Mr Gan, 67, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. He is a part-time bookstore staff and stays with his sister and nephew. In Mar 23, our aid ended, and his son and brother-in-law will be supporting him while he makes a SOCSO appeal.

LAI FOONG CHEONG

Mdm Lai, 69, is wheelchair-bound. She and her frail husband is taken care of by her son, who had just resumed working in Oct 22. In Jan 23, her son's income has stabilised. Thus, she no longer requires our aid thereafter.

















DEVANAH BIN HASSAN

Mr Devanah, 60, has kidney failure. He relies on SOCSO and JKM aid. In Feb 23, our aid ended, and his brother will cover for his living expenses and dialysis fees thereafter.

KALAIVANI A/P PERUMAL

Mdm Kalaivani, 48, has diabetes, kidney failure, and cataract. She is supported by her son and is still recuperating from her leg amputation. Her son is considering taking on a delivery rider part time job once her condition stabilised.

NORIZAN BINTI RAMLY

Mdm Norizan, 52, has diabetes and kidney failure. In Mar 23, her husband job stabilised. With that, she is now able to cover her dialysis fees with her Zakat aid and no longer requires our support.

LAU SAID NI

Mdm Lau, 42, hawker, has SOCSO aid for her dialysis but struggled when her business dropped. In Feb 23, she found an additional babysitter job and thus no longer require our aid.

MARCES A/L N.ANTANI ARIKAM

Mr Marces, 66, unemployed, left-leg amputee, is a SOCSO aid recipient. In Feb 23, he was hesitant to proceed with his JKM aid application. Thus, GHCA ended our aid to reduce his over-dependency.

CHONG KIM FUNG

Mr Chong, 65, has high blood pressure and kidney failure. In Mar 23, his breadwinner son, who had earlier lost his job, has managed to find a job. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

SAROJA A/P VYAMALAI

Mdm Saroja, 77, has hypertension, heart ailment, diabetes, asthma, and kidney failure. In Jan 23, MOH aid was renewed, but she now needs additional funds for dialysis via chest catheter. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Apr 23.

PREMALA DEVI A/P S MUNUSAMY

Mdm Premala, 48, has glaucoma, hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Jan 23, she started working with her sister. GHCA extended her aid to Apr 23, while she looks for a more stable job.

















WOONG WAH LEE

Mr Woong, 59, single, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney illness. In Jan 23, his haemoglobin level got worst. Thus, we extended his aid until Apr 23 to support his Epoetin and iron injection.

MOHD FAZLI BIN MOHD SALEH

Mr Fazli, 47, father of 4, has kidney failure. In Mar 23, his daughter started university and found a part-time job to reduce his burden. Thus, GHCA extended his aid as his daughter settles down.

SUPRAMANIAM A/L A. CHINNIAH

Mr Supramaniam, 62, has heart ailment, diabetes, hypertension, and kidney failure. In Jan 23, he had unfortunately passed away due to his illness. Thus, our support ended thereafter.

CHANDRAKUMAR A/L KANAPATHY

Mr Chandra, 65, unemployed father of 3, struggled for his dialysis fees. In Mar 23, his MOH aid was still in process. Thus, we extended his aid until Apr 23 to ease his wife's burden.

JANAK LAL KAMI A/L GAJALAL KAMI

Mr Janak, 66, has hypertension, heart ailment, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. In Jan 23, he still needed to do dressing at the clinic for his amputated right toe. Thus, GHCA extended his aid until Apr 23 to reduce his burden.

MURUGIAH A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Murugiah, 56, has diabetes, hypertension, and kidney failure. His wife caters for his dialysis fees. In Feb 23, his SOCSO aid was approved. Thus, he no longer requires our dialysis aid.

NAOMAH A/P SUPRAMANIAM

Mdm Naomah, 46, single, has partial blindness, hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. Support is still ongoing for her until May 23, while she waits for her eye operation later this year.

SITI BAIZURA BINTI HAMID

Mdm Siti, 40, unemployed, is taken care of by her barber husband. In Feb 23, her husband's income increased after completing a training course. She had also submitted her JKM aid application. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until May 23 while her husband stabilises in his new job role.















THAVAGEE A/P KOOTHIYAN

Mdm Thavagee, 65, widow of 4, is a SOCSO aid recipient. In Feb 23, her son has an increment after passing probation but still struggles for her dialysis. Her daughter is now looking for a job. Thus, GHCA extend her support until May 23.

SIM SENG HUAT

Mr Sim, 77, unemployed, has hypertension and kidney failure. His wife struggled to cover his dialysis fees. In Feb 23, as his MOH aid application is under processing, GHCA extend our support until May 23.

