to cover her dialyser fees. In Sep 21, she no longer requires catering for this, and with the reduced expenses, she will no longer require our assistance after Sep 21.



ZULKIFLI BIN HUSSIN

Both Mr Zulkifli, 51, and his wife have kidney illness. They have two children with low-income jobs. In Aug 21, his SOCSO aid application has been approved, and he would no longer require our support after that.



SANTHIRASEKAR A/L AYASAMY

Mr Santhirasekar, 37, has blurry vision, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Jul 21, he had used his EPF's i-Sinar facility to cover some of his outstanding dialysis fee and had depleted his bank savings. Thus, GHCA extended his dialysis aid to Oct 21 while he waits for his SOCSO aid approval process.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



MOHAMAD KHAIRUL FITRI

Mr Mohamad, 27, has kidney failure, and works as an Apple store salesman. In Sep 21, he successfully underwent a kidney transplant surgery at HKL. With that, he will no longer requires dialysis and our assistance from Oct 21.



LOH YAT HOONG

Mr Loh, 58, has high blood pressure, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. While waiting for his SOCSO application, GHCA aided with his dialysis fee. In Sep 21, his SOCSO aid was approved, and he no longer requires our support.



THEYAGU A/L SUKUMARAN

Mr Theyagu, 34, has kidney failure, diabetes, and high blood pressure. He receives SOCSO aid and is supported by his brother-in-law, whose income was hit by MCO. By Sep 21, his income improves. Thus, Theyagu no longer requires our aid.



MOHD AMIR FIRDAUZ

Mr Mohd Amir, 37, has diabetes, kidney failure, and high blood pressure. He receives SOCSO aid and needs RM500 monthly for his dialysis fee. GHCA supported him until Sep 21, upon which his sibling will cover his subsequent expenses.



ALICE AVILEA A/P MICHEAL

Mdm Alice, 27, has kidney failure and high blood pressure. GHCA supported her monthly with RM1,000 dialysis aid from Jul 21. From Oct 21, her aid amount will be reduced to RM720 as her husband's income as a food rider has improved.



RASILAH BINTI NORDIN

Mdm Rasilah, 64, has kidney failure, diabetes, and high blood pressure. GHCA supported her dialysis from Jul 21. In Sep 21, she moved to an NGO dialysis centre while her Zakat aid has also been approved. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.



WAN WAI MAN

Mr Wan, 71, wheelchair-bound, has diabetes, high cholesterol, kidney failure, and high blood pressure. His children's income was affected by the pandemic. GHCA provided him with dialysis aid from Jul 21. In Sep 21, his children's income stabilises. Thus, he no longer requires our aid.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



GAN ENG SIN

Mr Gan, 65, divorcee, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. He lives with his elder sister and his nephew, who covers his expenses. His SOCSO aid application is in the process. GHCA supports him with RM720 dialysis aid until Dec 21.



SITI NUR AIN FATIMAH BINTI JAMIL

Mdm Siti Nur Ain Fatimah, 28, unemployed, has kidney failure. She receives Zakat aid for her dialysis and relies on her father's pension to cover her remaining dialysis fee. GHCA provides her with RM360 monthly dialysis aid from Aug 21.



TAN LI TING

Mdm Tan, 53, unemployed, has kidney failure. She has SOCSO aid but still needs to cover her medical injection fee. Her brother used to cover her living expenses but had recently lost his job. Hence, GHCA provides her with dialysis aid from Sep 21.



KALACHELVE A/P JHULUKANAM

Mdm Kalachelve, 61, has diabetes, high blood pressure, and kidney failure. She is supported by her cleaner daughter and packaging worker son-in-law. GHCA assists her with RM1,000 monthly dialysis aid from Aug 21 to Jan 22.



TAN BOON YAW

Mr Tan, 58, has kidney cancer. He lives with his waitress in his in-law's house. His married son is a hawker and supports Mr Tan with home allowance occasionally. GHCA supports Mr Tan with RM720 dialysis aid monthly from Aug 21.



CHELLAPPAN A/L KUPPUSAMY

Mr Chellappan, 71, has kidney failure. He relies on welfare aid and his car wash helper son, who was on unpaid leave due to MCO. His NKF application was rejected as the centre's occupancy was full. Thankfully, in Sep 21, his son has resumed work. GHCA extended his support to Dec 21.



