Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the first quarter of 2025, our Dialysis Aid Program supported 30 kidney failure patients from the low-income or unemployed group, compared to 50 patients within the same period in 2024. Each patient receives a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,000 per month to ease their burden. From these 30 beneficiaries, 4 are new cases. The beneficiaries listing is as follow:

Mr. Hew, 46, father of 3, lost his job due to the weakening effects of kidney failure. Now, his wife became the family's breadwinner by working as a school transporter, earning a stable income that supports their household. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

LEE KIM YEW

Mr. Lee, 55, single, suffers from kidney failure which is further complicated by partial blindness, leaving him jobless. He currently lives with his elderly mother, while support from his siblings remains limited. He is now able to withdraw his EPF savings to sustain. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

MUHAMMAD AZLI BIN ABDULLAH

Mr. Azli, 32, single, suffers from kidney failure, and is currently recovering from a lower limb fracture and lives with his mother. He solely depends on Invalidity Pension and SOCSO for living. He is reapplying for Zakat and exploring other forms of assistance. Thus, GHCA has extended his support.

WONG KIM LOONG

Mr. Wong (left), 49, unemployed, divorced, father of 1, suffers from kidney failure and relies on SOCSO and JKM to support his living expenses. Currently, he is staying with a friend and in the process of selling his house. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

MUHAMMAD IBNIL SHAHIR BIN MOHD ALI

Mr. Ibnil, 27, single, suffers from hypertension and kidney failure. He currently lives and depends on his mother, who works as a babysitter. As of Dec 24, he remains unable to secure a job due to his health condition, as he frequently experiences episodes of syncope. Therefore, GHCA extended his support.

THENG CHON FAH

Mr. Theng, 62, father of 1, suffers from high blood pressure, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. He currently works as a freelance pipework. In Feb 25, he applied for government aid, including mySalam, but has yet to receive a response. Therefore, GHCA extended his support.











LAM KONG FOON

Mr. Lam, 74, married, suffers from hypertension and kidney failure He has been relying solely on his son, a salesman who is married and has his own family expenses, for support. On Mar 25, while exploring other aid options, his son was able to cover the expenses. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

ZAIRULNIZA BINTI AZIZUL

Mdm Zairulniza, 45, mother of 6, suffers from high blood pressure and kidney failure. She relies on her husband, a personal driver, to cover her dialysis expenses. While her Invalidity Pension application is still pending, her husband has been able to manage the costs. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

RAVICHANDRAN A/L GOPAL

Mr. Ravichandran, 50, is separated from his family and suffers from high blood pressure and kidney failure. He works as a cleaner in a temple and struggles to cover his dialysis fees. As of Jan 25, he was still awaiting his transplant procedure. Therefore, GHCA extended his support.

LIEW TZER GIO

Mr. Liew, 42, suffers from kidney failure. He solely depends on his part-time job as an administrator, struggling to manage his dialysis fees. As of Jan 25, he is still awaiting the completion of his probation period, with better pay. Thus, GHCA has extended our support.

WONG CHEW YUET

Mdm Wong, (left) 69, suffers from high blood pressure and kidney failure. Currently, she is living with her children and relies on them for living. While her son works as a lorry driver, he is facing financial challenges. Thus, GHCA has extended her support until their financial stabilise.

GANESAN A/L ODAYAPPEN

Mr. Ganesan, 72, suffers from high blood pressure, a history of stroke, and kidney failure. His eldest son struggles to afford his dialysis treatments, while his daughter-in-law, a housewife, has stopped working to care for him and their two school-aged children. Thus, GHCA extended its support to him.











LAI SIANG NGEE

Mr. Lai, 82, suffers from high blood pressure, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. His son, a school transporter, had a break during the school holidays. However, the holidays have ended, and his son has resumed work, he is able to provide the necessary support. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

SIVANILA A/P KALIMUTHOO

Mdm Sivanila, 54, married, mother of 5, suffers from kidney failure. Her husband is wheelchair-bound. She relies on SOCSO and her children to cover household expenses. Her family is now able to better manage on their own. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

ZAMRI BIN SENEN

Mr. Zamri suffers from high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. The unexpected onset of his dialysis treatment has placed a financial strain on him. He currently works at a factory and relies on SOCSO aid to support his family. Therefore, GHCA extended his support.

