Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the second quarter of 2023, we supported 29 underprivileged kidney patients from the low-income or unemployed group, compared to 25 patients in the previous quarter. Each patient receives subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,000 per month to ease their burden. 13 of these patients are new cases this quarter. Mdm Kalaivani, 48, has diabetes, kidney failure, and cataract. She is supported by her lorry driver son. In May 23, her son took on part time delivery rider job to better support her. Seeing his effort, we extended Mdm Kalaivani's aid until Aug 23.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



SAROJA A/P VYAMALAI

Mdm Saroja, 77, has hypertension, heart ailment, diabetes, asthma, and kidney failure. She relies on her hawker helper daughter. In Apr 23, she is still waiting for her fistula operation and has applied for JKM aid. Thus, we extend her aid until Jul 23.



PREMALA DEVI A/P S MUNUSAMY

Mdm Premala, 48, has glaucoma, hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Apr 23, she is still working with her sister at her pastry business and will be applying for JKM aid. Thus, we extend her aid while she goes through the process.



WOONG WAH LEE

Mr Woong, 59, single, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney illness. In Apr 23, his haemoglobin has stabilised, and he is more energetic. As SOCSO fully subsidised his dialysis fees now, he no longer requires our aid after Apr 23.



MOHD FAZLI BIN MOHD SALEH

Mr Fazli, 47, father of 4, has kidney failure. He works in the post office and has applied for an invalidity pension in Jun 23 due to his current weak health. Thus, we extended his aid while he waits for the pension approval.



CHANDRAKUMAR A/L KANAPATHY

Mr Chandra, 65, father of 3, struggled for his dialysis fees and is unemployed due to poor health. In Apr 23, his MOH aid was only approved as a one-off RM2000 aid. Thus, we extended his support while he applies for JKM welfare aid.



JANAK LAL KAMI A/L GAJALAL KAMI

Mr Janak, 66, has hypertension, heart ailment, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. In Apr 23, his amputated right toe has fully healed. As he is still waiting for his MOH aid status, we extended his aid until Jul 23 to reduce his burden.



NAOMAH A/P SUPRAMANIAM

Mdm Naomah, 46, single, has partial blindness, hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In May 23, she decided to postpone her eye surgery over fear of failure rate. As SOCSO is covering her dialysis fees now, she no longer requires our aid.

SITI BAIZURA BINTI HAMID

Mdm Siti, 40, unemployed, is taken care of by her barber husband. In May 23, her JKM aid was approved. However, she still struggles for her dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Aug 23 to ease her husband's burden.



THAVAGEE A/P KOOTHIYAN

Mdm Thavagee, 65, widow of 4, is a SOCSO aid recipient. In May 23, her children's income has stabilised and can now cover her dialysis fees. Thus, she no longer requires our aid thereafter and thank us for the support in her times in need.



SIM SENG HUAT

Mr Sim, 77, unemployed, has hypertension and kidney failure. His breadwinner wife struggled to cover his dialysis fees. In Jun 23, his MOH aid was approved and he no longer requires our support.



MOHD ROSLAN BIN YUSOF

Mr Roslan, 39, single, unemployed, is a SOCSO aid recipient who relies on Zakat and JKM aid for a living. In Jun 23, as no attempts were made to improve his livelihood condition even after our advice, we ended our support thereafter.



YEOH ENG HAI

Mr Yeoh, 55, father of 1, has hypertension, asthma, diabetes, and kidney failure. His babysitter wife struggles for his treatment. In Jun 23, his wife's income improves. Coupled by his son's income, he no longer requires our support thereafter.



NURUL HAFIZA BINTI RAMLI

Mdm Hafiza, 42, mother of 2, has hypertension, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. Both her SOCSO aid and Invalidity Pension was approved this quarter but her application for treatment at NKF and Zakat aid is still pending. Thus, we extended her aid until Aug 23.



ROSLI BIN MARRU

Mr Rosli, 53, father of 3, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Mar 23, his SOCSO aid was approved but he still struggles for his remaining dialysis fees. Thus, his aid was extended to Aug 23, while his son looks for a better paying job.

CHIA CHIN MOY

Mdm Chia, 74, is an MOH aid recipient. Her lorry driver son struggles to cover her EPO and Iron injections. In May 23, her JKM aid was increased. GHCA extended her aid until Aug 23, while her health condition stabilises.



LO HON MENG

Mr Lo, 73, has Hepatitis C and kidney failure recently. His children struggle to pay for his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA supported his dialysis fees from Apr 23 to Sep 23, to ease his children's burden during this difficult period.



HEW KEAT SOON

Mr Hew, 44, father of 3, started dialysis recently and lost his job. He now relies on his sales consultant eldest daughter, who struggles to pay for his dialysis. Thus, GHCA support his dialysis fees while he applies for Invalidity Pension.



