Mdm Lai, 57, widow, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Oct 21, her children's income was still affected by the effects of MCO while her MOH aid is still in process. Hence, GHCA extended her support until Apr 22.

CHAN HUNG MEI

Mdm Chan, 74, widow, lives with her part-time home IT support son. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She is currently still waiting for her MOH subsidy approval.

CHONG KIM FUNG

Mr Chong, 63, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. He relies on his son and brother to cover some of his dialysis fees. His MOH aid is still in process. Thus, GHCA extended his support until Jun 22.

DEVANAH BIN HASSAN

Mr Devanah, 58, lives alone in a rented flat. He has kidney failure and relies on SOCSO and JKM aid. His brother, who works in a hotel, used to support part of his expenses but is struggling now as the industry is hit hard. GHCA's aid is still ongoing.

LAU SAID NI

Ms Lau, 40, has kidney failure. Her dialysis fee is partly supported by SOCSO. Her hawker stall business is still affected and had to rely on her brother to cover some of her expenses. GHCA's aid is still ongoing to ease her burden.

MUHAMMAD AZLI BIN ABDULLAH

Mr Muhammad, 27, has kidney failure. He works as a cook, but has to be on leave often when he had to be on dialysis treatment. The restricted operation hour also affects his income. GHCA's aid is still ongoing to ease his burden.

ALICE AVILEA A/P MICHEAL

Mdm Alice, 27, has kidney failure and high blood pressure. She is supported by her food rider husband. In Dec 21, her MOH subsidy application is still in process. Thus, GHCA extended her support until Jun 22.















GAN ENG SIN

Mr Gan, 65, divorcee, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. He works part time in a bookstore and stays with his sister and nephew. In Dec 21. his SOCSO application is still in process. Thus, GHCA extended his support until Jun 22.

KALACHELVE A/P JHULUKANAM

Mdm Kalachelve, 61, has diabetes, high blood pressure, and kidney failure. She lives in a flat with her cleaner daughter's family. GHCA's aid is still ongoing to ease her family's burden.

TAN BOON YAW

Mr Tan, 58, has kidney cancer. He lives with his waitress wife in his in-law's house. His hawker son supports him occasionally. GHCA's aid is still ongoing to ease his family's burden.

CHONG MEE LIAN

Mdm Chong, 47, has kidney failure. She stays with her barber husband and construction estimator son. In Dec 21, her husband and son's income has yet to recover to normal level. Hence, GHCA will extend her support for 3 months until Mar 22.

GOPAL A/L SINNTHAMBY

Mr Gopal, 65, unemployed, has diabetes, high blood pressure, kidney failure, and is a right leg amputee. He is expected to have an interview session for his SOCSO aid appeal in Oct 21. Hence, GHCA extended his support until Jan 22 while he attends to his SOCSO aid appeal.

SANTHIRASEKAR A/L AYASAMY

Mr Santhirasekar, 37, has blurry vision, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Oct 21, the nerves in his eyes were bleeding and he is waiting for an operation date. GHCA extended his aid until Jan 22 while he waits for his SOCSO aid approval.

SITI NUR AIN FATIHAH BINTI JAMIL

Mdm Siti Nur Ain Fatihah, 28, unemployed, has kidney failure. She receives Zakat aid for her dialysis. In Oct 21, she had to add iron into her medical regime to increase her blood count. GHCA extended her aid until Jan 22, while she looks for a job.



TAN LI TING Mdm Tan, 53,

Mdm Tan, 53, unemployed, has kidney failure. She has SOCSO aid but needs to cover her injection fee. She is supported by her brother, whose job resumed in Oct 21, but whose income is still unstable. Thus, GHCA extended her aid to Feb 22.



PERUMAL A/L KONDAN

Mr. Perumal, 51, unemployed, has kidney failure. His wife has hearing ailment. SOCSO covers part of his dialysis fees. His factory worker daughter is unable to fully cover their household expenses. Thus, GHCA supports him with RM360 monthly aid while he applies for transfer to an NKF centre.



JACINTA ANNE A/P JACOB

Mdm Jacinta, 26, mother of a daughter, 2, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Her lorry driver breadwinner husband is unable to cover their household expenses, so she opted to skip dialysis once weekly. GHCA supported her with dialysis aid while she applies for SOCSO aid.



