Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In quarter two of 2022, 31 needy kidney patients were supported with a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,500 per month under our Dialysis Aid Program, compared to 27 patients within the same period in 2021. From these 31 patients, 10 are new cases. GHCA is very thankful to Yayasan Tan Sri Lee Shin Cheng, Blacksire, Chua Ka Sin, and Global Giving for their support this quarter.

Mdm Tan, 54, unemployed, has kidney failure since 2019. She struggles for her EPO injection fees. In Jun 22, with GHCA's EPO injection support, her haemoglobin level has improved.

CHONG KIM FUNG

Mr Chong, 64, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. In Jun 22, he was still waiting for his KKM aid approval. His children are now able to provide him with higher monthly allowance. Thus, his aid subsidy will be reduced to RM360 from Jul 22.



DEVANAH BIN HASSAN

Mr Devanah, 59, has kidney failure and relies on SOCSO and JKM aid. In Jun 22, his carer brother had now recuperated from his neck operation and resumed work. GHCA's aid will continue until Aug 22 while his brother's job becomes more stable.



LAU SAID NI

Mdm Lau, 41, is a hawker with kidney failure. She receives SOCSO aid. In May 22, her brother, who had previously lost his job, had started working as a Grab driver. Thus, her aid will be reduced to RM360 from Jun 22.



GAN ENG SIN

Mr Gan, 66, a part-time bookstore staff, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. In Jun 22, his SOCSO aid appeal was rejected. He now applies for MOH aid. GHCA extends his aid until Sep 22 while he waits for his MOH aid status.



WONG KOK WAI

Mr Wong, 50, has kidney failure. In Jun 22, his breadwinner wife's hawker business had gotten better while his daughter, 8 is now enrolled in a government school. As he waits for his MOH aid, GHCA extended his aid to Sep 22 at RM720.



NUR FATIHA BINTI NINGGAL

Ms Nur Fatiha, 28, has diabetes, kidney failure, and hypertension. She receives SOCSO aid. In Jun 22, her brother will be confirmed in his new job soon. With her brother and father's support, she no longer requires our aid after Jun 22.



SAROJA A/P VYAMALAI

Mdm Saroja, 76, has hypertension, heart ailment, diabetes, asthma, and kidney failure. She has MOH aid while her hawker stall daughter struggles to cover her remaining fee. GHCA's support for her is still ongoing.

CHIA KIA CHU

Mr Chia, 68, was diagnosed with kidney failure in 2021. He stays with his wife and college-going son. In Jun 22, he was successfully transferred to the Melaka General Hospital for treatment and will no longer require our aid thereafter.



NIRMALA A/P VENGITTASAN

Mdm Nirmala, 36, stays with her lorry driver husband. GHCA assisted with her EPO injections. In May 22, she had vaginal bleeding infection, causing her haemoglobin level to be without improvement. Her aid is still ongoing.



KALACHELVE A/P JHULUKANAM

Mdm Kalachelve, 62, has diabetes, hypertension, and kidney failure. She lives with her cleaner daughter's family. In Jun 22, her son-in-law had a small increment. Her aid is still ongoing.



CHONG MEE LIAN

Mdm Chong, 48, has kidney failure. She relies on her barber husband, whose income suffered due to the pandemic. In Jun 22, his income improved and they now no longer require our aid.



LOH KONG PAH

Mr Loh, 66, was a lorry driver until he had kidney illness in 2021. In May 22, there was still no update from MOH on his subsidy application. Thus, GHCA extend his aid to Aug 22.



RAJANDRAN A/L K.GOBAL

Mr Rajandran, 71, widower, has diabetes and kidney illness. In May 22, he had to resubmit his MOH aid application due to documentation issues. Thus, GHCA extends his aid to Aug 22.



LAI FOONG CHEONG

Mdm Lai, 68, is wheelchair-bound. In Apr 22, one of her sons has found work in a factory. There was still no update on her MOH aid application. Thus, GHCA extend her aid to Jul 22.



YAP HONG SENG

Mr Yap, 64, has kidney failure, hyperuricemia, diabetes, and hypertension. In Apr 22, he had to do blood transfusion for his condition. His MOH aid application is still in process. Thus, GHCA extend his aid to Aug 22.

