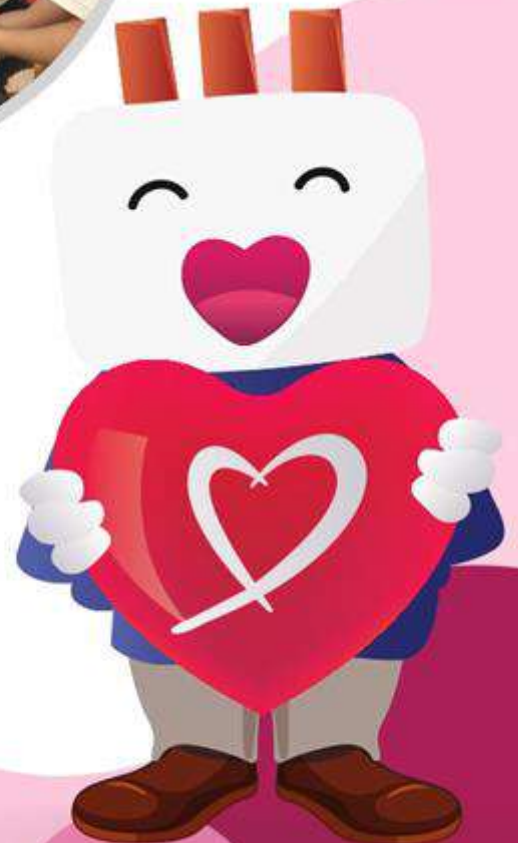

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM

Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

For the first quarter of 2026, our Hand-in-Hand Dialysis Aid program supported 23 people with chronic kidney disease from the low-income or unemployed group. Dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,100 per month were provided to enable them to continue their treatment. From these 23 patients, 5 are new cases. Special thanks to Yayasan Kossan, YB Ganabatirau, and YB Preakas for their support.

Mdm Vigiyah, 43, mother of 3, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Feb 26, her aid application with the DUN office is still ongoing. Thus, GHCA extend her dialysis aid until May 26.



KAMARIAH BINTI RASUL

Mdm Kamariah, 41, mother of 5, has hypertension high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Feb 26, her Zakat and mySalam aid application is delayed due to documentation issues. Thus, GHCA extended her dialysis aid until May 26.

HAND-IN-HAND CHARITY PROGRAM



KOR KIANG PENG

Mr Kor, 64, father of 3, has hypertension, cataract, hyperlipidaemia, prediabetes, and kidney failure. In Feb 26, his daughter had just completed confinement and was unable to help with his dialysis fees. Thus, we extend his aid until May 26.



MOHAMMAD RAZLI BIN RAMLIE

Mr Razli, 23, has kidney failure. His security guard father struggles to cover his dialysis fees and household expenses. In Jan 26, his health remains unstable. Thus, GHCA extend his dialysis subsidy until Jul 26 to ease his family's burden.



NG LEE CHIN

Mdm Ng, 45, stroke patient with kidney failure, relies on JKM aid to care for her mother who has stage 3 colon cancer. In Jan 26, still struggles for her dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA extends her dialysis subsidy until Jul 26 to ease her burden.



MUHAMMAD IBNIL SHAHIR

Mr Ibnil, 28, has kidney failure, hypertension, and heart blockage. He will undergo medical investigation for his heart in May 26. As his Grab driver income remains inconsistent, GHCA extends his dialysis aid until Jul 26.



THENG CHON FAH

Mr Theng, 63, father of 1, freelance plumber, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Jan 26, his health deteriorates again. As his JKM aid approval is still pending, GHCA extended his support until May 26.



GNANASEGARAM A/L VELLOO

Mr Gnanasegaram, 69, father of 6, has high blood pressure, heart illness, hyperlipidaemia, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Mar 26, he successfully transfers to a lower cost dialysis centre. Thus, his support amount was reduced to RM400.



DAYANGKU ZURAIDA KARIM

Mdm Dayangku, 40, mother of 5, has kidney failure and hypertension. In Jan 26, she has low blood pressure and breathing issue. As her Zakat aid has yet to be approved, GHCA extended her dialysis aid until Jul 26 to ease her burden.

NOR AISYAH BINTI KARIM

Mdm Aisyah, 34, mother of 3, has high cholesterol, asthma, and kidney failure. In Feb 26, her MAIM aid was approved, while her husband received a salary increment. However, she is still struggling with dialysis fees. Thus, her aid was extended until Aug 26 at a lower amount of RM400.



JOO HUI WAH

Mdm Joo, 57, widowed mother of 3, has hypertension, high cholesterol, and heart ailment. In Mar 26, while she applies from other government and private aid, GHCA extended her dialysis support until Jun 26.



YAP SUU KIM

Mdm Yap, 77, mother of 4, has hypertension and kidney failure. In Jan 26, her MOH aid application was approved to cover her dialysis treatment fees. Thus, she no longer requires our assistance thereafter.



ESIWARY A/P BATUMALA

Mdm Esiwary, 51, mother of 3, has hypertension, high cholesterol, prediabetes, and kidney failure. In Feb 26, she found a grasscutter job. Thus, GHCA lower her aid amount to RM400 until May 26, while she looks for a lower costing dialysis centre.



