Our Dialysis Aid Program supported 28 underprivileged kidney patients in the final quarter of 2022. Each patient receives a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,500 per month to ease their burden. 10 of these patients are new cases. Mdm Norizan, 51, has diabetes and kidney failure. Her son no longer supports her. She had to rely on Zakat aid as her other children are still in college. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Mar 23, while advising her to transfer to an NGO dialysis centre.



CHONG KIM FUNG

Mr Chong, 64, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. In Dec 22, his breadwinner son lost his factory job and struggled to make ends meet. Thus, GHCA extended his aid until Mar 23, to give his son time to look for a new job.



DEVANAH BIN HASSAN

Mr Devanah, 59, has kidney failure. He relies on SOCSO and JKM aid. His brother supported his living expenses but struggled to cover his dialysis fees. Thus, his aid is extended until Feb 23, while his brother assists him to apply for other aid.



LAU SAID NI

Mdm Lau, 41, is a hawker with kidney failure. SOCSO aid ease some of her burden. In Nov 22, her noodles business dropped, making her unable to cover her dialysis fee. She was also unable to secure a babysitter second job. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Feb 23.



GAN ENG SIN

Mr Gan, 66, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. He is a part-time bookstore staff and stays with his sister and nephew. As his MOH aid is still in processing, GHCA extends his aid until Mar 23 while he awaits for the application status.



LAI FOONG CHEONG

Mdm Lai, 68, is wheelchair-bound. His son had to quit his job to care for her and her ill husband. In Oct 22, her husband recovered, and her son is able to resume working. GHCA extends her aid to Jan 23 while she awaits for her MOH aid application.



SAROJA A/P VYAMALAI

Mdm Saroja, 76, has hypertension, heart ailment, diabetes, asthma, and kidney failure. Her hawker helper daughter struggled to support her. In Oct 22, she completed a fistula surgery to ease her dialysis session. As she awaits for her MOH aid renewal, GHCA extends her aid until Jan 23.

KALAIVANI A/P PERUMAL

Mdm Kalaivani, 47, has diabetes, kidney failure, and partial blindness. She relies on her lorry driver son for a living. In Dec 22, one of her legs was amputated due to an infection. Our support for her is still ongoing.



YAP HONG SENG

Mr Yap, 64, has kidney failure, hyperuricemia, diabetes, and hypertension. In Nov 22, he successfully transferred to the YASA dialysis centre, which fully covers his dialysis treatment. Thus, he no longer requires our aid thereafter.



SANTHDAVY A/P RAMASAMY

Mdm. Santhdavy, 71, has heart ailment, diabetes, hypertension, high cholesterol, and kidney illness. In Dec 22, her MOH aid has been approved. Thus, she no longer requires our support thereafter.



MAHESWARI A/P SINNAIAN

Mdm Maheswari, 69, widow, has kidney failure, diabetes, and hypertension. Her lorry attendant son struggles to cover her dialysis fee. In Dec 22, her MOH aid has been approved. Thus, she no longer requires our support thereafter.



NAOMAH A/P SUPRAMANIAM

Mdm Naomah, 45, single, has partial blindness, hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. She had to undergo an eye operation in 2023, which requires high surgical fees. Thus, GHCA extends her support until May 23 to reduce her burden.



MARCES A/L N.ANTANI ARIKAM

Mr Marces, 65, unemployed, left-leg amputee, is a SOCSO aid recipient. His daughter struggled to cover his dialysis fees. In Nov 22, he applies for JKM aid. Thus, GHCA extends his support until Feb 23, while he awaits for his JKM aid application.



RAJA ENSON BINTI RAJA YAACOB

Mdm Enson, 67, has kidney failure. Both her children are low-income earners and struggled to cover for her dialysis fees. In Nov 22, her Zakat aid has been approved. Thus, she no longer requires our support thereafter.

LAU SOW KUEN

Mdm Lau, 63, hairdresser, has high cholesterol and kidney illness. She struggled with her dialysis fee while awaiting her MOH aid renewal. In Nov 22, her MOH aid has been renewed. Thus, she no longer requires our support thereafter.