LIM HOCK CHAI

Mr Lim, 65, single, struggled for his dialysis after his MOH aid was discontinued. Thus, we provided him with dialysis aid from Apr 23. In Jul 23, his MOH aid was resumed. We extended his aid to Sep 23 while helping him to apply for JKM aid.



THANGGACHMMA RAMASAMY

Mdm Thanggachmma, 62, is on dialysis since Nov 22. Her hotel housekeeper husband struggles for her dialysis fees, resulting in rental and dialysis fee arrears. Thus, GHCA support her dialysis fees while she applies for SOCSO and JKM aid.



SUBRAMANIAM A/P APLASAY

Mr Subramaniam, 50, father of 3, left leg amputee dialysis patient with SOCSO aid, struggles on invalidity pension, resulting in utility and dialysis fees arrears. GHCA support his dialysis fees while he applies for admission into NGO dialysis centre.



DANALETCHUMEE A/P SUBRAMANIAM

Mdm. Danaletchumee, 65, had kidney ailment and is taken care of by her husband. Her warehouse supervisor son struggles to cover her dialysis fee. Thus, GHCA support her from May 23. Unfortunately, she had passed away in Jun 23.

LOW KOI WAH

Mdm Low, 73, widow, has heart disease and kidney illness. Her son struggles for her dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA supported her dialysis fee. In Jun 23, she was transferred to the Selayang Hospital for her treatment and no longer requires our aid.



CHEK SAW WAH

Mr Chek, 60, father of 3, has kidney illness. His second son struggles to pay for his dialysis fees as his eldest son is unable to work due to stroke. Thus, GHCA supported him while he applies for MOH aid, and his youngest son looks for a job.



CHEONG CHEE YUN

Mr Cheong, 51, father of 1, started dialysis in Nov 22 with SOCSO aid. In May 23, he left his job due to poor health and had been surviving on EPF savings. Thus, GHCA provide him with dialysis aid while he applies for invalidity pension.



MOHAMED JOHAN

Mr Johan, 40, father of 3, lost his job after having kidney failure. He struggles for his dialysis fee and now relies on JKM aid and Invalidity Pension for a living. Thus, GHCA support his dialysis fees from Jun 23 while he applies for MAIM support.



KAM CHUNG FOO

Mr Kam, 44, father of 3, is a SOCSO aid recipient. He struggles for his dialysis fees but still took on a part-time rider job recently, while his wife has also started working as a HR personnel. GHCA support him with dialysis aid from Jun 23 while he and his wife stabilise in their new job.



LOGESWARI A/P RAJA RATNAM

Mdm Logeswari, 45, security guard, single, started dialysis in Sep 22 with SOCSO aid, but struggled to pay the remaining fees. Thus, GHCA supported her from Jun 23 while she applies for JKM aid and admission to NGO dialysis centres.



MOHD RADZUAN BIN ABD KADIR

Mr Radzuan, 46, unemployed divorcee, depends on MAIM aid, SOCSO aid and invalidity pension for his dialysis treatment. He struggles to cover for any required additional injection fees. Thus, GHCA support his dialysis fees from Jun 23 while his medical condition improves.

Mdm Yap, 38, single mother, had to care for her daughter with spina bifida and is unable to work. She is supported by her brother. In Jun 23, a local NGO will be supporting her daughter's diaper supplies. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.



SRI RAJESWARAN A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Rajeswaran, 42, has hypertension, diabetes, and heart ailment. He struggles with his rent after losing his job previously. He has since found job while in Jun 23, his wife has also started work as a dishwasher. Thus, he no longer requires our aid.



BOO LEE KIAN

Mdm Boo, 53, single mother of 2, part-time night market helper, had struggled with her household expenses. In Jun 23, with her SOCSO dialysis aid JKM aid, and salary, she is now able to support herself and thus no longer requires our support.



MAISURI BINTI MUSTAFA SAKRI

Mdm Maisuri, 39, mother of 5, struggled to support her family as a RELA even with Zakat aid, after her husband met an accident and was unable to work. Our rental aid support is still ongoing while her husband recuperates.

Mdm Kesumawaty, 36, newly widowed mother of 5, is searching for a job and applying JKM and MAIM aid. She struggled to cover her rental after her husband's passing. Our rental aid support is still ongoing this quarter.

Mr Teh, 34, has cerebellar atrophy and lost his job. We supported his TCM treatment. In Jun 23, his condition has improved and is now able to walk and speak. He has also found a part time account job. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

Mdm Tia, 44, has SLE which inflames her joints, skin, and kidney. She had been unable to find a job due to her condition. In May 23, she found a part time job as a promoter. Thus, she will no longer requires our support thereafter.

Mdm Chua, 38, divorcee, has hypertension and a stroke. She stays in a welfare home and could not afford physiotherapy treatment for her condition. GHCA supported her medical fees from Apr 23. In Jun 23, her condition improves, and she is now able to work as an online auto parts seller.