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RAJASWARAN A/L THANABAL

Mr Rajaswaran, 31, single, has hypertension and kidney failure since Jan 22. He lives with his parents who struggle to cover his dialysis fees. In Jun 22, his SOCSO aid was approved. Thus, he no longer requires our support thereafter.



NORIZAN BINTI RAMLY

Mdm Norizan, 51, has diabetes and kidney failure. She struggles for her dialysis fees, relying on her EPF savings. In Jun 22, her husband started selling bananas to reduce her family's burden. She is now applying for treatment at an NGO dialysis centre.



SANTHDAVY A/P RAMASAMY

Mdm. Santhdavy, 71, has heart ailment, diabetes, hypertension, high cholesterol, and kidney cancer. She lives with her daughter, who struggles to cover her expenses. She is a SOCSO pension recipient and is now applying for MOH subsidy.



LOKE KOK YHING

Mr Loke, 69, has Hepatitis B and kidney failure. He lives with his sister and has depleted his EPF savings for his treatment. In Apr 22, his MOH subsidy application is still in process. Thus, GHCA extend our support until Jul 22.



TAN TEN LIONG

Mr Tan, 34, has diabetes, high blood pressure, and kidney failure. He lives with his mother and a sister with Down Syndrome. He was a Grab driver until he started dialysis. GHCA provide him with dialysis aid while he applies for MOH subsidy.



LAI YOKÉ THYE

Mdm Lai, 58, widow, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She struggled to cover her dialysis fees. In May 22, she sadly passed away due to Covid-19. Thus, GHCA ended our support.



EMMANUEL A/L N. ARUNASALAM

Mr Emmanuel, 28, has kidney failure and works as a driver for airport workers. In Apr 22, his MOH subsidy application has been approved, while he also found a cheaper house to rent, which lowers his expenses. Thus, he no longer requires our aid.

YAP KIAN SONG

Mr Yap, 33, father of 3, has kidney failure and lost his job. In May 22, he transferred to NKF dialysis centre, which covers his medical expenses. Thus, he no longer requires our aid thereafter.



KALAIVANI A/P PERUMAL

Mdm Kalaivani, 47, has diabetes, kidney failure, and partial blindness. In May 22, her son resumed work as a lorry driver but still struggles to cover her dialysis fee. Thus, GHCA extend our support until Aug 22, while her son's income stabilised.



WONG CHEE MENG

Mr Wong, 65, has kidney failure in Feb 22 and was unable to work. His wife used up her savings for his dialysis. Thus, GHCA provide him with dialysis aid while he applies for SOCSO and MOH subsidy.



MAHESWARI A/P SINNAIAN

Mdm Maheswari, 69, widow, has kidney failure, diabetes, and hypertension. Her son struggles to cover her dialysis fee. Hence, GHCA support her dialysis fee while she applies for MOH subsidy.



MOHD FIRDAUS BIN HASHIM

Mr Firdaus, 49, struggles to cover his dialysis fee after his MAIM dialysis aid stopped in Feb 22. Thus, GHCA support his dialysis fee while he applies for SOCSO subsidy.



RAJA ENSON BINTI RAJA YAACOB

Mdm Enson, 67, has kidney failure in Mar 22. Both her children struggled to cater to her dialysis fee. Thus, GHCA subsidise her dialysis fee while she applies for Zakat aid.



NAOMAH A/P SUPRAMANIAM

Mdm Naomah, 45, single, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. She stays with her mother and disabled brother, relying on her EPF and savings but struggles for her treatment fee. GHCA support her while she applies for MOH aid.



MARCES A/L N.ANTANI ARIKAM

Mr Marces, 65, unemployed, left-leg amputee, receives SOCSO aid but his daughter still struggles to cover his remaining fee. Thus, GHCA support his dialysis for 6 months, from Jun 22 to Nov 22.

Mdm Munira, 35, stays with her parents and 2 young children. She had just recovered from stroke and infective endocarditis. In Jun 22, their keropok business was still not doing well. GHCA's aid is still ongoing.