MOHD ROSLAN BIN YUSOF

Mr Roslan, 39, single, unemployed, is a SOCSO aid recipient. He stays with his security guard brother who struggles for his remaining dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA supported his dialysis fees while advising him to apply for an NGO dialysis centre.

YEOH ENG HAI

Mr Yeoh, 55, father of 1, has diabetes, asthma, high blood pressure, and kidney failure. His babysitter wife struggles for his treatment. In Mar 23, his SOCSO aid was approved, while his son has also found a part time job. Thus, our aid will be provided until Jun 23 to reduce his burden.

NURUL HAFIZA BINTI RAMLI

Mdm Hafiza, 42, mother of 2, has hypertension, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. Her technician husband with chronic abdominal illness, struggles to cover her dialysis fees. Thus, we support her while she applies for SOCSO aid.

ROSLI BIN MARRU

Mr Rosli, 53, father of 3, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. He used up all his savings for his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA supports him from Mar 23 to May 23, while he applies for SOCSO aid.

CHIA CHIN MOY

Mdm Chia, 74, is an MOH aid recipient. She stays with her husband and married lorry driver son, who struggles to cover her EPO and Iron injections for her dialysis treatment. Thus, GHCA supported her from Mar 23 to May 23 and hope that her condition gets better with the injections.

Individual Cases – Family Care

Our Family Care Program supported 44 underprivileged families in the first quarter of 2023 compared to 41 families within the same quarter in 2022. 10 of these are new cases. Mdm Mala, 51, struggled with her rent after her husband was admitted to the hospital. In Mar 23, her husband has discharged and has resumed work. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.

NOR LIZAH BINTI ABDUL NAZER

Mdm Lizah, 52, mother of 6, is recovering from a bowel surgery and is unable to work. In Jan 23, she divorced her husband and had to take care of all her 6 children. Thus, GHCA extended her rental aid until Apr 23 as she recuperates.

QUEK WEI KEAT

Mr Quek, 21, orphan, is our Didik-Kasih recipient. He struggles for his rent and works part time as a barista. GHCA extended our rental aid to May 23 while he looks for alternative part time jobs to cope with his rent.

VASANTHRADEVI BINTI ABDULLAH

Vasanthradevi, 12, comes from a single mother family. In Feb 23, her JKM aid was approved. Her mother also found part time job. Her education aid was extended to Aug 23 to help with her studies while her mother's income stabilises.

TEH HOCK LEONG

Mr Teh, 34, has cerebellar atrophy and lost his job. In Mar 23, after undergoing TCM treatment, he is able to walk better and speak more coherently. GHCA extend his aid to Jun 23 to assist with his treatment and recovery.

















DAYANG THARHATA HASAN BAGINDA

Mdm Dayang, 36, single mother of 2, runs a rice stall. In Mar 23, she had to care for her stage 4 cancer mother, who became bedridden. Thus, we extended her aid, while she applies for Zakat aid.

NG KIM HUAT

Mr Ng, 72, was bedridden after a fall and requires milk powder and diapers support. In Mar 23, he has recovered and is now able to walk slowly. Thus, he no longer requires our aid thereafter.

KRISHNAMORTHY A/L THOMAS

Mr Krishna, 41, leg amputee, is on dialysis covered by an NGO, but struggles for his transport fees to the dialysis centre. We extended his aid till Jun 23 while his sister applies for JKM aid.

NORHASLI BIN ISA

Mr Norhasli, 43, father of 3, lost his job. In Mar 23, his diabetic wife amputated her leg. They are now doing part-time jobs while applying SOSCO, JKM, and MAIM aid. Thus, we extend his aid to Jun 23.

APPA ROW A/L JAGANADHAN

Mr Appa Row, 62, is a dialysis patient with SOCSO aid, who lost his job in Apr 22. Both his JKM aid and hearing aid been approved in Jan 23. Thus, he no longer requires our support thereafter.

KIRAM BIN ABDULLAH

Mr Kiram, 50, recycleables collector, father of 6, struggles for his children's school transportation fees. In Mar 23, he managed to buy a second-hand van to fetch his own children to school. With his JKM and Baitulmal aid, he no longer requires our aid.

JEMIAH@JEMILAH BINTI MAHAMAD

Mdm Jemiah, 73, stuggles for rent and relies on JKM aid. In Feb 23, she submitted her application for MAIN aid. Thus, GHCA extended her aid to May 23 while she awaits for her MAIM aid approval.

DHANA LETCHEMY A/P BEDEWEL

Mdm Dhana, 31, mother of 4, lost her job. In Feb 23, she found a job, but her JKM aid was paused due to documentation. Thus, we extended her aid to May 23 while she resolves her JKM aid matter.

















