Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In quarter two of 2026, we supported 28 needy patients with chronic kidney disease from the low-income or unemployed group with dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,100 per month under our Dialysis Aid program, compared to 27 patients in the same period the year before, so that they could continue their treatment. From these 28 patients, 8 are new cases. Special thanks to Yayasan Kossan for their support this quarter.

Mdm Vigiyah, 43, mother of 3, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In May 26, as her DUN office aid application is still pending and she is still struggling financially, GHCA extend her dialysis aid until Aug 26 while she applies for treatment at NKF Seremban.

KAMARIAH BINTI RASUL

Mdm Kamariah, 41, mother of 5, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In May 26, her Zakat application failed, but her husband has found a new job. Thus, GHCA extended her dialysis aid until Aug 26 while their financials stabilise.



KOR KIANG PENG

Mr Kor, 64, father of 3, has hypertension, cataract, hyperlipidaemia, prediabetes, and kidney failure. In May 26, his family struggled to support his newborn grandchild. Thus, we extended his aid while he search for a cheaper dialysis centre.



MOHAMMAD RAZLI BIN RAMLIE

Mr Razli, 23, has kidney failure. His security guard father struggles to cover his dialysis fees. In Apr 26, he found a part-time warehouse job but still struggles for his treatment fees. Thus, GHCA continues his dialysis subsidy support until Jul 26.



NG LEE CHIN

Mdm Ng, 45, stroke patient with kidney failure, relies on JKM aid to care for her mother who has stage 3 colon cancer. Support for her dialysis treatment is still ongoing until Jul 26.



MUHAMMAD IBNIL SHAHIR

Mr Ibnil, 28, has kidney failure, hypertension, and heart blockage. In Jun 26, his heart condition has stabilised and he has resumed work. Thus, he no longer requires our support thereafter.



THENG CHON FAH

Mr Theng, 63, father of 1, freelance plumber, has hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. In May 26, his haemoglobin level dropped. As his JKM aid approval is still pending, GHCA extended his support until Aug 26.



DAYANGKU ZURAIDA KARIM

Mdm Dayangku, 40, mother of 5, has kidney failure and hypertension. In Apr 26, her health condition has not shown much improvement, and her other aid application is still pending. Support for her dialysis is still ongoing until Jul 26.

Mr Gnanasegaram, 69, father of 6, has multiple health issues. This quarter, his condition deteriorated and he was hospitalised for heart complications. Thus, GHCA extended his aid to Nov 26 to ensure continuity of treatment.



NOR AISYAH BINTI KARIM

Mdm Aisyah, 34, mother of 3, has high cholesterol, asthma, and kidney failure. She is still struggling to cater for her dialysis fees and related medical bills. Support for her dialysis treatment is still ongoing until Aug 26.



JOO HUI WAH

Mdm Joo, 57, widowed mother of 3, has hypertension, high cholesterol, and heart ailment. In Jun 26, her health has stabilised and is no longer in need of emergency assistance. Thus, GHCA concluded our support.



ESIWARY A/P BATUMALA

Mdm Esiwary, 51, grasscutter, mother of 3, has hypertension, high cholesterol, prediabetes, and kidney failure. In May 26, she is waiting for slot availability at a lower-cost dialysis centre. Thus, GHCA extends her dialysis aid until Nov 26.



EE AH CHAI

Mdm Ee, 84, mother of 1, has high cholesterol and kidney failure. Her hawker son struggles to feed his family of 5 and her dialysis fees. In Apr 26, Mdm Ee had unfortunately passed away, thus ending her support requirement.



SARAVANAN A/L RAMALINGAM

Mr Saravanan, 53, father of 1, has hypertension, heart disease, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Apr 26, his Iltizam aid has been approved. Thus, he no longer requires our support thereafter.



JAGATHEESAN A/L RAMANI

Mr Jagatheesan, 48, father of 3, has hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. In Apr 26, his Iltizam aid was rejected. Thus, GHCA extend his dialysis fee subsidy until Jul 26 while he waits for his other aid applications' processing.

MURUGAN A/L MUNIANDY

Mr Murugan, 79, has heart disease, hypertension, diabetes, and kidney illness. In Jun 26, he has successfully transferred to a dialysis centre near his home, and thus no longer requires our aid.



WOON CHUN HONG

Mr Woon, 32, has heart failure, visual impairment, and mobility issues. In Jun 26, he was hospitalised multiple times due to his health condition. While he actively searches for a job, we extended his dialysis aid until Sep 26.



TINA BINTI MOHAMAD YUSOFF

Mdm Tina, 52, has anaemia and kidney failure. Her husband struggles to support the household and her dialysis fees. As their financial situation has not improved, her dialysis aid was extended until Jul 26.



SARAS A/P PARAMASIVAM

Mdm Saras, 36, unemployed, has kidney failure and iron deficiency anaemia. In Apr 26, her condition is still unstable, requiring EPO and iron injections. Thus, GHCA extends her dialysis aid until Jul 26.