LAI YOKE THYE

Mdm Lai, 57, widow, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Her children struggle for her dialysis fee as they were forced to take unpaid leave from Jun 21 to Aug 21 due to the MCO. She is still waiting for her MOH aid approval.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



PANG PHEY SHUANG

Ms Pang, 35, single, blind, has kidney illness, and stays at a nursing home that is paid for by her sister. In Sep 21, China Press Foundation and her dialysis centre helped to fundraise for her medical fees that will be utilised after Oct 21.



CHAN SHI LING

Mdm Chan, 35, has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney failure, and partial blindness. She folds joss money for a living and is unable to seek other employment due to her condition. Her support was extended until Dec 21 to ease her burden.



CHAN HUNG MEI

Mdm Chan, 74, recently widowed, lives with her son. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Aug 21, her son found work as a part-time home IT support. Her aid is extended until Feb 22 while she awaits her MOH aid status.



AWRUONG A/P K. GOVINDASAMY

Mdm Awruong, 62, stays with her disabled son and daughter-in-law. She is still in the process of transferring to an NGO dialysis center to lower her treatment fees, which was delayed due to the pandemic. Thus, we extended her aid until Dec 21.



GOPAL A/L SINNTHAMBY

Mr Gopal, 65, unemployed, has diabetes, high blood pressure, kidney failure, and is a right leg amputee. In Aug 21, he is waiting for his interview session with a medical doctor for his SOCSO aid appeal, which was delayed due to the pandemic.



LEE AH MOI

Mdm Lee, 68, widow, stays with her daughter. A double amputee, she has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She is currently still waiting for her MOH aid approval process. Thus, her aid was extended to Oct 21.



WAHAB BIN MANGIN

Mr Wahab, 85, has high blood pressure, diabetes, kidney failure, and heart illness. He relies on his son's EPF for his expenses. In Sep 21, his Zakat aid application has been approved and he will be transferred to a Zakat dialysis centre. Thus, he no longer requires our support after Sep 21.

Individual Cases – Family Care

In the third quarter of 2021, we reached out to 58 underprivileged families, compared to 25 families within the same period in 2020. 37 of these families are new cases. Mr Tan, 51, father of 3 schooling children, is unfit to work. He has high blood pressure and brain surgery and is now on medication. His cleaner wife is the breadwinner. His rental aid is still ongoing to ease his family's burden.



CHUA SENG HENG

Mr Chua, 70, stays with his siblings, who work as a tailor, cleaner, and security guard and whose income are affected by MCO. He frequently volunteers at GHCC's vegetable garden. As their income are still affected, his rental aid support is still ongoing.

AMISAH BINTI MOHD ISA

Mdm Amisah, 35, widowed mother of 5, is deaf and mute, and had to stop her burger stall business due to the pandemic. In Sep 21, she has resumed her business and is able to self-sustain. Thus, she no longer requires our aid after Sep 21.



FARHA BINTI RAMLI

Mdm Farha, 35, lives with her husband and 3 children. She had to stop working to take care of her ailing mother. In Sep 21, her MAIM aid application has been approved. Thus, she no longer requires our support.



TOH LAI FAH

Mdm Toh, 44, single mother of three, stays with her father, 73. She had lost her factory job during the pandemic. In Sep 21, she found a home job and is now able to self-sustain. Thus, she no longer requires our support.



ROSHAIZAN BIN ABDUL WAHAB

En Roshazain, 47, father of 2, was a cancer survivor. His MBSJ stall application was approved, and he is expected to open his stall by year's end. Our support ended in Sep 21, but we might assist him with his stall's equipments next quarter.



SEGAR

Mr Segar, 43, lives with his wife and two children. He lost his job to factory shutdown. GHCA helped him with groceries aid while he search for a job. In Sep 21, his job hunt was still unsuccessful. So, his aid will be extended for 3 months at RM150.



SUGUNA

Ms Suguna, 21, had just completed her internship. She stays with 2 of her siblings. Her breadwinner sister lost her job due to MCO while her younger sister is still in college. They are struggling with rent. GHCA supports her with rental aid until Sep 21 while they look for a job.



