Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In third quarter of 2022, our Dialysis Aid Program supported 29 kidney failure patients from the low-income or unemployed group. Each patient receives a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,500 per month to ease their burden. From these 29 patients, 5 are new cases. HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



WONG KOK WAI

Mr Wong, 50, has kidney failure. In Sep 22, his wife's food stall business is taking off, and he now helps out at the stall. With their business income, he is now able to support his treatment fees and no longer requires our aid.



LOH KONG PAH

Mr Loh, 66, father of 2, was a lorry driver for over 40 years until he had kidney illness in 2021. In Aug 22, as his family's financial situation has gradually stabilised, his aid was ended.



RAJANDRAN A/L K.GOBAL

Mr Rajandran, 71, widower, has diabetes and kidney illness. In Aug 22, his MOH aid is still pending approval. In Sep 22, his MITRA aid application has been approved that will cover his dialysis fees. Thus, he no longer requires our aid.



LAI FOONG CHEONG

Mdm Lai, 68, is wheelchair-bound. In Jul 22, her husband had an emotional ailment and her son had to quit his job to take care of them. As her MOH aid is still in processing, GHCA extended her support until Oct 22.



YAP HONG SENG

Mr Yap, 64, has kidney failure, hyperuricemia, diabetes, and hypertension. He is a goods delivery man struggling to cover his expenses. He had his fistula surgery in Aug 22. As his MOH aid is still in process, GHCA extended his aid until Feb 23.



NORIZAN BINTI RAMLY

Mdm Norizan, 51, has diabetes and kidney failure. In Sep 22, her family still struggle to cover her dialysis fees even with SOCSO and Zakat aid. Hence, GHCA extended her aid until Dec 22 and advised her to transfer to an NGO Dialysis Centre.



SANTHDAVY A/P RAMASAMY

Mdm. Santhdavy, 71, has heart ailment, diabetes, hypertension, high cholesterol, and kidney illness. In Sep 22, her MOH subsidy is still in process. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Mar 23 while she awaits for the approval.

Mr Tan, 34, has diabetes, high blood pressure, and kidney failure. In Aug 22, his SOCSO aid has been approved. Thus, he no longer requires our dialysis subsidy aid thereafter.

Mr Wong, 65, has kidney failure in Feb 22 and was unable to work to cover his treatment. In Aug 22, his children are now able to cover his treatment fees and household expenses. Thus, he no longer requires our dialysis aid thereafter.



MAHESWARI A/P SINNAIAN

Mdm Maheswari, 69, widow, has kidney failure, diabetes, and hypertension. Her son struggles to cover her dialysis fee. In Aug 22, her MOH aid application is still in process. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Feb 23.



MOHD FIRDAUS BIN HASHIM

Mr Firdaus, 49, struggles to cover his dialysis fee after his MAIM dialysis aid stopped in Feb 22. In Aug 22, his SOCSO aid has been approved. Thus, he no longer requires our support thereafter.



CHONG KIM FUNG

Mr Chong, 64, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. In Sep 22, his MOH aid was rejected as he has working children. However, his son who is a factory worker is struggling to cover his medical bills. Thus, GHCA extended our aid until Dec 22.



DEVANAH BIN HASSAN

Mr Devanah, 59, has kidney failure and relies on SOCSO and JKM aid. In Aug 22, his brother is still struggling to cover his dialysis bills. Thus, GHCA extended his aid until Nov 22, while he looks to apply for other potential aid support.



LAU SAID NI

Mdm Lau, 41, is a hawker with kidney failure. She receives SOCSO aid. In Aug 22, her noodle stall business remained the same. She is planning to become a babysitter next year to earn a better income. Her aid was extended to Nov 22.

GAN ENG SIN

Mr Gan, 66, a part-time bookstore staff, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. In Sep 22, his MOH aid is still in process. Thus, GHCA extends his aid until Mar 23 while he waits for his MOH aid application status.



