In the third quarter of 2025, our program supported 22 underprivileged kidney patients from the low-income or unemployed group with dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,000 per month provided so that they could continue their treatment. Mdm Sunita, 48, married with 3 children, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Sep 25, she was hospitalised again, this time due to blood pressure anomaly. Her GHCA aid is still ongoing until Dec 25.



MUHAMAD FAUZI AKMAL

Mr Fauzi, 36, father of 1, has hypertension, diabetes, hyperlipidaemia, and kidney failure. In Sep 25, his condition stabilises but he still struggles for his dialysis fee. His GHCA aid is still ongoing until Dec 25.



SHANTI A/P LOURDUSAMY

Mdm Shanti, 47, married, mother of 1, suffers from high blood pressure and kidney failure. In Sep 25, her husband was still unable to find a job due to his leg condition. Her GHCA aid is still ongoing until Dec 25.



JOO HUI WAH

Mdm Joo, 56, mother of 3, has hypertension, high cholesterol, and heart ailment. Her husband passed away in 2024, and her children struggled to cover her dialysis fees. Hence, GHCA support her so that she could continue her treatment.



GANESAN A/L ODAYAPPEN

Mr Ganesan, 72, has hypertension, kidney failure & a stroke history. In Jul 25, his eldest son is still looking for a job while income from his wife's nasi lemak stall has been sluggish. Hence, GHCA extended his aid until Oct 25.



VIGIYAH A/P ANDY

Mdm Vigiyah, 42, mother of 3, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Aug 25, her health condition became worse, and she was admitted to the hospital due to a heart issue. Therefore, GHCA extended her aid until Nov 25.



SATIA SEELAN A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Satia Seelan, 53, father of 3, has hypertension, hyperlipidaemia, diabetes, hepatitis, and kidney failure. In Aug 25, he starts to develop vision issues and may need to go for an operation soon. His GHCA aid is still ongoing.

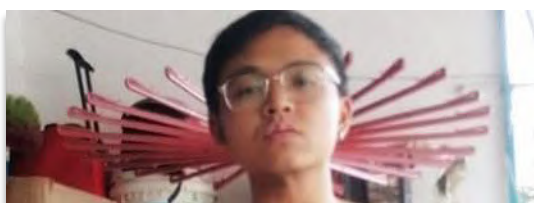
MUHAMMAD IBNIL SHAHIR

Mdm Azmah, 55, divorcee mother of 5, has high blood pressure, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Sep 25, her Grab driver brother still struggles for her treatment fees. Her GHCA aid is still ongoing until Dec 25.



CHIN JAI PENG

Mr Chin, 26, father of 1, has hypertension, heart ailment, and kidney failure. In Jul 25, he was admitted to the hospital for a bacterial infection. Thus, GHCA extended his aid to Oct 25 until his health improves.



NOR AISYAH BINTI KARIM

Mdm Aisyah, mother of 3, has high cholesterol, asthma, and kidney failure. In Aug 25, her contractor husband is still struggling to cover her dialysis fees and their toddler's expenses. Her GHCA aid is still ongoing until Nov 25.



KAMARIAH BINTI RASUL

Mdm Kamariah, mother of 5, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Aug 25, she admitted to hospital due to a seizure. Therefore, GHCA extended her until Nov 25 while she recuperates.



DAYANGKU ZURAIDA KARIM

Mdm Dayangku, 39, mother of 5, has hypertension and kidney failure. This quarter, her haemoglobin level has stabilised. However, she still struggles for her dialysis fees. Her GHCA aid is still ongoing until Oct 25.



GNANASEGARAM A/L VELLOO

Mr Gnanasegaram, 68, father of 6, has high blood pressure, heart illness, hyperlipidaemia, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Jul 25, his is looking for alternative income to cover his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA extends his dialysis aid until Oct 25.

NORHAIDA BINTI MUSTAFA

Mdm Norhaida, 47, mother of 1, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Sep 25, her MySalam aid was approved but she still struggles to cover her dialysis injection fees. Thus, GHCA extend her support until Dec 25.



MUHAMMAD RAIHAN BIN SAIS

Mr Raihan, 25, single, factory worker in a family of 7, has hypertension and kidney failure since 2022. His parents had struggled for his dialysis fees. In Sep 25, his contractor brother steps up to cover his dialysis fees. Thus, he no longer requires our support thereafter.



