HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the final quarter of 2023, our Dialysis Aid Program supported 41 kidney failure patients from the low-income or unemployed group, compared to 28 patients within the same period in 2022. Each patient receives a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,000 per month to ease their burden. From these 41 beneficiaries, 16 are new cases. GHCA is very thankful towards Xepa-Soul and GlobalGiving for their support this quarter. The beneficiaries listing is as follow:

Mdm Saroja, 77, has hypertension, heart ailment, diabetes, asthma, and kidney failure. In Oct 23, her daughter resumed her part-time work as a food stall helper but still struggles to support the family. As her daughter looks for a full-time job, we extended Saroja's dialysis aid until Apr 24.



KALAIVANI A/P PERUMAL

Mdm Kalaivani, 48, has diabetes, kidney failure, and cataract. She is supported by her lorry driver son, who is looking for an additional part time job. In Nov 23, while she applies for JKM disability aid, we extended her support until Feb 24.



CHANDRAKUMAR A/L KANAPATHY

Mr Chandra, 65, father of 3, struggled for his dialysis fees and is unemployed due to ill health. In Oct 23, his MITRA application was rejected due to funding constraints. Thus, GHCA extended his aid until Jan 24 while he reapplies again in 2024.



ROSLI BIN MARRU

Mr Rosli, 53, father of 3, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Nov 23, he moved in with his son. His health improved and no longer need iron injection. Thus, he no longer requires our support thereafter.



LO HON MENG

Mr Lo, 73, has Hepatitis C and kidney failure. His children struggle for his dialysis fees. In Dec 23, his Bantuan Sihat Selangor application is still ongoing, but his children are now able to support him. Thus, he no longer requires our aid.



HEW KEAT SOON

Mr Hew, 44, father of 3, lost his job due to his kidney illness. His eldest daughter struggled to support him. In Dec 23, his Invalidity Pension is still in process. As his wife looks for a job, we extend his aid until Mar 24 to ease his burden.

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THANGGACHMMA RAMASAMY

Mdm Thanggachmma, 62, has kidney illness. Her husband struggles for her dialysis fees arrears. In Oct 23, her family helped to pay off her arrears. As her SOCSO, JKM, and MOH aid are still in process, we extended her aid till Jan 24.



SUBRAMANIAM A/L APLASAY

Mr Subramaniam, 50, father of 3, left leg amputee dialysis patient, relies on invalidity pension. In Oct 23, his pension was increased. In Nov 23, he has changed his treatment type to peritoneal dialysis and would no longer requires our aid.



MOHD RADZUAN BIN ABD KADIR

Mr Radzuan, 46, unemployed divorcee, depends on MAIM aid, SOCSO aid and invalidity pension for his dialysis treatment. In Nov 23, he found a part time car park attendant job. Thus, GHCA extended his aid till Feb 24, while he stabilises in his job.



LAI YEE MOI

Mdm Lai, 71, single mother of 4, is an MOH aid recipient. Her son struggles to pay for her epoetin injection fees. In Dec 23, her haemoglobin level improved. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Mar 24 for her health condition to stabilise.



ALVIN A/L ANNANDAN

Mr Alvin, 42, father of 1, is a SOCSO aid recipient. He is unable to work due to his health condition. In Oct 23, his BINGKAS aid was approved but his wife lost her job and is now looking for a new one. Thus, GHCA extended his aid until Jan 24.



MATHIALAGAN A/L SANTHIRAN

Mr Mathialagan, 46, father of 1, has kidney illness and depended on his wife. In Oct 23 his SOCSO aid and invalidity pension was approved. Thus, GHCA extended his aid until Jan 24 to give him time to plan and manage his finances independently.



MUHAMMAD RADSYAMIR AFIQ

Mr Radsyamir, 29, single, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney illness. His father struggled to cover his dialysis fees. In Oct 23, his Bantuan Sihat Selangor aid was approved but his Zakat aid application was still pending. Thus, we extended his aid until Jan 24 to ease his father's burden.