TAN LI TING

Mdm Tan, 54, unemployed, has kidney failure. She has SOCSO aid but struggles for her EPO injection fees. In Aug 22, her brother's income has stabilised and is able to support her. Thus, she no longer requires our support thereafter.



SAROJA A/P VYAMALAI

Mdm Saroja, 76, has hypertension, heart ailment, diabetes, asthma, and kidney failure. In Jul 22, her daughter took on additional work as a part-time cleaner to help cover her treatment fees. Thus, GHCA extended her aid to Oct 22 to encourage her family to continue striving to improve their life.



LOKE KOK YHING

Mr Loke, 69, has Hepatitis B and kidney failure. He depleted his EPF savings for his treatment fees. In Jul 22, his two sisters are now able to jointly support his treatment fees. Thus, he no longer requires our support.



KALAIVANI A/P PERUMAL

Mdm Kalaivani, 47, has diabetes, kidney failure, and partial blindness. She relies on her lorry driver son for a living. In Aug 22, GHCA extend her aid to Feb 23, during which her son is expected to be able to resume work using his own lorry.



NIRMALA A/P VENGITTASAN

Mdm Nirmala, 36, stays with her lorry driver husband. She struggled with her EPO injection fees. Thus, GHCA assisted her with subsidy for her EPO injections. Nirmala had stated her appreciation for our support to her until Aug 22.



NAOMAH A/P SUPRAMANIAM

Mdm Naomah, 45, single, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. She stays with her mother and disabled brother. She is a SOCSO aid recipient and is currently applying for MOH aid. Her GHCA aid is still ongoing until Nov 22.

MARCES A/L N.ANTANI ARIKAM

Mr Marces, 65, unemployed, left-leg amputee, is a SOCSO aid recipient. In Sep 22, his daughter had a salary increment but still struggles to cover his treatment fees. GHCA will continue to support his dialysis fee till Nov 22.



RAJA ENSON BINTI RAJA YAACOB

Mdm Enson, 67, has kidney failure in Mar 22. Both her children struggled to cater to her dialysis fee. In Aug 22, she applied for Zakat aid. Thus, GHCA extended our support until Nov 22 while she waits for her Zakat aid approval.



LAU SOW KUEN

Mdm Lau, 63, hairdresser, has high cholesterol and kidney illness. In Jun 22, she struggled with her dialysis fee after her MOH aid was stopped pending renewal. Thus, GHCA support her while she waits for her MOH renewal application.



RAMAKRISHNA A/L KRISHNAN

Mr Ramakrishna, 49, father of 4 young children, has hypertension, diabetes, cataract, and kidney failure. He struggled for his dialysis fee. In Sep 22, both his SOCSO aid and MOH aid was approved. Thus, he no longer requires our aid thereafter.



MAHYUDIN BIN MOHAMED ISA

Mr Mahyudin, 60, has kidney failure and is unable to cover his dialysis fee. GHCA provide him with dialysis aid. In Sep 22, his SOCSO aid was approved, but as his daughter had just given birth and is unable to earn an income for the time being, GHCA extended his support until Dec 22.



PREMALA DEVI A/P S MUNUSAMY

Mdm Premala, 47, unemployed, has glaucoma, hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. She has SOCSO aid. GHCA support her with dialysis aid from Aug to Oct 22, while she applies to transfer to an NGO dialysis centre and looks for a job.



WOONG WAH LEE

Mr Woong, 58, single, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney illness. He has SOCSO aid but struggles to cover his Epoetin and iron injection. Thus, GHCA support his injection fees until Jan 23 while he attempts to apply for MOH aid.

Mdm Fadhilah, 41, single mother of 4, is a tailor. In Aug 22, her home tailor business had picked up and she are also doing other freelance packer jobs. Thus, she no longer requires our assistance.