WONG KOK WAI

Mr Wong, 49, has kidney failure in Aug 21 and lost his job. He is married with a daughter, 7. His wife is the breadwinner, working at a hawker noodle stall. GHCA supports him with monthly dialysis aid, while he applies for MOH subsidy.



JAY KUMAR A/L R. SANJEEVANTHAN

Mr Jay, 58, blind, diabetic, and has kidney failure, stays with his wife and two children. In Nov 21, his wife is still unable to resume her cleaner job and is now looking for other job. Our aid ends in Nov 21, as his brother will be supporting him.



THOO FONG MING

Mdm Thoo, 65, is a widow. She has high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney disease. In Nov 21, she will transfer to a government hospital which will subsidise her medical fees. Thus, she will no longer requires our aid after Nov 21.



PANG PHEY SHUANG

Ms Pang, 35, single, blind, has kidney illness, and stays at a nursing home. She had just received over RM70,000 in funds from China Press Foundation for her dialysis fees, and thus will no longer requires our aid after Oct 21.













CHAN SHI LING

Mdm Chan, 35, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Dec 21, a virus infection caused her blindness. She is unable to seek employment due to her current condition. Thus, GHCA extended her support for 3 months.

AWRUONG A/P K. GOVINDASAMY

Mdm Awruong, 62, stays with her disabled son. In Oct 21, she received her hospital report and has begun her transfer process to an NGO dialysis centre, which will lower her treatment cost substantially. Therefore, our aid ended in Dec 21.

LEE AH MOI

Mdm Lee, 68, widow, is a double amputee. She has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Her children are now able to support her as the pandemic is no longer affecting their income. Thus, our aid ended in Oct 21.

EMMANUEL A/L N.ARUNASALAM

Mr Emmanuel, 27, has kidney failure. In Oct 21, his father met with an accident and has to be on 3 months medical leave. His SOCSO aid is also still under processing. Thus, GHCA extended his dialysis aid until Jan 22.

TAN CHUAN CHAI

Mr Tan, 58, widower, has kidney failure. He stays with his brother, who was laid off recently, and his parents. They now depend on his brother's savings and EPF for their household and his dialysis fees. GHCA supports Mr Tan with dialysis aid while he applies for MOH subsidy.

LOH KONG PAH

Mr Loh, 65, was a lorry driver before he had kidney failure in Jul 21 and is now unable to work. His children are unable to cover his dialysis fees. GHCA supports him with monthly dialysis aid while he applies for MOH subsidy approval.

RAJANDRAN A/L K.GOBAL

Mr Rajandran, 70, widower, stays with his daughter and elder sister. He was a forklift driver but is now unemployed. He depends on his nurse daughter, who struggles for his dialysis fees. Hence, GHCA supports him with dialysis aid monthly while he waits for his MOH aid approval.

Individual Cases - Family Care

Ms Nerosha, 27, is wheelchair-bound. She is supported by her security guard mother. She is advancing further in her AIA Life Planner course and is expected to complete it in Dec 21. Thus, we extended her aid until Dec 21 until her course is completed and can begin working.













MUNIRA BINTI ANUAR

Mdm Munira, 34, mother of 2, had stroke and infective endocarditis. In Dec 21, her family started selling "keropok" to increase their income. Seeing their determination, her aid was extended for 3 months.

HARINI A/P KANANBATHI

Harini, 14, has Crohn's disease and needs to consume Ensure milk as her diet. In Nov 21, her father has just resumed work. Thus, GHCA extended her support for 1 month until Dec 21, after which they will no longer require our aid.

TAN SIEW CHEN

Mdm Tan, 40, runs a nasi lemak stall for a living, which was affected due to Covid-19. In Nov 21, her business has gradually stabilised. Thus, GHCA extended her support for 1 month until Dec 21, after which she will no longer require our aid.

KIRAM BIN ABDULLAH

Mr Kiram, 48, stays with his 6 young children. He was a recyclebles collector and is recuperating from a road accident. In Nov 21, he still unable to resume work and is relying on painkiller. Thus, GHCA extended his aid for 3 months until Feb 22.

