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HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the third quarter of 2023, we supported 33 underprivileged kidney patients from the low-income or unemployed group, compared to 29 patients within the same period in 2022. Each patient receives a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,000 per month to ease their burden. From these 33 beneficiaries, 12 are new cases. SAROJA A/P VYAMALAI

Mdm Saroja, 77, has hypertension, heart ailment, diabetes, asthma, and kidney failure. In Jul 23, her JKM aid was approved. However, her breadwinner daughter had to stop working to care for her 4-year-old daughter after a leg surgery. Thus, we extended her aid to Oct 23.



KALAIVANI A/P PERUMAL

Mdm Kalaivani, 48, has diabetes, kidney failure, and cataract. She is supported by her lorry driver and part time delivery rider son. In Aug 23, her son's part time income was affected due to lack of jobs. Thus, GHCA extended her support to Nov 23.



PREMALA DEVI A/P S MUNUSAMY

Mdm Premala, 48, has glaucoma, hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Jul 23, her sister and brother-in-law are now able to support her. Thus, she no longer requires our assistance.



MOHD FAZLI BIN MOHD SALEH

Mr Fazli, 47, father of 4, has kidney failure. In Sep 23, his Invalidity Pension was approved. However, he still struggled for his expenses and is applying for BINGKAS aid. Thus, GHCA extended his support while his application is being processed.



CHANDRAKUMAR A/L KANAPATHY

Mr Chandra, 65, father of 3, struggled for his dialysis fees and is unemployed due to poor health. In Jul 23, his JKM aid was approved. As his MITRA dialysis aid is still pending, GHCA extended his dialysis aid until Oct 23.



JANAK LAL KAMI A/L GAJALAL KAMI

Mr Janak, 66, has hypertension, heart ailment, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. We assisted him while he recuperates from right toe amputation. In Jul 23, his children are now able to support him. Thus, he no longer requires our aid.



SITI BAIZURA BINTI HAMID

Mdm Siti, 40, unemployed, is taken care of by her barber husband. In Aug 23, her haemoglobin level improves, while her husband's income has also stabilised. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.

NURUL HAFIZA BINTI RAMLI

Mdm Hafiza, 42, mother of 2, has hypertension, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. NKF approved her monthly Mircera injection in Aug 23. However, as she is still looking for slots at NGO dialysis centre, we extended her aid to Nov 23.



ROSLI BIN MARRU

Mr Rosli, 53, father of 3, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Aug 23, he was evicted by his landlord and is now staying with his son. Thus, his aid was extended to give him some time to settle down.



CHIA CHIN MOY

Mdm Chia, 74, is an MOH aid recipient. Her lorry driver son covers her expenses. We had assisted her with her dialysis fee due to her deteriorating health. In Aug 23, her health condition has stabilised and no longer requires our dialysis aid.



LO HON MENG

Mr Lo, 73, has Hepatitis C and kidney failure. His children struggle for his dialysis fees. In Sep 23, his application for Bantuan Sihat Selangor dialysis aid is still under processing. Thus, GHCA extended his aid until Dec 23.



HEW KEAT SOON

Mr Hew, 44, father of 3, lost his job due to his kidney illness and had to rely on his struggling eldest daughter. In Sep 23, his Bantuan Sihat Selangor aid was approved for a one-off subsidy, but his Invalidity Pension was still under process. Thus, GHCA extended his support until Dec 23.



LIM HOCK CHAI

Mr Lim, 65, single, struggled with his dialysis fees after his MOH aid was discontinued, which has since been resumed. In Sep 23, he no longer requires our support, but we will still assist him to apply for JKM aid once his health gets better.



THANGGACHMMA RAMASAMY

Mdm Thanggachmma, 62, is on dialysis since Nov 22. Her hotel housekeeper husband struggles for her dialysis fees, resulting in rental and dialysis fee arrears. In Jul 23, her SOCSO and JKM applications were still in process. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Oct 23.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



SUBRAMANIAM A/P APLASAY

Mr Subramaniam, 50, father of 3, left leg amputee dialysis patient with SOCSO aid, struggles on invalidity pension. In Jul 23, he was still searching for a nearby NGO dialysis centre. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Oct 23.



LOGESWARI A/P RAJA RATNAM

Mdm Logeswari, 45, security guard, single, has SOCSO aid, but struggled to pay her remaining dialysis fees. She is still waiting for her JKM aid and NGO dialysis centre application. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Nov 23.



CHEK SAW WAH

Mr Chek, 60, father of 3, has kidney illness. His second son struggles for his dialysis fees as his eldest son is affected by stroke. In Aug 23, after utilising some of his savings, his son is now able to support him, and he no longer requires our aid.