GREE RAJ

Mr Raj, 35, lorry driver, struggled for his rental. In Jan 23, his wife found a better paying job as a school cleaner and is now able to cope with their rental. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

JENNIFER A/P JEFFREY

Mdm Jennifer, 36, is a single mother of 3. In Jan 23, she has stabilised in her office clerk job while her family and friends will also help to care for her children. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.

NURHANIM BINTI ABDUL GANI

Mdm Nurhanim, 31, mother of 3, had previously struggled to care for her newborn baby. In Jan 23, both her and her husband's income has stabilised. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

SITI NOOR KHAIRA BINTI JAHAYA

Mdm Siti, 38, mother of 6, runs a drink stall. In Jan 23, her business has stabilised while her husband has also found a lorry driver job. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

SUFFIYAH NG BOON MIANG

Mdm Suffiyah, 48, unemployed stroke patient, struggles for her rent. In Jan 23, her JKM aid was approved, while her physical condition has also improved. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.

FARIDAH BINTI SALLEH

Mdm Faridah, 55, single mother of 6, lost her job and struggled to provide for her family. In Jan 23, her Baitumal aid was approved. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.

LEE SOW LOU

Mdm Lee, 74, divorcee, was unable to work after injuring her arm and leg in a fall. In Jan 23, she has recovered and resumed work. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

N SAMBAYA A/P NADASON

Mdm Sambaya, 85, is taken care of by her grandson, who struggled for their household expenses after losing his job. In Jan 23, his grandson had found a new job as a security guard. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

















SAROJAH A/P KUTHERAVELOO

Mdm Sarojah, 52, mother of 5, has hypertension and diabetes. In Jan 23, her husband is recovering well from stroke. She will be relying on JKM aid and her children after our aid ended.

BADRUL HISHAM BIN MOHD YUNUS

Mr Badrul, 50, father of 5, struggles with rent. In Feb 23, he passed away due to liver illness. Hence, his aid ended, but we will be extending support to his widowed wife thereafter to ease her burden.

FAN SIEW YUN @ JULIANA

Mdm Fan, 65, widow, successfully did her knee surgery in Jan 23 and has recovered well. Her daughter's income has also stabilised. Thus, she no longer requires our aid after Feb 23.

LASON ANAK PANES

Mdm Lason, 64, widow, struggled for rent to care for her three grandchildren. In Feb 23, her son is recuperating from a brain operation, while her jailed daughter will be released in Apr 23. Hence, GHCA extend her rental support until May 23.

YAP LEE YNG

Mdm Yap, 38, single mother, had to care for her daughter with spina bifida and is unable to work. In Jan 23, extended her aid to Jun 23 and assisted her to apply for JKM aid.

KANAGAMBIGAY A/P SAGAL

Mdm Kanagambigay, 29, mother of 6, struggled to make ends meet. In Feb 23, her husband found a job in a convenience store. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

MARIA FE GATCHALIAN DANOS

Mdm Maria, 62, lives with her diabetic husband and strugged for his insulin bills. In Feb 23, her husband's JKM aid was approved. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

NOR ATIQAH BINTI AHMAD PAUZI

Mdm Atiqah, 33, single mother of 4, relies on Zakat aid and struggles to put food on the table. In Feb 23, her JKM aid was approved. Thus, she no longer requires our support thereafter.















SUMANIYAH BINTI MUKI

Mdm Sumaniyah, 43, stall helper, mother of 2, struggled with rental. Her husband is a dialysis patient. In Feb 23, she fell ill and was unable to work. Thus, GHCA extended her rental aid until May 23 to ease her burden.

TIA TING CYEK

Mdm Tia, 44, has SLE which inflames her joints, skin, and kidney. Until Mar 23, she was still unable to find a job, due to her condition. Thus, we extended her medical aid until May 23 to ease her burden.

NURHEDAYAH BINTI YUSOP AFFANDI

Mdm Nurhedayah, 35, mother of 3, started a food stall business under our aid to ease her husband's burden. In Mar 23, her husband received a raise. Coupled with her business income, they can now sustain themselves and no longer need our aid.

RAMANI A/P NADESON

Mdm Ramani, 56, has diabetes, kidney illness, and partial blindness. In Jan 23, her carer son was jailed for breaking the law. With her weak condition, GHCA supported her with groceries aid until Jun 23 for her to have a balanced diet.

SRI RAJESWARAN A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Rajeswaran, 42, has hypertension, diabetes, and heart ailment. He depleted his savings for rent after losing his job. He now works as a parttime van driver and recycleables collector. Thus, GHCA support him with rental aid until Jun 23.