GOVINDASAMY A/L NADASAPATHAR

Mr Govindasamy, 76, is a widower. He has a grandchild who occasionally provides him with some groceries. He relies on SOCSO pension for a living, and struggles with his rental. GHCA's rental aid is still ongoing to ease his burden.

SITI FARIDAH BINTI MD KHAMARUDDIN

Mdm Siti, 32, is visually impaired and has kidney failure. In Sep 21, her plumber husband's salary was reduced to RM800 due to MCO. Thus, our support is ongoing to ease their burden.



NEROSHA A/P KRISHNAN

#BENDERAPUTIH ORANG ASLI GROCERY DISTRIBUTION

On the 28 Aug 21, GHCA distributed groceries to assist the indigenous community affected by the MCO, in conjunction with the White Flag Movement. A total of RM3,027.00 worth of groceries and medicine supplies were provided to 60 families from the Mah Meri Cultural Village in Pulau Carey to support them in overcoming the pandemic.

With the MCO still in place at the time, GHCA liaised with food suppliers to arrange for the aid to be delivered directly to the Mah Meri Cultural Village and distributed to the 60 families with the help of the village representative, Mr Rashid.

Covid-19 Special Projects and Initiatives



GREAT HEART COVID-19 RELIEF AID 2.0

In Jul 21, the Great Heart Covid-19 Relief Aid 2.0 (GHCRA 2.0) was launched to assist those affected by the pandemic. RM71,400 was disbursed to the 357 affected families. Priorities were given to those with disabilities or chronic disease, senior citizens, single-parent families, and applicants with loss of income due to the pandemic. 71.7 percent of the applicants were affected by loss of income. 38 of the families were further supported in a longer term via our Family Care program.



MEDICAL EQUIPMENT DONATION PROJECT

In Aug 21, GHCA donated RM506,560 worth of much needed live-saving medical equipment to 6 hospitals, namely Hospital Klang, Hospital Ampang, Hospital KL, Hospital Sungai Buloh, Hospital Serdang, and Hospital Selayang, in the fight against Covid-19. This includes 3,000 PPE jumpsuits, 74 oxygen concentrators, 12 oxygen tanks, 100 oxygen flowmeters, 200 humidifier bottles, 19 syringe pumps, and 10 5-ways splitters. Special thanks to all our donors for this Medical Equipment Donation Project.



MYANMAR MEDICAL EQUIPMENT DONATION

In Aug 21, volunteers from Great Heart Charity Myanmar visited the Phaung Gyi Medical Centre and donated 100 oxygen concentrators to the treatment center to assist them in the fight to treat Covid-19 patients. The medical centre is run by 16 doctors & nurses, and 200 volunteers, treating about 1,400 Covid-19 patients.



JAKARTA MEDICAL EQUIPMENT DONATION

In Sep 21, our volunteers in Indonesia delivered 100 oxygen concentrators to Artha Graha Peduli (AGP), an NGO in Jakarta. As a part of our founder Mr Franky See's initiative, GHCA worked together with local volunteers in Indonesia to carry out this medical equipment donation. AGP has been working tirelessly to help around 76,000 patients, staffed with 23 doctors, 7 specialists, 72 health workers and 285 volunteers. We hope that this donation can help in the fight against Covid-19 in Indonesia.

Knowledge sharing sessions are conducted for school and university students so that they initiate and organise charity projects with Great Heart partnering them as mentor and funder.

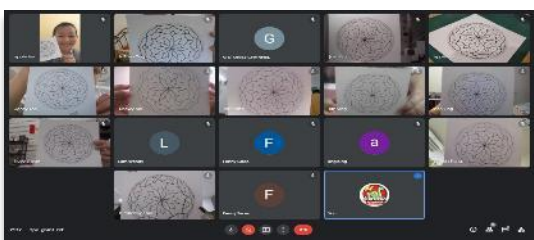
TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy

Due to the pandemic, the TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy Program was still suspended throughout the third quarter of 2021, until further notice.

Classes for the Children



In the third quarter of 2021, we conducted 62 sessions of Malay and English virtual language classes, attended by 388 students in total. Attendance rate is at 90% from enrolled students, with 90% students recording improvements. GHCA also conducted 8 sessions of virtual Mandala Art Class that are participated by 161 students.