CHEONG CHEE YUN

Mr Cheong, 51, father of 1, has kidney illness and survives on EPF savings. In Aug 23, his invalidity pension was approved but it was just enough to support his family. Thus, GHCA extended his aid until Nov 23 while he plans for his future finances.



MOHAMED JOHAN

Mr Johan, 40, father of 3, lost his job after having kidney failure. He struggles for his dialysis fee and now relies on JKM aid and Invalidity Pension for a living. In Aug 23, his brother had stepped up to support him. Thus, he no longer requires our aid.



MOHD RADZUAN BIN ABD KADIR

Mr Radzuan, 46, unemployed divorcee, depends on MAIM aid, SOCSO aid and invalidity pension for his dialysis treatment. He struggles to cover for any required additional injection fees. This quarter, his condition was still unstable. Thus, GHCA extended his support until Nov 23.



KAM CHUNG FOO

Mr Kam, 44, father of 3, is a SOCSO aid recipient. He is a Nirvana agent and a Grab driver, while his wife is a HR personnel. In Aug 23, his Grab driver income is still unstable as he had only just started out after his health got better. Thus, GHCA extended his support until Nov 23.

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BHAVANI REGINA

Mdm Bhavani, 37, mother of 1, has hypertension and kidney failure. Her lorry driver husband supported the household. She started dialysis in Feb 23. In Aug 23, she had unfortunately passed away, thus ending our support.



NABIL NAWAWI BIN ROSLI

Mr Nabil, 28, single, delivery rider, has kidney failure. His health worsened and he needed epoetin injections. After our 3 months support, his haemoglobin level is improving. We extended his aid until Nov 23 while his health stabilises.



LAI YEE MOI

Mdm Lai, 71, single mother of 4, is an MOH aid recipient. Her son struggles to pay for her epoetin injection fees, which is needed for her condition. Thus, GHCA supported her from Jul 23 to Dec 23 to help stabilise her medical condition.



KAYALVIZHI A/P PANNIRSELVAM

Mdm Kayalvizhi, 43, relies on her electrical technician husband for a living. She struggled for her dialysis fees and had to borrow money from relatives. Thus, GHCA supported her from Aug 23 while she applies for MOH subsidy.



ALVIN A/L ANNANDAN

Mr Alvin, 42, father of 1, is a SOCSO aid recipient. He is unable to work due to his health condition. His cashier wife struggles to support the family. Thus, GHCA support his dialysis fees from Aug 23 while he applies for BINGKAS aid.



MATHIALAGAN A/L SANTHIRAN

Mr Mathialagan, 46, father of 1, has kidney illness and just started dialysis treatment. His sales marketer wife struggles to pay for his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA support him from Aug 23 while he applies for SOCSO subsidy.



MUHAMMAD RADSYAMIR AFIQ

Mr Radsyamir, 29, single, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney illness. He stays with his parents and sister, who is also a dialysis patient. His factory worker father struggles to cover his dialysis fee. Thus, GHCA supported his dialysis fees from Aug 23 while he applies for Zakat aid.

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SIOW POOI KEONG

Mr Siow, 69, father of 3, has kidney and heart ailment and started dialysis in May 23. His 2 sons struggled for his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA supported his dialysis fees from Aug 23 while he applies for treatment at an NKF dialysis centre.



MOHAMAD DESA BIN YAHAYA

Mr Desa, 60, SOCSO aid recipient, started dialysis in Jan 23 and stays with his wife and son. His technician son struggles for his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA supported him from Sep 23 while he applies for Zakat and Bantuan Sihat Selangor aid.



PATHEMANI A/P KALIAPERUMAL

Mdm Pathemani, 60, started dialysis in May 23. Her technician son often had to take advance pay to cover her dialysis fee and living expenses. Thus, GHCA supported her dialysis fees from Sep 23 while she applies for MITRA dialysis subsidy.



YONG CHEONG FOOK

Mr Yong, 67, single, has Down syndrome and stays in a nursing home. He started dialysis in Apr 23. His siblings struggled for his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA support his dialysis fees from Sep 23 while he applies for MOH aid, JKM aid, and possible residence at an old folks' home.



HAM AH KIM

Mdm Ham, 51, single mother of 1, started dialysis in May 23. Her daughter, who works as an administrator, struggles to pay for her treatment fees. Thus, GHCA supported her from Sep 23 while she applies for MOH and SOCSO subsidy aid.