CHUA SENG HENG

Mr Chua, 71, gardener, stays with his siblings, who remains unemployed. His other sibling is a construction worker. He often volunteers his expertise at GHCC's vegetable garden. His rental aid is still ongoing.



KARPPAGAM A/P AROKIANATHAN

Mdm Karppagam, 45, single mother of 2, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and is a leg amputee. In Apr 22, her security guard son's income has stabilised and is now able to cover of their expenses. Thus, they no longer require our aid.

Mdm Suenderi, 43, single mother of 4, has spine issue and often visits the orthopaedic. In Jun 22, her JKM aid renewal was in the process. Thus, her aid was extended to Jul 22, after which she will be supported by another local NGO.

Mr Foo, 63, is an ice-cream seller, and his wife, 64, a seamstress, were both affected financially by MCO. In May 22, their income has stabilised. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

Mdm Ng, 50, mother of a schooling daughter, has muscular dystrophy. She sells tissue paper for a living. In May 22, her income has stabilised and she no longer requires our aid.



RUBAYAH BINTI TINGGAL

Mdm Rubayah, 47, single mother of 2, is waiting for her SOCSO invalidity pension approval. In May 22, she struggled to enrol her son into university. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Aug 22.



FADHILAH BINTI ZAINAL ABIDIN

Mdm Fadhilah, 41, single mother of 4, is a tailor. In May 22, her home tailor business improves. Seeing her effort to self-sustain, her aid was extended for 3 months at RM150 monthly.



DELWINA BINTI AMIR

Mdm Delwina, 34, mother of 3, and her husband lost their jobs in MCO. In May 22, her husband had since found a job and are now able to cover their expenses. Thus, they no longer require our aid



HARYATI BINTI IBRAHIM

Mdm Haryati, 39, mother of 5, was affected when her husband lost his job. In May 22, her husband has since stabilised in his newly found job. Thus, they no longer require our aid.

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MALINA OKTAVIRA BINTI SYAFRIL

Mdm Malina, 40, mother of 5, was abandoned by her husband in May 22. Her eldest son, 18, now takes care of his siblings. GHCA extended her aid to Aug 22 while she resolves her divorce matter.

Mdm Nor Yasmin, 27, single mother of 2, has now stabilised in her new job as a debt collector. She is now able to cover her family's expenses and no longer requires our aid after May 22.

Mdm Nurul, 33, single mother of 4, is a school car driver affected by MCO. She now also sells nasi lemak on Sundays. Her income has slowly stabilised. Her aid is still ongoing until Aug 22.

Mdm Azlina, 31, mother of 4, struggled to support her family as her nasi lemak and baking business was affected by low sales. In May 22, her business has picked up and she no longer requires our aid.

Mdm Sri Nila, 35, single mother of 3, lost her job. In May 22, she sells Raya cookies to earn some income. She now aims to get a car license to become a delivery rider. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Aug 22.

Mdm Sugenthi, 37, mother of 2, has diabetes and stomach cyst. Her husband is continuing his job as a lorry driver. In Jun 22, she was referred to another NGO for support, thus ending our aid.

Mr Sahrizan, 38, father of 4, was laid off and has since found a new job as a factory worker. In Jun 22, his income has stabilised and he no longer requires our support.



THO CHON YEN

Mdm Tho, 44, single mother of 2, has uterus tumour. She had been taking Western medical supplements for her condition. In Jun 22, she has since began treatment at government hospital and no longer requires our support.

Mr Balasubramaniam, 69, father of 2, is supported by GHCA to run a nasi lemak stall. In Apr 22, he is able to support his family with his income now and no longer requires our aid.

Mdm Dayang, 33, mother of 2, started a yellow rice business to help her husband. In Apr 22, her business was affected after she was hospitalised. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Jul 22.

Mdm Siti Fatimah, 30, single mother of 3, lost her part time job in Apr 22, as she was preoccupied with taking care of her children. GHCA extended her aid for 3 months while she looks for a job and also waits for her JKM and Zakat aid approval.

Mr Appa Row, 61, dialysis patient under SOCSO aid, lost his home gardener job in Apr 22 due to his health condition. His wife is now a babysitter. As he is appealing for his JKM aid, GHCA extend his support until Jul 22.