SHAIDAH BINTI BAHARUDDIN

Mdm Shaidah, 40, has diabetes, chronic pelvic inflammatory disease, and cervical spondylosis. In Dec 21, her ice-cream home business has stabilised after MCO was lifted. Thus, she no longer requires our aid thereafter.

SAW LAY HOON

Mdm Saw, 46, single mother of 3, was a school driver who shifted to babysitting due to MCO. In Nov 21, she managed to stabilise her babysitting income while also receiving SOCSO aid. Thus, she no longer requires our support after Dec 21.

SUENDERI A/P SUBRAMANIAM

Mdm Suenderi, 42, single mother of 4, has spine issue and often visits the orthopaedic. In Dec 21, her SOCSO aid has been approved, but she still struggles to pay off her monthly loan shark debt. Thus, GHCA extended her rental aid for 3 months.













TAN HOCK CHUAN

Mr Tan, 51, father of 3 schooling children, is unfit to work. He has high blood pressure and brain surgery and is now on medication. In Dec 21, he has started doing part-time welding work. Seeing his effort, GHCA extended his rental aid period.

CHUA SENG HENG

Mr Chua, 70, is our frequent vegetable garden volunteer. He stays with his siblings, one of which remains unemployed in Dec 21, and another who is a part time construction worker. His rental aid was extended as their income are still affected.

SEGAE

Mr Segar, 43, lives with his wife and two children. He lost his job to factory shutdown. In Dec 21, he finally managed to find a part time welder job. Thus, he will no longer require our support thereafter.

KARPPAGAM A/P AROKIANATHAN

Mdm Karppagam, 44, single mother of 2, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and is a left leg amputee. In Nov 21, her SOCSO prostetic leg was approved. She has been practicing walking with the prostetic leg since. Her aid was extended to Jan 22, as her daughter is still looking for a job.

PATMALOSNI A/P MURUGIAH

Mdm Patmalosni, 31, is a mother of 5, who lost her job to MCO. In Dec 21, she started working as a school cleaner and is planning to move to a better house with her brother. Thus, she no longer requires our support thereafter.

NOR SAGITA BINTI ABDUL MULUK

Ms Nor Sagita, 24, has sight disability. In Oct 21, her salary returned to normal. However, her family home in Sabah was affected by flood and she needed to support her family. Seeing her hardship, GHCA extended her aid until Jan 22.

Mr Foo, 62, is an ice-cream seller, while his wife, 64, is a seamstress. Their income was affected by MCO. In Nov 21, his ice-cream business has slowly improved. Thus, GHCA extended his aid until Feb 22 while his income stabilises.

NUR QISTINA BALQIS BINTI ZAIPUL

Nur Qistina, 12, sits for her UPSR this year. She stays with her parents and 5 siblings. In Oct 21, her mother had successfully applied for Baitulmal aid. Therefore, she will no longer requires our aid after Nov 21.

TASNIM BINTI ABDULLAH

Mdm Tasnim, 27, is a widowed mother of 2 young children, whose income as a school canteen helper was affected by MCO. GHCA had supported her with rental aid for 3 months from Aug 21 to Oct 21.

NUR SYAMIMI BINTI MOHD SABRI

Mdm Nur Syamimi, 32, mother of 4, runs a home cake and nasi lemak business. Her husband has just recovered and resumed his delivery rider job. In Nov 21, she started working as a part time Food Panda rider and no longer requires our support.

MOHD HAFIZUDDIN BIN AMMAN

Mr Mohd Hafizuddin, 30, father of 2, had his income reduced due to MCO. In Nov 21, his income is back to normal, while his wife had also secured a job as a water filter sales person. Thus, they no longer requires our support.

NUR RIAM BINTI MOHD YUNOS

Mdm Nur Riam, 37, lives with her husband and 5 children. She is a sales assistant. Her husband fell ill to pancreas illness in Apr 21 and is unable to work. In Nov 21, they are now able to manage their expenses, and no longer requires our aid.

MEENACHI A/P RAMAN

Mdm Meenachi, 36, mother of 5, had her family income affected by MCO. In Nov 21, her husband has resumed work, while they still sell palm fruit while free to earn additional income. Her son has also resumed his lorry driver job. Thus, they no longer require our aid.