NOR LIZAH BINTI ABDUL NAZER

Mdm Lizah, 52, divorcee mother of 6, struggles for her rent. In Jul 23, her health condition stabilised and she had managed to secure a cleaner job. Thus, GHCA extended her support until Oct 23, while she stabilises in her new job.



VASANTHRADEVI BINTI ABDULLAH

Vasanthradevi, 12, comes from a single mother family. In Aug 23, her mother started a nasi lemak stall nearby GHCC, and her business is doing well to support her and her 3 siblings. Thus, she no longer requires our support thereafter.



KRISHNAMORTHY A/L THOMAS

Mr Krishna, 41, leg amputee, is on dialysis covered by an NGO, but struggles to get to the dialysis centre. In Sep 23, he is still gathering documents for MOH and SOCSO aid application. Thus, we extended his transport aid until Dec 23.



NORHASLI BIN ISA

Mr Norhasli, 43, father of 3, struggled to care for his diabetic, leg amputee wife. In Sep 23, his wife is still in rehab, and they are still looking for a job. Thus, GHCA extend his aid to Dec 23 while he applies for MAIM aid and invalidity pension.



RAMANI A/P NADESON

Mdm Ramani, 56, has diabetes, kidney illness, and partial blindness. She relies on derivative pension for a living. In Sep 23, she is recovering from her dialysis tube operation while her JKM aid was also approved. Thus, we extend her aid until Dec 23 while her health gets better.



MAISURI BINTI MUSTAFA SAKRI

Mdm Maisuri, 39, mother of 5, struggled for her rent after her husband met an accident and was unable to work. Her husband is recovering well in Jul 23. She had also secured a job at a secondary school. Thus, GHCA extended her support till Oct 23 while her situation stabilises.

Wen Jie, 21, has autism. His parents struggled for his autism school fees. His father is undergoing cancer treatment. In Jul 23, his mother found a promoter job. As his JKM aid application aid is still in progress, GHCA extended his aid until Oct 23.



KESUMAWATY BINTI KAMAL BAHARIN

Mdm Kesumawaty, 36, widowed mother of 5, struggled for her rent. In Aug 23, she found a job as a store helper, while her MAIM aid was approved. GHCA extended her aid until Nov 23 while she waits for her JKM aid application.



BAVITHRA A/P R.ELLANKO

Mdm Bavithra, 32, mother of 1, had previously struggled with groceries after both her and her husband lost their income. In Aug 23, they are both now back working with stable income, and would no longer requires our support.



SARINAH BINTI AHMAD

Mdm Sarinah, 41, is a single mother of 3. GHCA assisted her to run a small burger stall. In Aug 23, she was admitted to the hospital for anemia and breathing difficulties. Thus, we extended her support until Nov 23 while she recuperates.



MUHAMMAD NORAMIN BIN YUSOFF

Mr Noramin, 32, father of 2, struggled for rent. In Aug 23, he welcomed another baby into his family, but had lost his job. Thus, GHCA extended his aid for 3 months while he looks for a new job and applies for JKM aid.



CHUA XIU WEI

Mdm Chua, 38, divorcee, is a stroke patient and struggles for her physiotherapy treatment. In Sep 23, she needed to continue her physiotherapy for a few more months to see further improvements. Thus, we extended her aid until Dec 23.



KALAMANI A/P ALAGIAN

Mdm Kalamani, 50, single mother of 1, struggled with rent. In Sep 23, she is still in probation for her newfound clerk position and is applying for BINGKAS aid. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Nov 23 while she stabilises in her job.

KRISHNAVENI

Krishnaveni, 21, orphan with 3 siblings, is our Didik-Kasih recipient. She had previously struggled with her rental arrears. In Sep 23, she has now stabilised in her part time job at IKEA and no longer requires our rental aid thereafter.



M.PARAMESWARY A/P M.MUNIANDY

Mdm Parameswary, 46, single mother, stays with her breadwinner daughter and 2 grandchildren. In Sep 23, her daughter quit her job due to unpaid salary. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Dec 23, while her daughter looks for another job.



PAKIAM A/P GOVINDASAMY

Mdm Pakiam, 65, stays with her daughter's family and struggled for groceries after losing her job. In Jul 23, her son had came back from overseas and will be supporting her. Thus, she no longer requires our support thereafter.



YOUNG FOOK LOON

Mr Young, 63, father of 1, has polio and is on crutches for mobility. He struggles for groceries and depends on his wife, and JKM aid. In Aug 23, he found a job working at a night market. Thus, he no longer requires our support thereafter.