KARTIK A/L PALANAINDY

Mr Kartik, 34, had Bell's Palsy in Dec 21 and is now unable to work. He was the breadwinner. His father and uncle has heart illness. As he is still struggling, GHCA extended his aid until Jul 22.



KAWITHA A/P MARATHA

Mdm Kawitha, 40, widowed mother of 4, struggled when her breadwinner husband passed away. In Apr 22, her husband's SOCSO pension has been approved. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

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MARIAH BINTI MAT

Mdm Mariah, 60, single, is a seamstress and kuih seller who was affected by MCO. In May 22, her sewing business is slowly recovering. Thus, GHCA extend her aid for 3 months while her business stabilises.



RAFIDAH BINTI ISMAIL

Mdm Rafidah, 26, mother of 2, struggled after her husband was laid off. Her husband has since found a stable income as a food delivery rider while she will also start work in a factory in Jun 22. Thus, they no longer requires our support.

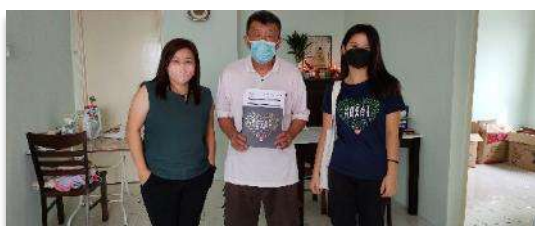
THAVAINI A/P ANNAMALAI

Mdm Thavaini, 63, is the caretaker for her grandson, 7. She relies on JKM and church aid. In Jun 22, she fell down and was hospitalised, but fortunately, she has since been discharged. GHCA will continue her aid until Aug 22.

Mdm Hamsnee, 24, housewife, mother of 3, struggled with their household expenses. In Apr 22, her husband started working as a food rider and is now able to cover their expenses. Thus, they no longer require our aid after May 22.



SUN KEE WAI

Mr Sun, 73, has diabetes and hypertension. His wife had just passed away. He now stays alone in his nephew's house, relying on JKM aid. GHCA is supporting him with transport aid for his hospital visits and arranged home counselling sessions for him to cope with his grief.



DURUKA DEWI

Mdm Duruka, 32, widow mother of 2, sells nasi lemak by the roadside after her husband died of Covid-19. In Dec 21, she was hit by a car and was unable to work after surgery. Thus, GHCA support her rental until Sep 22 while she recuperates.

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NG BOON SENG

Boon Seng, 10, live with his 2 younger siblings, mother, and grandmother. His breadwinner father died of a heart attack in Mar 22. GHCA provide his family with grocery aid until Sep 22 while his family strive to get back on their feet.



LIM YUH CHING

Mdm Lim, 45, single, factory worker, takes care of her siblings, all of which has mental illness and are unemployed. They receive JKM aid. GHCA support her with monthly grocery aid from Apr 22 to Sep 22.



LEE MEI CHOO

Mdm Lee, 39, single mother of 2, stays with her parents and brother. She lost her job during MCO and had depleted her savings to survive. Her family now relied on her technician brother for the household expenses. GHCA support her with grocery aid until Jul 22 while she looks for a job.



SUBASHINI A/P GOVINDAN

Mdm Subashini, 23, single mother of 3, was a factory operator until Jan 22. Her eldest son is malnourished and requires Pediasure milk as his diet, which she struggles to cover. Thus, GHCA supports her with grocery aid until Jul 22.



CHU GEOK LAN

Mdm Chu, 56, takes care of her 4 young grandchildren. Her son is going through divorce, and had just found work at a fish market. Thus, GHCA support her with grocery aid while her son stabilises in his new job.



NG GECK KHIM

Mdm Ng, 60, unemployed, has depression, blurred vision, and walking complications. She relies on JKM aid and food aid from some local NGOs but struggled for her rental. Thus, GHCA provide her with rental aid from May 22 to Oct 22.



LOKE CHAN ONN

Chan Onn, 14, stays with his breadwinner Grab driver single-parent mother and 2 siblings. Her mother's income was affected recently and struggled to cover Chan Onn's tuition fees. Thus, GHCA support his tuition fees until Oct 22.