Mdm Malina, 40, mother of 5, was abandoned by her husband in May 22. In Aug 22, she has settled her divorce matter. With her alimony and income as a shop helper, she no longer requires our aid.

Mdm Nurul, 33, single mother of 4, is a school car driver affected by MCO. In Aug 22, her income has regularised. Thus, she no longer requires our aid thereafter as she can now cover her own rental.

Mdm Sri Nila, 35, single mother of 3, lost her job. In Aug 22, her Baitumal aid has been approved. She will also be working as a delivery rider soon. Thus, she no longer requires our aid thereafter.

Mdm Dayang, 33, had her income affected after being hospitalised. In Jul 22, her food business resumes while her husband had also gotten an increment. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.



SITI FATIHAH BINTI CHE UDIN

Mdm Siti Fatimah, 30, widowed mother of 3, lost her job in Apr 22. In Jul 22, her SOCSO survivor's pension has been approved. Thus, she no longer requires our aid thereafter.



APPA ROW A/L JAGANADHAN

Mr Appa Row, 61, receives SOCSO aid for his dialysis. He lost his job in Apr 22 due to his health. In Jul 22, he is applying for his OKU card in order to be entitled to apply for JKM aid. Thus, GHCA extend his support until Jan 23.

Mdm Chu, 56, takes care of her 4 grandchildren. Her divorcee son is struggling to cater for his children, who started attending kindergarten. Thus, GHCA extended her support until Oct 22, while she looks for a part time job.

Mdm Ng, 60, unemployed, has depression, blurred vision, and walking complications. In Sep 22, her condition still remains. Our rental support is still ongoing.



LOKE CHAN ONN

Chan Onn, 14, stays with his single-parent Grab driver mother, who struggled to provide for his tuition fees. In Sep 22, his mother's income is improving. Our tuition aid for him is still ongoing.

Mdm Lim, 53, single, has skin disease and uterus illness. She struggled for diaper supplies for her aging mother, 81, and 4 disabled siblings. Our monthly diaper aid for her is still ongoing.

Education Seminars

CHARITY EDUCATION SEMINAR FOR SUNWAY UNIVERSITY

On 1 Sep 2022, social workers from GHCA, Andrew Lim, Farhanah Azhari, and Tham Kar Ting, were invited to the Sunway University to give a seminar on charity education for the students from the School of Hospitality & Service Management. Our team shared their knowledge and experiences as a social worker, while aiming to influence and inspire the students to develop their sense of social responsibility so that these students would then have a better view and start giving back to our society by lending a helping hand to those in need. The session was attended by 70 students, who were all invited to participate or collaborate with GHCA for their upcoming charity initiatives.



3R WORKSHOPS FOR PRESCHOOL CHILDREN

From 13 to 14 Sep 2022, our social workers team conducted a series of 3R (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle) workshops for 158 preschool children from the 3Q MRC Junior kindergartens at Port Klang, Teluk Pulau, and Taman Sri Muda to get the children well-versed in the concept of 3R and its importance to take care of our environment. The children were earlier informed to bring their recyclable wastes from home and during the session, they were taught to segregate the rubbish according to their waste types. The workshop receives encouraging support from parents as well as the kindergarten teachers. The children had a fun time learning about 3R in the interactive workshop sessions, where they get to actively participate as well as well as learnt to sing a 3R song.