INTAN NOR SUHANA BINTI AZIZ

Mdm Intan, 26, mother of 3, struggled with groceries after her factory worker husband lost his job. In Aug 23, her husband found work as a pest controller. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Nov 23, while her husband stabilises in his job.



THAMARAI A/P T.IVARU

Mdm Thamarai, 52, single mother of 2, struggled with rent. In Aug 23, her health deteriorated and was unable to find a full time now nor a cheaper rental place. Thus, we extended her support until Nov 23 while she gets better in her health.



PUGINASWARAN A/L MARUTHIAH

Puginaswaran, 23, single, is paralysed due to an accident. He relies on his admin clerk sister, who struggled to provide for the family. He had earlier promised to apply for JKM aid while we supported him, but as he had not make any attempt to do so, his aid was stopped in Aug 23.

VIKNESWAARI A/P ANNAVI

Vikneswaari, 14, has heart ailment. She had a serious infection and had to consume Pediasure milk after being discharged from the hospital. Her health is gradually improving with our support, which will still be ongoing until Nov 23.



SABARIA KANAMAH BINTI ABDULLAH

Mdm Sabaria, 58, newly widowed, has diabetes, heart illness, hypertension and high cholesterol. Her daughter had struggled to cover her groceries. In Sep 23, her Zakat aid was approved. Thus, she no longer requires our groceries support.



BUNAMA BINTI P RIFAI

Mdm Bunama, 47, newly widowed mother of 4, had to stop her food stall business temporarily to grieve. GHCA supported her with grocery aid to ease her burden. In Sep 23, she resumed her business and is now applying for Zakat aid.



NOR AZLINA BINTI KOMIZA

Mdm Azlina, 32, mother of 4, home baker, was our family care beneficiary in 2021. She and her mechanic husband struggled with groceries after having to relocate. In Sep 23, their finances normalised and thus no longer requires our aid.

Meethushan, 7 months old, had an imperforated anus and had undergone an operation. He needed to use stoma bags while waiting for his second operation. His mother is unable to work to care for him and his 2 siblings. Thus, GHCA supported part of his stoma bags until Dec 23.



NURUL SYAFIKA AKMA

Syafika, 28, single, has bone TB, while her mother is bedridden. She relies on her father, 82, who struggled to care for her even with Zakat and JKM aid. Thus, GHCA supported her with diaper aid while she applies for BINGKAS support.



PUVANESWARI

Mdm Puvaneswari, 25, housewife, mother of 4, and her security guard husband struggled to support their children. While she apply for JKM and BINGKAS aid, GHCA provided her with 3 months of milk powder and diaper supplies.

Mdm Sarasviathi, 67, widow, is recovering from a stroke. Her son struggles to provide for her milk powder supply, which is necessary for her recovery. Thus, GHCA supported her with 3 months of milk powder supply.

Mdm Devi, 45, mother of 4, has filariasis and a wound on her back, and needed medical supplies to heal. However, her forklift mechanic husband is unable to cover her medical expenses. Thus, GHCA supported her with medical supplies aid.

WINGS OF CHANGE PROJECT - SRI LANKA

On 1 Jul 23, GHCA, The Page, Evolcare, Sirius, RS Wines & Spirits, Hookie Dookie, FLTC, JCI Ipoh, JCI EMKL, and students from AIESEC University of Peradeniya came together to address the issue of chronic kidney disease caused by contaminated drinking water at the village of Meewaobe, Sri Lanka, by constructing a reverse osmosis water purification system that will benefit over 500 villagers there. The project was self-funded by all participating volunteers.



EDUCATION SUPPLIES FOR SRI LANKAN

During the same Jul 23 trip to Sri Lanka, the team from the Wings of Change project further distributed books, stationeries, and school bags to students from the Darmapradeepa Primary School and Darmapradeepa Kindergarten at Nugagolla. 450 students benefitted from the educational provisions, which is aimed to nurture their love for learning and empower them to thrive academically.

Lunch Box for the Hungry

In the third quarter of 2023, we distributed 4,978 lunch boxes in 74 distribution sessions, with 70 beneficiaries signed up for the support. Classes for the Children

Meanwhile, at GHCC Melaka, a further 11 sessions of English classes and 4 sessions of Malay classes were conducted, with 60 student slots filled. Attendance rate is at 75%.



Vegetable Garden for the Community



In the third quarter of 2023, we harvested 111.6kg of vegetables from our Vegetable Garden for the Community program via 21 harvesting sessions that were then distributed to 185 beneficiaries. The vegetables grown in this quarter are kangkong, Chinese mustard, amaranth, sawi, lady's finger, and brinjal.