MOHD AZMAN BIN SADAR

Mr. Azman, 41, single, suffers high blood pressure and kidney failure and cares for his parents. Despite earning an income as a technician and SOCSO aid, it remains insufficient to cover the household expenses. Therefore, GHCA has extended its support while seeking other assistance.

SARENA BINTI AHMAD

Mdm. Sarena, 60, mother of 4, suffers from high blood pressure and kidney failure. She and her husband work as mosque cleaners, but their income is limited, and they rely heavily on SOCSO aid for her treatment. Therefore, GHCA has extended her support while she seeks additional assistance.

SIVAALINGAM A/L NARANASAMY

Mr. Sivaalingam, 53, divorced, suffers from high blood pressure, high cholesterol, kidney failure, and vision impairment. He lives alone and currently his Invalidity Pension manages to cover his treatment and living expenses. Thus, he no longer requires our support.













THULANDHAS A/L KRISHNAN

Mr. Thulandhas, 67, suffers from diabetes, hypertension, and kidney failure. His application to Tzu Chi has been approved, and they are now providing aid to cover his dialysis treatment. Therefore, he no longer requires our support.

FAZLI BIN ISMAIL

Mr. Fazli, 47, married, father of 1, suffers from high blood pressure and kidney failure. His family depends on his SOCSO aid and his wife, a cancer patient and works as a store helper. However, it is insufficient to cover his treatment fees and living expenses. Therefore, GHCA extended his support.

LETCHUMIE A/P ARUMUGAM

Mdm Letchumie, 54, widow, mother of 4, suffers from high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She depends solely on her daughter, whose struggle to fully support them. Currently, she was admitted to hospital and receiving dialysis treatment. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.

RATHAKRISHNAN A/L SAMBASIVAM

Mr. Rathakrishnan, 70, father of 4, suffers from high blood pressure, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. Previously, his children struggled to afford his treatment fees, as they have their own families to care for. Currently, they are able to manage their expenses. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

NOORLAILA BINTI ZAKARIA

Mdm Noorlaila, 41, married, suffers from high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She depends on SOCSO aid and her husband, a security guard, who struggles to cover her dialysis treatment. Therefore, GHCA has extended her aid while she seeks assistance from JKM and KKM.

VIGIYAH A/P ANDY

Mdm Vigiyah, 43, married, mother of 3, suffers from high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. Her husband, a security guard, struggles to manage her treatment fees, and their SOCSO aid is insufficient to support the family. Therefore, GHCA has extended her aid while she apply for JKM.













TEO BOON LENG

Mr. Teo, 52, married, father of 2, suffers from high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. He is unemployed due to his health and depends on his wife, a part-time gardener, to support the family. In Feb 25, his wife are able to manage their expenses. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

SUNITA BINTI ZANIMI

Mdm Sunita, 48, mother of 3, suffers from high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She depends on SOCSO aid and her husband, a security guard. who struggles to cover her treatment fees. Therefore, GHCA provided her support while she seeks JKM and KKM assistance.

MUHAMAD FAUZI AKMAL

Mr. Fauzi, 36, father of 1, suffers from high blood pressure, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. His wife, who sells Kuih via online, struggles to cover his treatment fees. Therefore, GHCA has provided him support till Mar 25 while he waits for his SOCSO application approval.

BASKARAN A/L ARIVALAGAN

Mr. Baskaran, 31, orphan, suffers from kidney failure. He relies on his part-time as a machine operator and SOCSO aid but still struggles to cover his treatment fees. After losing his job on Jan 25, he reapplied for assistance from GHCA. Thus, GHCA has provided support while he seeks for new job.

CHIN JAI PENG

Mr. Chin, 26, father of 1, suffers from high blood pressure, heart issues, and kidney failure. Currently unemployed due to his health, and he relies on his wife, a part-time Grab driver, struggles to support his treatment fees. Therefore, GHCA supported his dialysis injections while he seeks other assistance.

SHANTI A/P LOURDUSAMY

Mdm Shanti, 47, mother of 1, suffers from high blood pressure and kidney failure. Currently unemployed and relies on her husband, a part-time security guard who suffers from leg problems caused by accident. Therefore, GHCA supported her dialysis injections while she seeks other assistance.