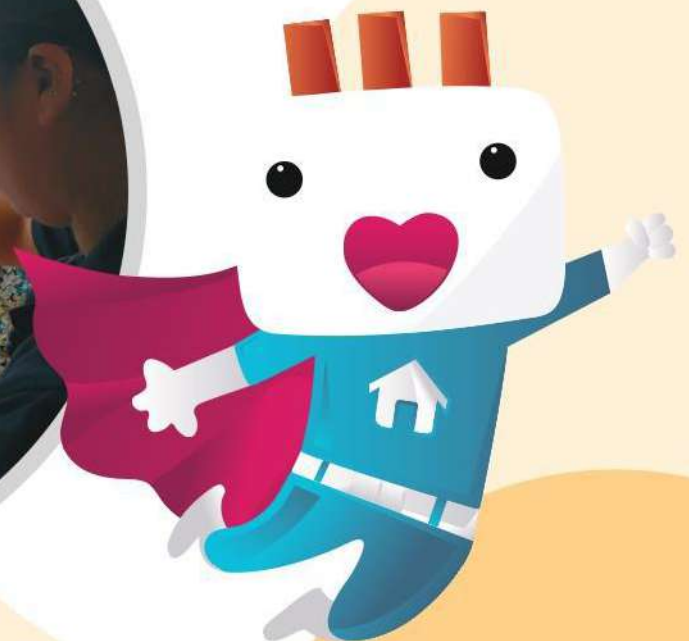
EWD AT SHAH ALAM LAKE

Lunch Box for the Hungry



In quarter 3 of 2022, 7,406 lunch boxes were distributed in 75 sessions to 100 needy families, compared to 628 lunch boxes in Q3 2021. The distribution continues to be run every Mon to Sat. Classes for the Children



In the third quarter of 2022, we conducted 60 sessions of Malay and English classes at GHCC, with 321 student slots filled. Attendance is at 74%, with 78% student showing improvements in the topics taught. Meanwhile, at GHCC Melaka (GHCCM), 10 English sessions were conducted, with 40 student slots filled. Attendance rate is at 92.5%, with 100% students having shown improvements in the topics taught in the sessions that they have participated in.

Vegetable Garden for the Community



In the third quarter of 2022, our vegetable garden was affected by pest issues again, lowering our harvest to 80.4kg of vegetables in 13 harvesting sessions. The vegetables were distributed to 87 beneficiaries. The vegetables grown this quarter are kangkong, choy sam, amaranth, pak choy, white radish, and Chinese Mustard. This quarter also saw us trying out a hydroponic set that was donated by Sunway Group, where we managed to harvest a batch of pak choy grown via the set.

TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy

Our TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy Program has yet to be run in the third quarter of 2022, as we are still unable to recruit qualified volunteer TCM practitioners to resume the program. Should there be any TCM practitioners or any parties with contacts to them who would like to volunteer with us for this program, feel free to reach out to our GHCC team.

Groceries for the Urban Poor



In the third quarter of 2022, GHCC Klang distributed 147 sets of groceries while GHCC Melaka (GHCCM) distributed 51 sets of groceries to urban poor families. In Sep 22, additional families were also onboarded for GHCCM to replace those who no longer requires our aid during the reassessment process. The children were brought on a boat ride along the river to see a mangrove forest from up close. While there, the group also took time to conduct an Earth Warriors clean-up session in conjunction with the Earth Warriors Day, clearing off an impressive 105kg of rubbish from the mangrove forest.

On 4 Sep 22, our team threw a Mid-Autumn Festival celebration at GHCC for our beneficiaries consisting of children, adults, and the young-at-heart from various races. All attendees were in a festive mood enjoying the night with lion dance performances, pomelo peeling competition, mooncakes sampling, and writing blessings and wishes on a lantern! Everyone had so much fun celebrating the festival and enjoying themselves.



CPR AND FIRST AID WORKSHOP

On 30 Sep 22, 6 Rover Scouts from Shiang Yang Rover Ipoh stop by at GHCC while on a 900km journey across several states of Malaysia. While they were at GHCC, the group conducted a session of CPR and First Aid demonstration and workshop for 15 volunteers and social workers of GHCA. The participants get the opportunity to equip themselves with useful hands-on CPR skills by practicing on a CPR manikin, learning how to use an AED, and first aid for choking, all under the guidance from the team of Rover Scouts.