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SIOW POOI KEONG

Mr Siow, 69, father of 3, has kidney and heart ailment and started dialysis in May 23. His 2 sons struggled for his dialysis fees. His application for treatment at the NKF dialysis centre is still in process. Thus, we extended his aid until Jan 24.



HAM AH KIM

Mdm Ham, 51, single mother of 1, started dialysis in May 23. Her administrator daughter struggles for her treatment fees. In Oct 23, her MOH and SOCSO aid is still under processing. Thus, her aid was extended until Feb 24.



MOHD FAZLI BIN MOHD SALEH

Mr Fazli, 47, father of 4, has kidney failure and has Invalidity Pension. In Dec 23, his BINGKAS aid was rejected. However, his online food reseller business venture became successful. Thus, he no longer requires our support thereafter.



NURUL HAFIZA BINTI RAMLI

Mdm Hafiza, 42, mother of 2, has hypertension, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. In Nov 23, she managed to switch to reusable dialyser, which significantly reduced her dialysis fees. Thus, she no longer requires our assistance.



LOGESWARI A/P RAJA RATNAM

Mdm Logeswari, 45, security guard, single, has SOCSO aid, but struggled to pay her remaining dialysis fees. In Nov 23, both her JKM application and NGO dialysis centre treatment slot failed. Thus, we extended her aid to Feb 24 while she applies for MITRA aid.



CHEONG CHEE YUN

Mr Cheong, 51, father of 1, has kidney illness and relies on invalidity pension for his family expenses. In Nov 23, he withdrew all his EPF savings to be utilised for the coming years. Thus, he no longer requires our support.



KAM CHUNG FOO

Mr Kam, 44, father of 3, is a SOCSO aid recipient. In Nov 23, his Grab driver job has stabilised. He is now arranging to sell off his old house to cover his expenses in the future. Thus, GHCA extended his aid for a final 3 months until Feb 24 while he works out his financial situation.

NABIL NAWAWI BIN ROSLI

Mr Nabil, 28, single, delivery rider, has kidney failure. In Dec 23, his haemoglobin level improved and he also no longer requires rental as he has moved in with his brother. Thus, he is now able to cover his expenses and no longer requires our aid.



KAYALVIZHI A/P PANNIRSELVAM

Mdm Kayalvizhi, 43, relies on her electrical technician husband for a living. She struggled for her dialysis fees. In Oct 23, her MOH aid was approved. Thus, she no longer requires our support thereafter.



MOHAMAD DESA BIN YAHAYA

Mr Desa, 60, SOCSO aid recipient, started dialysis in Jan 23 and stays with his wife and son. His technician son struggles for his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA supported him from Sep 23 while he applies for Zakat and Bantuan Sihat Selangor aid.



PATHEMANI A/P KALIAPERUMAL

Mdm Pathemani, 60, started dialysis in May 23. Her technician son often had to take advance pay to cover her dialysis fee and living expenses. Thus, GHCA supported her dialysis fees from Sep 23 while she applies for MITRA dialysis subsidy.



YONG CHEONG FOOK

Mr Yong, 67, single, has Down syndrome. His siblings struggled for his dialysis and nursing home fees. He was hospitalised since Sep 23 due to an infection. In Nov 23, his siblings are applying for a private aid for him. Thus, we extended his aid to Feb 24 while awaiting the application process.



ALVIN A/L ANNANDAN

Mr Alvin, 42, father of 1, is a SOCSO aid recipient. He is unable to work due to his health condition. His cashier wife struggles to support the family. Thus, GHCA support his dialysis fees from Aug 23 while he applies for BINGKAS aid.



MATHIALAGAN A/L SANTHIRAN

Mr Mathialagan, 46, father of 1, has kidney illness and just started dialysis treatment. His sales marketer wife struggles to pay for his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA support him from Aug 23 while he applies for SOCSO subsidy.