SITI NUR FATHIAH BINTI HASSHIM

Mdm Siti, 33, mother of 3, sells snacks to earn some income. Her logistic worker husband's income was affected by MCO. In Nov 21, her husband's income is reverted back to normal. Thus, they no longer require our support.

PREMMA A/P MAYALAGU

Mdm Premma, 32, lives with her hawker husband and her newborn baby, while 2 of her children are placed in welfare homes due to financial difficulties. GHCA had supported her with rental aid for 3 months from Sep 21 to Nov 21.

NGOO AI CHOO

Mdm Ngoo, 33, is a single mother of 3. In Nov 21, she has resumed her Grab driver job, while her exhusband had also started providing her with alimony. Thus, she no longer requires our support thereafter.

JAMAL BIN SULAIMAN

Mr Jamal, 47, father of 3, is on rehab after losing a leg due to diabetes and is waiting for a prosthetic leg via SOCSO. His daughter now supports the family. He had also received Baitumal monthly aid. Thus, our support ended in Nov 21.

KHAIRUN NISA BINTI ISMAIL

Ms Khairun Nisa, 20, stays with her mother and 3 siblings. Her family lost their jobs due to MCO. In Nov 21, she found a new job as a cashier, while her family members had also resumed their job. Thus, they no longer require our aid thereafter.

ARIZAN BIN ISMAIL

Mr Arizan, 32, married with a young child, was a contract worker who lost his job due to MCO. In Nov 21, he has resumed his job as a contract worker. Thus, he no longer requires our assistance thereafter.

Mdm Nurul, 32, single mother of 4, had her income affected by MCO. In Nov 21, she has resumed her job, but with lower income. As her rental has also been raised, GHCA will extend her aid for 3 months.

Mdm Tan, 37, lives with her renovation worker husband and 5 daughters. Her husband's job was affected during MCO. In Nov 21, her husband has resumed his job and income. Thus, they no longer requires our aid after thereafter.

NOR AZLINA BINTI KOMIZA

Mdm Azlina, 30, mother of 4, runs a nasi lemak business. In Nov 21, her business had improve slightly. Seeing her effort and hardwork, GHCA extended her aid for 3 months to encourage her to continue working hard for a better living.

MOHD SHARIF BIN SUNGEP

Mr Sharif, 39, father of 5, has fibroid tumor, gout, and a weak lower body. He is a logistic worker who was affected by MCO. In Nov 21, his income has normalised while his wife also works as a babysitter. Thus, he no longer requires our aid.

CHONG YOKE LIAN

Mdm Chong, 42, single mother of 1, is a night market hawker helper. In Nov 21, her income is normalising as night markets are allowed to resume. She also started selling prawn crackers part time. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.

Mdm Rasvidah, 25, single mother of 6, is a freelance recycleables collector. She borrowed money from loanshark and is struggling to repay. GHCA supported her with groceries aid for 3 months from Sep 21 to Nov 21.

SRI NILA AYU BINTI DARWIS

Mdm Sri Nila, 34, single mother of 3, lost her job to MCO and now works as a food packer. In Nov 21, she is trying to a find part time job that enable her to take care of her children at the same time. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Feb 22.













MERFAT BINTI KUWAJIR

Mdm Merfat, 40, stays with her husband and 2 nephews. Her husband's income was reduced due to MCO. In Nov 21, her husband's job has resumed. Thus, they no longer require our aid thereafter.

HEAH JIA YI

Jia Yi, 6, lives with his parents and two siblings. Her mother, a stage 4 breast cancer patient, supported the family but became unemployed during MCO and had used up her savings. Hence, GHCA support her kindergarten fees from Oct 21.

SUGENTHI A/P MUNIANDY

Mdm Sugenthi, 36, lives with her recycleable collector husband and two young children. She has diabetes and stomach cyst and will undergo surgery in Feb 22. GHCA provides her with rental aid from Oct 22 to Mar 22 to ease her burden.

SAHRIZAN BIN RAMLI

Mr Sahrizan, 37, father of 4 young children, was laid off as a lorry driver during MCO. GHCA supported him with grocery aid while he looks for a job. In Dec 21, he found a factory worker job, but needed time to repay his outstanding rentals and utilities. Thus, his aid was extended until Mar 22.