BOO LEE KIAN

Mdm Boo, 53, single mother of 2, part-time night market helper, is a SOCSO dialysis aid recipient, who struggled to cover her household expenses. Thus, GHCA support her with grocery aid until from Jan 23 to Jun 23.

LYE WEN JIE

Wen Jie, 21, has autism. His father is undergoing chemotherapy and unable to work. His promoter mother struggled to pay for his autism school fees. Hence, GHCA support his autism school fees from Feb 22 to Apr 23.















MAISURI BINTI MUSTAFA SAKRI

Mdm Maisuri, 39, mother of 5, struggled to support her family as a RELA even with Zakat aid, after her husband met an accident and was unable to work. Thus, GHCA supported her with rental aid while her husband recuperates.

MURUGIAH A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Murugiah, 56, father of 1, has kidney failure, diabetes, and hypertension. SOCSO covers his dialysis fees. However, he struggled for groceries. Thus, GHCA provide him with grocery aid until May 23 while he applies for invalidity pension.

JAYASEELAN A/L VINCENT PAUL

Mr Jayaseelan, 37, has mental disability and stays in a welfare home. His mother relies on JKM aid and struggled to pay for his welfare home fees. Thus, GHCA supported his welfare home fees until May 23, while he applies for other support.

BAVITHRA A/P R.ELLANKO

Mdm Bavithra, 32, nurse, mother of 1, broke her arm in Jan 23 and is now on unpaid leave. Her Grab driver husband struggles for their grocery. Thus, GHCA support her with grocery aid while she recuperates.

SARINAH BINTI AHMAD

Mdm Sarinah, 41, single mother of 3, used to operate a burger stall at her flat but the space was taken away. She now plans to operate her business from home but is lacking startup supply funds. Thus, GHCA supported her with business grocery aid from Mar 23 to May 23.

MUHAMMAD NORAMIN BIN YUSOFF

Mdm Kesumawaty, 36, newly widowed mother of 5, is searching for a job and applying JKM and MAIM aid. She struggled to cover her rental after her husband's passing. Thus, GHCA support her with rental aid from Mar 23 until Aug 23.

Mr Kiram, 50, was unable to work due to an accident and is now waiting for an operation. In Mar 23, he struggled to support his family due to his tight cash flow situation. Thus, GHCA provided him with grocery supplies to ease his burden.

Mdm Maria, 61, had struggled for her diabetic husband's insulin supply. In Mar 23, we provided her with ad-hoc medical support for her husband's insulin supplies to ease her burden.

RASHVIN A/L KUMAR

Rashvin, 7, struggled to buy new books and school supplies with the reopening of school in Mar 23 as her single mother family was struggling to make ends meet. Thus, GHCA provided him with the school supplies needed so that he could resume school with ease.

KUAN PIT CHAN

Mr Kuan, 62, father of 4, freelance renovation worker, lives in a leaky worn-down house. In Mar 23, he found a new house to move to, but was unable to fully pay the rental deposit. Thus, GHCA supported him for his partial rental deposit.

Orang Asli Empowerment Project

ENHANCING SUSTAINABLE FARMING VIA COMPOSTER MACHINE

Mr Jabar, 60, an Orang Asli villager, father of 5, from Kampung Bugis, Pahang, is a rubber tapper who also runs a farm for consumption and additional income generation. Our team had visited him in Sep 22 to assess his situation and explore options to empower him and expand his farming income. Mr Jabar had been using conventional methods to produce organic waste, which he then sells back to his fellow Orang Asli villagers to generate income and to help his fellow villagers with their farming. However, this method is time-consuming. On 23 Feb 2023, GHCA provided him with a composter machine, which is hoped to increase the efficiency of his fertiliser production process by reducing the time and labour required. This will increase his productivity and profitability level, and he will also be able to convert his organic waste into high-quality fertiliser to improve soil fertility and crop yields for his and his villagers' farms.



Clinic for Orang Asli Community Treatment (COACT)

COACT @ KAMPUNG TANJUNG

On 23 Feb 2023, GHCA and Malaysia Red Crescent Pahang continued the Clinic for Orang Asli Community Treatment (COACT) project with a session at Kampung Tanjung, Pahang. The mobile clinic team provided critical healthcare screening that covers BMI, blood glucose level, and blood pressure monitoring, and basic medical treatment to 110 Orang Asli villagers. Additionally, the team also provided essential groceries to support the community. This project was made possible with the support from 15 dedicated volunteers, who believe in the power of giving back to society.

Attendance rate is at 97.6%, with 74.5% students having shown improvements in the topics taught.