MOHAMAD FAHMI BIN SULAIMAN

Mr Fahmi, 50, divorcee with heart illness and kidney failure, is unable to work due to his condition. In May 26, he had unfortunately passed away, thus ending his support requirement.



IYAMPERUMAL A/L ANNAMALAI

Mr Iyamperumal, 76, father of 4, has kidney and heart illnesses and was our prior beneficiary. His security guard daughter struggles to cover his dialysis treatment after his MITRA aid ended. Thus, GHCA resume support for his dialysis treatment from Apr 26 onwards.



VALLI A/P SUBRAMANIAM

Mdm Valli, 34, unemployed, lost her left leg due to diabetes. Her family struggled to cover her dialysis fees after her government aid ended. Thus, GHCA provides her with dialysis aid while she waits for her other aid application processing.

TAN JIA XIN

Ms Tan, 23, began dialysis in Feb 26. She earned small income from lotus flower folding, while her father is being evaluated as potential kidney donor. To ease her burden, GHCA supported her dialysis until Sep 26.



LIONG CHOK

Mr Liong, 78, unemployed, has been on dialysis for a year. His wife is unwell and is not working. Their sole daughter struggles with multiple part-time jobs. Thus, GHCA subsidises his dialysis until Dec 26 to ease his burden.



LAW CHUI NGOR

Mdm Law, 79, began dialysis in Jun 25. Widowed and with a damaged heart valve, she lost her Madza and Tzu Chi aid in Jun 26. Her caregiver daughter struggled with fees, so GHCA provide her with dialysis subsidy until Dec 26.



TAN HONG BEE

Mr Tan, 70, a divorcee, has been on dialysis since Jan 25. Estranged from his children, he relies on his 66-year-old brother, who struggles with commitments. Thus, GHCA will subsidise his dialysis fees until Dec 26 to ease his burden



SARAVANAN A/L RAMAN

Mr Saravanan, 51, leg amputee, has been on dialysis since 2021. His haemoglobin recently dropped to a low level. He relies on his cleaner sister, while his 2 nephews began work after SPM to ease their burden. GHCA will subsidise his dialysis until Dec 26.



SANDARAN A/L SOMU

Mr Sandaran, 67, has been on dialysis since 2024. After partial toe amputation, he faces pain and mobility issues from severe leg swelling. Both he and his wife are unable to work, while his eldest son struggles to cover fees. GHCA will subsidise his dialysis until Dec 26.

Mr Low, 53, single, struggles to cover physio fees to recover from stroke. In May 26, he shows improvement and began practicing walking. GHCA extend his aid until Aug 26 as he heals.



ROY AK AJONG

Mr Roy, 36, father of 2, has autoimmune disease and epilepsy. In Jun 26, he remains bedridden. Support for his family in ongoing until Sep 26.



RAMANI A/P NADESON

Mdm Ramani, 59, widow, has cataract and kidney failure. She now relies on JKM aid after her muruku business failed. GHCA extend her aid to Aug 26 to ease her burden.



LEOW SWEE KIM

Mdm Leow, 66, widowed retiree, has vertigo, hypertension, and incontinence. In May 26, her health improves. GHCA extend her aid to Aug 26.

Mr Yeoh, 70, struggles for milk and diapers for his bedridden wife. In Apr 26, his wife's health shows improvement, and she can walk short distance with assistance. His aid is ongoing until Sep 26.



KRISHNA DEVI A/P KANNESAN

Mdm Krishna, 35, mother of 1, needed time to rebuild her life after her husband passed away in Jan 26. In May 26, she relocated back to her father's home and no longer requires our support.



CHIN MEE CHEN

Mdm Chin, 70, retiree with multiple health issues, cares for her stroke-stricken brother. In Apr 26, her JKM aid was approved. Her aid was extended to Aug 26, as she looks for elderly care options.



KUA HOCK SENG

Mr Kua, 51, struggled to care for his two disabled children after his wife passed away. In Jun 26, his diaper supplies application was approved. Thus, he no longer requires our aid.



TAN LING HWA

Mr Tan, 57, single, struggles with groceries after retiring. In Apr 26, he is actively looking for a job at food courts or restaurants. Thus, GHCA extended his aid until Jul 26 while he job hunts.

Mdm Senththamaray, 39, cashier, divorced mother of 2, faced severe financial strain due to her ex-husband's alcoholism. In Jun 26, after our initial grocery aid, she no longer required our support.

Mdm Noorhayati, 56, cleaner, single mother of 1, has multiple chronic health issues and struggles with rent. Medical travels to IJN and Hospital Melaka cause financial instability. Hence, GHCA provides her with rental support until Dec 26.

Mdm Supuleetchumy, 79, has hearing and mobility issues. She and her family relies on government aid. Facing financial strain, GHCA provides her with milk powder and diaper aid until Sep 26.

Mdm Zaharah, 67, kuih seller, mother of 3, cares for her unwell husband. She injured her limbs in an accident recently and struggled with groceries. GHCA provides her with grocery aid until Dec 26.