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LIM SIEW FONG

Mdm Lim, 53, single, has skin disease and uterus illness. She takes care of her mother, 81, who has stroke, and 4 of her siblings who has intellectual disability. She relied on JKM aid but struggled to cover their diaper supplies. Thus, GHCA support her with monthly diaper aid until Oct 22.



SITTO A/P K.SAUTHAN

Mdm Sitto, 68, stays with her retiree husband, 71, and 2 young grandchildren. She supports the family as a part-time cleaner but struggles to cover her rental. Thus, GHCA support her with rental aid from May 22 to Oct 22.



SITI MAFUZAH BINTI MAT JALI

Mdm Siti, 37, is a home tailor and food caterer. She was abandoned by her husband and struggled to care for her 5 children, including a newborn baby. Thus, GHCA support her with milk powder aid while she applies for JKM and Baitulmal support.



KUAN PIT CHAN

Mr Kuan, 61, stays with his wife and 4 young sons in a leaky house. He is a contract renovation labourer and struggles to feed his family. GHCA support him with grocery aid from Jun 22 to Aug 22, while he aims to find a house with a better environment for his family.



DHANA LETCHEMY A/P BEDEWEL

Mdm Dhana, 30, mother of 4 young children, is an orphanage caretaker. Her husband is in prison since 2020. She is struggling to cover her living expenses. Therefore, GHCA support her with grocery aid from Jun 22 to Aug 22 to reduce her financial burden.

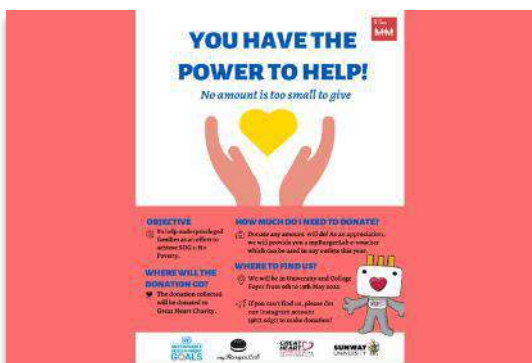
SEMINAR AT SUNWAY UNIVERSITY

Lunch Box for the Hungry



In the second quarter of 2022, we distributed 7,053 packs of lunch boxes via 73 distribution sessions to 100 urban poor families, compared to 5,476 lunch boxes in the first quarter. The program is being run from Monday to Saturday every week. Special thanks to Lim Chen Leng, Ong Yew Lui, Chow Hon Yong, 冯定忠, LSGMY, 李宽义, 善心佛友, and Fontaine Fong and friends for their support to the program this quarter.

Classes for the Children



In the second quarter of 2022, 58 sessions of Malay and English language classes were conducted at GHCC, with 313 student slots filled up in total. The classes are still held virtually. Attendance rate is at 86% from the enrolled students, with 86% of the students recording improvements in the sessions that they have participated in during the quarter under review.



Meanwhile, over at GHCC Melaka (GHCCM), the Classes for the Children program was kick started in Apr 22. 12 sessions of English classes were conducted this quarter in the roll out, with 48 student slots filled up. Attendance rate for GHCCM is at 87.5%, with 100% students having shown improvements in the sessions that they have participated in during the quarter under review.

Vegetable Garden for the Community



In the second quarter of 2022, our vegetable garden yield improves, enabling us to harvest 199.5kg of vegetables in 29 harvesting sessions that were distributed to 216 beneficiaries from GHCC. We were also joined by some children of our beneficiaries in our harvesting sessions this quarter, who volunteered and learnt some useful knowledge on where the vegetable food that they eat comes from. The vegetables grown this quarter are kangkong, Chinese mustard, spinach, and lettuce. We also managed to harvest some coconuts this round.

TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy

Our TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy Program was still suspended in the second quarter of 2022, as we look for qualified volunteer TCM practitioner who could help us to resume the program. Should there be any parties with contacts to qualified TCM practitioner who would like to volunteer with us for this program, feel free to reach out to our GHCC team.