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MUHAMMAD RADSYAMIR AFIQ

Mr Radsyamir, 29, single, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney illness. He stays with his parents and sister, who is also a dialysis patient. His factory worker father struggles to cover his dialysis fee. Thus, GHCA supported his dialysis fees from Aug 23 while he applies for Zakat aid.



SIOW POOI KEONG

Mr Siow, 69, father of 3, has kidney and heart ailment and started dialysis in May 23. His 2 sons struggled for his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA supported his dialysis fees from Aug 23 while he applies for treatment at an NKF dialysis centre.



MOHAMAD DESA BIN YAHAYA

Mr Desa, 60, SOCSO aid recipient, stays with his wife and son. His technician son struggles for his dialysis fees. In Nov 23, his Zakat and Bantuan Sihat Selangor aid applications are still pending. Thus, we extended his aid until Feb 24.



PATHEMANI A/P KALIAPERUMAL

Mdm Pathemani, 60, has kidney illness and is cared for by her son. In Nov 23, her MITRA aid was approved but her son was laid off due to company bankruptcy. Thus, GHCA extended her support until Feb 24, while her son looks for a new job.



YONG CHEONG FOOK

Mr Yong, 67, single, has Down syndrome and stays in a nursing home. He started dialysis in Apr 23. His siblings struggled for his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA support his dialysis fees from Sep 23 while he applies for MOH aid, JKM aid, and possible residence at an old folks' home.



NURUL SYAMIMI BINTI ABD AZIZ

Mdm Nurul, 34, admin clerk, mother of 2, started dialysis in Jul 23 and struggled for her fees. In Dec 23, her SOCSO application was approved. Thus, GHCA extended her support until Mar 24 to enable her to readjust her finances.



LEE KIM YEW

Mr Lee, 53, single, unemployed, SOCSO and JKM aid recipient, is partially blind and lives with his mother. GHCA support his dialysis fees from Oct 23 to Mar 24 to provide time for him to make arrangements with his siblings on his future financial plans.

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MUHAMMAD AZLI BIN ABDULLAH

Mr Azli, 29, single, SOCSO aid recipient, stays with his mother. He lost his barista job and struggles on invalidity pension. Thus, GHCA provided him with dialysis subsidy from Nov 23 while he applies for Zakat and JKM aid.



IYAMPERUMAL A/L ANNAMALAI

Mr Perumal, 73, started dialysis in Jul 23. His children struggled for his dialysis fees. Currently, he is applying for MITRA aid. Thus, GHCA supported with dialysis support from Nov 23 while he waits for the MITRA aid application.



BASKARAN A/L ARIVALAGAN

Mr Baskaran, 29, orphan, part-time machine operator, has kidney failure. He has SOCSO aid but struggles for his remaining dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA provided him with dialysis aid from Nov 23 while he applies for other long-term support.



ROSITA BINTI MAHMUD

Mdm Rosita, 49, mother of 5, is on dialysis with MAIM subsidy. Her lorry driver husband was recently admitted to the hospital due to asthma and was unable to cover her dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA assisted her from Nov 23 while her husband recuperates and resumes working.



SURINDER SINGH A/L M LALLSINGH

Mr Surinder, 57, admin clerk, father of 1, started dialysis in Jul 23. He struggled to support his family and to cover his dialysis fee. Thus, GHCA provided him with dialysis aid from Nov 23. Unfortunately, he passed away in Dec 23.



WONG KIM LOONG

Mr Wong, 48, unemployed divorcee, father of 1, is a SOCSO aid recipient. He relies on JKM aid and struggles for his treatment fees. Thus, GHCA provided him with dialysis subsidy from Nov 23 while he arranges to sell off his house for funding.



LAI LAN LIN

Mdm Lai, 74, widowed mother of 4, has kidney failure and hypertension. Her children struggled to cover her dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA supported her with dialysis aid from Dec 23 while she applies for a private medical subsidy.