MAHYUDIN BIN MOHAMED ISA

Mr Mahyudin, 60, has kidney failure and is unable to cover his dialysis fee. In Dec 22, his daughter will be resuming work soon, after her maternity leave and coupled with his approved SOCSO aid, he no longer requires our support thereafter.



PREMALA DEVI A/P S MUNUSAMY

Mdm Premala, 47, unemployed, has glaucoma, hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. She is still unable to find a job due to her poor health and is looking for an NGO dialysis centre to transfer to. Thus, GHCA extends her aid until Jan 23.



WOONG WAH LEE

Mr Woong, 58, single, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney illness. He has SOCSO aid but struggles to cover his Epoetin and iron injection. Our support for him is still ongoing, as he further applies for JKM aid.



MAH LAI MUN

Mdm Mah, 38, was our former beneficiary. She is blind and struggled to cover her dialysis fees as her high house rental is burdening her. In Dec 22, she managed to move to a cheaper rental house. Thus, she no longer requires our aid thereafter.



TAN SWEE LEE

Mdm Tan, 68, has heart ailment, high cholesterol, hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. She is unable to pay for her dialysis after her MOH aid ended and is awaiting renewal. In Dec 22, her MOH aid renewal was approved, and she no longer requires our support.



MOHD FAZLI BIN MOHD SALEH

Mr Fazli, 46, father of 4, has kidney failure and struggled for his dialysis fee. He works in a post office and is the sole breadwinner. GHCA supports him for 6 months while his eldest daughter looks for a job to reduce his family's burden.

Mr Chandra, 64, unemployed father of 3, started dialysis in Jan 22. His kindergarten teacher wife and children struggle to cover his dialysis fees. GHCA supported his dialysis fees for 3 months while he applies for MOH aid.



JANAK LAL KAMI A/L GAJALAL KAMI

Mr Janak, 66, has hypertension, heart ailment, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. His bus driver son struggles to cover his medical fees. Thus, GHCA supports him with dialysis subsidy while he applies for JKM and MOH aid.



SUPRAMANIAM A/L A. CHINNIAM

Mr Supramaniam, 61, has heart ailment, diabetes, hypertension, and kidney failure. Her wife, who does part-time packing job, struggles to cover their household expenses and his dialysis fees. We support him for 6 months to reduce his burden.



SITI BAIZURA BINTI HAMID

Mdm Siti, 39, unemployed, is taken care of by her barber husband, who is now enrolled in a hairstylist course to increase his income. Thus, GHCA support her dialysis fees until Feb 23 while her husband concentrates on his training.



MURUGIAH A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Murugiah, 55, has diabetes, hypertension, and kidney failure. He depends on his struggling wife for his dialysis fees, as his poor health prevents him from working. Thus, GHCA helps with his dialysis fees while he applies for SOCSO support.



THAVAGEE A/P KOOTHIYAN

Mdm Thavagee, 64, widow of 4, is a SOCSO aid recipient. Her son has just gotten work as a forklift driver and struggled to cover her dialysis fee. Thus, GHCA supports her dialysis fees until Feb 23, while waiting for his son to pass his probation period.



SIM SENG HUAT

Mr Sim, 76, unemployed, has hypertension and kidney failure. His apparel worker wife struggled to cover his dialysis fees and had to borrow from others. GHCA supports his dialysis fees until Feb 23 while he applies for MOH aid in 2023.

Mr Tan, 52, father of 3, part-time welder, struggled with his rent. He has high blood pressure and is on medication after brain surgery. In Dec 22, his son has started working as a shop helper to ease his burden. Thus, he no longer requires our assistance thereafter.