EARTH WARRIORS PROJECT

Earth Warriors Day 2022

Throughout Aug 22 and Sep 22, in conjunction with Malaysia's national months, we organised the Earth Warriors Day 2022 campaign to encourage the public to show our love for our country and environment by keeping it clean. The campaign makes a rousing comeback after not being able to be organised in the past 2 years due to the pandemic. This time, 2,938 volunteers participated in the campaign to clean up a total of 3,633.24kg of rubbish from across various public parks, streets, beaches, and townships. From this amount, 2,272.00kg are further segregated as recyclable waste and sent to recyclers accordingly.

Spearheaded by 70 separately organised teams, one-hour clean-up sessions were conducted at locations throughout 11 states of Malaysia that includes Selangor, Johor, Kelantan, Sarawak, Sabah, Negeri Sembilan, Pahang, Melaka, Perak, and Putrajaya. The campaign also drew participation by teams based in Taiwan, Thailand, and Indonesia. Participating organisers include schools, universities, kindergartens, societies, residents' group, families, and individuals both young and old. Meanwhile, on 17 Sep 22, the main Earth Warriors Day 2022 session was held at Kota Kemuning, which happens to be GHCA's headquarter. The session saw participation from 360 Earth Warriors from Kota Kemuning residents, corporate staffs, student groups, and partner NGOs that include Tzu Chi, Lovely Disable Home, and Seedy Zero Waste Store. 551kg of rubbish was collected during this session, which concludes with a waste segregation session.

The Earth Warriors Day 2022 is not made possible without the support from all participants, as well as our panel of sponsors which include twentyfive.7, Quayside Mall, Persatuan Kebajikan Xin Dai, Gamuda Walk, The Page, MPP Zon 12, and Zane Concepts, so a big shout out and appreciation to all our partners!

Shopping Buddy Program



In quarter 3 of 2022, we bring our Shopping Buddy Program to the residents in PPR Hicom, providing personalised groceries aid to 60 families there to ease their household burden. 20 low-income families were assisted every month with groceries worth RM200 that are based on each respective families' selection. Every month, our team of volunteers acted as the families' Shopping Buddy' to help them get their selected groceries that is aimed at providing them with a nutritional balanced diet.

PRUKasih Program

In the third quarter of 2022, we assisted 15 families with PRUKasih claims related to accidents and illnesses, totalling RM5,708 in funds that were approved and disbursed to the affected families.

PRUKASIH HIGHLIGHTS



MAZENI BINTI DOLLAH (ILLNESS CLAIM)

Mdm Mazeni, a kuih seller, is unable to work as she undergoes 10 days of treatment for heart illness at the hospital. Thankfully, her PRUKasih claims provides her with some peace of mind while she undergoes treatment.



NOOR RANI (ILLNESS CLAIM)

Mdm Noor is a babysitter. She had urethral stricture and had undergone treatment at the hospital. Her PRUKasih claims provided her with food allowance and housing allowance, which enables her to concentrate on recuperating.

Didik-Kasih EduCare Program

In third quarter of 2022, our program assisted 33 needy tertiary education students, with each student being provided with start-up assistance and monthly study allowances for their studies. Guidance and mentorship are also provided to equip them with the skill sets to organise charity projects to give back to the society. 6 of the students are newly onboarded in this quarter. 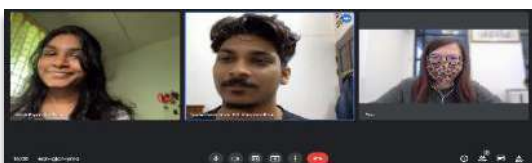
ROSE QUEK PEK YIN

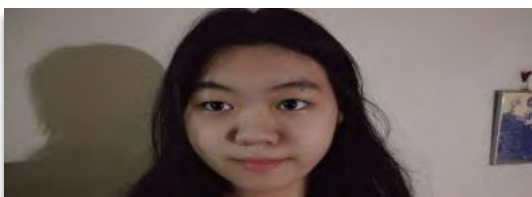