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MURUGAN A/L NARAYANASAMY

Mr Murugan, 45, father of 1, has diabetes, weak hearing, kidney failure, and mobility issue. He relies on his invalidity pension and struggles for his dialysis fees. GHCA supported his dialysis fees from Dec 23 while he applies for government aid.



CHONG CHOON KEONG

Mr Chong, 50, single, has hypertension, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. He lives with his mother and sister, who struggles for his dialysis fees. GHCA support his dialysis fees from Dec 23 while he applies for MOH and SUK aid.



LIEW AH SANG

Mr Liew, 74, widower, started dialysis recently. He stays with his waitress daughter's family of 5, who struggles to pay for his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA provide him with dialysis subsidy from Dec 23 while his family readjust their finances.



SHEKAR A/L PALANIYANDY

Mr Shekar, 56, father of 2, is a SOCSO aid recipient. His factory worker wife struggles to cover his remaining dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA provided him with dialysis subsidy from Dec 23 while he applies for invalidity pension.



SING THIAM HOCK

Mr Sing, 64, single, stays with his 2 siblings. He has schizophrenia and is a SOCSO aid recipient and depends on JKM aid for a living. His siblings struggle to cover his dialysis fees after a recent financial issue. Thus, GHCA support him from Dec 23 while his family readjust their finances.



PANG TECK WA

Mdm Pang, 75, single, seamstress, stays with his brother. She and her brother struggle to cover her dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA provided her with dialysis subsidy from Dec 23 while she applies for long term aid from other private NGO.



YAP FEI YING

Mdm Yap, 38, single, admin, lives with her mother and sister. She has hypertension, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. She receives SOCSO aid but struggles to cover the remaining fees. Thus, GHCA supported her dialysis fees from Dec 23 while she arranges to sell off her house for fundings.

A LITTLE GOES A LONG WAY

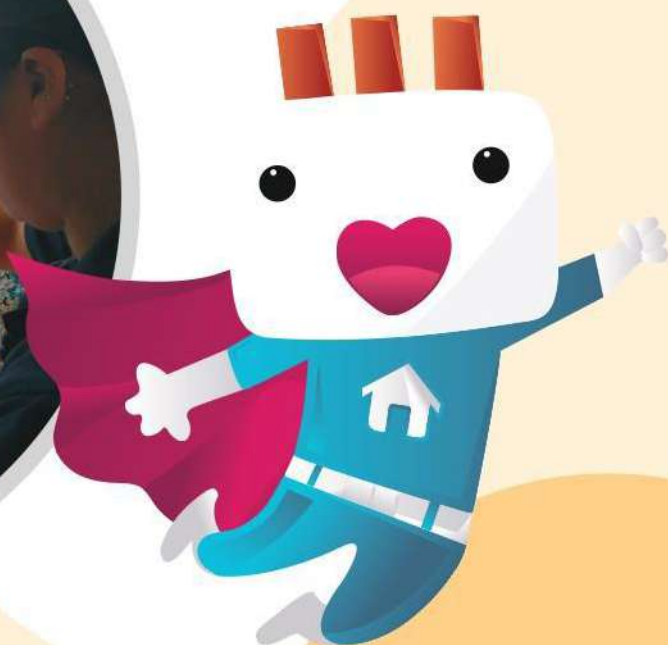

Attendance rate is at 77.1%, with 80.3% students recording improvements in the topics taught. Meanwhile, at GHCC Melaka, 36 sessions of Malay and English classes were conducted, that were attended by 23 students. Attendance rate is at 37.4%.



Vegetable Garden for the Community



In the fourth quarter of 2023, we manage to harvest 79.7kg of vegetables from our Vegetable Garden for the Community program via 9 harvesting sessions. A total of 185 beneficiaries receives the harvested crops. The vegetables grown in this quarter are kangkong, Chinese mustard, and sawi.

In the final quarter of 2023, 12 TCM check-up sessions were held to provide service to 106 patients from needy family and members of the public. The program is held on every Tuesdays and Saturdays.