EE AH CHAI

Mdm Ee, 84, mother of 1, has high cholesterol and kidney failure. Her hawker son struggles to feed his family of 5 and her dialysis fees. In Jan 26, their situation remains. Thus, GHCA extended her support until Jun 26 to ease her burden.



LOH SIEW YIN

Mdm Loh, 68, mother of 2, has kidney failure. Her breadwinner barber daughter struggles to cover for her dialysis treatment fees. In Jan 26, her Iltizam aid was approved. Thus, she no longer requires our support thereafter.



TIW BEE CHOO

Mdm Tiw, 69, mother of 4, has hypertension, diabetes, kidney failure, and poor eyesight. She began dialysis in Feb 25. In Jan 26, her restaurant helper daughter is now able to cover her dialysis fees. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

SARAVANAN A/L RAMALINGAM

Mr Saravanan, 53, father of 1, has hypertension, heart disease, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Jan 26, his daughter is looking for a job to ease his burden. Thus, GHCA extend his aid until Apr 26 while his daughter concentrates on job seeking.



JAGATHEESAN A/L RAMANI

Mr Jagatheesan, 48, father of 3, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Jan 26, his Iltizam aid is still in progress. Thus, GHCA extend his dialysis fee subsidy until Apr 26 at an increased amount of RM400 to ease his burden.



MURUGAN A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Murugan, 79, has heart disease, hypertension, diabetes, and kidney illness. He lives with his wife. His family struggles to cover his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA provides him with dialysis aid until Jun 26 so that he could continue his treatment.



WOON CHUN HONG

Mr Woon, 32, has heart failure, visual impairment, and mobility issues. Although he receives JKM and MOH assistance, he still struggles to cover his remaining dialysis fees. Hence, GHCA provides him with dialysis subsidy to ease his burden.



TINA BINTI MOHAMAD YUSOFF

Mdm Tina, 52, has anaemia and kidney failure. Her husband struggles to support the household and her dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA support her with dialysis subsidy to ensure she could continue her treatment with ease.



SARAS A/P PARAMASIVAM

Ms Saras, 36, unemployed, has kidney failure and iron deficiency anaemia. Her husband struggled to support their family of 4 and her dialysis fees. Although she has SOCSO aid, she is unable to cover her EPO and iron injections. Thus, GHCA provide support for her EPO and iron injections.



MOHAMAD FAHMI BIN SULAIMAN

Mr Fahmi, 50, divorcee with heart illness and kidney failure, is unable to work due to his condition. He stays with his sister. His family struggled to cover his dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA provide him with dialysis aid to ease his burden.

Mr Rajendran, 46, single, cares for his bedridden mother. After his international school job application failed, GHCA extended his aid until Apr 26 to ease his financial hardship.

Mdm Rajeswari, 68, leg amputee, has diabetes, hypertension and heart issue. She struggled with groceries. In Jan 26, her son has secured a stable income and no longer requires our aid.



RAMAYA A/L ARUMUGAM

Mr Ramaya, 50, father of 1, has kidney failure and hepatitis C. In Jan 26, his health condition remains unstable and is unable to work much. Thus, GHCA extend his assistance to Apr 26.



MOHAMED SHARFIRNAIDI BIN YUSOF

Mr Sharfinaidi, 39, father of 3, is recuperating from an accident and unable to work. His MAIM aid was approved on Jan 26 but was insufficient to cover his family's needs. Thus, GHCA extends his aid until Aug 26.

Mdm Leow, 66, widowed retiree, has vertigo, hypertension, and incontinence. In Feb 26, her health improves but her financials are still strained. Thus, GHCA extend her aid to May 26.

Mr Tan, 69, has multiple health issues. He and his blind son rely on JKM aid. In Feb 26, they are still unsuccessful in their job hunt. Thus, GHCA extend his aid until May 26.

Mdm Azilahani, 54, mother of 6, with multiple health issues, is still weak and recuperating from a toe amputation. Thus, her aid is extended until May 26 to ease her burden.



NEELAVENI A/P SEIGER

Mdm Neelaveni, 29, mother of a child with Pierre Robin syndrome and cerebral palsy, struggled to afford milk. In Feb 26, her husband secured a better-paying job, so aid was discontinued.



YANG CHEK BINTI ISNIN

Mdm Yang Chek, 79, who can barely walk and lives with her daughter and cancer-stricken brother, continued to struggle for groceries despite her brother's JKM aid approval in Feb 26. Thus, GHCA extend her aid until Aug 26.



PERIANAYAGI A/P MARIAAPAN

Mdm Perianayagi, 32, a cleaner and divorced mother of 3 who lives with her blind mother, experienced dizziness and limb weakness in Mar 26. GHCA extends her groceries aid until Jun 26.



YEOH OON SIEW

Mr Yeoh, 70, struggles to provide milk and diapers for his bedridden. His JKM aid was approved in Mar 26, but as medical costs remained high, GHCA extended his aid until Sep 26.