THO CHON YEN

Mdm Tho, 43, divorcee with two young children, is a cleaner. She has uterus tumour but refused to undergo surgery and opted for traditional Chinese medicine treatment. Thus, GHCA support her treatment fees for 6 months starting Oct 21.

RAMACHANDRAN A/L MARIAPPAN

Mr Ramachandran, 46, stays with his wife and inlaws. He lost his driver job to MCO and is now working in freelance odd jobs. GHCA support him with grocery provision for 6 months starting Oct 21, while he focuses on looking for a better job.

MOHD SABRI BIN JOHARI

Mr Mohd Sabri, 36, father of 6, sells mixed rice with his wife at a roadside stall. His business was affected by MCO 4.0. Thus, GHCA supported him with business grocery aid. In Dec 21, his business has normalised. So, he no longer requires our aid.













ALI BIN RASMI

Mr Ali, 39, father of 3 young children, is a painter and construction worker, whose salary was reduced half due to MCO and had to rely on BPR to support his family. GHCA decided to help his family with monthly grocery aid from Nov 21.

SYAHRUL HUSNA BINTI MOHD SHARIFF

Mdm Syahrul, 40, single mother of 5 young children, is a kindergarten teacher. She receives monthly Baitulmal aid but is still unable to cover her household expenses. GHCA provide her with monthly grocery aid from Nov 21 to Jan 22.

BALASUBRAMANIAM A/L PONNUSAMY

Mr Balasubramaniam, 68, father of 2, sells nasi lemak at the roadside for a living, but was forced to stop in Jun 21 due to Covid-19. He wanted to restart his business but he has no starting capital to do so. Thus, GHCA assisted him with monthly aid from Nov 21 to jumpstart his business.

DAYANG RAFIDAH BINTI HASAN BAGINDA

Mdm Dayang, 32, mother of 2, just started a homecook yellow rice business while her husband is a lorry driver. They struggle with their house rental. Thus, GHCA support them with monthly rental subsidy from Nov 21 to Jan 22.

SITI FATIHAH BINTI CHE UDIN

Mdm Siti Fatihah, 29, widowed mother of 3, struggled to find a job since her husband passed away. She now relies on Baitulmal aid and her inlaws. GHCA support her with monthly rental aid from Nov 21 while she focuses on finding a job.

APPA ROW A/L JAGANADHAN

Mr Appa Row, 60, is a dialysis patient. His fees is subsidised by SOCSO. His wife was a babysitter but is now jobless. He is struggling to pay for groceries. Thus, GHCA support him with monthly groceries aid from Nov 21 to Jan 22.

YONG TIAM @ YOON WAN KIOW

Mr Yong Tiam, 86, stays with his two nephews and adopted daughter, who is forced to take unpaid leave to take care of his daily routine. GHCA subsidise his monthly Nutren Optimum milk supplies from Dec 21 to Feb 22.

Mr Mohd Faiz, 31, father of 4, has hearing loss, lost his job in MCO, and is unable to pay his rental. He also lost his IC and was unable to secure a job. GHCA aided him with his rental in Oct 21 and Nov 21 and his replacement IC cost.

ROSHAIZAN BIN ABDUL WAHAB

Mr Roshaizan, 47, father of 2, is a cancer survivor. He successfully registered a stall in Pasar Moden SS15 to run a nasi lemak business. GHCA provided him with equipment such as fridge, blender, banner, and ingredients to jump start his stall business. Now, he can earn RM2,500 monthly.

NUR SYAMIMI BINTI MOHD SABRI

Mdm Nur Syamimi, 32, mother of 4, is our Family Care beneficiary. She planned to start a frozen food business to improve her family's situation but was unable to afford a freezer. Thus, GHCA supplied her with a freezer to support her.

TEW AH KAU

Mr Tew, 82, stays alone in a dilapidated wooden house that needed urgent repair. In Oct 21, GHCA helped with his outdoor cement flooring, rooftop replacement, door replacement, repainting, and toilet installation. In Dec 2021, we brought some furniture for him to provide him some comfort.

NORFARHANA BINTI ZAKARIA

Mdm Norfarhana, 30, mother of 4, is our Family Care beneficiary. She planned to restart her burger stall business after MCO but did not have the capital to buy the ingredients needed. Thus, GHCA supported her with her start-up supplies.