Groceries for the Urban Poor



In the second quarter of 2022, GHCC Klang distributed 144 sets of groceries under the Groceries for the Urban Poor program, and GHCC Melaka (GHCCM) distributed a further 51 sets of groceries to needy families staying nearby our respective community centres. Meanwhile, for GHCCM, starting Jun 22, each family were accompanied by volunteers for their groceries purchase session at a local hypermarket.

Shopping Buddy Program

In the second quarter of 2022, our Shopping Buddy Program provided personalised groceries aid to 75 families from PPR Pantai Ria to ease their household burden. Our team assisted 20 to 35 low-income families monthly to obtain their self-picked grocery wish list worth RM200 every month, with our team of volunteers acting as the families' Shopping Buddy' to help them get their groceries that is also aimed to provide them with a nutritional balanced diet. In Jun 22, GVCA received the MyICE grant that enabled us to support 35 families for that month.

"It was my first time joining Rakan Shopping and it was very different compared with the other volunteering projects that I've joined. I have to choose the groceries listed by the beneficiaries and send it to them thereafter. And GVCA Social Worker, Nazihah was right when she said, "We choose what we eat," because when I buy groceries, I will choose the best for myself. So, when we buy the goods for the families, automatically, I incorporated the same practice because I also want the best for the beneficiary family".

PRUKasih Program

In the second quarter of 2022, GVCA resumed physical service for the PPR Pantai Ria community. During this quarter, we have assisted 17 families with claims related to accidents, illnesses, and deaths, totalling RM21,496 in funds that were approved and disbursed to the affected families. 12 of these families were further provided with Financial Education training by our social workers to enhance their knowledge.

PRUKASIH HIGHLIGHTS



PUTERI NURUL AZRIZZA (ILLNESS CLAIM)

Mdm Puteri is a kindergarten teacher with chronic asthma. Due to her illness, she had to be on sick leave quite often, which affected her income. With the claims received from PRUKasih, she was able to use it to cover some of her expenses during her treatment period.



MUHAMMAD SYAMIR (ACCIDENT CLAIM)

Mr Syamir works a food seller. He was injured in a work accident, where the stove exploded and burnt his arm. He is currently recuperating. With the claims received from PRUKasih, he is able to buy his daily necessities with peace of mind.

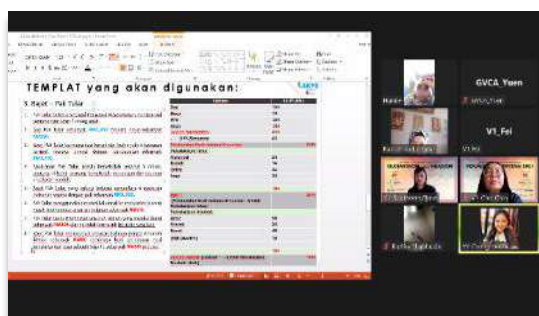


THULASIMANI A/P RAMAN (DEATH CLAIM)

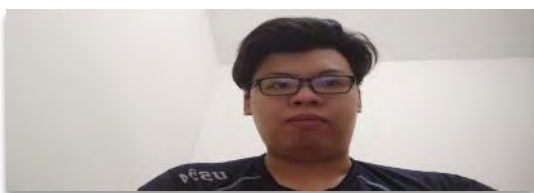
SAAKTHYSRI A/P PUSPANATHAN

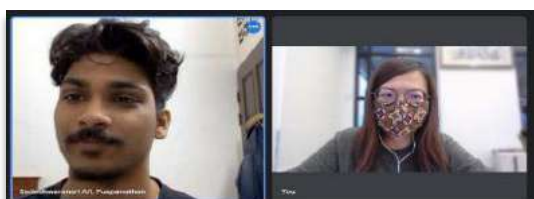
NUR ALFADINA BINTI MOHD BORHAN

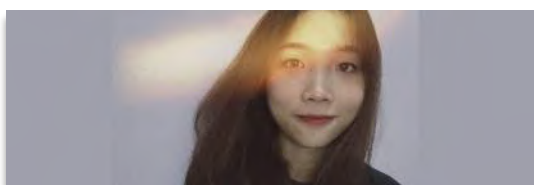
ASHREEN NATASHA BINTI MOHD NASIR