KRISHNA DEVI A/P KANNESAN

Mdm Krishna, 35, mother of 1, quit her job to care for her husband after he began dialysis. He passed away in Jan 26. GHCA extended her aid to Apr 26 while she applies for SOCSO Survivor's Pension.



RAJENDRAN A/L V.DOESAMY

Mr Rajendran, 64, handyman father of 3, struggles for diapers and groceries for his bedridden daughter. In Feb 26, he has secured a better paying job and no longer requires our support.

Mdm Chin, 70, retiree, stays with her brother. She has hypertension, diabetes, high cholesterol, and partial blindness. In Feb 26, she still struggled for groceries. Thus, her aid was extended to May 26.

Mr Tamil, 56, father of 1, is bedridden due to stroke, seizures, hypertension, and diabetes. He is on tube feeding and struggles to obtain milk supply. GHCA assisted him until Mar 26, after which another NGO will continue support.

Mr Kua, 51, struggled for groceries to care for his two disabled children after his wife passed away in Dec 25. Thus, GHCA provide him with groceries aid until Jun 26 to ease his burden.

Mr Tan, 57, single, struggles with groceries after retiring as a tuition centre transporter due to age limit. While seeking new employment, GHCA provides him with groceries aid until Apr 26.

Mdm Sahela, 55, single mother of 3, relies on her cashier daughter while also caring for an adopted son whose parents were imprisoned. She struggled for groceries. Thus, GHCA provide her with groceries aid until Apr 26.

Mdm Sagayamary, 52, widowed mother of 4, lost her husband in Oct 25. Living with breast cancer since 2021, she works a Grab driver. She struggled to pay for her son's SPM tuition fees. Thus, GHCA helped her with education aid to ease her burden.



MALA A/P THARMALINGAM

Mdm Mala, 48, widowed mother of 4, works as a school transporter and cleaner. Her son, 16, struggles with his studies but she could not afford to send him for tuition. Thus, GHCA assisted her with education aid.

Nurul, 20, is an IIUM student. Her father, a kitchen staff member, and her brother, an admin assistant, struggled to pay her semester fees. GHCA covered the cost so she could focus on her studies

Mdm Selvi, 52, caregiver for her family, had a fall and fractured her hip. As she could not work due to the injury, she has no means to pay for treatment. Thus, GHCA covered her medical fees.

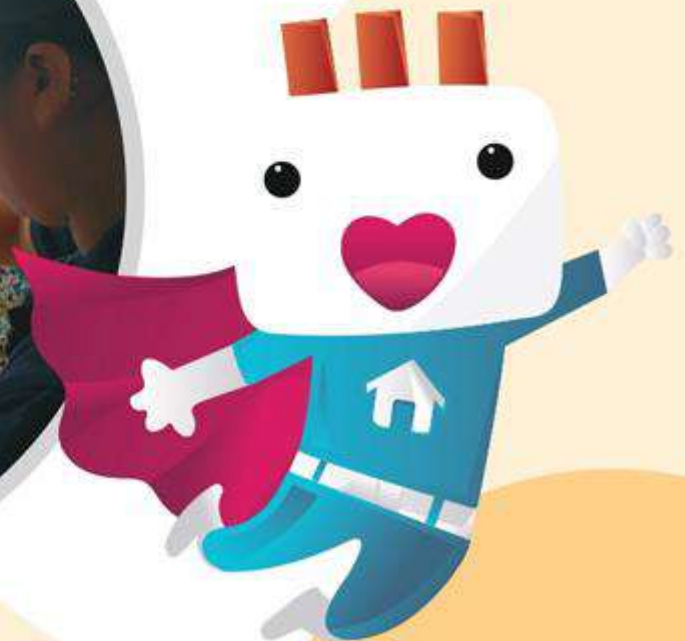

Vegetable Garden for the Community

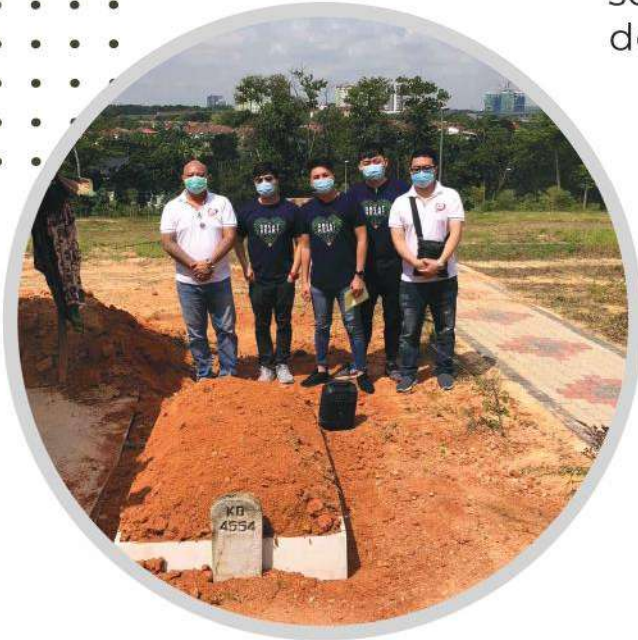
CNY CELEBRATION WITH GRACE HOME