MURNI BINTI MOHD JAAFAR

Mdm Murni, 31, mother of 3, is a cleaner. In Oct 21, her husband lost his job and is unable to pay their rental. GHCA helped her pay off their outstanding rental, while her husband focuses on looking for a new job.









SARASU A/P PALANAIANDY

Mdm Sarasu, 35, mother of 3, is the breadwinner and is unable to pay her rent. Her husband lost his job during MCO. Thus, GHCA helped her pay off her outstanding rental while her husband focuses on looking for a new job.

VOONG CHIN EE

Mr Voong, 53, was a minimarket handyman who stayed at the worker hostel. He lost his job and place to stay when the minimarket shut down. He found a new job at Penang but lacked the money to pay the rental deposit. Thus, GHCA assisted him with his room rental deposit at Penang.

JAYAMANI A/L MUNUSAMY

Mr Jayamani, 59, father of 2 young children, is on SOCSO pension for cataract, and has kidney illness. He struggled for his dialysis fees. GHCA helps pay off some of his unpaid fees. Thankfully, his SOCSO dialysis aid was then approved, which will cover his dialysis treatment fees thereafter.

ABDUL LATIFF BIN ABDUL RAHMAN

Mr Abdul Latiff, 80, had a heart attack and needed a bypass surgery which costs RM16k. RM10k was subsidised by the hospital and Baitulmal but he is unable to pay the remaining amount. Thus, GHCA support a portion of his remaining surgery fees, with the balance being paid by his children.

Charity Events











HEARTY DIWALI WITH GREAT HEART

On 4 Nov 21, GHCA and SWIFT organised the 'Hearty Diwali with Great Heart' to deliver RM30,000 groceries to 600 old folks, children, and disabled friends from 20 care centres and 10 needy families across Selangor, Melaka, Perak, and Negeri Sembilan in conjunction with Deepavali. 6 of our Didik-Kasih students joined in as volunteers for the session.

LOVE WITHOUT BORDERS

In Nov and Dec 21, GHCA distributed RM12,916 groceries to 388 old folks and underprivileged children from 11 care centres across Klang Valley and Melaka with the help from 10 volunteers.

CHILDREN'S DAY WITH ORPHANAGES

On 14 Nov 2021, we celebrated Children's Day virtually with 77 children from 3 orphanages, with the wish list items from each child and their luncheon being personally purchased and delivered by 9 GHCA volunteers. Then, the session continued virtually, with fun games and origami session for the children.

AIDING PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

From Jul 21 to Oct 21, 19 underprivileged individuals with disabilities living in PPR Lembah Subang 2 and PPR Hicom were assisted with groceries, rental subsidies, hearing aid, home repairs, and medical aid, to ease their burden during the Covid-19 second wave.

FINANCIAL EDUCATION AND SAVINGS

On 11 Dec 21, a Financial Education and Savings campaign was conducted to educate 35 of our underprivileged family beneficiaries to better manage their income and expenses while instilling saving habits. The campaign will see the beneficiaries aiming to save 5% to 10% of their monthly income for a period of one year.

Orang Asli Villages



GROCERY DISTRIBUTION @ PAHANG

From Aug to Oct 21, GHCA continued our #Benderaputih Orang Asli Distribution project in Pahang to help the indigenous community there who were affected by the MCO. RM1,800 worth of groceries was provided to 30 families each month, totalling RM5,411.85 in aid for 90 families in the village. Due to the MCO restrictions, Mr Tan, the representative from the village, took charge to purchase and deliver the groceries to the villagers.

KAMPUNG BULUH TELUR BRIDGE RECONSTRUCTION AND GROCERIES DISTRIBUTION

With the reconstructed access bridge to Kampung Buluh Telur that was completed in Jun 21, the 100 villagers residing there, many of whom are farmers, have benefited from the accessibility that was restored. The bridge was previously damaged due to flood. The new sturdy bridge can now withstand strong water current from the river and rain. Our team visited the village on 23 Oct 21 to officiate the opening of the bridge, while also distributing 50 sets of groceries to the villagers there. Special thanks to Global Giving for funding the bridge reconstruction project.