Mdm. Nalani, 36, mother of 4, relies on government aid, which remains insufficient to support her family. Mdm Geok Len, 79, single, suffers from a stroke and undergoing treatment in NASAM. She lives with her brother and depends on their savings and borrowed funds to meet daily expenses. Therefore, GHCA has extended support for her physiotherapy treatment while she applies for JKM assistance.

LIM BOON PENG

Mr. Lim, 40, father of 1, suffers from a stroke and depend on his wife, who works part-time as a dishwasher but struggles to support their family and child who will start school. Hence, GHCA has extended grocery aid while they seek new job and receive aid from Tzu Chi.

Mdm. Nor Alia, 39, mother of 4, whose children face heart conditions and disabilities, previously faced transport issue. She has been supported with a second-hand van to support her business in the night market and facilitate hospital visits. Therefore, she no longer require our support.

Mdm Kesumawaty, (left) 37, widow, mother of 3 secured a permanent position as a waitress in February 2025 and is now receiving MAIM support. With the current new job and higher pay, she's able to manage her family expenses. Therefore, she no longer requires our rental support.

Kannagai A/P K Ananda Sekran

Mdm. Kannagai, 41, mother of 3, struggles to secure a full-time job. Currently relying on financial support from her relatives to provide for her children. Therefore, to encourage her progress toward independence, GHCA has concluded her grocery aid

Mdm. Looi, 67, suffers colon cancer while caring for her husband, who is undergoing dialysis. Her daughter works full-time as a caretaker at a center struggles to afford for her stoma bags. Therefore, GHCA extends to her with medical aid, while they apply for MAKNA support.

Mdm Nirmala, 45, mother of 3, struggles to provide for her family following the passing of her husband on Nov 24. Mdm Woon (right), 47, mother of 2 OKU children. She suffers from high blood pressure, heart issues, the effects of a stroke, and a psychological disorder. They relies on her husband, who works in a factory and struggles to their household expenses. Therefore, GHCA provided grocery aid.

LOOI WOON LEONG

Mr. Looi, 49, single, suffers from the aftereffects of a stroke. He previously worked as a security guard but was dismissed from his job. Since then, he has struggled to find employment. With no source of income, GHCA is providing him with grocery aid until he is able to secure a new job.

KHAIRUNNISA BINTI ABDULL HALIM

Mdm Khairunnisa, 30, mother of 1, suffers from slipped disc. Her husband, who works as a car washer, is the breadwinner and also cares for her mother, who has been bedridden due to stroke in 2019. Therefore. GHCA provided her with grocery aid to support the family.

SITI AISYAH BINTI RAMARUDDIN

Mdm Siti Aisyah, 44, mother of 3, relies on her husband, who suffers from high blood pressure and diabetes, and works as a security guard as the sole breadwinner of the family and struggle to afford milk and diapers for their baby. Therefore, GHCA provides grocery aid in the form of milk and diapers.









TAMIL SELVI A/P SUPIAH

Mdm Tamil Selvi, 52, mother of 1, is the breadwinner of her family. Her husband, suffers from stroke, and her father, who has colon disease and heart issues, are both bedridden. She works in an NGO with limited income. Therefore, GHCA provided grocery aid to help ease the their burden.

ARUNA A/P ANATHAN

Mdm Aruna, 33, single, suffers from depression after an accident left her unable to continue work as Grab, making it difficult to afford her car loan. As the sole breadwinner, she also cares for her ailing mother. Therefore, GHCA is providing rental subsidy support to help ease their financial burden.

TAN HONG KHENG

Mdm Tan, 60, married, and the sole breadwinner of the family, while caring for her husband suffers from swollen feet, heart issues, and hyperuricemia. at the night market, but her limited income is still not enough to support the family. Therefore, GHCA provides grocery aid to help ease their burden.

SOH SIEW LAN

Mdm Soh, 57, widow, mother of 2, relies on her children to help cover caregiver fees, as well as the cost of milk and diapers for her brother, who is bedridden with neurological, all with a limited household income. Therefore, GHCA provides milk and pampers aid for this family.