LEE CHOW FOONG

Mdm Lee, 67, mother of 1, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure since Oct 2024 and struggled for her dialysis fee. In Jul 25, she was transferred to a hospital which covers her dialysis. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.



YAP SUU KIM

Mdm Yap, 76, mother of 4, has hypertension, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. She started dialysis this year, but her hawker son struggles to cover her fees. Hence, GHCA provide her with treatment fees subsidy until Oct 25.



ESIWARY A/P BATUMALA

Mdm Esiwary, 50, mother of 3, has hypertension, high cholesterol, prediabetes and kidney failure. Her part-time grass cutter husband struggles to cover her dialysis fee. Thus, GHCA supports her with dialysis treatment subsidy until Nov 25.



KOR KIANG PENG

Mr Kor, 63, father of 3, has high blood pressure, high cholesterol, prediabetes, kidney failure and cataract. He had to stop working as a van driver and started dialysis in 2024 but struggled for its fees. Hence, GHCA supports him until Nov 25.

Individual Cases – Family Care

In the third quarter of 2025, our Family Care program assisted 45 underprivileged families with aid that ranges from groceries, medical, rental, education, business support, and transportation, compared to 36 families in the same quarter last year. 14 of these families are new cases. 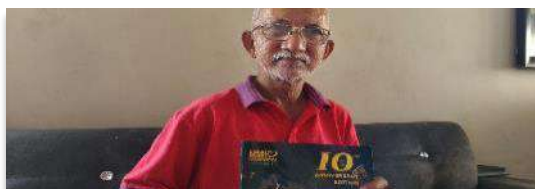
WOON LEE FOONG

Mdm Pamela, 42, mother of 2, babysitter, lost her husband in Sep 25. She relies on JKM and church aid, but still struggles to afford groceries. To ease her burden, GHCA will support her until Feb 26.

Mdm Ramani, 58, widowed mother of 4, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Aug 25, her health condition worsens. Thus, GHCA extends her aid until Feb 26.

Mdm Nanthini, 31, single mother of 5, stays with her parents and struggles to feed her children. In Jul 25, she plans to start working and apply for her children's birth certificate. GHCA extends her aid until Oct 25 to ease her burden.

Classes for the Children

In the third quarter of 2025, 46 sessions of Malay and English classes were held at GHCC Klang, with 226 student slots being filled up. Attendance rate is at 73.25%, with 73.66% students recording improvements in the topics taught. Meanwhile, over at GHCC Melaka, 11 sessions of Malay and English classes were conducted, with 53 student slots being filled up. Attendance rate is at 61.25%, with 68.83% students recording improvements in the topics taught.

Although RM200 may seem like a small amount to some, but for us, it means a great deal and makes a real difference in our daily lives to ensure that my family is able to get a sufficient and balanced diet."

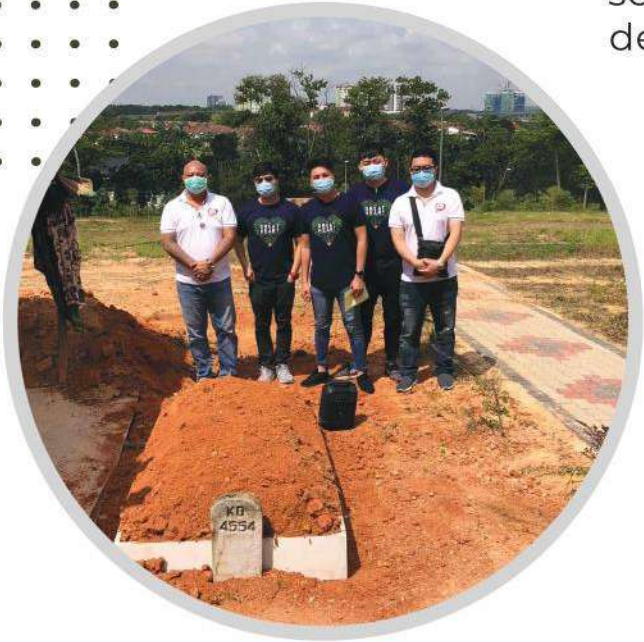