Vegetable Garden for the Community



In the third quarter of 2021, 150.1kg of vegetables were harvested in 23 harvesting sessions, benefitting 74 beneficiaries and 44 neighbours. The vegetables grown this quarter are bok choy, kangkong, Chinese mustard green, lettuce, Cameron choy sum, and coconut.

Community Legal Clinic Services



In the third quarter of 2021, 2 persons benefited from the sponsored community legal clinic. On 24 Sep 21, a virtual legal talk session was conducted through Facebook Live, where our guest speaker Ms Yan Leong from Tan & Yan Leong Advocates & Solicitors provides an informative and interactive session for audience to impart them with knowledge on “Why Write a Will?” as well as answering some of the burning questions that the audience had about will writing.

Groceries for the Urban Poor



In the third quarter of 2021, GHCC distributed 290 sets of groceries and GHCC Melaka distributed a further 60 sets of groceries to urban poor families staying nearby our respective community centres. The distributions are conducted monthly to ease the burden of urban poor families onboarded to the program. 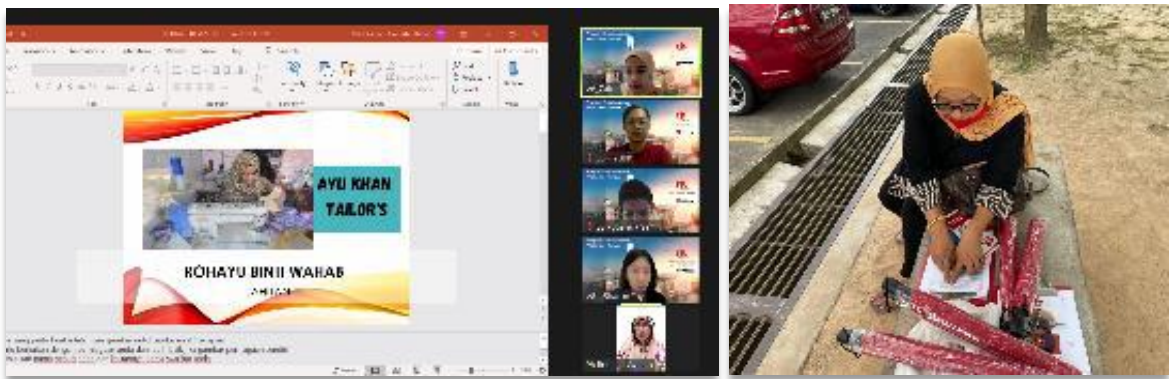


COMMUNITY DISINFECTION SERVICES

The Community Disinfection Services Project was initiated on 2 Aug 21 as a community initiative to combat Covid-19 by providing disinfection teams with disinfectants, equipment, or monetary aid to conduct disinfection measures for premises hit by Covid-19. Via this project, close to 1,290 premises including residential areas, shop lots, and community areas has been disinfected, providing RM38,619.28 worth of supplies and equipment.

PRUKasih Program

The third quarter of 2021 was a tough period for the community in PPR Pantai Ria where the PRUKasih program is held at, as the community was placed under EMCO in Jul 21 due to the high infection rate of Covid-19 there. Due to this, there were a huge spike in 108 claims, mostly related to Covid-19, amounting to RM59,592 that were approved and disbursed in the quarter. We have also onboarded 24 new members onto the program. Meanwhile, under the PRUKasih Entrepreneurship program, both our participants successfully passed their pitching day session and received business grant worth RM1,000 in equipment to help grow their business. Both candidates showed good feedback after attending the program and now understood better on how to manage their businesses systematically.



PRUKASIH HIGHLIGHTS



NURBAIDURI (ILLNESS CLAIM)

Mdm Nurbaiduri was hospitalised for 30 days due to Covid-19 and was on ventilator for 10 days. She has now recovered but has long Covid-19 and requires physiotherapy to restore her respiratory system. She received RM1,488 in claims.

Didik-Kasih EduCare Program

In third quarter of 2021, there are 25 candidates enrolled with the program that provides needy students with startup assistance and monthly study allowances for their tertiary education. 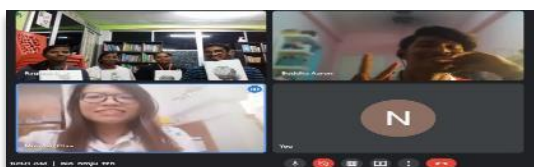
