## Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the final quarter of 2025, we supported 28 needy kidney patients from the low-income or unemployed group under our Hand-in-Hand Dialysis Aid program, with dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,000 per month provided so that they could continue their treatment. From these 28 patients, 9 are new cases. Our appreciation to Yayasan Kossan, IOI Foundation, Mr Joshua Tien, YB Preakas, and Global Giving for supporting the program this quarter.

Mdm Sunita, 48, mother of 3, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Dec 25, her daughter received a pay raise. Her SOCSO aid increase has also been approved. Thus, she no longer requires our aid thereafter.



## MUHAMAD FAUZI AKMAL

Mr Fauzi, 36, father of 1, has hypertension, diabetes, hyperlipidaemia, and kidney failure. In Dec 25, he moved back to his hometown in Perak due to work opportunity and lower monthly expenses. Thus, he no longer requires our aid.



## SHANTI A/P LOURDUSAMY

Mdm Shanti, 47, mother of 1, has hypertension and kidney failure. In Dec 25, she had unfortunately passed away after developing complications arising from epilepsy. Thus, her support ended thereafter.



## JOO HUI WAH

Mdm Joo, 56, widowed mother of 3, has hypertension, high cholesterol, and heart ailment. In Dec 25, her night market vendor son still struggles for her dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA extended her dialysis aid until Mar 26.



## SATIA SEELAN A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Satia Seelan, 53, father of 3, has hypertension, hyperlipidaemia, diabetes, hepatitis, and kidney failure. In Dec 25, his blood pressure worsened due to insomnia. His wife also started to have neuropathic pain. Thus, his aid was extended to Mar 26 to ease his burden.



## YAP SUU KIM

Mdm Yap, 76, mother of 4, has hypertension, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. She started dialysis this year. In Oct 25, she had submitted her MOH aid application and is awaiting approval. Thus, GHCA extended her dialysis aid until Jan 26.

Mr Kor, 63, father of 3, has high blood pressure, high cholesterol, prediabetes, kidney failure and cataract. In Nov 25, he plans to apply JKM aid. He is also expecting a grandchild in Dec 25. Hence, GHCA extends his aid until Feb 26.



## HALIP BIN AHMAD

Mr Halip, 86, has kidney and hearing illnesses. His driver son-in-law struggles for his dialysis fees. He has applied for government aid and is awaiting approval. Thus, GHCA provide him with dialysis subsidy until Mar 26 to ease his burden.



## IYAMPERUMAL A/L ANNAMALAI

Mr Iyamperumal, 76, father of 4, has kidney and heart illnesses. His security guard daughter struggles to cover his dialysis treatment. Hence, GHCA support him with dialysis treatment subsidy until Mar 26 to ease his burden.



## TIW BEE CHOO

Mdm Tiw, 68, mother of 4, has hypertension, diabetes, kidney failure, and poor eyesight. She began dialysis in Feb 25. Her restaurant helper daughter struggles for her dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA provide her with dialysis aid until Jan 26.



## SARAVANAN A/L RAMALINGAM

Mr Saravanan, 52, father of 1, has hypertension, heart disease, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. His family struggled for his treatment fees when he began dialysis in Sep 25. Thus, GHCA support him with dialysis aid until Jan 26 to ease his burden.



## MUHAMMAD IBNIL SHAHIR

Mr Ibnil, 27, stays with his caregiver mother, 72, who has mobility issues. He has kidney failure, hypertension, and heart blockage. In Dec 25, GHCA extended his support until Mar 26 while his and his mother's health condition stabilise.

Mr Chin, 26, father of 1, has hypertension, heart ailment, and kidney failure. In Oct 25, his medical condition has stabilised and he has since been able to cover his treatment fees. Thus, he no longer requires our support thereafter.

Mdm Aisyah, 33, mother of 3, has high cholesterol, asthma, and kidney failure. In Nov 25, her family still struggles for her treatment fees. She has applied for MAIM aid and is awaiting approval. Thus, GHCA extended her dialysis aid until Feb 26.

Mr Ganesan, 72, has hypertension, kidney failure & a stroke history. In Oct 25, his son is now working to cover the expenses of the family. Thus, he no longer requires our support thereafter.

Mdm Vigiyah, 42, mother of 3, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Nov 25, her JKM aid application was rejected. She has since submitted an aid application with the DUN office. Thus, GHCA extend her dialysis aid until Feb 26.

Mr Gnanasegaram, 68, father of 6, has high blood pressure, heart illness, hyperlipidaemia, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Oct 25, his JKM aid was stopped, and he had to reapply for the aid again. Thus, GHCA extended his dialysis aid until Jan 26.

Mdm Ee, 83, mother of 1, has high cholesterol and kidney failure since Aug 25. Her hawker son struggles to feed his family of 5 and her dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA provide her with dialysis treatment aid until Mar 26 to ease her burden.



## JAGATHEESAN A/L RAMANI

Mr Jagatheesan, 47, father of 3, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. He started dialysis in Aug 25 and had to stop working. As he applies for SOCSO aid, GHCA support him with dialysis fee subsidy until Jan 26.



## LOH SIEW YIN

Mdm Loh, 67, mother of 2, has kidney failure since 2020. Her breadwinner barber daughter struggles to cover for her dialysis treatment fees. Thus, GHCA provides her with dialysis subsidy until Jan 26 to ease her burden.



## MOHAMMAD RAZLI BIN RAMLIE

Mr Razli, 22, stays with his parents and four siblings. He began dialysis in Mar 25 after having kidney failure. His security guard father struggles to cover his treatment fees. Thus, GHCA provide him with dialysis subsidy until Jan 26.



## NG LEE CHIN

Mdm Ng, 44, stroke patient, has kidney failure and had to start dialysis treatment. Her mother is a stage 3 colon cancer patient. She and her mother rely on JKM aid for a living and struggles for her dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA provides her with dialysis fee aid until Mar 26 to ease her burden.

## Lunch Box for the Hungry

At GHCC Melaka, a further 9 sessions of Malay and English classes were held, with 56 student slots being filled up. Attendance rate is at 61.58%, with 70.00% students recording improvements in the topics taught.

The initiative provided life skills such as emotional awareness, communication, social skills, self-confidence building, teamwork, and problem-solving for 35 needy children and foster volunteerism and leadership among students.



### ECORANGER JUNIOR WITH UiTM

On 14, 17, and 21 Nov 25, 18 UiTM students ran the Ecoranger Junior project to provide environmental awareness exposure to 22 preschool children by introducing 3R concepts (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle) through hands-on, play-based activities. The project encouraged active participation and helped the children appreciate the importance of caring for nature, culminating in the planting of 22 trees.



### SHINE 1.0 WITH IIUM

From 23 to 25 Nov 25, 47 students from IIUM travelled all the way to Kampung Orang Asli Air Bah that is located deep into the hills of the Lenggong Geopark, to run the Spreading Hope and Nurturing with Emphaty (SHINE) 1.0 project. Through this initiative, the students provided various much-needed essential food supplies and clothing to 271 Orang Asli villagers, extending support and care to the community.



### UBUNTU WITH UUM

On 26 and 27 Dec 25, 30 students from the Psychology, Policy, and Social Work programme at Universiti Utara Malaysia (UUM) implemented the UBUNTU UUM Empowers Marginalised Communities project to engage 30 Orang Asli children in learning and basic educational support activities. The children's mothers were also invited for one of the sessions, where they bonded and cook together with their children.

The interactive bird show was a highlight, bringing excitement to the children. 
### BACK TO SCHOOL @ HOUSE OF JOY