DURUKA DEWI

Mdm Duruka, 33, widow mother of 3, struggles with her rent. In Jun 23, she started a part-time sewing job. Her BINGKAS aid was also approved. As her ankle and hand are still injured, we extended her aid to Sep 23 while she recovers.



NOR LIZAH BINTI ABDUL NAZER

Mdm Lizah, 52, divorcee mother of 6, struggles for her rent. She is still weak and is unable to work as she is recovering from a bowel surgery. Thus, GHCA extended her rental aid until Jul 23 for her to recuperate and then find for a job.



QUEK WEI KEAT

Mr Quek, 21, orphan, is our Didik-Kasih recipient. He struggles for his rent. In May 23, he started interning at an auto parts service centre. With the allowance received and the income from his part-time barista job, he no longer requires our aid.



DAYANG THARHATA HASAN BAGINDA

Mdm Dayang, 36, single mother of 2, runs a rice stall and struggles to care for her ailing mother. In Jun 23, her mother had passed away. She will now be moving to her hometown with her family and will no longer requires our support thereon.

Mr Krishna, 41, leg amputee, is on dialysis covered by an NGO, but struggles for his transport fees to the dialysis centre. In Jun 23, he is applying for MOH aid. Thus, we extended his aid till Sep 23 while his application process is underway.



NORHASLI BIN ISA

Mr Norhasli, 43, father of 3, struggled to care for his diabetic, leg amputee wife. In Jun 23, his wife's prosthetic leg and JKM aid was approved. She will undergo a 3-month rehab, but they lost their part time jobs. Thus, GHCA extend his aid to Sep 23.

Mdm Jemiah, 73, had previously struggled for rent and relies on JKM aid and our support. In May 23, she has managed to clear off her rental arrears partially and is now awaiting for her MAIM aid approval, as our support draws to an end.

Mdm Lason, 64, widow, struggled for rent for her three grandchildren. In May 23, her daughter was released from prison and is now supporting her. Her son has also started supporting her. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.

Mdm Sumaniyah, 43, mother of 2, struggled with rental after her husband started dialysis. In May 23, her husband's dialysis MAIM aid was approved. Thus, she can now cover her rental and no longer requires our support thereafter.

Mdm Ramani, 56, has diabetes, kidney illness, and partial blindness. She relies on derivative pension for a living. In Jun 23, her dialysis tube is wearing down and requires an operation soon. As she applies for JKM aid, we extend her aid to Sep 23.

Wen Jie, 21, has autism. His parents struggled to pay for his autism school fees. In Apr 23, his mother lost her job after needing to care for his father who was hospitalised for cancer. Thus, GHCA extend his autism school fees aid to Jul 23.

Mr Noramin, 32, father of 2, struggled for rent. In May 23, he has yet to pass his probationary period as a lorry attendant. Thus, GHCA extended his aid to Aug 23 and further advise him to apply for JKM aid for his children.

Mdm Kalamani, 50, single mother, struggled with rent after her food business ended. GHCA helped her with rental aid. In Jun 23, she found work as a clerk while also starting a home food business. We extended her aid while her job stabilises.

Krishnaveni, 21, orphan with 3 siblings, is our Didik-Kasih recipient. She struggled with rental arrears. Thus, GHCA supported her room rental from Apr 23. In Jun 23, she found a part-time job. GHCA extended her rental aid to Sep 23 until she stabilises in her job.

Lunch Box for the Hungry

In the second quarter of 2023, we conducted a reassessment for our Lunch Box for the Hungry program beneficiaries, with 42 beneficiaries no longer requiring our support. This quarter, we distributed 3,913 lunch boxes in 70 distribution sessions, as our team look into onboarding more elders, urban poor families, and needy students who would be in need of our lunch box support, which takes place every Monday to Saturday from 11am until 1pm. Classes for the Children

In the second quarter of 2023, we conducted 40 sessions of Malay and English classes at GHCC Klang, with 198 student slots filled. Attendance rate is at 73%, with 74% students recording improvements in the topics taught. Over at GHCC Melaka, this quarter saw us commencing 20 Malay classes in addition to the ongoing 30 English classes, with 88 student slots filled. Attendance rate is at 88%, with 72.1% students having shown improvements in the topics taught.



Vegetable Garden for the Community



In the second quarter of 2023, our Vegetable Garden for the Community program managed to produce a harvest of 142.1kg of vegetables from our crops via 35 harvesting sessions. 155 beneficiaries benefitted from the harvest, which consists of bitter ground, kangkong, long beans, Chinese mustard, amaranth, sawi, pandan leaves, lady's finger, and egg plant.

TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy

Mangrove Rehabilitation and Clean-Up Project

Our Mangrove Rehabilitation and Clean-up Project makes a return in the second quarter of 2023 after a four-year hiatus due to the pandemic, with two sessions of the project being held. On 24 Apr 2023, 11 volunteers and staffs from RS Wines & Spirits Sdn Bhd and The Page Asia Sdn Bhd replanted 50 mangrove saplings while raising awareness on preserving our mangrove forest from destruction.