KRISHNAN A/L VELOO

Mr. Krishnan, 59, unemployed father of 4, needed dialysis and leg wound dressings. With his Iltizam aid ended and a heart-patient daughter to feed, GHCA provides him with grocery aid that will be transitioned to dialysis subsidies starting Jul 26.

Mr They, 79, taxi driver, struggles for his bedridden, stroke-surviving wife's nursing home fees. Lacking support for her costly medical supplies, GHCA provides medical aid until Sep 26.



MOHD NOR HIESYAM

Mr Hiesyam, 42, is the full-time caregiver for his bedridden wife, who has a stroke, heart issues, and a severe leg injury. Supported only by his sister's low storekeeper income, GHCA provides him with medical aid for his wife until Sep 26.



VIMALESHWARY CHANDRA SEGGRAN

Mdm Vimalleshwary, 42, widowed mother of 3, started a pasar malam food stall. As her earnings are unstable, GHCA provide grocery aid until Sep 26 to ensure her children have nutritious food.



PAVITHRA A/P PARAMASELVAM

Mdm Pavithra, 31, mother of 5, faced financial strain after her husband had an accident and was unable to work. GHCA provided her with grocery aid. In Jun 26, her husband has since resumed work and no longer requires our support.

Mdm Telargavathy, 69, single mother, cares for her mentally ill son. Age and poor health prevent her from securing stable employment, causing severe financial and emotional stress. Hence, GHCA provides grocery aid until Oct 26.

Mdm Habsah, 74, mother of 3, is bedridden with Parkinson's, hypertension, and high cholesterol. Her children are unemployed or earning unstably. We provide grocery and diaper aid until Oct 26.



DARIUS LIM HUNG YIT

Mr. Darius, 54, suffered a second stroke in Mar 26 and requires nursing home care. As his wife is the sole breadwinner facing high medical expenses, GHCA subsidises his rehabilitation until Jul 26.



TAN KAI YANG

Kai Yang, 19, is an MMU student with no family support following his mother's passing and his father's remarriage. GHCA provides rental assistance until Nov 26 to support his education.



SELVAKUMAR A/L A. PERUMAL

Mr Selvakumar, 49, faces severe strain after his workplace burnt down. With his adult children unable to assist and three younger children in a shelter, GHCA provides grocery aid until Nov 26.



SUBULETCHUMY A/P SURINA YANAN

Mdm Subuleetchumy, 55, divorced mother of 4, has severe joint pain, mobility issues, and thus unable to work to support her school-going children. Hence, GHCA provides grocery aid until Nov 26.



ER SOON KEONG

Mr Er, 42, father of 2, has stage 4 lung and spinal cancer. His breadwinner wife struggled to support their autistic child and a toddler. Hence, GHCA provides him with grocery aid until Nov 26.



ONG HOCK CHAI

Mr Ong, 64, single, had stage 4 lung cancer and required specialised milk during chemotherapy. Unfortunately, he passed away at the end of Jun 26, thus ending our support.

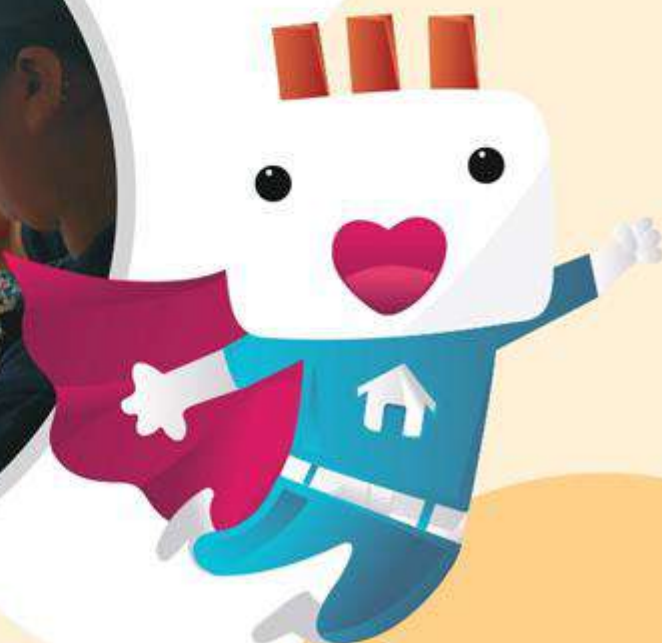

Classes for the Children

In the second quarter of 2026, 43 sessions of Malay and English classes were held at GHCC Klang under our Classes for the Children program, with 219 student slots being filled up. The attendance rate is at 84.16%, with 64.75% students recording improvements in the topics taught. Meanwhile, at GHCC Melaka, 14 sessions of Malay and English classes were conducted, with 91 student slots being filled up. Attendance rate is up at 59.33%, with 63.00% students recording improvements in the topics taught.

Vegetable Garden for the Community

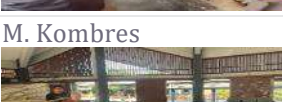