Special Projects and Initiatives

MEDICAL EQUIPMENT DONATION PROJECT FINAL PHASE

The final phase of our Medical Equipment Donation Project saw 1 Arterial Blood Gas (ABG) Machine, costing RM60,000 being delivered to Hospital Sungai Buloh and 1 Close Incubator for babies, 5,000 face shields, and 66 pieces of PPE suits, costing RM40,000 being delivered to Hospital Ampang. Special thanks to Bosch Malaysia for donating RM100,000 to this project.





KLANG VALLEY FLOOD RELIEF AID

In Dec 21, many areas around Klang Valley were affected by flood. GHCA promptly responded to the flood victims with the Klang Valley Flood Relief Aid initiative to provide support to the victims from Taman Sri Muda, Klang, Pulau Indah, Jalan Kebun, and Putra Heights. GHCA teams of social workers and volunteers distributed relief aids that include basic necessities, mineral water, hygiene kits, dry food, pillows, blankets, mattresses, medical supplies, face masks, and others to evacuation centres at SK Integrasi Tengku Ampuan Fatimah, Vocational Special Education Secondary School Shah Alam, Seksyen 17, Taman Sri Muda, SK Kemuning 2, Dewan Camelia, Putra Heights and Surau Baiturrahman. 300 sets of care packs worth RM200 each were also distributed to flood victims from Taman Klang Utama, Jalan Kebun and Taman Sri Muda. Each set consists of cleaning tools, gas stove, electric kettle, and a cash aid. A big thank you to the kindness of everyone who have contributed to the Great Heart Flood Relief Aid.

Lunch Box for the Hungry

Due to the pandemic, the Lunch Box for the Hungry Program was suspended throughout the fourth quarter of 2021 and replaced by groceries distribution to the beneficiaries instead.

TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy

Due to the pandemic, the TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy Program was still suspended throughout the fourth quarter of 2021, until further notice.

Classes for the Children



In the fourth quarter of 2021, in view of the pandemic situation, the program is still being conducted virtually via Google Meet. 49 sessions of Malay and English language classes were conducted, attended by 254 students in total. Attendance rate is at 85% from enrolled students, with 91% students recording improvements in the topics being taught in the quarter under review.

Vegetable Garden for the Community



In the fourth quarter of 2021, 266kg of vegetables were harvested in 14 harvesting sessions, benefitting 164 beneficiaries and 29 neighbours. The vegetables grown this quarter are bok choy, kangkong, Chinese mustard green, lettuce, choy sum, kai choy, brinjal, snake bean, and coconut.

Groceries for the Urban Poor



In the fourth quarter of 2021, GHCC Klang distributed 269 set of groceries while GHCC Melaka distributed a further 45 set of groceries to urban poor families staying nearby our respective community centres. Shopping Buddy Program

In the fourth quarter of 2021, 90 low-income families benefitted from the monthly program that provides groceries aid to ease their burden. BACK TO SCHOOL WITH DIDIK-KASIH

In Dec 21, five Didik-Kasih students, Krishnaveni, Yovinka, Kaylie, Aaron, and Zulaikha, organised a Back-To-School project for two children's home, namely, Rumah Ozanam Klang and Destiny Starting Point, to equip the children there with education supplies such as uniforms, shoes, and stationaries, so that they will be ready for the coming school reopening. 30 children benefitted from the project, and they were also being treated to a mouth-watering luncheon.

PRUKasih Program

In the final quarter of 2021, in view of the pandemic, all PRUKasih activities were conducted online. 79 new members were onboarded this quarter to get them protected under the program. Meanwhile, RM27,972 worth of claims has been approved and disbursed to affected families, with 53 of the families receiving a Financial Education training provided by our social workers. This quarter also saw 2 candidates from PPR Pantai Ria, Mr Mohd Faizal and Mdm Shakila Dewi, successfully graduating from the PRUKasih Enterpreneurship Program for their respective food businesses.

Mdm Rosnah is a food stall operator. She broke her leg after falling in the bathroom and was unable to run her stall business. She received RM844 in claims to support herself and her family while she recuperates.

SAIFULLAH (ACCIDENT CLAIM)

Mr Saiffullah is a Tealive barista. He had a road accident and broke his right leg and had to be on leave for 32 days. He received RM664 in claims for food and rental aid while he recuperates.
