Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In quarter two of 2025, 27 needy kidney patients from the low-income or unemployed group were supported with dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,000 per month under our Dialysis Aid Program so that they could continue their treatment. From these 27 patients, 10 are new cases. Special thanks to our restaurant partners who were involved in our Charity Dining 2025 campaign, funds raised of which goes towards running our Dialysis Aid Program this quarter.

Mr Theng, 62, father of 1, freelance plumber, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. In May 25, he was admitted to the hospital for hypertension and a heart disease. Therefore, GHCA extended his support till Aug 25.



RAVICHANDRAN A/L GOPAL

Mr Ravichandran, 50, part-time cleaner, has kidney failure and high blood pressure since 2008. He struggles to manage his dialysis fees. In Apr 25, his Bantuan Sihat Selangor aid was approved. Thus, he no longer requires our aid.



LIEW TZER GIO

Mr Liew, 42, has had high blood pressure and kidney failure for 12 years. He had previously just changed job and was on probation. He has since been confirmed in his job with increment, and thus no longer requires our support.



WONG CHEW YUET

Mdm Wong, 69, has high blood pressure, kidney failure & heart disease. In Apr 25, her sons had started part-time job and coupled with her approved MOH aid and support from her other children, she no longer requires our support.



GANESAN A/L ODAYAPPEN

Mr Ganesan, 72, has hypertension, kidney failure & a stroke history. His son struggles to cover his dialysis fees and unfortunately, further lost his job in Mar 25. Thus, GHCA extended his support until Jul 25 to ease his burden.



ZAMRI BIN SENEN

Mr Zamri, 52, suffers from diabetes, hypertension, hyperlipidaemia, and kidney failure since 2024. In Jun 25, after his family reorganises their finances, they are now able to cover his dialysis fee. Hence, he no longer requires our support.

Mr Azman, 40, single, has hypertension, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. In Apr 25, his brother has started working and along with Mr Azman's MAIM aid, is able to cover his dialysis fee. Therefore, he no longer requires our support.

Mr Fazli, 46, father of 1, has hypertension and kidney failure. His cancer patient wife is the breadwinner, working as a store helper. In Apr 25, his SOCSO invalidity pension was approved. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

Mr Rathakrishnan, 69, father of 4, suffers from high blood pressure, cholesterol, and kidney failure. In Jun 25, his health condition deteriorates and was admitted to the hospital. Therefore, GHCA extended his aid until Dec 25.

Mdm Noorlaila, 48, married, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Apr 25, she was admitted to the hospital and passed away. With heavy hearts, GHCA concluded the aid that was previously extended to her.

Mdm Vigiya, 42, mother of 3, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In May 25, her eldest daughter lost her job, which impacted their financial stability. Therefore, GHCA extended her aid until Aug 25.

Mdm Sunita, 48, married with 3 children, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Jun 25, she had to be hospitalised due to a heart ailment. Thus, GHCA extended her aid until Dec 25 for her to recuperate with peace of mind.

Mr Fauzi, 36, father of 1, has hypertension, diabetes, hyperlipidaemia, and kidney failure. In Jun 25, he was admitted to the hospital due to deteriorating health. Hence, GHCA extended his aid until Dec 25 while his condition stabilises.

Mr Raihan, 25, single, factory worker in a family of 7, has hypertension and kidney failure since 2022. His security guard father and stall helper mother struggles with his dialysis fees. GHCA provides him with dialysis aid to ease his family's burden.

Mdm Azmah, 55, divorcee mother of 5, has high blood pressure, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. She relies on her brother and daughter for a living and struggles with her dialysis fees. Thus, we support her until Sep 25.

Mr Satia Seelan, 53, father of 3, has hypertension, hyperlipidaemia, diabetes, hepatitis, and kidney failure. Currently, he is unemployed and depends on his children and wife for support. GHCA provides him with dialysis aid to ease his burden.

Mdm Cheryl, 56, mother of 2, suffers from high blood pressure, high cholesterol, hepatitis B, and kidney failure. Her husband and son struggle for her dialysis fee. In Jun 25, her treatment transfer to NKF was successful. Thus, she no longer requires support.

Mdm Kamariah, mother of 5, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure since Apr 25. She depends on her contractor husband, who struggles to cover her dialysis fees. Therefore, GHCA supports her until Aug 25.

Lunch Box for the Hungry



In the second quarter of 2025, we distributed 6,936 packs of lunch boxes via 72 distribution sessions to 100 urban poor families, compared to 5,923 lunch boxes in the first quarter. Classes for the Children



This quarter, our Classes for the Children program was conducted for a total of 40 sessions, covering Malay and English language classes that were conducted at GHCC. 194 student slots filled up were filled up this quarter. Attendance rate is at 78.75%, with 81.25% students recording improvements in the topics taught during the quarter.



Meanwhile, at GHCC Melaka (GHCCM), the program was held over 13 sessions this quarter, which also covers classes for the Malay and English languages. 50 student slots were filled up at GHCCM, with attendance rate of 63.41%, and with 68.66% of the students having shown improvements after going through the topics that were being taught to them this quarter.

Vegetable Garden for the Community



In quarter two of 2025, our vegetable garden collected a harvest of 106.5kg of vegetables in 9 harvesting sessions that were distributed to 178 beneficiaries from GHCC. The vegetables grown this quarter are Chinese mustard, kangkong, bok choy, and spinach.

TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy

In quarter two of 2025, our TCM Medical Check Up for the Needy program held 12 TCM check-up sessions, providing service to 122 patients from needy family and members of the public. 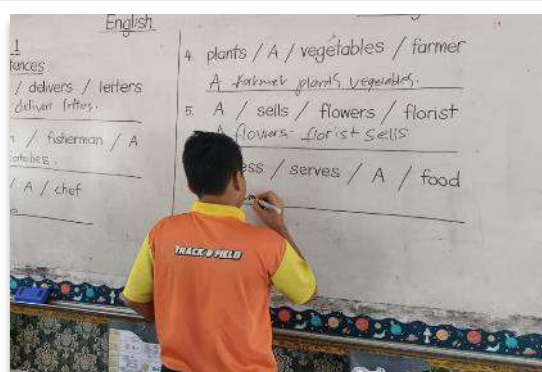

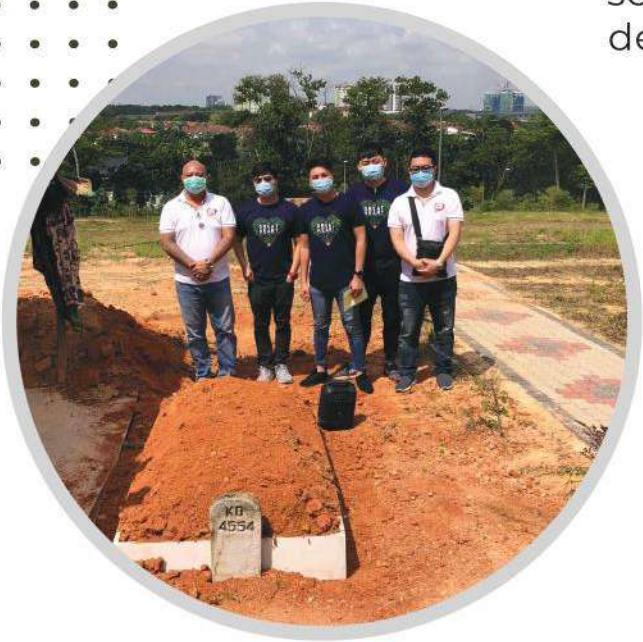