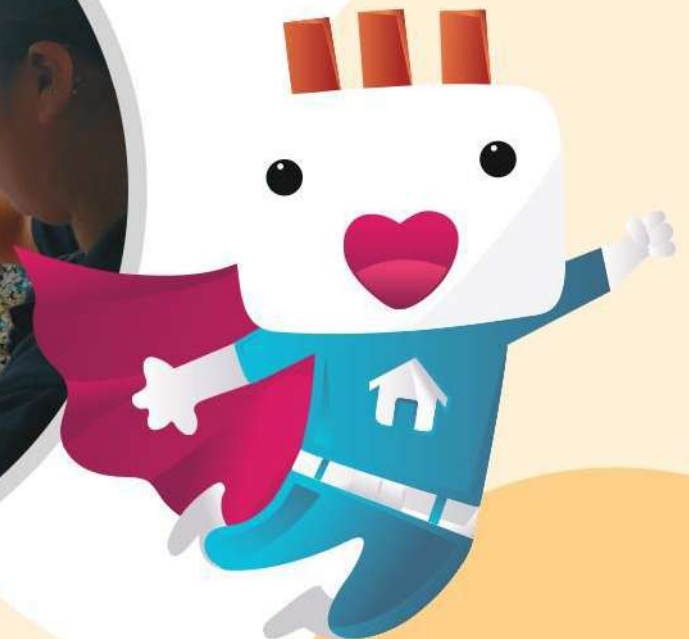
FUNDRAISERS BY UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

Lunch Box for the Hungry

Attendance rate is at 91.7%, with 57.5% students having shown improvements in the topics taught in the sessions that they have participated in.

PRUKasih Program

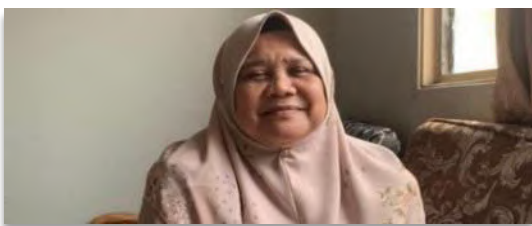
The fourth quarter of 2022 marks the end of the PRUKasih program, which will be rebranded into a new paid insurance plan in 2023 that will thereafter be run by Prudential Assurance. This quarter, 11 families were assisted with PRUKasih claims related to illnesses, accidents, and death, totalling RM15,338 in funds that were approved and disbursed to the affected families.

PRUKASIH HIGHLIGHTS



ROSTAM BIN ARSHAD (ILLNESS CLAIM)

Mr Rostam, personal driver, had post-accident complications and had to undergo a 37-days treatment. With the claim money received from PRUKasih, he was able to cope with some of his expenses while recuperating.



OTHMAN BIN MOHD NOOR (DEATH CLAIM)

Mr Othman passed away from kidney failure, leaving behind his widow, Mdm Esah, who is a housewife. With the death claim that covers food and housing allowance for a year, Mdm Esah is able to have peace of mind while planning for her next phase in life after her grief period.

Didik-Kasih EduCare Program

In final quarter of 2022, 28 needy tertiary education students are supported under our Didik-Kasih EduCare program that provides the student with not only start-up assistance and monthly study allowances, but also guidance and mentorship to serve the needy society. 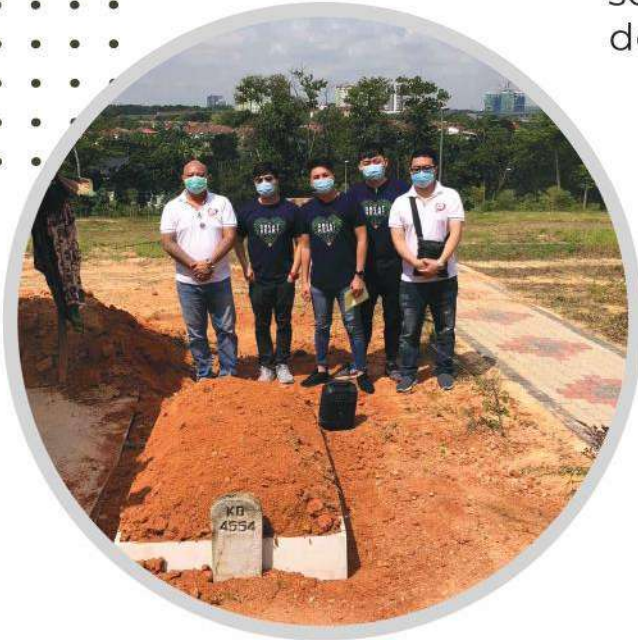
